BON IDEA

He would have to be supplemented in order to run in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but **Bonapaw** (Sabona) stated his case yesterday with a strong performance in the GI Vosburgh H. at Belmont. Sent off as the slight second choice to **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector), the speedy six-year-old was accompanied by **Voodoo** (Petionville) through a relatively easy half of :45.1, opened a clear lead in midstretch and was kept busy to hold the favorite at bay. "When he goes :45 for the half, I haven't seen him get beat yet," said winning trainer Norman Miller. As for the Breeders' Cup, Miller said, "Whatever the owners tell me to do, I do. They tell me to go to Dubai, I go to Dubai. They tell me to go to Des Moines, I go to Des Moines." Aldebaran--now runner-up in his last five starts--will go for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. "I don't think he can get up going three-quarters," admitted trainer Bobby Frankel. "[And] he loves the turf." KEENELAND CONCLUDES

The Keeneland September Yearling Sale concluded yesterday, with a \$45,000 son of Beau Genius topping the final session. Stonerside Stable purchased the chestnut colt out of Annul (Conquistador Cielo), who was consigned by McKee Stables Inc. In total, 2,933 horses sold over the course of the 12-day auction, grossing \$210,802,500. Though the total was the fourth highest in the sale's history, it was well down, as expected, from the 2,895 horses selling for \$254,190,600 at the 2001 sale. The select sessions showed the most declines--15 yearlings sold for \$1 million or more this year, while 27 youngsters reached that figure in 2001. A \$2.5 million son of Storm Cat--Clear Mandate (Deputy Minister) topped all receipts in 2002, compared to a \$6.4 million Storm Cat--Halory (Halo) colt last year. The sale's figures improved towards the end, with the cumulative median rising to \$30,000 from the \$25,000 mark reached in 2001. The cumulative average was down, from \$87,803 last year to \$71,873 this year. "There was an obvious adjustment in the market," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "At the highest level, there was less competition for horses. Conversely, bidding was very competitive in other segments of the market, all the way to the end of the sale." Russell was philosophical about the results. "There are reasons to be optimistic," he said. "From the perspective of the buyer and seller both, the sale was based on economic reality. Consignors allowed their horses to sell and buyers paid prices with a realistic opportunity for return on their investment from racetrack purses." *Keeneland Statistics, p7*

Essence of Dubai led nearly every step of the Super Derby XXIII, taking his earnings to the brink of \$2 million and just about winning back his purchase price. Winner of the GII Norfolk S. as a juvenile, the \$2.3-million yearling started 2002 off in Dubai, where he captured a pair of largely intramural contests, the G3 UAE Guineas and the G2 UAE Derby. The dark bay never factored in the Kentucky Derby or the Belmont, finishing ninth and sixth respectively, but looked like his old self in chasing home Harlan's Holiday in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby, running second in that Labor Day contest. Breaking alertly, the blinkered sophomore was tracked by Louisiana longshot Walk in the Snow through fractions of :47.96 and 1:12.42, then drew off under jockey Jorge Chavez.

It took Brusque four tries to break her maiden, but the chestnut filly did so in fine style, wiring Woodbine maidens by 5 1/4 lengths July 21. She faced Handpainted in her next start, the Ontario Debutante S. Aug. 11, only to lose her rider at the start. Back with allowance foes Sept. 7, Brusque took command at the start and never looked back, galloping home by a seven-length margin as the 3-5 chalk. She broke alertly once again and the others elected to take back as she opened up a clear lead through a half in :47.3 and a three-quarters split of 1:12.24. The heavy favorite, Handpainted, made a run at the pacesetter in the stretch, but Brusque was never in any serious danger of relinquishing command and came home 2 1/4 lengths in front. "We were confident going into the Ontario Debutante S., but she was rushed to the gate and went down on her heels in that one," said winning owner/trainer Ronald Woods. "But she came back strong." Brusque will now have the remainder of the year off. "She's very difficult to train, she's very tough to gallop and I don't want to run her into the ground," Woods explained. "She's a pretty nice filly."

Rochester came from just off the pace to earn his first graded-stakes success. The Pennsylvania-bred had finished second in the GIII Elkhorn Apr. 24 at Keeneland, with Cetewayo (His Majesty) back in third, but his next two forays into graded company were less successful. Seventh in the GII Louisville H. June 1 after severely clipping heels in the stretch, he ran fourth to Del Mar Show in the GIII New Hampshire Sweepstakes June 22. He then travelled to Delaware to take a division of the Cape Henlopen H. July 21 and most recently ran second in the Caesar Rodney H. at the same course Aug. 24. Never far back as Riddlesdown (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) set out in front, the Augustin Stable colorbearer challenged four wide nearing the stretch, gained command at the eighth pole and finished strongly. Favored Cetewayo was outrun early and didn't display his usual stretch kick, running fourth.

David Copperfield was purchased for an eye-opening \$2.6 million from the 505 Farms dispersal in July of 2000--just days after winning the GIII Cinema H.--but finished a distant 10th in his first start in his new colors, the GII Del Mar Derby. The dark bay showed promise when second in the GII Oak Tree Derby and third (but moved into second by the stewards) in the GI Hollywood Derby later that season, then finally picked up his first win for his new owner in a Keeneland allowance race in April of 2001. He was off the board in his next two starts, however, and disappeared for 13 months. David Copperfield came back in an optional-claiming event at Del Mar Aug. 15 and posted a determined nose victory. The second choice in this five-horse field, he sat a stalking second early, moved to challenge after six furlongs, drove to a clear lead at midstretch and held on gamely over the late-closing Ninebanks. Dance Dreamer (Nureyev), the 7-10 chalk for trainer Bobby Frankel, swerved at the start, bumping Little Ghazi, was caught in tight quarters while trying to rally on the second turn and bumped with Ninebanks, then was trapped behind the winner as they raced down the stretch and ended up fourth, beaten only a length for all the money.

Cutting back to a more suitable distance after facing some of the best in her division, **Tates Creek** got back on track with this sharp effort. Winner of the **GIII Jenny Wiley** at Keeneland Apr. 11, the chestnut missed by a neck to **Babae (Chi)** in the **GIII Just a Game Breeders' Cup** over this course June 8, but came back to post an impressive victory in a Belmont allowance July 6. Shipped up to Saratoga, **Tates Creek** just got the better of **Voodoo Dancer** by a nose in the **GII Diana H.** July 27, an effort that earned her a trip to Chicago for the **GI Beverly D.** The likes of **Golden Apples (Ire)**, **Astra** and **England's Legend**, combined with the 1 3/16-miles distance, proved too much for the **Juddmonte** homebred, who tired late to finish sixth at Arlington in that Aug. 17 event. Rating just off the pace in sixth, **Tates Creek** came four wide entering the stretch, colared **Amonita** inside the final furlong and secured the victory by a length. "There was so much more speed in there today than there was in the **Just a Game**," said winning trainer **Bobby Frankel**. "I was wondering what **Jerry [jockey Bailey]** was doing, but I guess he didn't want to run up in there and get stopped and shut off. He just let the horses outrun her, and came around. I think she runs her best races from out of it rather than being up close. She's probably okay at [up to] a mile and an eighth." A half-sister to the talented **Sightseek (Distant View)**, an impressive winner Friday at Belmont, **Tates Creek** is now 6-4-2-0 at a mile on turf.

A Ir£2,000 purchase at the **Goffs Autumn Bonus Sale** two years ago, **Nerys Dutfield's** stable star has belied that price tag with some sterling performances in top company. At two, she took eventual champion juvenile filly **Queen's Logic (Ire)** to 3/4 of a length in a conditions event over this course in May before finishing second in the **Listed Sweet Solera S.** over seven furlongs at **Newmarket** in July. This term, she has finished third behind eventual **G1 Haydock Sprint Cup** winner **Invincible Spirit (Ire)** in the six-furlong **G2 Duke of York S.** at **York** May 16 before being beaten a head by **Danehurst (GB)** in the **G2 Flying Five S.** at **The Curragh** Sept. 1 after being returned to the minimum trip. The filly was drawn wide this time, and jockey **Paul Doe** at first wanted to take her over to the far rail, but he changed tactics as the remainder of the field pulled into the centre of the track. Despite losing valuable ground, **Lady Dominatrix** had enough speed to recover and race in sixth as **Cyclone Connie (GB)** (**Dr Devious {Ire}**) led overall on the stands' side. She quickened to take command with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and only **Smokin Beau** could keep tabs with her from there, but she had enough to deny his determined challenge on the drive to the line. The dark bay raced in tough company while still a maiden, running second in the GII Norfolk S. and ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile last year. Third in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad Al Sheba to start his 2002 campaign, the Sheikh Mohammed colorbearer was switched to turf after running fifth in the GII Peter Pan S. and responded with an eye-catching 9 1/2-length score. He picks up three pounds off his Saranac victory.
