“BON” CHANCE

A winner in four of his last five starts, **Bonapaw** (Sabona) looks for his fifth stakes win of the year in the GI Vosburgh at Belmont Park today. After winning a

pair of Fair Grounds stakes to start 2002, the six-year-old flew to Nad al Sheba, but failed to fire in the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and finished sixth behind Caller One. “Dubai was a fiasco,” said trainer Norman Miller III, who saddled the gelding for the first time in that

race. “An hour before you run, they pick you up in a van. It’s about four or five miles to the track and the van’s running over speed bumps. He washed out and then, in the paddock, he washed out again. He was trying to flip. But at least we made it there and back in one piece.” Bonapaw was given a three-month break after that experience, returning to finish fourth in the July 4 Iowa Sprint H. He got back on track with a victory in the July 20 GIII Hanshin H. going a mile at Arlington Park before cruising to a 4 1/2-length score in the six-furlong Arlington Park Sprint H. last time out Aug. 24. In order to beat Bonapaw, **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector) will have to get over his habit of running second. The four-year-old has been runner-up in nine of his 14 career starts and comes into this race on a four-race streak of seconditis. The bay was most recently 2 1/4 lengths behind Orientate in the Sept. 1 GI Forego H. at Saratoga with Pat Day aboard for the first time. “Pat learned something from riding him the other day,” trainer Bobby Frankel said. “He inched him into the race instead of sitting back and making one run. ZAFEEN TAKES MILL REEF

Zafeen (Fr) (Zafonic) justified confident market support to record his first stakes success in yesterday’s G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury. Having taken his maiden at Salisbury July 26, he was pitched in at the deep end in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 25 and ran with great credit, finding only the impressive Elusive City 3/4 of a length too strong there. Dropped in class here, trainer Mick Channon’s self-proclaimed “best” nevertheless appeared to have a stiff task against some sharp juveniles. But, settled in second early, Zafeen struck the front with 500 yards remaining and held sway for a comfortable score. “He’s a smashing horse and there’s plenty more to come,” commented Channon. “I’ll have to speak to [owner Jaber Abdullah] about it, but he’s in the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 3] and I’d be very keen to have a go at that.” Bookmakers William Hill remained unconvinced of the winner’s Classic credentials afterwards, quoting him at odds of 33-1 for next year’s G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in May. **Cassis** (Red Ransom), who stayed on well to be third, received the same quote for the fillies’ version. **Click for the racingpost.com chart or the brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree.**

SAKHEE LIKELY TO MISS ARC Trainer Saeed bin Suroor yesterday issued an upbeat bulletin on last year's International Classifications highweight **Sakhee** (Bahri), but appeared to rule the five-year-old out of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. Godolphin have the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden winner **Marienbard (Ire)** (Caerleon) entered for that mile-and-a-half contest, clearing the way for Sakhee to contest the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19. "[Sakhee] worked yesterday and worked very well," bin Suroor said of last year's Arc hero. "I can see that his action over the last two days is different and because of that we have to be patient and give him more time before we decide where to run him. I have to speak to Sheikh Mohammed and Sheikh Hamdan, but the plan is to run him in the Champion."

ELUSIVE MAY HAVE ARLINGTON DATE **Elusive City** (Elusive Quality) may run in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Arlington Park Oct. 26, connections revealed to the *Racing Post* yesterday. Having taken the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30, the Gerard Butler-trained colt maintained his unbeaten record when defeating yesterday's G2 Mill Reef S. winner Zafeen (Fr) by 3/4 of a length in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 25. He may meet that rival again in the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Oct. 3 before a crack at the dirt contest, according to Willie Carson, European racing manager for owners The Thoroughbred Corporation. He told the *Post*, "At this stage, we're taking it one race at a time, and we'll see what happens first in the Middle Park. However, he's a very sound, big and strong colt who is likely to be suited by the dirt--his first race was on the polytrack at Lingfield--so there's certainly no reason why he shouldn't go to the Breeders' Cup."

PENULTIMATE SESSION AT KEENELAND A colt by Elusive Quality and a filly by Wolf Power (SAf) each brought bids of \$95,000 to top the penultimate session of the Keeneland September Sale in Lexington yesterday. The colt, out of stakes winner Nasty But Worth It (Nasty and Bold), was consigned by Forbush Farm, Agent IV, and purchased by Cam Allard. He is from the family of Canadian champions La Lorgnette and Thornfield and G1SW Hawk Wing. The filly, out of Cornish Image (Cornish Prince), was from the consignment of James M. Herbener, Jr., Agent IV. She was purchased by Tee Time Farm. Taylor Made Sales Agency, the second-leading consignor at yesterday's session, is the leading consignor overall at the sale. With just one session left to go, Taylor Made has sold 253 yearlings for a gross of \$25,313,100 and an average of \$100,051. Lane's End is second after selling 140 yearlings for a gross of \$20,448,600 and an average of \$146,061. The 12-day auction ends today, with the final session beginning at 10 a.m.

The consistent **The Judge Sez Who**, on the board in 14 of his 15 career dirt starts, was just a length and three-quarters behind Magic Weisner and Wiseman's Ferry when third in the GII Ohio Derby July 20, then rallied to be second by a neck to Wiseman's Ferry in the Aug. 10 GIII West Virginia Derby. The late-running bay got up for the victory in his latest, taking the Aug. 25 GIII Oklahoma Derby. The \$10,000 OBSAUG yearling has now earned \$505,876. New York-bred **Private Emblem** won his first three starts of the season, including the Apr. 13 GII Arkansas Derby, but never got untracked and finished 14th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Given a short break after his abortive Triple Crown campaign, the dark bay came back against state-bred foes and was third in the June 29 Mike Lee S. at Belmont Park. He followed with a second in the restricted New York Derby July 27 before posting a 2 1/4-length score over fellow New York-breds in the Albany H. at Saratoga Aug. 21. He is a perfect two-for-two at the nine-furlong distance of the Super Derby.

Unbeaten in three previous starts, **Handpainted** looms a heavy favorite in her first try at a route. The bay filly, produced by a full sister to Touch Gold, has posted victories in the My Dear S. June 22 and the Ontario Debutante S. Aug. 11. "Until you stretch them out, you really don't have a good grasp on just how talented they are," said trainer Josie Carroll. "But I think she's a pretty special filly." The pride of Western Canada, **Raylene** ships in off a pair of dominating stakes victories, including an 11-length romp in the Bird of Pay S. at Northlands Park Aug. 31. **Curiosity** won at first asking and followed that up with a third to Handpainted. Switched to the turf for the GIII Natalma Sept. 7, she was far back early, but rallied to be fifth. The Florida-bred adds blinkers and Lasix for this event, and is the only runner in the field with any route experience.

HARLAN'S HOLIDAY POSSIBLE FOR PEGASUS

Harlan's Holiday (Harlan) could make his next start in the Sept. 27 GII Pegasus H. at the Meadowlands, reports trainer Todd Pletcher. Pletcher is also considering the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, run the next day at Belmont. "The advantage of the Pegasus is that it's the last significant race of the year for straight three-year-olds," Pletcher said. "He had a significant break after the Preakness and, from what I can see, it looks like his best race will be his third in his form cycle. He seems to improve each time. Maybe the best way to have him peak at Arlington for the Breeders' Cup is to have him go in the easier spot that's not as deep as the Jockey Club Gold Cup." The trainer added that he is "leaning slightly" toward the Pegasus. Harlan's Holiday made a successful comeback when capturing the GIII Pennsylvania Derby on Labor Day in his first start for Pletcher.

Travers Winner Breezes:

Travers hero **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) stretched his legs through a five-eighths breeze in 1:01 2/5 yesterday at Belmont Park, galloping out three-quarters in 1:14 3/5. The dark bay will train up to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 26. "We've still got plenty of time until the race," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "We'll get more serious with him later. Right now, we're just keeping him fit." Frankel also sent out **Starine (Fr)** (Mendocino) for a six-furlong breeze in 1:15. The grey mare will start in next week's GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. "I think she's ready to go," said Frankel. Third in last year's Flower Bowl, Starine has run second in her only two starts in 2002, the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 23 and the GI Gamely May 27.

Beldame Hopefuls on Work Tab:

Prepping for a possible start in the GI Beldame S. Oct. 5, **Victory Ride** (Seeking the Gold) worked five furlongs in 1:02 Friday. The four-year-old was given a vacation following a third in the GII Shuvee H. May 18 and returned to win the Omnibus S. at Monmouth Sept. 1. "I'm not positive where she'll run," admitted trainer Rusty Arnold, who said that an alternative would be Keeneland's GI Overbrook Spinster Oct. 6. Listed as definite for the Beldame is GI Gazelle H. winner **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr), who went a half in :50 1/5 Friday.

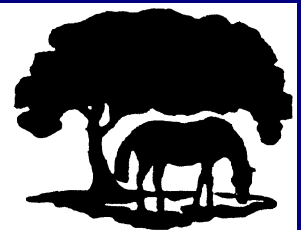

Next year her programme will be based on the Arc and the autumn when she will probably run abroad. She is likely to begin the season in the G1 Prix Ganay. By making the decision at this time we have also released Christophe Soumillon so that he can renew his association with Anabaa Blue in the Arc." Pearly Shells follows the Andreas Schutz-trained **Next Desert (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) in missing the autumn highlight, after that colt was ruled out for the season by his trainer this week.

GODOLPHIN READIES FOR STRONG OCTOBER Marienbard (Ire) (Caerleon {USA}), who also took the G1 WGZ Deutschland Bank-Preis at Dusseldorf July 28 before his success in the Sept. 1 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, was reported in his "best form" by the trainer yesterday as he continues his preparations for the G1 Arc de Triomphe. "He has to have good ground," trainer Saeed bin Suroor explained. "If there is soft ground, there has to be a question mark about him running. He worked well yesterday and is in his best form--he came back from Germany very well and we're happy so far with him." Meanwhile, **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), winner of the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 7, was reported on course for the G1 Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Oct. 26.
