### BATTLE OF THE SEXES AT LONGCHAMP

Two of Europe's finest fillies will take on a pair of Derby winners in this afternoon's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp when **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill) and **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) take on **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}). One of Ballydoyle's 'big three,' High Chaparral has never crossed swords with Rock of Gibraltar (Ire), but he put another member of the triumvirate, Hawk Wing, firmly in his place in the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. However, unlike most winners of this contest, he

missed a vital prep due to an unclear blood test, a fact that may render him vulnerable to the domestic defense headed by Sulamani. His 1 1/2-length defeat of Act One (GB) in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 2 secured his meteoric rise to the heights reached by his sire and half-brother Dream Well (Fr). It will not help Sulamani's cause that he was involved in a farcically run G2 Prix Niel here Sept. 15 last time and his relative lack of experience may prove his undoing here. Aquarelliste, who was beaten six lengths by Sakhee when runner-up last year, bids to become the third since 1974 to have gone one better the following year. Like the heroine of that year, Allez France, she is a Wildenstein filly in the great tradition. Sakhee remains the only horse to have beaten her at this track, on which she has plundered last September's G1 Prix Vermeille, the G1 Prix Ganay Apr. 28 and G2 Prix Foy Sept. 15. In the latter she buried the memory of her fourth-placing behind Golan (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27 and hinted that she is returning to her best. Islington will bid to become the first three-year-old filly to win since Akiyda (GB) in 1982. She annihilated her opponents in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 21 and bids to go one better than the family's Sun Princess (GB), who took that contest before finishing runner-up in this in 1983. *Field, p12*

### IMPERIOUS DAME

Godolphin's **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr) became a millionaire with a determined performance on the front end, defeating older fillies to take the \$750,000 G1 Beldame yesterday at Belmont. She wired fellow three-year-olds in the G1 Gazelle H. Sept. 7 and was sent off as the second choice to **Summer Colony** (Summer Squall). Breaking alertly, Imperial Gesture went straight to the front, where she was hounded by **Allamerican Bertie** (Quiet American). When that rival tired in the stretch, Imperial Gesture held a 5 1/2-length advantage and maintained a clear margin at the wire as the favorite spun her wheels. "I don't know if this was the ideal race," said assistant trainer Tom Albertrani, "but it is certainly a good race to get her going to the Breeders' Cup [Distaff, Oct. 26]." The exquisitely bred Storm Flag Flying cemented her status as the favorite for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with this sharp victory over West Coast invader Santa Catarina. After prevailing in her Aug. 18 career opener despite racing greenly, the Phipps colorbearer posted an eye-popping 12 3/4-length victory in the GI Matron S. Sept. 15 and was sent off as the odds-on favorite in this seven-horse field. Allowed to settle just off Santa Catarina, Storm Flag Flying was confidently ridden by John Velazquez, ranging up to draw on even terms turning for home. But just as the pair hooked up in the stretch, Storm Flag Flying lengthened her stride and drew clear while simply being shown the whip by her pilot. "I never had to hit her," said Velazquez.

"She's really learning now. She was dragging me during the first part and I didn't want to fight her. So I gave her her head." Winning trainer Shug McGaughey isn't sure when his unbeaten charge will head to Arlington for the Breeders' Cup, but she will certainly be there by Oct. 26. "You've got two scenarios: either you get there right on top of the race," he explained, "or give her plenty of time to settle in. A lot depends on how she comes out of this mentally." As for the runner-up, Santa Catarina will have another go at Storm Flag Flying. "Yes, she'll improve in another three weeks," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "I just hope the winner doesn't improve."

Toccet was bet down to even-money in his July 7 debut at Colonial Downs, but found the six furlongs of that race too short and finished a distant third. He stretched out to seven furlongs at Laurel Aug. 16 and cruised to a 10-length victory, then tried two turns for the first time in a Pimlico allowance Sept. 6 and won by 8 1/2 lengths. Jumping right into Grade I company off that effort, the homebred bay tucked in behind the leaders as first Desert Warrior (Deputy Minister) and then Icecoldbeeratreds cut out the fractions. He eased back and angled outside while looking for running room as they turned for home, dropped back to the inside for the stretch run and closed well along the rail to take the lead late and draw clear. "The colt is a little green still," trainer John Scanlan said. "He plays around a lot. He's going to learn a lot off this race. I expect big things out of him." The colt will go on to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26. "He'll be at Arlington a week before the race to get a work over the track," Scanlan said. Runner-up Icecoldbeeratreds is possible for the Juvenile, but third-place finisher Erinsouthernman is unlikely to make the trip to Chicago, instead pointing for the GI Remsen S. at Aqueduct Nov. 30. Pretty Wild (Wild Again), the 13-10 favorite off second-place finishes in the GI Hopeful and GI Futurity, made a mild bid on the turn, but came up empty late and finished fourth. "I called on him and he didn't have a response," jockey Shaun Bridgmohan said.

Golden Apples earned her \$90,000 supplementary fee for the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf by getting the best of champion Banks Hill in the Yellow Ribbon. Content to race in third as longshots Noches de Rosa (Stagecraft {GB}) and Nepenthe (Broad Brush) disputed things up front, Golden Apples took the overland route heading into the far turn as Banks Hill was trapped on the rail. Voodoo Dancer was directly to her inside and gave her a run for her money, but Gary Tanaka's colorbearer forged ahead in the final sixteenth. "I said [before the race] she was in the best shape ever, and I think she is," said winning trainer Ben Cecil. "It's not necessarily her style to lie as close to the pace as she did today." Golden Apples will train up to her Breeders' Cup date at Santa Anita and will ship to Chicago early in the week prior to the \$1-million event. After showing promise in four starts in Ireland, she paid immediate dividends by capturing the GI Del Mar Oaks in her state-side debut. She has taken two of three meetings with Astra this year, winning the GII Santa Ana H. and, most recently, the GI Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 17. Favored Banks Hill was mired in traffic at the head of the lane and finished a non-threatening third.

Giving the distaffers a clean sweep of graded sprint stakes yesterday, Kalookan Queen outfinished Crafty C.T. for a game victory, becoming a millionaire in the process. The dark bay mare had beaten males before, taking the GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. in March, a win that earned her a two-month vacation. Beaten a neck in her comeback, the June 7 GIII Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood Park, she tired to be third in the seven-furlong GII A Gleam H. July 14, but cruised to a 3 1/2-length score in the 6 1/2-furlong GIII Rancho Bernardo H. at Del Mar Aug. 25. First or second in all 10 prior starts at this distance, Kalookan Queen started from the far outside in the six-horse field, stalking the pace from fourth as longshot Rio Oro (Oraibi) dashed through a quarter in :21.08 and a half in :43.27. She drove to the front from the outside as they straightened for home and staved off the final surge of Crafty C.T. But she will not face Xtra Heat in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Arlington Park. "There's no chance she'll go to the Breeders' Cup," trainer Bruce Headley said. "It would be hard to run her back in 20 days after she just ran her guts out." But trainer Howie Zucker said the runner-up is possible for the Sprint. "We'll keep our options open," he said.

Trying two turns for the first time, Sky Mesa maintained his unbeaten record with this solid effort. The colt got sick after capturing his career debut, but returned to record a 103 Beyer Speed Figure in winning the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Aug. 31, defeating the highly regarded Zavata. With an eye on the nine-furlong GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, trainer John Ward opted for this Keeneland feature over Belmont's Champagne and the handsome colt was sent off as the heavy chalk. Truckle Feature went up to set the pace, with Sky Mesa content to glide along in third on the outside. The favorite moved up to challenge on the far turn and looked around a bit at the top of the stretch, but was kept busy by jockey Edgar Prado on his way to a four-length victory. "He made every mistake a young horse could make and he still got it done," said Ward. "He relaxed too much around the half-mile pole and he was pricking his ears down the lane. Even though he trains at Keeneland, he's not used to having 20,000 people watching him." The victory was the first graded-stakes success at Keeneland for owner John Oxley. "It's my first one in 30 years of racing horses," he said. "I hope it doesn't take another 30 years for the next one."

For \$75,000, Green Fee could have been claimed out of a race he won by 4 1/2 lengths at Belmont June 23, his first race of 2002. Taken off the market following that one, the handsome chestnut finished third in allowance test July 24, ran fourth against that level in a race won by the MGSW Balto Star Aug. 11, and in his latest was second behind Baptize (Dynaformer) Sept. 6. Making his first start in a graded event since finishing fifth in the 1999 renewal of the GIII Lexington S., the six-year-old was smartly kept off the pace while Patrol (Lear Fan) and Krieger (Lord at War {Arg}) battled up front. Those two faded turning for home, but it was Green Fee who emerged the obvious threat to favored Forbidden Apple at the eighth pole. Under a spirited drive, Green Fee reeled in that rival and asserted in the final stages for his first graded-stakes success. "This was a nice surprise," said winning jockey John Velazquez. "The race figured to set up for us. Once he was clear and on the outside, he really kicked." Just as Green Fee's ride was well timed, so was his entry into the race. "I nominated him at 5:45 p.m. the day [the Kelso] closed," said his trainer Dan Peitz. "I wasn't even really thinking about it; then, all of the sudden, it hit me: 'You know, maybe I ought to nominate this horse for the Kelso.'" Well back in sixth as Bull Market set the pace, Kafwain began to pick off horses approaching the far turn and entered the stretch wide, but under a full head of steam. Bull Market battled back gamely on the inside, but Kafwain had a little bit more in the tank and secured the narrow victory. "They're both going to the Breeders' Cup," said Baffert. "I love Bull Market's race. We've been high on that horse." Third-place finisher Listen Indy was moving well under the wire and will likely be at Arlington for the Juvenile. "He kind of got lost in the shuffle at the quarter-pole there for a minute and I thought that's all he had," said trainer Richard Mandella. "But geez, he dug back in and came like hell. We'll have to think about it [Breeders' Cup]."



Taking command with 400 yards remaining, he was driven out to go clear as Binary File and Eagle Café produced late efforts to fill the places. Trainer Flemming Poulsen said, "I train 15 horses in Denmark and this horse is the best in the country. This is a big thrill and hopefully now we have gained some international recognition. We hope to compete in Hong Kong or Japan which we would like to do now."

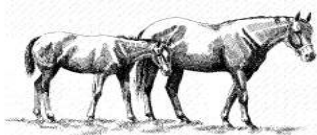

Connections of **Bright Sky** were considering a crack at the Arc before deciding she would drop back in trip for this event. Despite her tendency to race freely, she has shown a highly impressive turn of acceleration which gained her a well-deserved success in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 9. Her keenness in the early stages of the mile and a half G1 Prix Vermeille here Sept. 15 compromised her chances, but she still finished strongly to take third behind Pearly Shells (GB). She faces her elders for the first time here and **Rebelline** will ensure she has an experience she will not forget. Kevin Prendergast's battle-hardened filly remains unbeaten in three starts this year, having claimed the scalp of Johannesburg in the G3 Gladness S. at The Curragh Apr. 7. She added the Listed Mooresbridge S. at that track May 6 before beating Bach (Ire) and Nayef in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup there May 26. Connections will be hoping for overnight rain to produce the testing conditions in which she excels. **Irresistible Jewel** took the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 20 before disappointing when eighth in the G1 Irish Oaks July 14 and fifth in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 21. She bounced back to give Chorist (GB) weight and a half-length beating in the G3 Blandford S. at The Curragh Sept. 15 and must go close. **Quarter Moon** needs to return to the sort of form that saw her finish a half length runner-up to Kazzia (Ger) in the Epsom Classic.

Previously run over a mile, the Grand Criterium was changed to seven furlongs last year and was inaugurated with a scintillating performance by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire). This year Aidan O'Brien saddles **Spartacus**, **Hold That Tiger**, **Great Pyramid** and **Kimberley Mine**. While the former was readily passed over by Michael Kinane in favour of Hold That Tiger in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 11, the outsider surprised his rivals with a game success there as Hold That Tiger trailed in last. Although that colt was found to be suffering from respiratory distress afterwards, it is significant that Kinane sides with Spartacus here. No filly has won this since 1986, but connections of **Intercontinental**, a full sister to milers Dansili (GB) and Banks Hill (GB), evidently feel this seven furlongs will suit her better than the mile of the Prix Marcel Boussac. She can shake up the colts on the evidence of her successes in a debutantes event at Deauville Aug. 18 and conditions score here Sept. 12. **Maghanim** will provide further clues as to the merit of the Newmarket maiden Aug. 23 won by subsequent G2 Champagne S. winner Almushahar. That day he finished ahead of impressive Newbury maiden scorer Trade Fair (GB) before scoring in a conditions event at Doncaster Sept. 11.

Pascal Bary caused an upset when saddling Amonita (GB) to win this two years ago, but there will be no element of surprise if **Six Perfections** follows up here. She outclassed her rivals when winning the Listed Prix Roland de Chambure at Deauville July 11 and showed the same disdain for her rivals in the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville Aug. 23. Bary also saddled Sierra Madre (Fr) to win this in 1993 and this imposing filly can bring up the hat-trick here. All eyes will be on the juveniles **Mister Links** and **Wunders Dream** as they bid to take advantage of this generous weight concession. Sigy (Fr) was the last two-year-old to achieve the feat in 1978 and Superstar Leo (Ire) has come the closest since, when finishing second in 2000. Mister Links has shown his best form over six furlongs, having won the G3 July S. at Newmarket July 10 and finishing second in both the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 21 and St Leger Yearling S. at Doncaster Sept. 11. He may find this too sharp, but **Wunders Dream** has excellent credentials as a five-furlong specialist. The winner of the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood Aug. 1, she was fifth behind Russian Rhythm in the six-furlong G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 22 before returning to the minimum trip to add the G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster Sept. 14 under a penalty. **Continent** had **Bahamian Pirate** a half-length back in second when winning the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 11 before finishing a fine fourth in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 22. He may be best over six furlongs and may struggle to confirm form with his stable companion, who was beaten a half-length by Imperial Beauty in this last year. Since Moorestyle (GB) scored in 1980, only six sophomores have won this and interestingly, five were fillies. They dominate this contest again as **Porlezza** and **Maybe Forever** renew rivalry, with the former holding the edge at present. Since being pulled up and vanned off in the GII Strub S. in February, **Momentum** as been as good as you can be without actually winning a race, finishing within a grand total of two lengths off the victor in his last four races combined. Following the Strub, he was second by a neck versus Hollywood allowance foes in May, was third by a length in the GII Californian S., then was nosed out of a win by Sky Jack in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in mid-July. Last out, he overcame traffic through the stretch to finish 3/4-lengths second to Came Home in the GI Pacific Classic S. Aug. 25. The average of €90,324 represents a 24.5-percent bump against the corresponding figure from 2001.
