### A MID' PARK DREAM

He did it the hard way, but 6-1 chance **Oasis Dream** (GB) (Green Desert) had enough in the tank to beat **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) and **Elusive City** (Elusive Quality) and set a new track record in yesterday's G1 Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. at Newmarket. "It was a very, very fast time and I've always liked him," trainer John Gosden said after the colt had grabbed the advantage at the quarter-mile marker and powered away from his rivals, finishing the six furlongs in 1:09.61. "And now he's the fastest in Europe over a mile." Having finished fifth in his debut in a Salisbury maiden Aug. 14, Oasis Dream found the smart Rimrod 3 1/2 lengths too strong in a similar event at Sandown Aug. 30. He made no mistake next time when taking a Nottingham maiden in impressive style Sept. 20 and showed the same blistering speed to capture this prize. Although **Irrawaddy** (Nureyev) provided a lead for the first three furlongs, Oasis Dream was perfectly positioned in second by Jimmy Fortune and struck as Tomahawk was committed by Michael Kinane at halfway. Hitting the front with a quarter-mile remaining, his acceleration carried him clear of that rival and Elusive City, who stayed on well having raced keenly for Kieren Fallon in the early stages. "This is a very nice horse, and he won in a canter at Nottingham and carried on improving," Fortune said. "It's very fast ground, which he needs, and they have a tailwind." Gosden added, "He was very green first time out, and he was beaten over a stiff seven furlongs by a very good horse who went on to break the track record at Goodwood next time. I was confident about him being quite hard to beat here, but he's a Green Desert, so he's not guaranteed to stay a mile. He'll go seven though, so he might be more one for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [French 2000 Guineas at Longchamp] instead, as it's an easier mile." Trainer Gerard Butler said of Elusive City, "I am disappointed, but we'll be back. He just didn't flow down the hill and Kieren [Fallon] said he was keener than he wanted him to be." William Hill reacted by cutting Oasis Dream to 16-1 from 33-1 for the Newmarket Classic, while Elusive City was eased to 33-1 from 16-1.

### SADLER'S WELLS TOPPER AT HOUGHTON

Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estates outbid David Thompson to take home the 1.1-million guineas topper at last night's finale of the Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale in Newmarket. The bidding battle between Angus Gold, Sheikh Hamdan's racing manager, and Thompson, owner of the Cheveley Park Stud in Newmarket was over lot 178, the Sadler's Wells filly out of Group 3 winner Dazzling Park (Ire) (Warning {GB}), consigned by Seamus Burns's Lodge Park Stud. When Thompson tried to gain the upper hand at 1,050,000 guineas, it was no surprise to see Gold, with his employer standing close by, go the final distance.

Of the session-topping yearling, Gold said: "She is a very well-bred filly out of a good mare and by the top stallion around. We hope she will be a good racemare like her dam. You have to pay for this quality, though you never really know how much it will take. We never really discussed a price. I thought about 750,000 but Cheveley Park were persistent. Sheikh Hamdan fell in love with her." Burns was understandably delighted at the outcome for the first foal of the mare. He said: "I was told all week that she was the nicest filly in the sale. She has always been beautiful since she was born. The dam has a foal by Desert Prince and she is in foal to Grand Lodge."

**Busy Buyers**

Demi O'Byrne, who signs for the Coolmore purchases, bought 16 overall for 8,205,000 guineas, with three Maktoum family buyers next in line, Shadwell with 11 for 3,875,000 guineas, John Ferguson Bloodstock with 8 for 2,635,000 guineas and Gainsborough with 8 for 2,070,000 guineas. Michael Goodbody, managing director of Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud, signed the 590,000-guineas ticket for lot 177, the Barathea (Sadler's Wells) filly out of Dynata (Shirley Heights) who has already produced five winners. Goodbody commented: "She has a fantastic pedigree and is out of a full sister to Darshaan (Shirley Heights). It is a female line that we have always wanted. She is a good individual and very athletic and I thought she might make 750,000 guineas."

**A Strong Sale**

Tattersalls felt vindicated in keeping the catalogue small, with the gross for the entire sale down only one percent, 28,220,000 guineas as against 28,563,000 guineas in 2001. Both the median and the average were up, with the former standing at 160,000, up three percent on last year's 155,000. The average rose by four percent to 227,580 guineas. Out of the 193 yearlings catalogued, 164 were offered and 124 sold. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said: "To have exceeded last year's figures would have been more than satisfactory under any circumstances, but in the prevailing economic climate we would have to be delighted with the outcome of the sale. It has not been an easy year at this level of the market and we approached this week with a measure of caution, but this year's dual Derby winner High Chaparral has been a great advertisement for the Houghton and we felt that the catalogue was a little bit special. The fillies in particular were a spectacular bunch and it was no surprise that the sale topper was a filly for the first time since the great Bosra Sham in 1994." Last night's affair saw 94 catalogued, with 81 being offered and 62 selling for 13,933,000 guineas, at an average of 224,725 guineas and a median of 160,000 guineas.

**ZAVATA TO MISS CHAMPAGNE** Michael Tabor's **Zavata** (Phone Trick), who raced to the top of the two-year-old division with victories in the GIII Tremont S. and GII Saratoga Special earlier this season, will miss Saturday's GI Champagne S. after suffering a bruised left hind foot. "He must have kicked his stall at night," commented trainer Patrick Biancone. "He's not lame, but he does have swelling in his left hind. With such little time until the race, we're better off safe than sorry." It is uncertain how the injury will affect Zavata's chances of contesting the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, though his conditioner is hopeful that his charge can recover in time to make the race. Owner and trainer will be represented in the Champagne by **Brancusi** (Deputy Commander), second to Champagne starter **Erinsouthernman** (Eltish) in a Sept. 1 Saratoga maiden.

**AMERICAN OAKS WORTH \$750,000 IN 2003** Next year's running of the American Oaks will be worth \$750,000. This year's inaugural running of the race, held during Hollywood Park's Spring/Summer meet, was worth \$250,000. "Obviously we are striving to develop the American Oaks into one of our premier events at the Spring/Summer Meet along with the Hollywood Gold Cup," commented Hollywood racing secretary Martin Panza. "Our goal is to establish another international event in California, complementing the Turf Festival at our Autumn Meet." The American Oaks will be run on July 5 in 2003. The 1 1/4-mile turf event for three-year-old fillies will be limited to 14 starters, with graded/group stakes winners receiving preference. Invitees will be announced June 22.

**YAVANA'S PACE IMPROVING** Trainer Mark Johnston yesterday issued an upbeat bulletin on **Yavana's Pace (Ire)** (Accordion {Ire}) after the 10-year-old suffered a potentially career-ending injury on Sunday. Having finished third behind Ballingarry (Ire) in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine, the gelding was discovered to have injured the suspensory ligament on his left foreleg, but the injury does not appear as serious as first thought. "He looks much better now," Johnston said. "As far as suspensory injuries go, it is not as serious as it could have been, and it's a mild one. It might have been troubling him a bit in Canada as he was hanging right, which is unlike him. If he was a young horse he would recover, but [owner] John [Keaney] was thinking about retirement anyway."

**NAYEF TO CHAMPION** **Nayef** (Gulch) will miss Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp and head for the G1 Emirates Airlines Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19, it was announced yesterday. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's four-year-old may now clash with the same owner's **Sakhee** (Bahri) as he bids to win consecutive renewals of the 10-furlong contest. The decision means Nayef will also forego the Breeders' Cup meeting at Arlington Oct. 26. He is expected to stay in training for the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba in March. Trainer Marcus Tregoning said yesterday, "It was a very difficult decision, as the ground at Longchamp this weekend was thought to be in his favour, but we decided to keep him to a 1 1/4 miles, which may be his best trip. The best thing, if he goes for the March race [Dubai World Cup], [would be to] stay in training for next year." **Tau Ceti (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) was the other withdrawal from the Arc at yesterday's stage, while Sir Michael Stoute has declared **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) for the 1 1/2-mile showpiece.

**What They're Saying At Houghton...**

John Warren, the British agent who is also a director of Highclere Thoroughbred Racing, the top-level ownership syndication company, had a sale total of five purchases for 1,425,000 guineas. He gave a fascinating insight into the depth of quality on offer during this Houghton Sale. After paying 420,000 guineas for lot 166, the Machiavellian (Mr. Prospector) colt who is the half brother to two Group 3 winners, he revealed that he had vetted 40 yearlings at the Houghton. He said: "This is the best collection of yearlings that Tattersalls has ever put together in terms of pedigree and individuals. It is just a shame there are not more buyers as this is a magnificent group of horses." He contrasted the situation at the 2002 Houghton with Keeneland's September Sale. He said: "At Keeneland I identified 250 European types from the catalogues covering the first four days and found only eight to vet. I ended up buying none of them, going for one with an American pedigree instead."

The unbeaten **Russian Rhythm** will be a warm order to give trainer Sir Michael Stoute his four victory in this race. Having scored on her debut on the July course in a June 28 maiden, she won the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 27, then faced what appeared a stiff task against the G3 Queen Mary S. winner Romantic Liason (GB) in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 21. Having been shut off on the rail at a crucial stage of that race, she showed high-class acceleration to pass that rival and eventual runner-up **Danaskaya (Ire)** to win by a decisive 1 1/2 lengths. Recent trends are on her side, with Blue Duster and Embassy (GB) having taken the Princess Margaret before winning this in 1995 and 1997, respectively, while last year's winner Queen's Logic (Ire) was following up after the Lowther. If she is in the same form at this late stage of the season, she will prove hard to beat. Geoff Wragg relies on **Ego (GB)** to double his tally in this event. Having won a competitive maiden on the July course here Aug. 24, she showed an electrifying burst of speed to beat the useful yardstick Sarayat (GB) in a conditions event at Doncaster Sept. 14. It has been a long time since Henry Candy handled a two-year-old as impressive as **Airwave (GB)** and that filly's rise has contributed greatly to her stable's revival. She was unlucky to meet subsequent G1 Fillies' Mile winner Soviet Song (Ire) on her debut in a Kempton maiden July 17 before winning a lesser event at Leicester July 31. She was unlucky when fourth in the St Leger Yearling S. at Doncaster Sept. 11 before winning the Listed Firth of Clyde S. at Ayr Sept. 21.

**Affluent**, winner of the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup at this course last fall, found herself second behind the dominant Azeri in three straight Grade I events: The Apr. 6 Apple Blossom, the May 25 Milady Breeders' Cup H. and the June 22 GI Vanity H. Beaten only once in four turf appearance, the chestnut filly returned to the grass to take the July 27 GI Ramona H. in her last trip to the post. **Surya** opened her North American campaign with three straight wins, culminating with a two-length victory in the GIII Royal Heroine at Hollywood Park. Fourth behind Affluent in the Ramona, the bay filly splashed home a 9 1/4-length winner in the Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup last out Aug. 24. **Five Fishes**, a listed stakes winner in France, missed by just a neck in the May 28 G3 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud--her European finale. The French-bred filly was vying for the lead in her American debut, but was bumped and forced to check before coming home only sixth in the July 4 GII New York H.
