Partnered by Ted Durcan, Godolphin's G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Oaks winner worked with stable companion **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) over seven furlongs of the Round Gallop as she completed her preparation. Racing Manager Simon Crisford said of the filly, who left for the United States yesterday evening, "The filly worked really well this morning and we are pleased with her."

INDIAN CHARLIE TO AIRDRIE

Indian Charlie (In Excess {Ire})--Soviet Sojourn, by Leo Castelli) has been moved to Mr. and Mrs. Brereton Jones' Airdrie Stud in Midway, Kentucky where he will stand the 2003 season. The winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby in 1998, the seven-year-old stallion is currently ranked sixth with seven winners among leading freshman sires of 2002. "Indian Charlie is a dynamite young stallion with a great future," said former Kentucky Governor Brereton Jones. "He is a magnificent physical specimen and all of us at Airdrie are really excited to have him here." Also pleased with the decision is one of the stallion's shareholders, Tom Van Meter. "We feel that Airdrie is a superior stallion operation that will give a horse of this caliber the support he needs to be a top flight stallion," commented Van Meter. "Indian Charlie has already shown he has the ability at stud and Airdrie will move this horse up with its outstanding mare base and solid marketing abilities."

WAR EMBLEM WORKS

War Emblem (Our Emblem) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 3/5 Monday on the Santa Anita main track in preparation for his next, and final start, in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic set for Arlington Park Oct. 26. "We went early with him, at 6:30 [a.m.]," said trainer Bob Baffert. "The way the weather has been [hot, dry], it is better to work early in the morning when there's more moisture in the track." The winner of the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. was nominated to the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 6, but those plans were abandoned after the colt was sold for \$17 million to Katsumi and Teruya Yoshida to stand stud in Japan in 2003.

NAYEF READY FOR AUTUMN TESTS

Trainer Marcus Tregoning yesterday confirmed **Nayef** (Gulch) on course for either the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6 or G1 Emirates Airlines Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19. Although the four-year-old also has the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Arlington Oct. 26 on his agenda, it is unlikely that he will race against **Sakhee** (Bahri), who is reported on course for the Newmarket contest. Although plans for the G1 Juddmonte International S. winner are not decided as yet, it is likely that he will remain in training as a five-year-old to tackle the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba in March. "The decision hasn't quite been made yet and we're still in discussion at the moment," Tregoning commented. "One or the other [the Arc or Champion S.] will do, but it would be lovely to win another Champion. We'll have to wait and see what Sheikh Hamdan wants to do. We are in the race at Chicago as well and I doubt if the pair will take each other on. If he stays in training, he has a great chance in the Dubai World Cup, but its all in the boiling pot at the moment."

MACHO UNO PREPS FOR WASHINGTON ‘CAP’

Champion juvenile **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull), breezed five furlongs in 1:03 at Arlington Park Monday while preparing for his next start in Sunday’s 9 1/2-furlong GII Washington Park H. over the same track. According to trainer Joe Orseno, his charge, who galloped out three quarters in 1:16 2/5, “Got a lot out of it.” He continued, “All cylinders are working. We’ll see how tired he is over the next day or so, but assuming he comes out of it ok, everything is a ‘go’ for Sunday.” This year, the \$400,000 event will serve as the final local prep for the upcoming GI Breeders’ Cup Classic to be held at the Chicago-area oval for the first time in the Breeders’ Cup 19-year history.

SKY MESA WORKS AT KEENELAND Sky Mesa (Pulpit), recent winner of the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Aug. 31, turned a few heads with a crisp five-furlong work at Keeneland Monday morning in one of his final preparatory moves heading into the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 5. "[Jockey] Edgar [Prado] was happy with the work," trainer John Ward told the *Thoroughbred Times*. The \$750,000 KEESSEP yearling purchase, who galloped out six furlongs in 1:13 yesterday, is being pointed toward the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Arlington Park Oct. 26. "Sky Mesa was very relaxed, and at this level, it's always good to have the horse and rider get to know one another," added Ward. "It'll help Sky Mesa be more responsive over the Keeneland race-track in his next start."

McPeek Tightens Screws on Repent for Gold Cup:

Repent (Louis Quatorze), second behind Medaglia d'Oro in Saratoga's GI Travers S. Aug. 24, worked four panels over the Belmont main track Sunday in :47 3/5. Set to face older foes for the first time in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont, the dark bay colt sat on the sidelines for four months leading up to his fast-closing Travers finish last time. "My colt bounced out of the Travers in good shape and I think he's capable of taking it to the next level," said the sophomore's trainer, Ken McPeck. Jockey Edgar Prado will ride the colt in Saturday's Gold Cup.

Handpainted to Miss Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies:

Handpainted (A.P. Indy--Daijin, by Deputy Minister), winner of the Ontario Debutante S. at Woodbine Aug. 11, will miss a planned start in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' at Arlington Oct. 26, after sustaining an injury in her most recent start, the GII Mazarine S. at Woodbine Sept. 21. "We dodged a bullet," said attending Veterinarian Dan Duncan. "We are very fortunate the laceration did not damage her tendon. I expect a full recovery and return to racing." Sidelined for the rest of the 2002 racing season at Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington, the John and Glenn Sikura-owned juvenile, who has earned \$256,210 to date, is expected to resume training in about six to eight weeks.

Team Valor recently acquired **Grand (Ire)** (Grand Lodge--Easy Pop {Ire}, by Shernazar {Ire}), a 23-length winner on the dirt at Newmarket Sept. 7, with the intention of running the colt in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Arlington Oct. 26, reports the *Blood-Horse*. Purchased for an undisclosed amount, the colt will make his next start in the GII Grey Breeders' Cup S. at Woodbine Oct. 6. "He definitely has the stamina to go the distance," Irwin told the *Blood-Horse*. "I think the English horses will have an edge over the American horses in the Breeders' Cup." Grand will make his final start for current trainer Nick Littmoden in the Juvenile and he will then be transferred to trainer Elliot Walden.

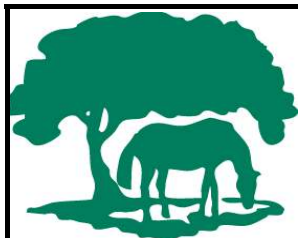
