THE BARD OF LONGCHAMP

Marienbard (Ire) (Caerleon), deputizing for last year's Arc hero Sakhee, belied his odds of 16-1 to give Godolphin its third renewal of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp yesterday afternoon. The bay unleashed a powerful drive under Frankie Dettori inside the final furlong to overhaul

Islington (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) before holding off the late flourish of **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) to win by 3/4 of a length. "I love

this place!" screamed Dettori, who had ridden Godolphin's two previous winners, Lammtarra and Sakhee. "Just to ride in this beautiful race is a privilege." Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin, added, "It was fabulous. The horse was at the peak of his form today and really justified our hopes for him."

Godolphin Goes Back-to-Back...

Last year, a second straight Arc win for Godolphin looked a million miles away as connections pursued a staying campaign with Marienbard. But he has shown vastly improved form at middle distances this year, stepping up on each performance after finishing fourth in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. The winner of the G2 Jockey Club S. May 3, he came unstuck in the testing ground and ran a distant fourth in the June 7 G1 Coronation Cup June 7, but bounced back to win the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschland-Preis July 28 and G1 Grosse Preis von Baden Sept. 1. The decision was made to send the five-year-old to this contest in place of Sakhee and he duly justified that faith. Held up in seventh early on the inner as **Black Sam Bellamy (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) set a respectable tempo, he was where Dettori wanted him to be. "My horse was going really well and, although he was a little

bit slow away, I found myself in a beautiful spot," the rider said. Angled off the rail as Islington was committed in the final straight, he found a gap between High Chaparral and the wandering **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danhill) inside the final 300 yards. "I thought for a minute, 'I hope this gap doesn't close,' and then he changed his lead and found another kick," continued the Italian. Quickening to hit the front with 100 yards remaining, he stayed on strongly all the way to the line as Sulamani closed late. "Last year, we were trying to make him into a slightly longer distance horse than he really is and Sheikh Mohammed said, 'stop messing about,' and bring him back to the trip we know he is effective over," Crisford explained. "In the last few months, he has really come to himself. He's in the G1 Japan Cup and everything else." Pascal Bary, trainer of Sulamani, said, "You've got to be disappointed to finish second, but he ran a superb race and showed he is the best three-year-old in Europe," adding, "He is probably through for the season." Take Charge Lady hadn't been beaten in three previous Keeneland appearances and she got the job done once again as the even-money favorite yesterday. The ultra-consistent bay followed a second-place finish as the 8-5 choice in the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks with a win in the May 25 GIII Dogwood S. at Churchill, then was sent to the sidelines for a freshening. She returned to be second behind Saturday's impressive GI Beldame S. winner Imperial Gesture in the Sept. 7 GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Park, then shipped to the scene of her victories in the 2001 GII Alcibiades S. and 2002 GI Ashland S. Jockey Edgar Prado settled the filly along the rail as You sprinted to the early lead, then sent her through on the inside at the three-sixteenths pole. Ridden out to the wire, Take Charge Lady drove home a decisive winner. "She's just awesome," trainer Ken McPeek said. "When that hole opened up, she just took off. I think the time off we gave her over the summer was a big deal. I had to resist a bit not to run her in the Mother Goose and those races and now we're seeing some rewards." Looking ahead to the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Arlington Park Oct. 26, where the filly will again go nine furlongs, he added, "I questioned in my mind if she would go a mile and an eighth, but she proved she can today." Hold That Tiger demonstrated an incredible finishing burst that took him from last to first in under a furlong and gave trainer Aidan O'Brien his fourth edition of this race since 1997. The colt showed the same speed when accounting for his rivals in a Leopardstown maiden June 12, but he had to battle in the soft going to hold off the tough Pakhoes (Ire) by a neck in the G3 Railway S. at The Curragh June 30. Sent off the 11-10 choice in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 11, he trailed in last behind Spartacus (Ire) (Danehill) that day, after which it was discovered that he had succumbed to the virus that had afflicted Ballydoyle's older horses. He had recovered, but O'Brien admitted, "I knew he was coming around to his best, but didn't know whether he was fit enough, as he had only been back in work for three weeks." That may have swayed Michael Kinane to partner Spartacus, leaving Kieren Fallon to steer Hold That Tiger. Things did not look promising at the start as he dwelt from the stalls and had to race in last position off the pace set by Le Vie dei Colori. Still trapped in the rear as the race unfolded in the straight, Hold That Tiger was switched wide for his run and delivered a spectacular turn of acceleration to cut down the game frontrunner in the final strides. While Coral Eurobet now quote him as the 8-1 joint-favourite with Trade Fair (GB) for the 2003 2000 Guineas, O'Brien cited that the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile as a possible target in the interim. Second to Trevisé (Fr) in a debutantes event at Chantilly June 17, Six Perfections made no mistake when stepped up in trip for the Listed Prix Roland de Chambure at Deauville July 11, pounding the smart Nellie Nolan by six lengths that day. She was equally impressive when winning the G3 Prix du Calvados back at that track Aug. 23 and was a warm order to follow up in her sternest task here. Travelling easily in fifth under jockey Thierry Thulliez off the moderate pace set by Etoile Montante, she moved closer at the top of the straight as the long-time leader stole a healthy advantage on the rail. Quickening effortlessly to take over with 300 yards remaining, she needed hand-and-heels encouragement to assert over that rival as they pulled clear of the remainder. Trainer Pascal Bary, who won this race with Sierra Madre (Fr) in '93 and Amonita (GB) in '00, was delighted. "She's fantastic and won very well twice at Deauville," said Bary. "She's a lovely filly and has plenty of scope, with speed, ability and the pedigree to match. Today, she was always travelling very well; she came to win quite easily and was just looking a little in front. It is too early to say whether she will go for the English or French 1000 Guineas--we will see how she does early next year." William Hill responded by quoting her as the 4-1 joint-favourite for the Newmarket Classic alongside Soviet Song (Ire). Six Perfections is out of a half-sister to champion miler, two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner and star broodmare Miesque (Nureyev). Bright Sky turned this race into a procession with a brilliant turn of acceleration to reward connections' decision to bypass the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe later in the afternoon. That mile and a half may have proved beyond her, as it did last time when she finished third behind Pearly Shells (GB) in the G1 Prix Vermeille Sept. 15. But over 10 furlongs, her potent finishing speed had previously proved too much for her rivals in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly June 9. This time, she was reserved in the rear early by jockey Dominique Boeuf as stable companion Blue Lightning cut out fast fractions with Irresistible Jewel in close company. Irresistible Jewel moved to the lead, but Bright Sky loomed large and, when Boeuf asked her to quicken, she responded emphatically to hit the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before powering clear for an impressive success. Trainer Elie Lellouche commented, "She's a really top-class filly and had the race won a furlong from home, which was quite amazing. She showed she doesn't stay in the Prix Vermeille, but was fresh here and in top condition, showing all her class and ability. She may go for the GI Breeders' Cup Fillies and Mares Turf [at Arlington Oct. 26] or the G1 Hong Kong Cup [at Sha Tin Dec. 5] and will stay in training next year." Mass confusion reigned in Longchamp's winner's enclosure, where the connections of Slap Shot held premature celebrations, but the photo finish showed it was, in fact, Continent in front at the wire. Last year's Ayr Gold Cup H. winner had made the impact at stakes level this term, beating Bahamian Pirate (Housebuster) by a half-length in the G1 Darley July Cup July 11 before finishing fourth in the G1 Nunthorpe S. Aug. 22. Last time, he struggled to get on terms before finishing fifth behind Invincible Spirit (Ire) in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 7, but his customary late thrust proved enough this time. Showing tactical speed to track over from his high draw, he was able to sit in sixth early under Darryll Holland as Slap Shot went to the front. That filly did not relent in the drive to the line despite the strong challenge of Ziping, but it was Continent who had his nose in front on the final dip of their heads. Trainer "Dandy" Nicholls said, "I thought we were beaten--I was confused by the Italians celebrating. You've got to give credit to Darryll, as he gave him a brilliant ride today. He will probably go for the G1 Hong Kong Sprint [at Sha Tin Dec. 5] now." The winner will meet Ziping there, who has been confirmed on target for the race by a delighted trainer Robert Collet. Give Notice marked his arrival on the staying scene when beating Persian Punch (Persian Heights {GB}) in the G3 Sagaro S. Apr. 30. He disappointed when fifth in the G3 Lonsdale S. Aug. 20 last time, but was off at 6-1 to turn things around here. Rated near the back by jockey Johnny Murtagh as Persian Punch assumed his rightful role as pace setter, he made steady headway on the outside and was in striking position as that veteran attempted to draw the sting from his rivals on the false straight. The winner was asked to lengthen as Polish Summer (GB) (Polish Precedent) quickened to the front with quarter of a mile remaining and responded in game fashion to hit the front with 50 yards remaining before pulling out all the stops as Pushkin closed late. "I thought when [Polish Summer] kicked, he was quickening up very well," said Murtagh, "but I had a furlong to go and I was always getting there." Trainer John Dunlop said, "We will keep him in training and aim him at the Cup races next year." Polish Summer finished third, but had wandered right across Persian Punch under pressure and was disqualified and placed 15th. Persian Punch, fifth, was also disqualified and placed last. Their riders, Christophe Soumillon and Martin Dwyer, were banned for four days and two days, respectively. 


