**REFUSE TO LOSE**

**Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), sent off at 7-1, defied both his inexperience and the Aidan O'Brien-trained 5-4 favourite **Van Nistelrooy** (Storm Cat) yesterday at The Curragh to provide trainer Dermot Weld with his fifth win in the G1 National S. Highly impressive in a seven-furlong Gowran maiden Aug. 14, Refuse to Bend showed he possessed adequate stamina and he used that strength yesterday to grab the initiative, galloping to the front approaching the furlong marker before holding the favourite on the run to the line. "He won well at Gowran when he was just a baby," Weld said. "The tactics worked out perfectly here and he stays well and the emphasis was on stamina. My only concern was whether he had the pace over seven furlongs." Held up in sixth early by Pat Smullen, the imposing colt took closer order past halfway as the pace started to increase. Always traveling strongly, he hit the front with a furlong remaining, where he was immediately challenged by Van Nistelrooy. Refuse to Bend relished the competition and quickened away from that rival, asserting in the final 100 yards for the score. "There is nothing flashy about him," Weld continued. "He is a tough, solid individual and a proper horse. Obviously, he will be trained for the G1 2000 Guineas [at Newmarket in May] and then the G1 Epsom Derby." Smullen added, "I like him. He quickened like a good horse and galloped all the way to the line." O'Brien, forced to withdraw **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill) with a fever, said of the runner-up, "We have had to be gentle on him, so there should be some improvement. I wouldn't rule out him running again this season." Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford said of third-place finisher **Dublin (Ire)** (Carson City), "He ran really well, but would have preferred a stronger pace throughout--he was doing all his best work at the finish. He might run again before going to Dubai for the winter, and we could step him up to a mile."

**PRIX VERMEILLE results cont.**

Having won the G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud June 30 from Ana Marie, Pearly Shells showed she was improving at an impressive rate with a victory in the G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville Aug. 25. She showed the same electric turn of acceleration to take this competitive contest in race-record time, shaving three-tenths of a second off the time achieved by Volvoretta (GB) two years ago. Not entered for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe here in three weeks' time, she would need to be supplemented if she is to take her chance, but also has the Breeders' Cup as an alternative. Settled in eighth early off the furious tempo set by the two rabbits headed by Blue Lightning (Fr) (Alzao), she traveled easily on the bridle on the approach to the straight as Ana Marie found space on the rail under Davy Bonilla. When the gap came, she quickened under a hand ride to catch that rival with 100 yards remaining before stretching out for a comfortable success. "This filly is just amazing--she's a very impressive filly," trainer Francois Rohaut said. "She doesn't stop improving from race to race, and after Deauville we took her home to Pau and she showed in her work that she had taken her last race in her stride. She knows how to quicken off a fast pace and stays well, but I didn't expect her to win like that as I was worried about the ground. We will see how she recovers, but she can go anywhere now. We have until the Thursday before the Arc to decide, and we will not commit ourselves now." Philippe Demercastel, trainer of Ana Marie, said, "I am not surprised she ran so well as she is a really nice filly. Maybe the ground was too firm, and she was also not really at the top of her game as we gave her a lot of time off. She will come back either in the Arc or the G1 Prix de l'Opera on the same afternoon." Elie Lellouche, trainer of Bright Sky, commented, "She was too keen early and too fresh. The royally bred Storm Flag Flying raced greenly while winning her Aug. 18 debut over six furlongs at Saratoga and was making her stakes debut in her second outing only after an allowance contest failed to fill. The filly raced just off the pacesetters before angling out three wide on the turn. She again raced greenly down the stretch, but put the field away with little encouragement in the final furlong. "I figured she'd show more speed stretching out from three-quarters to a mile, but I was even surprised with how much speed she had today," winning jockey John Velasquez commented. Of his trip in the race, Velasquez added, "I had to grab a hold of her down the backside. I wanted to be outside. I think that's the better part of the track. When I asked her for run at the top of the stretch, she took off. She switched her leads perfect, but she shied away from the whip. She's not used to being spanked. I got her back on her right lead. She was a lot better behaved horse today. She was a completely different horse today." Trainer Shug McGaughey, winning his third Matron in the race's last four runnings, said, "I wasn't surprised that she was that close today. I'm glad to see it. We can dictate a little bit more what's going on than when you have to come from so far out of it. Johnny said she was very aggressive away from the gate today. I kind of liked hearing that. It looks like now going a distance of ground, if she had to be, she could be on the lead."

Aquarelliste re-emerged on the scene with a return to form here and will now bid to go one better than her second-place finish behind Sakhee in last year's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. That day she met with her first defeat against a champion at his height. Winner of last year's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) and Prix Vermeille, the filly returned this year to capture the G1 Prix Ganay before a lackluster third when in season for the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 30. She was coming off a fourth-placing behind Golan (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27. Held up in fourth early by Dominique Boeuf, she traveled easily off a steady pace before making smooth progress on the outside on the final turn into the straight. Shaken up as Polish Summer (GB) (Polish Precedent) turned the contest into a two-furlong sprint, she quickened to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before comfortably holding the late effort of Anabaa Blue, who denied Falbrav the runner-up spot. "She will run in the Arc," proclaimed trainer Elie Lellouche. "She is really at home at Longchamp and was very relaxed today and quickened nicely." Owner Alec Wildenstein added, "I am convinced she will run a great race again there like last year. She might stay in training as a five-year-old and go to Dubai in March for the World Cup meeting. She will tell us when she has had enough."

He would have done more on a work morning at Les Aigles, but Sulamani came through this farcical affair with flying colors. In a shocking display of ineptitude on the part of Thierry Gillet, rider of Morozov, and Olivier Placais, who partnered Gulf News, the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) winner was never threatened in his G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe prep. As the trio broke from the gate, they immediately came down to a light canter while Parisians looked at each other incredulously, expecting a false start to be announced. After 2 1/2 furlongs, Sulamani strode past Gulf News to begin picking up the tempo to racing level. Never seriously troubled once he had been gifted a headstart by the proven stayer Morozov, he quickened all the way to the line for a facile score. "I understand very well that Mr. Fabre's horses do not have to set the pace for me, but the most important thing is that the best horse won," trainer Pascal Bary explained afterwards against the backdrop of booing and jeering from the crowd. "He showed he can do anything today as he had to lead for the first time, and I was very happy with the way he quickened. He doesn't need a lot of work and, in terms of a prep run, that was perfect. He is a very light horse, and we just have to keep him fresh and happy." The Niarchos Family's racing manager Alan Cooper added, "He learnt a lot today being in front and at least Thierry [Thulliez] had the gumption to go on. Irresistible Jewel got the better of Chorist after a prolonged battle to return to winning ways here. Having won a Naas maiden June 3, she was pitched in at the deep end in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot 17 days later and justified her connections' faith by beating Shadow Dancing (GB) by 3/4 of a length. She found the soft ground against her when only eighth behind Margarula (Ire) in the G1 Irish Oaks here July 14 and performed with credit to finish fifth behind Islington (Ire) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 21. Here she tracked Chorist in second under Pat Smullen as Pat Eddery set a generous pace. As the pair drew away to battle out the finish, it was Irresistible Jewel who had the call, gaining the upper hand at the furlong marker before asserting over her determined rival in game fashion. "She's a class filly and the ground was too soft on her last two runs," Weld said. Having witnessed an afternoon of trials for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, punters were unimpressed by the success of **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) in a slowly run G2 Prix Niel. Despite overcoming the adversity of lack of pace in the early stages, the Pascal Bary-trained colt remains the 5-2 joint-favourite with **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) for the mile-and-a-half contest in three weeks' time. **Pearly Shells (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), winner of the G1 Prix Vermeille, was cut from 33-1 to 14-1, while G2 Prix Foy winner **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill {USA}) is 7-1 from 14-1.
