**A CLASSIC REVERSAL**

After winning the June 15 GI Charlie Whittingham H., **Denon** (Pleasant Colony) was narrowly outfinished by **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) in both the July 6 GI United Nations H. and the Aug. 10 GI Sword Dancer H.

The pair met again in yesterday's GI Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont Park, but this time Denon was all alone at the finish. The slight favorite over his silver nemesis yesterday, Denon was away slowly and angled to the inside where he settled just off the pace as his stablemate **Timboroa (GB)** (Salse) dueling with **Ulundi (GB)** (Rainbow Quest). Denon moved

to the outside in upper stretch, split foes and gained the lead before holding off **Blazing Fury** (Dynaformer) for the half-length win. "Turning for home, I just needed a place," commented winning jockey Edgar Prado. "I got one and he took off. He started to loaf around once he got to the lead, but we got to the wire first." Winning trainer Bobby Frankel added, "I was a little concerned that maybe he wasn't tight enough, but I think now he'll be perfect for the [Oct. 26] Breeders' Cup [Turf] with four weeks. I don't think he ran too hard today. If I can get a little bit of cut in the ground, I would be very confident with him." Of his charge's rivalry with **With Anticipation**, Frankel added, "[The Turf Classic] is more money. If I had a choice of which one to win, I guess it would be this one." **With Anticipation** never offered a serious threat yesterday and ran sixth. "When I asked my horse to run, I had no response," said jockey Pat Day. "We had nothing but racetrack in front of us and he couldn't pick it up." **BALLINGARRY TAKES INTERNATIONAL**

**Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) led home a one-two-three finish for the European-breds in yesterday's GI Canadian International S. at Woodbine. The bay colt, winner of last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, has been keeping top company this year. He was third behind High Chaparral in the G1 Irish Derby in June and returned to run third in the Sept. 14 G1 Irish St Leger last time out. **Ballingarry** settled in second as the veteran **Yavana's Pace (Ire)** (Accordion {Ire}) took the field along through fractions of :25.52, :52.03 and 1:17.97. **Ballingarry** overtook that rival on the final turn and drew clear down the stretch to win by 2 1/4 lengths. "He was full of himself today, he enjoyed himself," jockey Mick Kinane said of the winner. "He loved the experience and was at the top of his game. When you get a three-year-old maturing at this point in the season and going forward, the sky's the limit." Due to major reconstruction taking place at Tokyo Racecourse, the usual site for the G1 Sprinters' S., the race was moved over to Niigata for the 2002 edition. With a full field of 11 on hand for Niigata's first Group 1 event, Believe needed everything she had in her arsenal to eke out a half-length victory over 1998 juvenile champion Admire Cozzene. One of only two fillies in the field, the winner of the Centaur S. proved difficult to load, but once she overcame that obstacle she settled behind early leader Shonan Kampf, with Admire Cozzene camped close to her hip. As the field turned for home, the trio drew clear of the rest, but it was Believe who proved gamest of all as she inched clear for the win. The winner's dam, Great Christine, is a half sister to the 'Iron Lady' Lady's Secret, the spectacular grey filly who won 10 U.S. Grade 1 events in 1986 en route to a Horse of the Year championship.

Fraulein captured the July 26 one-mile Listed Valiant S. at Ascot July 26 before a runner-up finish in the 10-furlong Listed Upavon S. at Salisbury Aug. 14. Making her U.S. bow, the English miss broke from the rail and was allowed to settled behind slow early fractions of :29.70, :57.93 and 1:23.33. She forged to the front on the final bend and opened a clear lead nearing the sixteenth pole before holding off the late charge of Alasha. "When I saw there was a gap on the inside, my filly quickened to get there and then she stays on," said winning rider Kevin Darley. "I thought that if I don't give her clear run, when we get in the straight, I'll be stuck for turn of foot. I just edged up the inside and when I asked her, she lengthened her gallop all the way to the line. She stayed. Thankfully she just held on." Assistant trainer Peter Boothman indicated Fraulein would start next in the Oct. 14 GIII Pebbles S. at Belmont Park.

Tenpins capped off a six-race win streak with a victory in his stakes debut in the May 18 Gill Schaffer H. The chestnut colt ran gamely to finish third behind Street Cry (Ire) and Dollar Bill in the June 15 GI Stephen Foster H. last time out. Tenpins settled off the pacesetting Generous Rosi. He gained the lead with a furlong to run and battled to the wire for a narrow score. "He's such a kind horse to ride," said winning jockey Robby Albarado. "He has the will to win. He saw Bonus Pack come to him on the outside with tons of horse and Tenpins refused to give in. He's got a heart of steel on him." Trainer Don Winfree is not ruling out a trip to the Breeders' Cup Classic with the colt. "We're going to leave our options open and play it by ear for a few days," he said. "We'll think about the Breeders' Cup very seriously, but he had to really run today. This horse doesn't like to get beat." Even-money favorite Macho Uno (Holy Bull), coming off a fourth-place finish in the Aug. 3 GI Whitney H., raced in mid-pack early but offered no rally and finished last. "The horse felt fine going into the race," commented the colt's jockey Gary Stevens. "He was going in pretty comfortable. When I started to catch up, Robby moved me right back down behind Generous Rosi. I just didn't have any horse to go on." "It was no shock to see the way he ran today, but I think he can be even better than he showed," said winning trainer Abraham Katryan. Systematic ground out this career-best victory in game fashion to close out his busy sophomore campaign. Having won a mile maiden on the opening day of the turf flat season at Doncaster Mar. 21, he took four of his next five starts, including the extremely competitive King George V H. at Royal Ascot June 20, in which he had subsequent St Leger runner-up Highest (Ire) a neck back in second. Fifth but beaten just a length by his victorious stable companion Bandari (Ire) in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York Aug. 20, he came back to take the Listed Troy S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. Here he was taken to the front in the early stages by Darryll Holland. Headed by Warrsan and Frankie Dettori with 500 yards remaining, he battled to regain the lead at the furlong marker and kicked away from that rival to get firmly on top in the closing stages as Jorge Paulielo closed late on Frankies Dream. Trainer Mark Johnston commented, "He's never won by a wide margin and I think there's a little bit more there, particularly if they came close to him. I think this will probably be his last run this year--I think he's probably had enough now." Holland added, "My horse really put his belly to the floor and really stretched his neck out. **O'BRIEN FOCUSES ON LONGCHAMP** After saddling **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) to a runner-up finish in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot and witnessing the racecourse gallop of **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) after racing, Aidan O'Brien turned his attention to next Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. O'Brien's Arc runner **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) was sidelined with a bout of coughing after adding the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 30 to the Epsom version June 8 and missed his intended prep run in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 15 due to an adverse blood count. "It has to be a worry how some of the horses have run," said O'Brien at Ascot Saturday. "They were sick and could do nothing for six weeks, and it's a long time for horses that were absolutely up in the air with well-being. When they go down, it's very hard to get them back up. We didn't get to run High Chaparral in a prep and we're just hoping that, if he is well, he will run a good race on the day. There is really nowhere else we can start him, but he's in good form and we have always thought he was an exceptional horse." High Chaparral may yet join the "Rock" and possibly Hawk Wing at the Breeders' Cup meeting at Arlington Oct. 26, according to O'Brien, who added, "Our running plans depended on what happened today and what happens next week with High Chaparral. We'll see what happens next week before a decision is made." Meanwhile, Ascot racecourse have issued a statutory £3,000 fine to O'Brien for withdrawing the "Rock" from Saturday's mile contest.

**MILLS RULES OUT ARLINGTON BID** Terry Mills yesterday reported **Where or When (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) fine after his two-length defeat of Hawk Wing (USA) in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Mills is currently against sending the three-year-old to the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile at Arlington Oct. 26. "I can't see [him running again] this year." Mills said. "You are going to see him next year. 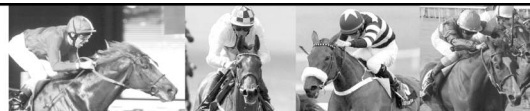
