HENNESSY COLT TOPS THURSDAY

An attractive son of Hennessy--Altair (Alydar) topped Thursday's session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale at \$1.1 million. He was purchased by Coolmore with Paul Shanahan, on the phone with Demi O'Byrne, doing the bidding.

"He's an absolutely beautiful horse--absolutely gorgeous," said Coolmore's Aisling Cross. "We had a fight on our hands to get him." Consignor Jim FitzGerald of FitzGerald/Keogh was thrilled with the result. "He's the best Hennessy I've ever seen," he enthused. "We had everyone on

him from pinhookers to racing people. The horse had been vetted more times than I've ever had a horse vetted. He's such a free-flowing horse--he has been out 60 times a day since he arrived and he has never turned a hair. He's a wonderful athlete and that is what they are buying these days--a big, physical athlete. I thought I was getting silly ideas at maybe a half-million, but when two guys hook up and they want something...it's like fine art, they have to have it. We are over the moon--delighted." From the family of Cannonade and Halo, the bay colt will head to Ballydoyle for his racing career. Late on Thursday, a pair of fillies by young sires hit the \$450,000 mark to share the honors as the day's highest-priced fillies. Hip 1342, from the first crop of MGISW Menifee (Harlan) and consigned by Nursery Place as agent, attracted the attention of Mr. and Mrs. Jerome Moss. Her dam, the Black Tie Affair (Ire) mare Madeira M'dear, is a half-sister to Moment of Hope. One of the last hips through the ring was a daughter of champion Real Quiet, another first-year sire; the bay filly was purchased by S. David Plummer. Viking Stud consigned the filly out of MSW Morris Code (Lost Code). Overall, the day's median was up against last year's number, with \$72,000 achieved this year to \$65,000 reached in 2001. After a day off today, the September Yearling Sale will resume Saturday morning at 10 a.m.

Bill Farish, Lane's End:

"I think overall things are going very well, although it's kind of down 30 percent across the board. Considering that, I think that everyone has readjusted their sights accordingly. If you haven't adjusted your reserves, then things are going to be rough. We have definitely had some surprises, on the upside and downside too. But you adjust and hopefully you get it right at some point, a few times anyway."

Bloodstock agent Mike Ryan:

"I think the sale has gotten stronger as it has progressed. I made a few excellent buys on Monday that I wouldn't have been able to get on Wednesday. Monday we had no idea how the sale was going to go, but it is better than I expected. Sellers seem to be readjusting their expectations and there has been great demand in the middle range--between \$150,000 and \$350,000. I am very encouraged. I think the sale is healthy. We bought a few and we have more to buy."

An impressive winner of the Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville Aug. 4, Loving Pride returned to the same track for the G3 Prix du Calvados Aug. 23 and finished a creditable fourth. She returned to winning ways here, at somewhat generous odds, to secure her first group race success in determined fashion and also provided jockey Ronan Thomas with his first group win. Thomas settled his filly behind the front rank in fourth place as High Praise made a vain attempt to lead from pillar to post. Loving Pride came under pressure when asked to challenge at the quarter-mile marker along with Welcome Millenium as High Praise found extra reserves from the front. The three fillies hooked up for a battle of classic proportions, but it was only in the final stride that Loving Pride ousted the hitherto unbeaten Welcome Millenium for the victory. Winning trainer Criquette Head-Maarek said: "She didn't run her race last time in the Calvados, but she showed her true quality here. I am also very happy because it is the first group race win for her jockey Ronan Thomas. Now we have no other choice but to go for the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp Oct. 6."

One of Luca Cumani's favourite charges, Boreas scored a first group win when winning the G3 Lonsdale S. at York Aug. 20 and he continued in similar form here with an impressive display to deny the ultra-game Persian Punch. Following instructions to the letter, jockey Jamie Spencer switched off the lights on Boreas as the Punch assumed his customary front-running tactics. The race began in earnest as the field turned for home and it was the binoculars which picked out Boreas as the likely winner from the quarter-mile marker. The homebred moved best of all at that point and it was only a matter of time before Spencer pressed the button. The cherub-faced jockey did so at the eighth pole and the result was settled in a matter of strides as Boreas stretched to the line for a convincing win. Winning trainer Luca Cumani said: "I was pretty confident that if he got the trip he would have too much speed for the others. I told Jamie to go to sleep and set his alarm for 7 a.m. at the two-furlong marker. The G2 Jockey Club Cup, at Newmarket Oct. 19, would be the obvious target for him now."

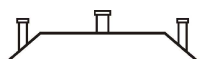

Successful on her debut in a maiden event at Newmarket July 19, Summitville returned to the same track to finish second in the Listed Sweet Solera S. Aug. 10, but she surpassed both of those efforts here to record a game first group success by leading from wire-to-wire. Michael Fenton sent Summitville to the front from flagfall and allowed his mount to bowl along on her own terms at the the head of affairs. Fenton asked the pacesetter for her effort approaching the final quarter-mile and the response was a positive one. She still held command at the eighth pole and was not to be denied in the latter stages by holding on in game style to safely account for the well-bred Approach. Winning trainer James Given said: "Now we can start dreaming of races like the G1 1000 Guineas and the G1 Vodafone Oaks. She got the mile really well here, but she's a long-striding filly, so Epsom would not be the ideal track for her. Maybe she would be better suited to The Curragh or Longchamp. She could now go for the [G1] Fillies' Mile at Ascot Sept. 28, or the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp Oct. 6."

The well regarded David Loder inmate was highly impressive when securing a hot Newmarket maiden Aug. 23, and the form was franked in no uncertain manner by second-placed Maghanim, who was very impressive in breaking his maiden Wednesday. The Sheikh Mohammed-owned juvenile is already quoted at 12-1 for Classic success next year and it will be something of a surprise if he fails to build on his burgeoning reputation. **Wizard of Noz** is well thought of by Jeremy Noseda and is a lively outsider based on his impressive three length success in a Haydock maiden July 20, and has a solid each-way chance. The consistent **Checkit** also holds place claims and had already placed in four stakes races before benefitting from a stewards decision to secure the G2 Maurice Lacroix Trophy at Baden-Baden Aug. 30. Wherever he finishes will provide a good formline for future events.

UPTURN CONTINUES AT DONCASTER

Doncaster Bloodstock Sales' managing director Henry Beeby heralded an, "unbelievably good trade" after the third day of the St Leger Yearling Sales. With a record median of 14,500gns and a 10.3-percent increase in average to 18,415gns, the session picked up markedly from Wednesday evening's slight dip. Of the 101 lots offered, 98 were sold, grossing 1,804,700gns, constituting a 11.4-percent increase from 12 months ago. Having accounted for the top lot on the second day, Primo Dominie (GB) dominated last night's session, being responsible for two of the three top-priced yearlings. Leading the way was hip 326, a half brother to the G2 Prix Robert Papin winner Never a Doubt (GB) (Night Shift). From the draft of Catridge Farm Stud, the yearling was purchased by BBA Ireland for 70,000gns. Cheveley Park Stud stepped in to secure hip 391, the top-priced filly of the session. By the Newmarket stud's current success story Pivotal (GB), whose presence was felt in Tuesday's Sales race thanks to the winning exploits of Somnus (GB), the daughter of multiple winner Noor El Houdah (Ire) from the consignment of Throckmorton Court Stud fetched 45,000gns. Beeby commented, "It was an unbelievably good trade and essentially made up the ground lost last night, with as strong a trade as we've seen for a while. They were a really excellent bunch of horses that brought everybody out. We're delighted to continue our bucking."
