GOLD CUP LOOKOUT

As the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Arlington Park draws nearer, the prospect of distilling the wide-open division down to a handful of favorites starts here, with a solid field of proven performers gathered for the \$1 million GI Jockey Club Gold Cup this afternoon at Belmont Park. Leading the charge is the newly rejuvenated **Repent** (Louis Quatorze), who was sidelined for 4 1/2 months after having a chip removed from his left front ankle. In his return to the track, the dark bay gave Medaglia d'Oro all that he could handle when he came from 11 lengths back to test that foe in the final stages of the GI Travers S. over a sloppy Saratoga oval Aug. 24, finishing second by a half-length under the wire. That performance instilled a healthy dose of confidence in his trainer, Ken McPeck, who asserted, "He's like a mailman: he delivers." Not to be outdone, trainer Bobby Frankel sends two to the Gold Cup--**Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again), who comes off a game third-place effort in the GI Pacific Classic, and **Lido Palace** (Rich Man's Gold), whose winning performance in the GI Woodward S. over this track Sept. 7 didn't necessarily stamp his ticket to Chicago. "He'd probably have to win the Jockey Club Gold Cup to get into the Breeders' Cup," said Frankel, whose charge would have to be supplemented \$800,000 to start in the Classic. Handicappers are sure to be watching the odds on trainer Kiaran McLaughlin's seven-year-old **Abreeze** (Danzig). The gelding comes off a flat fourth in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic, but loves the off going and may have an uncontested lead over a wet Belmont track, where he's proven he can get it done.

NOTHING BUT FLOWERS

It remains to be seen whether champion **Banks Hill** (GB) (Danehill) will take her place in today's \$750,000 GI Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont, but the rest of the field can certainly hold its own. Godolphin has shipped in **Kazzia** (Ger) (Zinaad {GB}), who has accomplished about as much a race-horse can in five career starts. The dark brown filly put forth tenacious performances in capturing the G1 1000 Guineas and the G1 Oaks, but lost her unbeaten record when fourth to Islington (Ire) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 21. "She's a very talented horse and she's done everything we've expected," said assistant trainer Tom Albertrani. "She likes to be in front. Hopefully, she can dictate the pace." That may be easier said than done with **England's Legend** (Fr) (Lure) in the race. The big bay does her best running on the front end. Second in this event in 2001, she didn't see the track this year until wiring the GIII Modesty H. July 27. She followed that up with a bang-up third--beaten a length by Golden Apples (Ire) and Astra--in the GI Beverly D. Aug. 17, a race she captured last year. Trainer Bobby Frankel sends out a tough pair in **Starine** (Fr) (Mendocino) and **Surya** (Unbridled). The former will have the services of John Velazquez if Banks Hill opts out due to the rain-softened ground.

Rock of Gibraltar was on the plane from Ireland with **Hawk Wing**, but it is highly unlikely that both colts will line up in this event. Yesterday's ground reports suggested that the official label of good-to-firm was far from the truth, so it seems that the "Rock" will represent the stable. Aidan O'Brien's record-breaking colt has shown he can run on any surface, but he is particularly adept at handling ground that causes others to falter. He encountered soft ground when taking the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp last October and again when turning the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas into a procession at The Curragh May 26. Ground conditions were also on the easier side when he beat Banks Hill (GB) by a half-length in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp last time Sept. 8. That victory proved a landmark, as he beat Mill Reef's record of six consecutive Group 1 wins, a mark that had stood for 30 years. If the ground is considered suitable for Hawk Wing, he can be expected to have improved from his last effort, a short-head defeat by Grandera (Ire) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 7. But he needs a quick surface, which he had when breaking the seven-furlong track record in the G1 National S. at The Curragh last September. **Best of the Bests** finished a neck behind Hawk Wing when third in the 10-furlong Irish Champion, but drops back to a mile here. Godolphin's runner was third to Observatory in this race two years ago, but has subsequently shown his best form at a longer trip. Nevertheless, a reproduction of his respectable third placing behind Banks Hill (GB) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois Aug. 18 would see him pose the biggest threat to the favourite. His jockey, Frankie Dettori, has won this three times--with Markofdistinction (GB) in 1990, Mark of Esteem (Ire) in 1996 and Dubai Millennium (GB) in 1999--will attempt to stretch Hawk Wing as Jamie Spencer did at Leopardstown. **Noverre Scratched, p5**

Having claimed the notable scalp of Airwave (GB) on her debut in a fast-ground Kempton maiden July 17, **Soviet Song** had **Summitville** three lengths back in second in the Listed Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket Aug. 10. Soviet Song was subsequently sidelined with a cough, but the runner-up showed her well-being when comfortably beating **Approach** in the G3 May Hill S. over a mile at Doncaster Sept. 12. While Approach undermined her chances by racing too freely in the early stages there, Summitville was always in command when committed and relished the step up in trip. On the form of their maiden successes, Approach is closely matched with **Rainbow Queen**, but the latter may have more room for improvement and rates a major threat to the market leaders. Judging by her performance when winning a Warwick maiden 12 days ago, she has inherited her sire's stamina and the finishing kick of her dam Dazzle (GB), who possessed impressive acceleration on a fast surface. Rainbow Queen bids to end the 17-year drought for Sir Michael Stoute in this contest. Aidan O'Brien is represented by **Reach for the Moon**, who impressed when winning a Cork maiden on her debut Aug. 4. She is bred to come into her own at this distance, but fears linger that she may need the run, having been forced to miss the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh Sept. 1 due to a cough.

Malhub bids to defy a six-pound penalty for his success in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 22. That came at the expense of **Three Points**, who was two lengths back in third there. Although Malhub beat that rival by the same distance when runner-up in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 7 last time, he may struggle to confirm placings with his extra burden. **Polar Way**, unbeaten in his four starts so far, took the step up in grade in his step when winning the G3 Boland S. at The Curragh last time Sept. 14. He had the consistent yardstick One Won One 1 1/2 lengths back in second that day and would not need to find much improvement to be in the shake-up here. **Crystal Castle**, who took the competitive Tote International H. at Ascot July 27, followed up in the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville Aug. 17 last time and warrants respect.

Van Nistelrooy makes a quick reappearance after surrendering his unbeaten record when 3/4 of a length runner-up to Refuse to Bend (Ire) in the G1 National S. at The Curragh Sept. 15. Previously, he had taken the farcically run Listed Tyros S. July 27 before winning the G2 Futurity S. Aug. 24 at that track. He picks up a three-pound penalty for that success, but has the ability to overcome that obstacle and provide Aidan O'Brien with his third win in the last four renewals of this contest. **Al Jadeed** took a conditions race at Sandown 10 days ago, and that form received a timely boost mid-week when the third-place finisher in that race took a similar event in impressive fashion. Al Jadeed bids to provide John Gosden with his second success in this race; Gosden's Benny the Dip scored in 1996 en route to Epsom Derby glory. But the colt had previously been beaten 4 1/4 lengths by **Norse Dancer** in a competitive conditions event July 13, and he will have a hard task reversing that form on 11 pounds worse terms this time. Norse Dancer was subsequently fourth behind Dublin (Ire) in the G3 Vintage S. at Goodwood July 31, having knocked his head on the stalls, and will give Van Nistelrooy most to do here.

HOLE IN COURSE CAUSES SPILL AT ASCOT

Officials at Ascot were scouring the track after a hole in the course caused a fall during the first race on yesterday's card. Khayyam (USA) went down after stumbling in a piece of ground that gave away before the furlong marker in the opening handicap. Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne and the ground staff discovered a large hole that was later confirmed to be a collapsed drain. Having dolled off that area with a false rail, racing was allowed to continue, but the jockeys were critical of the state of the ground, which Richard Hughes said was "an absolute disaster and full of holes." Cheyne countered, "It is extremely surprising--I walked that part of the track this morning and late last night and I never identified anything like that. It is a concern to find that. After racing today we will have a very thorough look across the whole of the course and I'm hopeful that its just this one hole that has appeared. It is unlikely we will use the full width tomorrow--we will doll off that whole area." Nick Smith, head of public relations at the track, added, "All jockeys have got their opinion, but Nick Cheyne has tremendous respect in the industry and has years of experience in preparing the ground here. He's been watering intermittently over the week and he always tries to provide ground which is as near as to what nature allows as possible. The collapsed drain is beyond his control--there are drains all over the place. That, unfortunately, is one of those things today, a shame, but unpredictable."

DOLEUZE TO MISS ARC

The spate of high-profile jockey suspensions continues. Olivier Doleuze was the latest to incur the wrath of stewards when he was handed a four-day suspension for careless riding by Longchamp stewards yesterday. The suspension starts Oct. 6 and, as a result, Doleuze will miss G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe day, although he does have the option to appeal. The infraction occurred when Doleuze, riding Picque Sous (Fr) for trainer Marcel Rolland in the final race of the day, was disqualified from first for causing continued interference in the home straight. The race was awarded to Six Of One (GB), a phrase obviously not taken into consideration by the stewards when arriving at their decision.

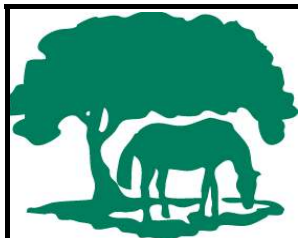
