LODER LOADED FOR BEAR

Fresh from saddling Almushahar to win Friday's G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster, trainer David Loder sends the unbeaten **Dublin (Ire)** (Carson City) into battle with \$6.4 million KEESEP yearling **Van Nistelrooy** (Storm Cat) in the G1 Aga Khan Studs National S. at The Curragh this afternoon. Following in the hoofsteps of stablemate Hawk Wing, Van Nistelrooy took the G2 Futurity S. Aug. 24 last time, albeit in less dramatic fashion. He had previously won a slowly run Listed Tyros S. at this track July 27 and gives the impression he will be better off a stronger pace. Dublin took a competitive renewal of the G3 Vintage S. at Goodwood July 31, beating subsequent Listed Acomb S. winner Bourbonnais (Ire) by 1 1/4 lengths and showing battling qualities that will stand him in good stead. The two help form a four-pronged attack from Ballydoyle that also includes **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill), winner of the G1 Phoenix S. over this track Aug. 11, as trainer Aidan O'Brien bids for his fifth renewal since 1996. Dermot Weld will be looking to the impressive Gowran maiden winner **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Salder's Wells) to provide him with his third National S. since '95, while John Oxx is bidding for this third edition since '93 with the Tipperary maiden scorer **Hanabad (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}).

GOING THE DISTANCE

Mandy's Gold (Gilded Time) had been farther than seven furlongs just once before, finishing first in the Gill Comely S. at a mile at Aqueduct in April of 2001. The chestnut filly was disqualified and placed second for drifting in during the stretch drive in that race, but she caused no trouble in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park yesterday, posting a rallying 2 1/4-length score. "I thought that if we could sit off it a little bit, things would work out," trainer Michael Gorham said. "[Jockey Jose Santos] did an excellent job of sensing the pace. He just sat back and did what he had to do." Gorham added that the four-year-old could try a little more ground in the future. "The Breeders' Cup [Distaff] is a possibility," he said. "That's why we wanted to stretch her out and get a feel...it looks like she could definitely get the distance." (*More on the Ruffian, p2*)

A GOLDEN GRADE I Mandy's Gold (Gilded Time), on the board in all 14 previous starts, had managed two wins in graded company, taking the June 8 GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. at Arlington and the Aug. 2 GIII Honorable Miss S. at Saratoga. The Virginia-bred tried a Grade I for the first time in her latest and was not disgraced, finishing third behind **Shine Again** (Wild Again) and **Raging Fever** (Storm Cat) after setting a fast pace in the seven-furlong GI Ballerina H. at the Spa Aug. 25. Last of five in the Ruffian as first favored Raging Fever and then **You** (You and I) led, the longshot in the field fought her way to the front at the eighth pole and drew clear. Raging Fever faded to last. Bollin Eric swept past Bandari in the straight and held off the late effort of Highest to give the North its first St Leger since Peleid (GB) in 1973. Recording his first success since taking a mile nursery over this course in September, the Tim Easterby-trained colt bounced back from a series of defeats in lesser class. But he had stayed on into third behind Bandari in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. last time at York Aug. 20, suggesting he would relish this extended 14 furlongs. Settled in fifth early as Mr Dinos (Ire) (Desert King {Ire}) set a generous pace, he always travelled strongly and was angled wide for his challenge inside the final half mile as Richard Hills committed Bandari. Lengthening past that rival with 500 yards remaining, he stretched out well from there to win handily. "I've been trying so long for an English Classic," said jockey Kevin Darley, "and for it to happen on one of Tim's for the North is brilliant. I wanted to ease out and give him a bit of room--he's a big long-striding horse. When he got out, he pricked his ears a little bit, but kept galloping all the way to the line." Easterby, whose uncle and father trained for the Westbrooks before him, commented, "This is the best ground he has run on all year and he really got the trip well. It's like a fairytale. When he was a foal, my father said he was unbelievable and we've never had any trouble with him. Vinnie Roe followed up his success in this contest last year with another convincing win from arch-rival Pugin. They enjoyed some thrilling battles last year, most notably in the Listed Ballycullen S. over this track in August, when Vinnie Roe had the call by a hard-fought head. Vinnie Roe has not stopped improving since, rattling off the double of Irish St Leger and G1 Prix Royal-Oak (French St Leger) before returning to take the Listed Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown May 30. He was a game neck runner-up to Royal Rebel (GB) in the G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot June 20, where the 2 1/2 miles proved too far, but bounced back to win the Listed Ballyroan S. at that track Aug. 18. This time, he settled in third travelling easily as Pugin was sent to the front by Johnny Murtagh. Asked to take closer order in the straight, he delivered a strong challenge to the long-time leader and passed him with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before asserting for the score. "This is a very brave horse, one of the toughest I have trained," said an elated Dermot Weld. "He goes into quarantine on Sunday for the G1 Melbourne Cup. He has matured mentally and physically since last year and his greatest quality is his battling quality. He has very similar credentials to Vintage Crop." Pugin may turn up for the rematch, according to trainer John Oxx, who said, "He has run a super race, but Vinnie Roe has that little extra turn of foot." The regally bred Pure Prize finally lived up to his heritage with this gallant score. An allowance winner at Belmont Park in his second start of the year May 22, the chestnut was favored in an off-the-turf allowance going a mile and three-eighths in the slop June 15, but finished a well-beaten third. Fifth as a 21-1 outsider in the GII Brooklyn H. next time out, the four-year-old bounced back to take a Saratoga allowance Aug. 10. Entered for the main track only in the Aug. 24 GIII Fourstardave H. last time, the colt finished well to be second when that race was indeed moved off the turf. Moderately backed this time, Pure Prize settled in third as Cigar S. winner There's Zealous (Broad Brush) and 2-1 favorite Abreeze (Danzig), runner-up in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. last time out, duelled on the front end. Those two tired down the lane, but the winner was full of run, taking the lead at midstretch and hanging on to beat Dollar Bill at the wire. "There are days when [Pure Prize] doesn't put his best race together, but when he does, he's capable of running a race like you saw today," said Buzzy Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey. "We'll have to think about the Breeders' Cup Classic now. At least it's an option. If we were to go, I think we'd go straight without a race before then." Abreeze tired to be fourth. "He gave me everything he had," jockey Richie Migliore said. Startac captured the GI Secretariat S. by a nose over a yielding Arlington course last August, but had not visited the winner's circle in his seven subsequent starts. The bay was off the board in the Oct. 13 GII Oak Tree Derby and the Nov. 25 GI Hollywood Derby to end his 2001 campaign, then came back after a five-month freshening to be third behind Ladies Din in a Hollywood allowance in April. Second to Skipping in the Jim Murray Memorial H. May 19, he then returned to graded-stakes company and failed to hit the board in his next three appearances. Last time out, the four-year-old finished a lackluster fifth in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga Aug. 10. The second choice facing a softer field this time, Startac sat a tracking fourth as Volponi cut out solid fractions, snuck up the rail in the stretch and drove past the pacesetter in the final yards for the score. As for the future, trainer Bill Mott said, "I guess maybe we'll look at the Breeders' Cup Mile--we'll have to see. There had been a question as to Boston Common's ability to handle a route--the three-year-old had been winless in five previous attempts beyond six panels--but there was no doubt yesterday as the bay led every step of Belmont's one-turn mile. He went back to sprinting after an eighth to War Emblem in the GII Illinois Derby Apr. 6, earning a victory in the GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup July 4. After getting caught up in a speed duel, he ran second in the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga Aug. 3, but followed with a solid second to Gygistar in the GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 24 and was sent off as the second choice. Breaking from the outside, he stumbled at the start, but quickly recovered to secure the lead and was able to set comfortable fractions. Jockey Jorge Chavez asked for more at the top of the stretch and Boston Common responded, drawing away from his rivals. "He's been getting some brutal paces and was putting some good horses away," said trainer Michael Pino. "I always wondered how tough this horse would be if he got a little bit of a breather. DONCASTER HAIL "BEST" SALE They thought it was the "best" catalogue they had offered, and based on the end of sale figures, Doncaster Bloodstock Sales had grounds for that belief as their St Leger Yearling Sale concluded with more records Friday night. Recording an increased total average (by 2.5 percent) and aggregate (by 9.4 percent) over last year's figures, DBS' flagship auction arrested the downward trend of the world's yearling sales so far in 2002. Of the 103 lots offered in Friday's session, 93 were sold, grossing 1,381,400 guineas. The median stood at 13,000 guineas, up from 10,000 guineas last year, and the average was up at 14,854 guineas, an increase from the 12,734 guineas recorded 12 months ago. Charlie Gordon-Watson went to 52,000 guineas to secure hip 423, the session's top-priced yearling, a colt by Danehill Dancer (Ire) out of Princess Leona (Ire) from the draft of Glenvale Stud. Tom Goff's Blandford Bloodstock gave 30,000 guineas for hip 422, the session's top-priced filly by Royal Applause (GB) out of Tea Colony (USA) from Camas Park Stud. "I can only say that we are absolutely delighted to have returned record breaking figures and well and truly bucked the downward trend that has been seen at virtually every other major yearling sale in the Northern Hemisphere this year," said Managing Director Henry Beeby. "We said at the start of the week that we would be supremely confident had there not been so many other negative factors around and that we would be satisfied to match last year's record breaking figures. To advance those is a real achievement and a testament to the increasing popularity of the St Leger Yearling Sales which has consistently improved in quality in recent years."

Smokin Beau may now run in the G3 World Trophy at Newbury Saturday before wintering in Dubai where he will be aimed at the G1 Golden Shaheen at the World Cup meeting.
