ALL DRESSED UP FOR THE BREEDERS' CUP

He is possessed of a much different running style than his sire, who won the 1991 Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs on the engine, but **Evening Attire** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) will likely get a chance to emulate his sire following his 9-1 upset in yesterday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. Not many people knew who he was when he bested subsequent G1

Dubai World Cup hero Street Cry (Ire) in the GIII Discovery H. last fall, but he has quietly built a reputation as a consistent performer. Second to Macho Uno in the GII Massachusetts H. June 1, the gray was fourth behind E Dubai in the GII Suburban H. over course and distance July 6, but atoned for that effort with a solid victory in

the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. at the Spa Aug. 17. Slow into stride, the four-year-old was unhurried behind the early pace set by **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), **Abreeze** (Danzig) and, surprisingly, favored **Repent** (Louis Quatorze). The latter was finished with fully three furlongs to run, but that's just when jockey Shaun Bridgmohan was getting his mount into gear. Evening Attire advanced along the inside into the stretch, angled outside to lead at the eighth pole and pulled clear. "He didn't break alertly. I didn't want to rush him," the winning jockey commented. "This is the best he's ever been. I'm sure he's earned a trip to the Breeders' Cup. This has been a special week." Bridgmohan registered a five-bagger at Belmont on Wednesday. The connections of Repent, the 17-10 favorite, were hard-pressed to explain his performance. "He broke really well. I was in good position, but when we got to the far turn, he died," jockey Edgar Prado said. "He was breathing well. He was going beautifully. By the turn he was done." ANTICIPATION, DENON--THE THREE-QUEL

Having hooked up in a pair of memorable stretch duels this season, **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) and **Denon** (Pleasant Colony) renew acquaintances for the third time in the past three months in this afternoon's GI Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont Park. The big gray

decided his younger rival by a neck to successfully defend his title in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park July 6 and handed the Bobby Frankel trainee another gut-wrenching defeat in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational at Saratoga Aug. 10, getting his head down on the line first. For good measure, the Augustin homebred ran down loose-on-the-lead Balto Star to win a second consecutive GI Man o' War S. Sept. 7. "It's been a fun time," admitted trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "He's just been an unbelievable horse over the last two years. I'm very proud of him. Horses like that make you want to go to the barn every morning." Making his return to the races this afternoon is defending Turf Classic champion **Timboroa (GB)** (Salse). Subsequently third in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, the bay is unraced since a 15th-place effort in the GI Japan Cup last Nov. 25.

Flower Bowl Inv. cont.

The Flower Bowl lost some of its intrigue with the scratch of Banks Hill (GB) (*see story p9*), but Kazzia more than made up for that loss with a determined score. Unbeaten in two starts at two, the German-bred was privately acquired by Godolphin and launched her sophomore season in style, leading every step of the G1 English 1000 Guineas May 5. Stepped up to 12 furlongs for her next, the dark bay made the June 7 G1 Vodafone Oaks a test of stamina, leading within the first furlong before holding on late to win by 1/2 a length. She found the classy Islington (Ire) five lengths too good in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 21, but was cutting back in distance for her U.S. bow. Sent immediately for the lead by jockey Jorge Chavez, Kazzia cut out moderate fractions in the soft going while pestered early by favored England's Legend (Fr) (Lure). The latter gave way turning for home as Turtle Bow tipped out to attack the frontrunner, but could not get by that rival and settled for second. "The Breeders' Cup [Filly and Mare Turf] was part of the reason to bring her here," said Tom Albertrani, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "She proved today she could handle older fillies. Everything worked out perfect today." Of the beaten favorite, jockey Jerry Bailey said, "I never had any horse at any time." In a piece of supreme jockeyship, Kevin Darley kicked Where or When past the hot favourite Hawk Wing at the furlong marker and never looked back as he powered away. "We went out there conscious that we had one horse to beat and I tracked him all the way round and stalked him," Darley said. That involved settling the chestnut in fourth on the tail of the market leader as Sholokhov (Sadler's Wells) blazed the trail in front. Always travelling easily, he was pulled wide as Mick Kinane sent Hawk Wing past Sholokhov with 250 yards remaining. That rival's lead was short-lived as Where or When quickened dramatically to hit the front at the furlong marker before galloping enthusiastically clear for a convincing score. Winner of the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at Newmarket last October, Where or When was fourth in the G1 Dewhurst S. back at that track 15 days later. The colt never figured in this year's classics, but finally earned a victory in the Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood Aug. 3 before a luckless fourth behind Tillerman in the G2 Celebration Mile back at that track Aug. 24. Trainer Terry Mills said: "I can't put words into place--I haven't slept for three nights. He's a very, very good horse, but we've got faith in him and next year he's going to be better still." As for the beaten favorite, trainer Aidan O'Brien said, "I thought he ran a real big race. Things didn't work out today--it was very dead, rolling ground, but I am not going to use that as an excuse." Fillies' Mile cont.

"She's always looked classy," trainer James Fanshawe said after Soviet Song had extended her unbeaten record in this competitive contest. She certainly had looked so when beating subsequent Listed scorer Airwave (GB) by a half length on her debut in a six-furlong Kempton maiden July 17. Having surprised connections by opening her account over that trip, Soviet Song powered past Summitville (GB) (Grand Lodge) in the seventh furlong of the Listed Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket Aug. 10 to win by a decisive three lengths. Here she raced in fifth on the inner under Oscar Urbina as Summitville was taken to the front in the early stages. Always travelling strongly off the generous tempo, she was switched off the rail at the top of the straight and was brought to challenge on the bridle inside the final quarter of a mile. As Casual Look passed the long-time leader, Soviet Song was asked to quicken by Urbina and she responded in emphatic fashion to settle the result in a few strides. "Oscar gave her the most beautiful ride today because I was a slightly concerned that with her draw she would get tucked on the rail and might not relax, but she relaxed beautifully. She's been very well behaved to saddle and she was a little bit edgy but it was a hot day. She travels in her races and I hope she travels that way next May." Ladbrokes responded by cutting her to 10-1 for the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket in May. Lightly raced five-year-old Defier swept into Cox Plate contention by comprehensively lowering the colours of Sunline and Lonhro (Octagonal {NZ}, fourth) courtesy of a supremely tactical ride by jockey Chris Munce. The deceptively arduous rise at the top of the Randwick straight told on Sunline, who pulled hard under a tight hold by Childs and tired in the final 200 meters in her first appearance since winning the G2 Mudgway S. at Hastings Aug. 24. Ousted by 11-8 Lonhro as favorite for the much-anticipated Cox Plate prelude, Sunline was first out of the gates and she swept to a 1 3/4-length lead, setting a leisurely pace in front. Defier settled a length away third and moved to shadow Sunline with Munce content to sit two lengths behind the mare before moving up to her hindquarters entering the straight. "I was worried he was up close with no cover at all and that is not the way he is normally ridden, but he has proven what a great, adaptable horse he is, apart from all the other qualities, he's tremendous," said trainer Guy Walter. Defier's next scheduled outing is the G1 A\$600,000 Epsom H. at Randwick Oct. 5. Sunline, chasing Kingston Town's record of three Cox Plates and 14 Group 1 wins, is scheduled to contest the G1 Yalumba S. at Caulfield Oct. 12 and then the Cox Plate at Moonee Valley two weeks later.

Still eligible for a first-level allowance, Regal Sanction put it all together under the lights and outbattled No Parole over a sloppy Meadowlands strip. The chestnut colt broke his maiden in his first start off a four-month layoff Apr. 11 and then produced runner-up finishes in his next four starts, including a second in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup July 21 on the turf at Delaware. That streak ended when he came up empty in the GIII Saranac H., tiring to seventh behind Ibn al Haitham (GB) Sept. 2 at Saratoga. Jockey Jose Santos settled the colt into a ground-saving third as favored Trump Marina (Honour and Glory) went up to set the pace, then angled him three wide approaching the far turn. Regal Sanction took over at the top of the stretch and was soon headed by No Parole, but dug in deep to secure the narrow victory. "I saved ground and from the quarter-pole home I knew he would win because he was very strong," said Santos. "The other horse came to him, but he never went by. My horse just kept digging in. I would have won if they'd gone around again." As for the beaten favorite, jockey Eibar Coa said, "He was fighting to the half-mile pole and he just quit running. They'll take a look at him to see what happened." Having finished fourth on his debut behind Norse Dancer (Ire) (Halling) in a conditions event here July 13, Al Jadeed was third in a Goodwood maiden Aug. 2. I think a mile to a mile and one will be his trip--he's the sort of horse you could think about for the Guineas. "[Trainer] Paul [Webber] walked the course this morning and advised us that it was on the soft side," trainer Andre Fabre commented from France. "She's leaving Wednesday for the [GI] Yellow Ribbon S. [Saturday at Santa Anita]." Surya, winner of four of her last five efforts for Frankel including the off-the-turf GIII Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup at Saratoga Aug. 24, will run next in the GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland on Friday.

OFFICER TO BE RETIRED? Officer (Bertrando), unraced since a six-length victory in the Zany Tactics S. for California-breds in April, is unlikely to return to the races and could retire to stud for the 2003 breeding season, *Thoroughbred Times* reports. Owned by The Thoroughbred Corporation, the dark bay colt was unbeaten in his first five career starts, including a 3 3/4-length score in the GI Champagne S. Fifth as the odds-on favorite in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he was second a week later in the California Cup Juvenile and closed the year with a third-place finish in the GI Hollywood Futurity. Sidelined with a tendon injury following the Zany Tactics, the \$700,000 Barretts March two-year-old purchase has earned better than \$800,000 in his career.

Aidan O'Brien has left in nine colts, while David Loder will be represented by **Country Reel (USA)** (Danzig {USA}). Friday's G1 Betfair.com Cheveley Park S. has attracted 12 entries headed by **Russian Rhythm (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), winner of the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 22. She is likely to be opposed by **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}) and **Ego (GB)** (Green Desert {USA}).

ASCOT OFFERS SOLUTION Officials at Ascot yesterday gave details of the inspection of the track on Friday evening due to the discovery of the hole near the furlong pole during that afternoon's card. With a false rail cutting off the problem area for yesterday's meeting, the track enjoyed an uneventful day. "The hole discovered yesterday was caused by a collapsed drain, which hasn't happened before," said Ascot's Chief Executive Douglas Erskine-Crum. "The track is scheduled to be realigned and reconstructed as part of the forthcoming £180-million redevelopment using the most advanced turf technology available. This will involve constructing a completely new straight mile, 42 metres to the north of its current location."
