Just this year, **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), **Mail the Desert (Ire)** (Desert Prince {Ire}), **Margarula (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}), **Pearly Shells (GB)** (Efisio {GB}) and **Rebelline (Ire)** (Robellino) have advertised the auction by winning at the highest level.

### Sire Power...

This year's catalogue is boosted by a strong representation of Sadler's Wells, who has 20 yearlings in the sale; and his illustrious neighbour Danehill, who accounts for 19. Numerically, freshman sire Peintre Celebre has the greatest presence at the Orby auction with 22. Other top stallions with sizeable lots on offer are Desert Prince (Ire), Grand Lodge and Indian Ridge (Ire), while the top American sires Danzig, Diesis (GB), Gone West, Kingmambo, Nureyev and Seeking the Gold have small or sole offerings.

### MARIENBARD RETURNS

Godolphin yesterday reported that **Marienbard (Ire)** (Caerleon) is 'fine' after his success in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. Sammy Avis, Godolphin's travelling head lad, accompanied the five-year-old back to England Monday morning. He said: "Marienbard cooled down well after the race and travelled back this morning. He is none the worse for the journey and was back in his box at 10 a.m." Connections of Marienbard have yet to decide on the horse's next race. "The GI Breeders Cup Turf [at Arlington Oct. 26], the G1 Japan Cup [at Nakayama Nov. 24] or the G1 Hong Kong Cup--we'll be considering all these races and more," trainer Saeed bin Suroor told *Gulf News* yesterday. "But it's still far too early to make concrete plans. A mile and a half is clearly his best trip."

**SMILE VICTORIOUS IN METROPOLITAN** Bargain-basement purchase **Victory Smile (NZ)** (Victory Dance {Ire}) cost just A\$1200 and the tough stayer doubled his prizemoney, to A\$600,000, leading home a New Zealand-bred trifecta Monday in the G1 Metropolitan S. at Randwick. The New Zealand Warriors were thrashed 30-8 by the Sydney team Easts in the National Rugby League grand final Sunday night, and Victory Smile's trainer Donna Logan, who prepares a team of 40 north of Auckland, told the Warrior players to back the six-year-old and change their luck. Logan, who dedicated the win to the team, said, "He had to run one, two or three today to justify pressing toward the G1 Melbourne Cup [Nov. 5], and Melbourne--we're coming." Victory Smile settled at the rear of the 18-horse field while **Master Pom (Aus)** (Garcia) set a solid tempo in front. Jockey Dan Beasley elected to shadow **Dress Circle (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) out at the 800 meters, where he quickly gathered in six rivals in front of him to win by 1 1/4 lengths. The winner covered the 2400 meters in a race record of 2:31.30, with the first 1200 meters in 1:16.16 and the final 600 meters in 37.14. Trainer Gai Waterhouse was denied a seventh Metropolitan win with the best result from four representatives being third-placed Dress Circle, who won the 2001 edition of this race, ahead of stablemate **Red Trinket (Aus)** (Lure). Victory Smile received a 1.5kg penalty for the win, assuring him of a start with 52kg in the Melbourne Cup. Waterhouse said Dress Circle is likely to contest the G1 Caulfield Cup [Oct. 19], but Logan is not sure the race will suit her charge. Victory Smile finished two lengths seventh on a heavy track over 2000 meters at Ellerslie on Sept. 21 at his Metropolitan lead-up and first appearance since jockey Stathi Katsidis was dislodged in the Grafton Cup in New South Wales in July.

When breeders use a high-priced stallion, it is a pretty safe bet that most of them are hoping for a colt, rather than a filly. One notable exception to this general rule, though, was Darshaan, who commanded a fee of Ir£75,000 last year in his final season at the Aga Khan's Giltown Stud.

While Darshaan has established himself as a very good sire of colts through the exploits of such as Kotashaan, Mark of Esteem, Mutamam, Olden Times, Dilshaan and Josr Algarhoud, it was his growing reputation as a sensational sire of broodmares which compelled owner-breeders to use him in 2001, after his 2000 season had been cut short by colic surgery in March.

### *(Darshaan's female influence...)*

Darshaan's broodmare daughters had been producing Group 1 winner after Group 1 winner, with Sendawar, Enzeli, Alborada, Greek Dance, Astarabad, Zainta, Ebadiyla and Edabiya all winning at the top level in a relatively short space of time. Since then, this flow of major winners out of Darshaan mares has developed into a torrent. Last year saw his daughters add four more Group 1 winners to their list, thanks to High Chaparral, Milan, Quarter Moon and Sulk, and this year's tally of Group 1 performers includes the winners Best of the Bests, High Chaparral, Islington and Marienbard; and the Group 1 runners-up Alasha, Medecis, Quarter Moon and Sulk.

It probably won't have escaped your notice that three of these 2002 Group 1 winners out of Darshaan mares were among the 16 runners in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, with Marienbard winning, High Chaparral finishing a close third and Islington coming home an honorable fifth.

So what is it that has made Darshaan such a force as a broodmare sire? The explanation could be no more complicated than the fact that Darshaan was a very good racehorse--he defeated Sadler's Wells and Rainbow Quest in a vintage Prix du Jockey-Club--who was mated to a lot of mares from excellent families.

Darshaan was also an excellent physical specimen, with a truly beautiful head and neck running into a very good shoulder. In fact, he oozed quality and among his physical attributes were his size (16.1 hands), good bone, an excellent hind-leg, good pasterns and big feet. Whereas many of today's Thoroughbreds are flat through the knees, Darshaan was a little over at the knees. *(Pedigree Insights cont. p4)*

## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

### The Heat is On

Last year's champion three-year-old filly, **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) arrived at Arlington Park Sunday afternoon to prepare for her next start, the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Second in the 2001 Sprint, the four-year-old defeated males for the first time in winning the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup H. Saturday at Keeneland. "She cooled out well and ate up well Saturday night," said the filly's groom, Javier Cruz. "She will probably have three days off and may go to the track here Wednesday. That's her usual schedule."

### *(Pedigree Insights cont.)*

Looking at photographs of him, you could be forgiven for thinking that he was one of the many good-looking horses produced by Marcel Boussac in the 1940s. Of course, Darshaan was bred by the Aga Khan from Delsy, a mare acquired from Boussac. The female line traces to Djezima, who found fame as the dam of the top-class Priam, the similarly talented Djeddah and the exceptional broodmare Tourzima. You'll find Tourzima in the bottom line of Darshaan's pedigree and her three-parts brother Djeddah in the top half, where he appears as the broodmare sire of Never Bend.

Several of Never Bend's descendants, such as Riverman and Irish River, have excelled as broodmare sires, as did Darshaan's grandsire Mill Reef and his sire Shirley Heights.

The choice of Caerleon as the 1996 mate for Marienbard's very similarly named dam, Marienbad, probably had a lot to do with the success Caerleon had enjoyed with Shirley Heights' broodmare daughters. This type of pairing was given a boost when Atoll, a member of Caerleon's third crop, was narrowly beaten in the 1990 Irish Oaks after winning the 1000 Guineas and Oaks in Italy. Then, on June 7, 1996, the Oaks was won by nine lengths by Lady Carla, another filly by Caerleon out of a Shirley Heights mare, and on June 21, the G2 King Edward VII S. was won by Amfortas, a colt by Caerleon out of a Shirley Heights mare. Marienbad had failed to conceive to Salse, her first mate of 1996, and her owner Saif Ali switched her from England to Ireland to visit Caerleon, who must have impregnated her around June 26, judging by Marienbard's foaling date of May 26.

This foaling date needs to be taken into account when assessing Marienbard's overall record, which excuses him for not having raced as a juvenile. He is also a big horse and the combination of his size and his late birthday helps explain why it has taken him some time to display the full extent of his considerable ability, which he has done with three Group 1 wins this year.

Marienbard is a member of the penultimate crop by Caerleon, who died early in 1998. Although Caerleon always tended to be overshadowed by Sadler's Wells, who occupied the box two doors down at Coolmore, this son of Nijinsky II achieved a tremendous amount.

He was a very, very good stallion, without achieving greatness. From an output of less than 1000 named foals, he sired 72 group or graded winners (including eight in Japan) and Marienbard has boosted his total of Group 1 winners to 24 (including five in Japan).

For a horse who won a classic over 1 1/2 miles, Caerleon proved very adept at siring smart two-year-old winners, such as Generous, Tenby, Cape Verdi and the Cartier Million winners Corwyn Bay and The Caretaker.

However, many of his progeny also relished middle distances at three, and Caerleon had the rare distinction of having sired a five-length winner of the 1000 Guineas (Cape Verdi), a five-length winner of the Derby (Generous) and a nine-length winner of the Oaks (Lady Carla). His stock also won the St Leger, the Irish Derby, the Prix de Diane, the Prix Royal-Oak, the Japanese Derby and four of the five Italian classics, including the Derby and the Oaks. Now we can add the Arc to his long list of major victories.

Marienbard acts well on fast ground, something he has in common with many of Caerleon's progeny. This ability to handle firm going made Caerleon's stock very suitable for racing in the U.S., where Auriette and Kostroma headed a strong team, and in Japan.

The main flaw in Caerleon's record so far is that he has yet to come up with a really good stallion son (not that many of his sons have had a real chance of making the grade). Generous has done respectably, but has only one Group 1 winner to his credit.

It is going to be interesting to see whether breeders are prepared to help Marienbard change this situation when his racing days are over, especially as he has never raced at much less than 1 1/2 miles during his 16-race career. However, he has the attraction of coming from a good family. His second dam Marie de Fontenoy, a daughter of the very big Lightning, was a half-sister to Sakura Reiko, winner of the Prix Morny; and to Marie de Russy, dam of the Prix Royal-Oak winner Top Sunrise.

**RACING PROMISES ACTION**

Following the broadcast of the Panorama exposé on Sunday evening, Jockey Club spokesman John Maxse yesterday moved to defend the organisation. 'The Corruption of Racing' sought to expose racing as being what its main witness Roger Buffham, former Jockey Club head of security, termed "institutionally corrupt". However, despite its allegations that the Jockey Club failed to act effectively over the subsequent high-profile cases of Dermot Browne and Graham Bradley, racing's ruling body pointed to lack of evidence to back up its premise. "The allegations put forward by Panorama last night in many cases were unfounded, but they do make a point about public confidence," Maxse said. "The point that the program makes is that we are trying to suggest that we have our heads in the sand and we don't want to act with it. I have to deal with those suggestions and I think racing has got a thing to learn from Panorama. The program last night, I don't think was really quite good enough to ram home the points it was trying to make because it lacked the evidence. That shouldn't stop the industry being willing to be a little bit more open-minded and we can take it forward and increase the widespread attraction of racing." Senior steward Christopher Spence commented: "Although skillfully put together, in my view the Panorama programme was flawed as a result of its over reliance on discredited witnesses with their own agendas." The British Horseracing Board's Communications manager Alan Delmonte said: "BHB's Racing Review Committee, which began its work in June and is expected to report by April 2003, is considering in detail all aspects of British racing and its product. This includes a review of the composition and scope of integrity services and the financial, administrative and governance structure of the sport. The review will be consulting widely as racing seeks to confirm the optimum means of maintaining the integrity and reputation of the sport."
