"There was a little more concern about her going too slow because she's real laid back. If you turn her on, she'll work well. If you leave her alone, she'll stay turned off." **Zavata** (Phone Trick) breezed over Saratoga's Oklahoma training track yesterday, clocking the five furlongs in around 1:03, according to trainer Patrick Biancone. "It was just an easy work and I was very happy with it," Biancone said. "We're not trying to break track records in the morning. He looks bright and happy and he's learned to relax more." Zavata ran third as the 1-5 favorite in the GI Hopeful last time out.

Matron third-place finisher **Fircroft** (A.P. Indy) worked a half mile yesterday at Belmont in :49. "I think she learned a lot in the Matron," trainer Rusty Arnold commented. "She's the kind of filly that can't get stopped. She's so big that it's hard for her to get going again. She probably needs to make one big run. I think she'll be better Saturday than she was in the Matron."

Undefeated **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), who won the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Aug. 31, breezed an easy seven-eighths of a mile Monday morning for trainer John Ward over Keeneland's main track in preparation for Saturday's feature. The colt covered the first quarter in just over 14 seconds and completed the work in 1:32.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

One of the first lessons to be learned by any budding bloodstock agent is never underestimate the latent power of the bloodlines developed by the Aga Khan's famous studs. This must have been foremost in the mind of the BBA (England) representative who bid a modest \$20,000 at Keeneland's 1990 November Sale to buy Future Past, a six-year-old mare by Super Concorde out of the Aga Khan-bred Afasheen.

Future Past had earned less than \$34,000 in a 59-race career spanning five years on the track, and the fact that she had gained only four wins, compared to 12 seconds, rather suggested that she was lacking in either finishing speed or enthusiasm. However, Future Past's ordinary racing record was of almost secondary importance to the bottom line of her pedigree, which featured such illustrious broodmares as her fourth dam Éclair (dam of the excellent stallion Khaled) and her accomplished second dam Aimee.

Although Aimee provided the Aga Khan with three stakes winners--Flaming Heart, Afayoun and Adjarida--her greatest talent was her ability to produce excellent broodmares. Five of her seven daughters produced at least one stakes winner, the finest examples being Runaway Bride, dam of the exceptional Blushing Groom; Flaming Heart, dam of the very good miler Maroun; Khazaeen, dam of the Oaks third The Dancer; and Zannira, dam of the Italian Oaks winner Zabarella.

Future Past's dam, the non-winning Afasheen, was one of the two daughters of Aimee which failed to produce a stakes winner, but the strength of her bloodlines has also enabled Afasheen to make a lasting impression through her own daughters. Future Past's buyers in 1990 would have been well aware that the mare's half-sister On The Tiles was responsible for Air de Rien, a cheap yearling who developed into one of the best three-year-old fillies in France in 1990, when she won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary. Afasheen's last foal Sheena's Gold, who was sold for only \$19,000 as a yearling, is also the dam of a Grade 1 winner, in the shape of The Groom Is Red, the 1998 Champagne S. winner who is inbred 4x3 to Aimee.

Now Future Past has become the third daughter of Afasheen to become the dam of a Group 1 winner, thanks to Where Or When, the impressive conqueror of Hawk Wing in the Queen Elizabeth II S. It could be claimed that Future Past had already achieved that distinction because she is also the dam of All The Way, a Shirley Heights colt who collected the 2000 Singapore Derby for Godolphin, having finished a creditable fifth in the previous year's Epsom Derby for Where Or When's trainer, Terry Mills. Future Past had been carrying All The Way when she was sold for only 14,500 guineas in 1995.

Where Or When has played a major role in turning the spotlight onto his young sire, Danehill Dancer. This son of Danehill proved a great bargain at the 38,000 Irish guineas he cost as a yearling, carrying Michael Tabor's colors to victory in four of his first five starts. Danehill Dancer won the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S., the G1 National S. and the G3 Greenham S., as well as finishing second in the G1 Dewhurst S. Unfortunately, the second half of Danehill Dancer's racing career was much less distinguished and he finished no closer than third in any of his last six starts. *(cont p3)*

Sterling Rose captured his second straight group stakes triumph at Hanshin Sunday following his score in the G3 Procyon Stakes in June. Breaking from outside draw, the Shuji Kitahashi-trained five-year-old was off the pace early in the race before taking the lead in mid-stretch. Kept to task through the lane, he was under only moderate urging to lodge the smart half-length success.

Sakura President, who broke his maiden at first asking in August, was unhurried early, but mounted an impressive challenge in the straight and stormed home for the 3/4-length victory.

Consequently, his earlier achievements had been tarnished by the time he started his Northern Hemisphere stallion career in 1998 at Kilsheelan Stud, a Coolmore substation. His fee of only 4,000 Irish guineas ensured that he received strong numerical support, but many of the mares had no pretensions to producing anything better than a run-of-the-mill winner--something which was reflected in his median price of only 8,000 guineas when his first yearlings sold in 2000.

Needless to say, there were some excellent buys among them, such as Ziria, a 27,000-guinea filly, who has won the G3 Prix du Bois and the G3 Prix du Petit Couvert. This fast filly is inbred 4x3 to Northern Dancer and 5x5x4 to Natalma.

Also in that first crop were Lahinch, his top-priced yearling, who has justified her price with Listed wins at two and three and a head second in the G2 Rockfel S.; the Group-winning Lady Dominatrix, who has established herself as one of England's fastest three-year-old fillies despite having cost as little as 2,000 Irish guineas; the Listed winner Bright Edge, who cost 4,000 guineas (and is inbred 3x3 to Sharpen Up); and the 26,000-guineas Where Or When, who now has three stakes wins to his name and a growing reputation as one of the best milers in Europe.

Although Danehill Dancer's second Irish crop is smaller, it too is producing some above-average performers, such as St Pancras (a good second to the highly regarded Almushahar in the G2 Champagne S.), Monsieur Bond (a close second in the G2 Mill Reef S.), Miss Takeortwo (a Listed-placed triple winner) and Daganya (a creditable fourth in the G1 Phoenix S.).

The success of Danehill Dancer's first crop ensured that he was in great demand this year in Ireland, where he covered 196 mares at a fee of Ir£9,000, and he is currently in Australia, where his representatives include the Group winners Jar Jar Binks and Choisir. Now, with three Group winners in his first crop, he is likely to be more popular than ever when he returns to Ireland at the end of the year.

"They both went well," Lellouche said yesterday. "Aquarelliste worked as she usually does, as she never shows too much in the mornings. However, she proved she is in very good condition and Bright Sky also went nicely." He is also entered in Sunday's G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp alongside Spartacus, while **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) and **Miss Helga (Ire)** (Alzao {USA}), second and fifth respectively behind **Rainbows for All (Ire)** (Rainbows for Life {Can}) in the G3 Debutante S. at The Curragh Aug. 11, may contest the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on the same card.

**YAVANA'S PACE LAME**

Trainer Mark Johnston yesterday revealed that **Yavana's Pace (Ire)** (Accordion {Ire}) returned lame after finishing third in Sunday's G1 Canadian International at Woodbine. Having notched a third in last Sunday's G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne, Johnston indicated that the 10-year-old had been treated for a foot abscess before the race and was hoping that the present lameness was a direct result of that problem. ## TWO-YEAR-OLD REVIEW

By Sunday, the juvenile picture will become clearer, with no less than four Group 1 juvenile contests scheduled from Thursday. That day witnesses the return to the track of the unbeaten **Russian Rhythm (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), who overcame considerable trouble in running to win the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 21. Having looked workmanlike previously when taking the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 27, she appeared nothing short of exceptional on the knavesmire, picking herself out of a hole on the fence before overwhelming her rivals in the closing stages. That was the first time the crowds had witnessed the acceleration that had been exciting trainer Sir Michael Stoute and jockey Kieren Fallon on the Newmarket gallops since the spring. She faces the promising **Ego (GB)** (Green Desert {USA}), who hails from the stable of Geoff Wragg, and Henry Candy's star filly **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}) over the six furlongs of the Rowley Mile, and it would be a testament to her natural ability if she manages to contain this speedy duo. Victory will cement her worthy position as favourite for next year's 1000 Guineas in May. If she happens to fail, then the filly to assume the mantle may be Saturday's G1 Fillies' Mile winner **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}). Her form is closely tied in with Airwave, and that filly will provide further clues on Thursday.

**Elusive City (USA)** (Elusive Quality {USA}) looked different class in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30 before outpointing **Zafeen (Fr)** (Zafonic {USA}) in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 25. With the runner-up subsequently taking a competitive renewal of the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury Sept. 20, jockey Mick Channon was understandably keen to take on trainer Gerard Butler's colt again at Newmarket. However, if Elusive City makes it into the starting gate on Friday and has the furious tempo and fast ground he requires, he may prove too strong again. Success on Friday will undoubtedly secure a visit to Arlington in a bid to emulate Johannesburg (USA) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26, but he has a long way to go to match that exceptional colt's achievement.

In France, the general gloom surrounding the standard of the colts was lifted by the impressive **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {Ire}) in last Sunday's G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. He made decent rivals look pedestrian in the closing stages there, despite showing greenness. As a half brother to Daylami (Ire), who had a similar profile at two, he is a cast-iron certainty to stay middle distances next year, and it will be surprising if he fails to progress. A crack at the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud Nov. 2 beckons, as does the title of top French two-year-old should he succeed there.

This weekend's features look set to be dominated by the fillies, who also accounted for the entire domestic defense of the Prix Morny. It will be fascinating to see if the unbeaten **Intercontinental (GB)** (Danehill {USA}) is routed to that one rather than the G1 Prix Marcel Bousac the same afternoon. Her performances so far suggest she is on the road to adding another chapter to the remarkable story that is her dam Hasili (Ire). If trainer Andre Fabre decides not to take on the colts, that will set up an intriguing clash with **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}). Pascal Bary's filly showed the same relentless galloping style of her sire when powering away with the Listed Prix Roland de Chambure at Deauville July 11 before making light work of the task set upon her in G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville Aug. 23.

While Aidan O'Brien's juvenile team has been beset with the untimely coughing that intervened in mid-summer, it has been left to trainer Dermot Weld to seize the initiative and the imposing **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) provided the ultimate bonus in winning the G1 National S. at The Curragh Sept. 15. With consistent yardsticks **Van Nistelrooy (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) and **Dublin (Ire)** (Carson City {USA}) in second and third, respectively, the form looks solid, and it will be a major surprise if he fails to build on that.

Two days before Dublin's solid run in the National S., his stable companion **Almushahar (USA)** (Silver Hawk {USA}) took an already lofty reputation to new heights with a comfortable score in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. While his performance in that event fell short of that produced by last year's winner Dubai Destination (USA), who gunned down Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in that colt's only legitimate defeat, the post-race talk was exalted. Comparisons with Dubai Millennium (GB) will have to wait for justification as, like Dubai Destination, injury has denied Almushahar a vital run in the Dewhurst S. Oct. 19.

Had he made that Newmarket contest, he may have had to confirm the form of his debut maiden success with the runner-up **Maghanim (GB)** (Nashwan {USA}) and third-placed **Trade Fair (GB)** (Zafonic {USA}), both impressive in winning subsequently. Like Zafeen, Trade Fair is a particularly promising son of the ill-fated Zafonic, and it will be ironic if, in the wake of his recent tragic death, they can complete the Middle Park-Dewhurst double for their sire.
