MR. GREELEY FILLY BESTS MONDAY SESSION

A filly by hot sire Mr. Greeley drew the highest bid since Friday's 'dark day' when Reiley McDonald, acting on behalf of Betty Moran's Brushwood Stable, went to \$485,000 to secure the second foal of Group 1-stakes producer Star of Paris (Dayjur) at yesterday's seventh session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington.

Part of the Three Chimneys Sales consignment, the half sister to G1 Prix Morny winner Elusive City (Elusive Quality) outdistanced 275 other yearlings offered Monday, but proved the biggest bargain according to McDonald.

"I think if she had sold last Monday or Tuesday [during the select sessions], when all the top buyers were here, she would have sold for a lot more than she did today--maybe closer to a \$1 million," said McDonald. The filly will be broken in the United States and it is still uncertain whether the bay will remain in the U.S. or head overseas to race in Europe. Based on a, "last minute decision by Mrs. Moran" to buy the filly, an enthused McDonald added, "She had the most beautiful walk you have ever seen on a filly." The seventh session concluded on a high note with both average (up four percent) and median (up 16.7 percent) improving over one year ago. The number of unsold yearlings dropped by a third from last year and McDonald pointed to the middle market for a possible explanation. "In this middle range--\$30,000 to \$80,000--there are a lot of people to participate. It seems like there are a lot of people on each horse." The sale's eighth session begins today at 10:00 a.m.

PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Just as the Greeks used to say that one swallow doesn't make a summer, one successful horse bred to a particular pattern doesn't necessarily mean that more will follow. There was nothing very summery about the weather when Whywhywhy took the GI Futurity S., but his victory was the equivalent of a second swallow winging its way home, showing the way for others to follow.

Whywhywhy, who ranks alongside Sky Mesa as a potential leader of his generation, is by the increasingly impressive Mr. Greeley out of a mare with Mr. Prospector in the third generation of her pedigree. He's therefore inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector, with the first line coming through a fast son of Gone West. Across the Atlantic in Europe, another Group 1-winning juvenile colt, the Prix Morny winner Elusive City, is also inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector and he too is by one of Gone West's exciting stallion sons, Elusive Quality.

Whywhywhy's latest success means that Mr. Greeley has sired at least one Grade I winner in each of his first four American crops, the colt's predecessors being El Corredor, Celtic Melody and Nonsuch Bay. This is a very praiseworthy achievement by the Spendthrift stallion, even allowing for the fact that each of these four crops is quite large, containing at least 76 named foals. There was even a Group 1 winner, Miss Kournikova, in Mr. Greeley's only Australian crop, born in 1997.

Altogether this is pretty good going for a horse who himself contested only one Grade I contest during a 16-race career. Of course, that Grade I contest was no less a race than the Breeders' Cup Sprint and Mr. Greeley very nearly won it at odds of over 31-1, after showing his customary early speed to battle for the lead with Desert Stormer throughout the six furlongs.

It has to be significant that Whywhywhy is the second of Mr. Greeley's Grade I winners with a pedigree featuring 3x4 inbreeding to Mr. Prospector. The Cigar Mile H. winner El Corredor, who now commands a stud fee of \$20,000, is bred on a similar pattern to Elusive City in that they both have broodmare sires who are out of Mr. Prospector mares.

It is always very tempting to inbreed to any stallion of Mr. Prospector's vast achievements, which include nearly 180 stakes winners. Well over 100 of his progeny became group or graded winners, with more than 40 of his progeny scoring at the highest level. Add to this a splendid record as a sire of sires and an enviable reputation as a first-rate broodmare sire and the temptation to inbreed becomes fairly compelling.

On the other hand, breeders--especially those breeding for the sales ring--must be concerned that close inbreeding will produce youngsters embodying Mr. Prospector's faults, and not just his virtues. Tony Morris, in his *Thoroughbred Stallions* book, commented that Mr. Prospector's stock "come in all shapes and sizes, and they come with physical faults which most judges would regard as unacceptable in the progeny of any normal stallion. They are plain about the head, they have crooked legs--many, like their sire, turn their off-fore out--and they have small feet." He could have added a tendency for a rather straight hind-leg.

Remember too that Mr. Prospector's own racing career was interrupted by an off-putting catalog of problems. Apparently he came back shin sore whenever he was worked at two and consequently didn't race at that age. His three-year-old campaign came to a premature end when he chipped a fetlock and his career ended at four when he fractured a sesamoid.

Although the field of the Polla included three Grade 1 winners, Peasant had enough background to be considered a tough contender. This was his just his third start and first try in a graded event, but he had won the June 3 Listed Julio Penna S. by nine lengths and then notched a tough allowance win by six lengths July 20. Taken slowly and carefully, his connections always had this race in mind. Peasant was away in good order in mid-pack as the pacesetting Loes Joy (Arg) sped through sharp fractions. As that one started to weaken entering the stretch, Peasant dug in gamely and edged clear from the tightly bunched field for the determined win. His next race should be the G1 Jockey Club S. in 30 days.

 Balance of Game earned his third graded stakes success in this contest, a prep race for G1 Kikuka Sho at Niigata Oct. 20. The three-year-old won last year's G3 Niigata Nisai S. in track-record time and finished fourth in G1 Asahi Hai Futurity S. in December. This year, he won the G2 Yayoi Sho in March, but finished a disappointing eighth in G1 Satsuki Sho in April before finishing seventh in the Japanese Derby in May. Breaking from the outside draw, the bay was well controlled by Katsuharu Tanaka, gained command in mid-stretch and drew clear of the favored Admire Max by 1 1/2 lengths.

Settled off the pace under Mikio Matsunaga, the Danehill filly took control turning for home and widened the margin to three lengths under the wire. Matsunaga said of the winner, "She was not relaxed in the first stage of the race, but she responded strongly in the stretch."

Breeders are going to inbreed to him, though, sometimes partly of necessity because his blood is so widespread. Expect the Fappiano branch to figure prominently. Fappiano's son Cryptoclearance has several stakes winners inbred 3x3 to Mr. Prospector, including that very good juvenile filly Strategic Maneuver, and Quiet American, another of Fappiano's sons, has sired Warrior Queen, a fast Irish filly who is inbred 3x3 to Mr. Prospector. (Quiet American's best representative, Real Quiet, is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector's sire Raise A Native). Quiet American is also the broodmare sire of Whywhywhy.

It is tempting to attribute Whywhywhy's excellence to the inbreeding in his pedigree, especially as he is out of a mare, Thorough Fair, who was claimed for \$5,000 and who earned only \$7,747 despite winning three times. However, Thorough Fair was bred to be better than an ordinary claimer. Her dam, the triple winner Very Fair, was bred by King Ranch and sold for \$165,000 as a yearling in 1982.

Although Very Fair didn't earn black type, she held her value fairly well, selling for \$125,000 in 1989. This reflected the achievements of several of her relatives during the 1980s. Her half sister Spur Wing (by Storm Bird) won the G3 Carousel H. in 1988, the same year that another half sister, the Roberto filly Make Change, was runner-up in no fewer than four Grade I events, including the CCA Oaks and Alabama S.

Whywhywhy's fourth dam Fairness, produced the very good seven-furlong horse No Bias before doing even better with her Nijinsky II colt Solford, winner of the G1 Eclipse S. in 1983. Fairness was herself a half sister to the very good performers Saidam, Heartland and Prove Out, so this is an excellent family. It remains very effective and nearly completed a Grade I double last weekend. Very Fair's half sister Spur Wing is the second dam of Highest, a creditable second in the St Leger.
