COMIC STRIP COLT TOPS KEENELAND DAY 8

A colt from the first crop of MGSW Comic Strip (Red Ransom) fetched a session-topping bid of \$250,000 as the Keeneland September Yearling Sale marched into its second week yesterday in Lexington, Kentucky. Hip number 2762, consigned by Lane's End, agent, was purchased by Jimmy Gladwell III. The bay is out of MGSW Chapel of Dreams (Northern Dancer), a half sister to Storm Cat, and he is a half brother to SP Seeking the Dream (Seeking the Gold). Hip number 2637, a daughter of Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet (Quiet American) out of Silver Chance (Silver Buck), a full sister to Derby winner Silver Charm, was the top-priced filly of the session. The dark bay yearling was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent, and Aki Kato, agent, made the final bid of \$105,000. Through eight sessions, the average sale price is \$98,291--down 23 percent from the same period last year. The median remained steady at \$50,000. The buy-back rate is 24 percent, bettering last year's figure of 28 percent. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

ALL'S FAIR

Fair Mix (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}) secured his first group victory with a cozy win at the expense of renowned international traveler Jim and Tonic (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}) in the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte Tuesday afternoon. Unraced as a juvenile, Fair Mix only made two starts as a sophomore, but one of those was a successful one at Saint-Cloud last December. This season has been his busiest to date, with two handicap successes at Longchamp the platform for promotion to stakes company, where he has won the Listed Prix de Reux at Deauville Aug. 6 and finished third in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville Aug. 25. Fair Mix was settled in a close second as Italian challenger Sunstrach (Ire) (Polar Falcon) cut out the early running, but came under pressure approaching the final furlong. Jockey Stephane Pasquier sent the eventual winner into the lead at the eighth pole and Fair Mix was always holding the vain bid of Jim and Tonic thereafter to score in comfortable fashion. "He will not run in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe as the race will be too good for him and I wouldn't want to ask too much of the horse too early," said winning trainer Marcel Rolland. "He will probably go for the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris at Longchamp Oct. 20, a track where he always runs well."

The most recent weekend was a significant one for Storm Cat. Not only was he responsible for Grade I winner Storm Flag Flying and Grade II winner Pure Prize, but two of his freshman sire sons--Stormy Atlantic and Tale of the Cat--were represented by their first stakes winners. Storm Flag Flying and Pure Prize--both owned and bred by the Phippses and both trained by Shug McGaughey--are both first time stakes winners, taking Storm Cat's tally for the year to 15 (including seven two-year-old stakes winners) and his lifetime total to 104, of which 66 have been graded.

Storm Flag Flying had acted up in the paddock and had run extremely greenly when winning a six-furlong maiden at Saratoga on her debut. She still showed signs of inexperience in the Matron, but that didn't prevent her drawing off to win by nearly 13 lengths. This performance shot Storm Flag Flying to the leadership of her division, a position she will attempt to consolidate in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, with a possible shot at the GI Frizette S. en route.

Both of Storm Flag Flying's parents contested their respective Breeders' Cup Juvenile events. Storm Cat was beaten inches in the Juvenile by Tasso, but Storm Flag Flying's dam My Flag captured the GI Juvenile Fillies after finishing third in the GI Matron and second in the GI Frizette. My Flag added to her laurels at three with four more graded-stakes victories, including the GI Coaching Club American Oaks, GI Ashland S. and GI Gazelle H.

My Flag's sire, the short-lived Easy Goer, started as an odds-on favorite for the 1988 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but failed to handle an off track and finished second to Is It True. My Flag's dam Personal Ensign might well have started favorite for the 1986 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies had she not fractured a hind pastern in a workout two weeks after capturing the GI Frizette S. on only her second outing. Remarkably, Personal Ensign returned with five screws in her leg to campaign at three and four, eventually compiling a 13-for-13 record which made her the first North American runner to complete an undefeated career at the highest level since Colin in 1908. The last of those victories came in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, where despite disliking the muddy track and looking, in the words of her trainer "hopelessly beaten," at the three-eighths pole, she caught Winning Colors in the very last stride.

Like her daughter and granddaughter, Personal Ensign bore the Phipps colors and this female line has been in the Phipps family ever since the purchase of Personal Ensign's granddam Dorine for \$125,000 in the early 1970's. A champion sprinter in Argentina, Dorine was bred on the same Aristophanes/Advocate cross as Forli. She proved an instant success for the Phippses as her first foal in the U.S. was the multiple stakes-winning sprinter Our Hero and her second was the Hoist the Flag filly Grecian Banner, the dam of Personal Ensign and of her brother Personal Flag, winner of several stakes including the GI Widener H. and GI Suburban H. and now a successful sire standing in New York.

Personal Ensign has turned out to be every bit as important as a broodmare as she was a runner. Her first foal was the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup victor Miner's Mark (by Mr. Prospector). Her second foal, the late-closing sprinter Our Emblem, produced his best effort when a close second in the GI Carter H.; he is sire of this year's GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. winner War Emblem. Storm Flag Flying's dam My Flag is Personal Ensign's fourth foal and her next two foals--brothers to Miner's Mark and Our Emblem--are graded-stakes placed Proud and True, and the 2001 GI Oaklawn H. hero Traditionally. After foaling Traditionally, Personal Ensign missed two years, but then produced the current two-year-old filly Possibility, a daughter of A.P. Indy.

My Flag herself is also wasting little time in making her name at stud. Storm Flag Flying is only her second foal, and her first foal was Storm Flag Flying's full-sister On Parade, who finished third in last year's GIII Valley Stream S.

My Flag is inbred 3x4 to Buckpasser, but Storm Flag Flying has a far more outcrossed pedigree, as her nearest duplication is a 5x5 cross of Native Dancer. That said, Storm Cat was an extremely logical mate for My Flag. My Flag is a granddaughter of Alydar, and Storm Cat has sired at least eight stakes winners out of mares by Alydar and his sons, including Grade I winners November Snow, Cat Thief, Catinca and Aldiza. Personal Ensign is out of a mare by Private Account, broodmare sire of three graded-stakes winners by Storm Cat. Storm Flag Flying's third dam Grecian Banner is by Hoist the Flag, broodmare sire of three Storm Cat stakes winners, including Grade I winner Sardula.

REAL QUIET TO TAYLOR MADE **Real Quiet** (Quiet American--Really Blue, by Believe It), winner of the 1998 Kentucky Derby, will stand the 2003 breeding season at Taylor Made Farm near Nicholasville, Kentucky. The seven-year-old stallion stood last season at Vinery Kentucky for \$15,000. His first foals are yearlings this year. Real Quiet stood at Vinery under a three-year management agreement which expires at the end of the 2002 Southern Hemisphere breeding season. No 2003 stud fee has been announced.

LORD AVIE PENSIONED **Lord Avie** (Lord Gaylord--Avie, by *Gallant Man), champion two-year-old of 1980 and the sire of 74 stakes has been pensioned at Lane's End Farm, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The 24-year-old stallion began his stud career at Spendthrift Farm and has been at Lane's End since 1989. Lord Avie won the 1980 GI Champagne S. and GI Young America S. and the 1981 GI Florida Derby. Among his 23 group or graded stakes winners are, Magical Maiden, Fly for Avie, Metamorphose, Pigricia, Witchful Thinking, Feasibility Study, Ode, Avies Copy, Avie's Fancy, Avie's Gal, Bungalow and Boyce.
