SKY JACK UNDERGOES SURGERY

Sky Jack (Jaklin Klugman), winner earlier this year of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, will be sidelined for six months after undergoing surgery to remove bone chips from his right knee. The six-year-old, undefeated in five career starts and a three-time graded winner at Holly-

wood, also underwent arthroscopic surgery on the same knee in January 2001, causing him to miss that entire season. "He's a tough old horse who's already made one comeback from surgery and I'm confident he'll be able to do so again," Dr. Wayne McIlwraith, who performed the procedure, told


Thoroughbred Times. Also the winner of the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. this campaign, Sky Jack was last seen when a distant 11th behind Came Home in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 25.

BOOKEND TOPPERS AT KEENELAND

Horses which sold at either end of yesterday's ninth session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale led the proceedings with a colt from the first crop of GI Haskell Invitational winner Menifee (Harlan) taking down top honors at \$120,000. Followed through the ring by just five horses, the bay, consigned to the sale by Highclere Sales, agent, was purchased by M & M Racing. The May 17 foal is out of the unraced mare Moon Gem (Kris S.) and hails from the female family of three-time Grade I winner Tallahto. Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud, acting as agent, consigned the afternoon's second highest-priced offering. Cataloged at hip number 2987, the bay colt by Souvenir Copy--Pristine Princess (Alydar) was hammered down to Centreville Stable for \$110,000. The New York-bred is kin to GSW and track record setter Very Special Lite, the dam of Strategic Partner, winner of the GIII Crown Royal American Turf in 2001. Wednesday's session was a solid one statistically, with increases in the average and median and a sharp decline in RNAs from a year ago. With three days remaining in the sale, cumulative gross receipts and average are down markedly while the median is just slightly off from last year.

MILLENNIUM WIND TO MILLENNIUM FARMS

Millennium Wind (Cryptoclearance--Bali Babe, by Drone), a leading three-year-old of 2001, has been sold and will enter stud next year at Millennium Farms in Kentucky. A stud fee has not yet been set. Purchased by David and Jill Heerensperger for \$1.2 million at the 1999 Keeneland September sale, the dark bay colt broke his maiden at first asking before finishing second to Point Given in the GI Hollywood Futurity. The winner of the GII Santa Catalina S. to begin his sophomore season, the half brother to 1999 Kentucky Derby winner Charismatic and Tossofthecoin was second in the GII Louisiana Derby prior to a front-running success in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. A 9-1 chance in the Kentucky Derby, he could do no better than 11th place behind Monarchos. Plagued by a tendon problem, which ultimately led to his retirement, Millennium Wind made just one start after the Derby resulting in a seventh-place finish in the Skywalker H. at Santa Anita last Nov. 2. He enters stud with a lifetime record of 7-3-2-0 and earnings of \$769,920.

LIT DE JUSTICE TO CALIFORNIA Champion sprinter **Lit de Justice** (El Gran Senor--Kanmary {Fr}, by Kenmare) will stand the 2003 breeding season at Magali Farms near Santa Ynez, California, after being purchased from Frank Stronach's Adena Springs Kentucky near Midway. He will stand for a fee of \$7,500 live foal. "He's going to be one of the best horses to come to California in many years," Tom Hudson, manager of Magali Farms, told *Thoroughbred Times*. "We started looking for a stallion and we were very fortunate to have gotten [Lit de Justice]. It can be tough to pull a stallion of his quality out of Kentucky." From three crops of racing age, the 12-year-old stallion is the sire of 66 overall winners, three of those stakes winners, including Mike Lee S. winner No Parole, English Listed stakes winner Sir Edwin Landseer and Lit A Fire. The former was most recently third in the GII Jerome H. Sept. 14. The winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint en route to his Eclipse Award in 1996, Lit de Justice won 10 of his 36 career efforts for earnings of \$1,397,874.

AFFIRMED SUCCESS GETTING A BREAK Treble Grade I winner **Affirmed Success** (Affirmed), who has bankrolled over \$2 million during his five years at the racetrack, has been turned out at owner Albert Fried's farm in Westchester County, New York, his career in limbo. The eight-year-old gelding, winner this year of the GI Carter H. at Aqueduct, exited his second-place effort to Left Bank in the GII Tom Fool H. July 4 "tired and worn out" according to trainer Richard Schosberg. "He wasn't acting like himself," the conditioner said. "We sent him to Cornell University for a full exam and he cleared it fine. He's going to get a little more R & R. If we bring him back and he doesn't have that fire, then we'll call it a career. I couldn't be happier with him going out a Grade I winner if this is his last year in training."

Repent Works Towards JC Gold Cup:

Select Stable's **Repent** (Louis Quatorze), a multiple graded-stakes winner at two and three, worked five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 over the Belmont main track Sunday morning and is on track to make his next start in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at the New York oval Sept. 28. Sidelined off his runner-up finish in the GII Illinois Derby Apr. 6, Repent returned to action in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 24, just failing to catch Medaglia d'Oro in the final strides. "I thought about just training him to the Breeders' Cup, but he is doing so well right now that he'll go in the Gold Cup" trainer Ken McPeck said. "That work the other day was solid. I'll probably work him again Saturday or Sunday."

Brew Makes Frankel Double Tough:

GI Santa Anita H. hero **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again), who along with stablemate **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) figure to be the top two choices in the Gold Cup, worked six furlongs yesterday morning over the Belmont main track in 1:13 3/5 with blinkers on. Trainer Bobby Frankel toyed with the idea of adding that piece of equipment for the race itself, but has apparently decided against doing so. "I was thinking about [putting blinkers on him], but I'm not going to do it," the Hall of Fame conditioner explained. "I don't necessarily want him closer, but you have to ride him to keep him in the race. It's always a hard decision when to put the blinkers on and when not to." The late-running five-year-old was most recently a hard-charging third to Came Home in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 25. Jockey Kent Desormeaux will fly in for the ride.

WRITERS UP

THE HEARD MENTALITY By Frank Carlson

In 1938, the year trainer Tommy Heard, Jr. won his first stakes race, Franklin Delano Roosevelt was president. A dozen men have held the office since. On Aug. 10, 2002, Lawbook won the first leg of the Florida Stallion S. and put Heard's name in the history books, giving his conditioner a stakes win for the eighth straight decade and moving him past the legendary Hall of Fame trainer Sunny Jim Fitzsimmons, who won stakes in seven decades.

Asked how he was able to accomplish the feat, Heard said, "That's easy. I've lived longer than anyone else."

Heard's early years were spent on his father's ranch in Refugio, Texas. His father bred and raced horses in Texas, and Heard got his first taste of the sport.

"I loved working with my dad," Heard said from Calder, his base of operations for the last 20 years.

Just to have something to fall back on, Heard studied journalism at the University of Texas. But when his father moved his operation to the New England circuit after racing was outlawed in Texas in the 1930s, Heard packed up and went along.

"Other than spending some time in the service for World War II, I've never been away from racing," said the 84-year-old trainer.

In 1938, his father retired and turned his stock over to his son.

"He went back to Texas to take care of his trucking business, and I inherited a stable," Heard said with a twinge of Texas still in his voice.

His first stakes winner was Be Blue, won the \$5,000 Commonwealth H. at Suffolk Downs in 1938. Another horse Heard inherited from his father was Boysy, who would win a combined total of \$125,000 on the New York circuit and equaled a track record at Belmont. Boysy's other claim to fame was that he raced against Whirlaway in 1941, albeit with very little luck.

Over the years, Heard successfully campaigned his public stable in New England, New York, New Jersey and Chicago. But he had the idea that if he opened a training center in the Miami area, he could work all his horses at his own pace and entertain his owners. Thus, Heardsdale Training Center came into existence.

"I thought it could be a place where you could have fun and everyone could see their horses," Heard said.

It turned out to be less fun that Heard anticipated.

"With a public stable, I had as many as 25 owners at one time and that was no fun," he recalled. "You don't have any time for yourself. It was like having a lot of bosses."

He sold the property in 1973.

"I got rid of all my owners except for Caesar Kimmel, who was a very good friend," he said.

Looking for a change of pace, Heard packed up and headed for Southern California in 1976, where he was leading owner at Hollywood Park his first year. But, after three years, Heard moved back to South Florida and Calder, where he's been ever since.

Since returning to Florida, Heard has been into breeding his own horses, although he does reach into a sale occasionally and pick out something.

"I used to claim horses, but most of the times you are getting someone else's trouble," he explained. "If you start with yearlings, you get something that can turn out good."

Heard's eight decades of stakes success is not the only record he has set. His Built For Pleasure, who won the Sapling S. at as a juvenile, went off at 143-1 in the 1996 Fountain of Youth at Gulfstream Park. Up against the likes of Unbridled's Song, Skip Away and Editor's Note, Built For Pleasure shocked the crowd and paid \$288.20.

Lawbook, who heard purchased privately, won the second leg of the Florida Stallions S. Aug. 31 and is in line to sweep the series if he can win the last leg on Oct. 12. Only four other horses have been able to accomplish the feat: Smile (1984), Naked Greed (1991), Seacliff (1995) and Express Tour (2000).

Heard keeps talking about reducing his stable to five or six horses, but he doesn't seem to be able to make the break. He currently has 12 horses in training and six broodmares.

As Woody Stevens used to say, "You can't retire when you have a good two-year-old."
