FINALITY FINALLY GETS IT DONE

Finality (Dehere), second in four of his five previous stakes attempts, finally broke through with his first black-type score in the GII Jamaica H. at Belmont Park yesterday. The chestnut just missed in his latest, running second to **Ibn Al Haitham (GB)** (Zafonic) by a half-length in the Sept. 2 GIII Saranac H. at Saratoga. Enjoying a perfect trip this time, the New York-bred sat a tracking third as **Union Place** (Out of Place) cut out solid fractions, then drove past that gallant rival in the stretch to take it by a length. "He really likes Belmont," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He got a good trip today and everything worked out smoothly." Added jockey John Velazquez, "We had some tough beats earlier in the year. MADE IN THE SHADE

Well Made (Ger) (Mondrian {Ger}) showed his liking for the course at Cologne, and for soft ground, when winning the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft Apr. 7 and the G2 Gerling-Preis May 5. He completed the Cologne hat-trick with a 3/4-length score over the filly **Salve Regina (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) in the G1 Deutsche Post Euro Express-Preis Von Europa yesterday. The five-year-old, coming off a fourth-place finish behind **Yavana's Pace (Ire)** (Accordion {Ire}) and **Salve Regina** in the G1 Credit Suisse Private Banking Pokal at Cologne Aug. 11, reversed that form with a power-packed run under Terence Hellier. Held up in seventh early as **Yavana's Pace** took up to his customary position at the head of affairs, he was travelling strongly while the pacesetter had to be kept to his work. Forced wide into the centre of the track at the top of the straight, **Well Made** quickened as **Salve Regina** tackled the long-time leader. The filly looked to have the contest won inside the final furlong, but it was **Well Made** who had the strongest finish, heading the game three-year-old in the final 25 yards. In a thrilling four-way finish, Royal Dragon proved strongest to return to the winner's enclosure for the first time in over a year. Having won the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) here last May, the colt attempted to stretch his stamina in the 10-furlong G2 Grosser Muller Brot-Preis at Munich the following month. After being beaten 3/4 of a length by Zollner (Ger) there, the decision was made to revert back to miling and he duly won the G2 Berlin Brandenburg- Trophy at Hoppegarten in July. Subsequently sixth in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August, he returned to finish third behind Sambaprinz (Ger) (Big Shuffle) in this year's renewal of the Berlin Brandenburg-Trophy July 14 before finding the task of giving 10 pounds to Zarewitsch (Ger) (Night Shift) too much when seventh in the G3 Oettingen-Rennen at Baden Baden Aug. 27. In this contest, he settled on the inner in seventh through the early stages as Love Regardless (Storm Cat) was rushed to the front to set a respectable tempo. As that frontrunner bravely battled to maintain his lead in the straight, Royal Dragon was switched off the rail and quickened with a late flourish between War Blade and Horeion Directa in the final 25 yards to ake it in the dying strides. His half-brother Daylami (Ire) achieved stakes success on his second run, taking the Listed Prix Herod at Evry in 1996, and Dalakhani followed suit here with a convincing score. Having impressed when winning a debutantes contest at Deauville Aug. 29, the dark grey was sent to post the favourite to extend his unbeaten record. Confidently placed in third by jockey Christophe Soumillon as Mister Charm and Graikos dominated the early exchanges, he was asked to gain closer order on the turn into the final straight. Quickening past Graikos with 300 yards remaining, he needed only a shake of the reins to catch Mister Charm at the furlong marker before quickly asserting. Eased down when clear in the final 75 yards, he was allowed to enjoy the closing stages of a facile score. Daylami went on to finish runner-up in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud; Dalakhani will bid to go one better now according to trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "This is a horse who has a lot of class," he said. "He doesn't look like Daylami at all--he looks more like his sire and, like him, he will stay in the future. Gaining a well-deserved first stakes success, Tau Ceti shed his 'nearly' tag at this level with a comfortable success. Third in the G3 Prix de Conde on this course last October, he was fourth on his return in the G2 Prix de Fontainebleau Apr. 14. Fourth behind Act One (GB) in the G1 Prix Lupin here May 12, he took a conditions event at Chantilly June 9, then was again fourth behind Burning Sun in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 14. The colt filled the same spot last time out when beaten 8½ lengths by Nysaeon (Ire) in the Listed Prix Ridgway at Deauville Aug. 10. He raced in fourth early under Thierry Jarnet this time as jockey Christophe Soumillon took Shaanmer to the front. Angled wide for his run inside the final quarter-mile, he quickened to wear down that rival with 125 yards remaining before asserting for the score. "He has been quite consistent all year," Alan Cooper, racing manager to the Niarchos family said. "Last time, we expected better at Deauville, but it rained heavily before the race and it was too soft. I will have to speak with his trainer and Mrs Niarchos, but he is in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 6] and he may be left in at the first forfeit stage." CASTLE GANDOLFO TO KEENELAND Mrs. John Magnier's **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) will make his next start in the **G1 Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile S.** in **Lexington Oct. 6**, a spokesperson from the **Aidan O'Brien** stable confirmed yesterday. The homebred three-year-old, winner of the **G3 Beresford S.** and second to **High Chaparral (Ire)** in the **G1 Racing Post Trophy** at two, set a track record at **Lingfield** at **Apr. 6** before finishing up the track in the **May 5 Kentucky Derby**. Returned to Europe, the chestnut finished sixth in the **G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby)** **June 2**, but most recently returned from a three-month hiatus to be a good third, beaten 1/2 a length in the **Listed Solonaway S.** at **The Curragh Sept. 15**. He may be accompanied on the trip to Kentucky by stablemate **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat). The daughter of **Serena's Song** won the **G1 Coronation Cup** at **Ascot June 21** and could line up for the **G1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup** at nine furlongs on the turf **Oct. 12**.

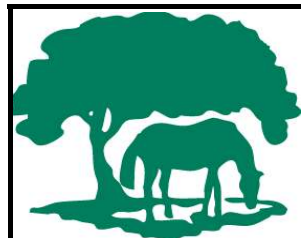

CAFÉ TUNES UP FOR THE ARC **Manhattan Café (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence {USA}) yesterday galloped at Longchamp ahead of his tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. Partnered by regular work-rider Shigeharu Matsumoto in a light exercise with a lead horse partnered by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, the Futoshi Kojima-trained colt was asked to quicken up the Longchamp straight and went about his task with relish. Manhattan Café, who is currently housed at Richard Gibson's Chantilly yard, beat Jungle Pocket (Jpn) by a neck in the G1 Tenno Sho at Kyoto Apr. 28.

O'BRIEN ON WEATHER WATCH Aidan O'Brien is yet to decide whether **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) or **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) will represent Ballydoyle in Saturday's £300,000 G1 NetJets Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, but the weather is likely to be a key factor. Hawk Wing found rain-softened conditions on his last three starts, when runner-up in the G1 Epsom Derby June 8, winning the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 6 and again when runner-up in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 7 behind Grandera (Ire). However, with a dry forecast ahead of the mile contest, O'Brien may be tempted to let Hawk Wing take his chance there. "Things have probably not gone right for Hawk Wing this year," he said. "I thought he ran a huge race at Leopardstown, and it is possible he laboured a bit when the rain came. We will see how they are closer to the time, but at this stage Rock Of Gibraltar and Hawk Wing are both possibles for the Queen Elizabeth and maybe one of them would run." He may be re-opposed by Godolphin's **Best Of The Bests (Ire)** (Machiavellian {USA}), who finished a neck further back in third at Leopardstown last time. Meanwhile, doubts surround the participation of the Luca Cumani-trained **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), third behind the "Rock" in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Sept. 8 last time. Cumani has warned that significant rain is required for the filly, who worked impressively at Newmarket on Saturday morning, to take her chance.
