**WONDERFUL AGAIN?**

Once again, an accomplished field of sophomore fillies has been assembled for the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland, and **Wonder Again** (Silver Hawk) will hope to keep it all in the family. Her connections have won five of the race's 18 renewals, including the 1993 running with her dam's full sister, Tribulation.

The bay filly hasn't missed a beat since breaking her maiden June 26, capping a four-race skein with a victory in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 8 at Belmont. With wins over both firm and yielding ground, Wonder Again shouldn't be bothered by Kentucky's recent rains, but she will have to face a pair of tough challengers: **Zenda (GB)**

(Zamindar), the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine from England; and the transplanted **Megahertz (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who has been nearly unstoppable in Southern California since beginning her career in France. Juddmonte's Zenda has not run since missing by a neck to Sophisticat in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 21. **Little Treasure (Fr)** (Night Shift) is unbeaten in two starts since entering Laura de Seroux's shedrow. **Riskaverse** (Dynaformer) has come back for another go at Wonder Again. The dark bay has run into traffic in both of her last two starts--runner-up finishes to Wonder Again--and draws the rail this time.

**REBELLINE RETIRED**

Lady O'Reilly's **Rebelline (Ire)** (Robellino--Fleeting Rainbow, by Rainbow Quest) has been retired from racing and will join the broodmare band at Castlemartin Stud in County Kildare, Ireland. A 28,000gns TATDEC weanling purchase, she was pinhooked and brought Ir£68,000 at the following year's Orby Sale. The winner of the G2 Pretty Polly S. at three, the bay came to hand this season for trainer Kevin Prendergast, upsetting Johannesburg in the G3 Gladness S. in April before winning the Listed Mooresbridge S. the following month. In what would become the final race of her career, Rebelline turned in an outstanding performance to account for Bach (Ire) and Nayef in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup May 26. She was scratched from last Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp. "She has been a great servant to all who have had the pleasure of working with her," commented James Kelly, racing manager to the O'Reillys.

**NETJETS MILE, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 1mT**

**Chopinina** (Lear Fan), runner-up in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine Sept. 8, is in career form right now, but is lacking in one key area, according to trainer Alec Fehr: R-E-S-P-E-C-T. "I don't know if that's going to happen anytime soon," the conditioner says of the four-year-old filly, who set the pace in the Atto before yielding late and finishing just one length behind Mile hopeful **Good Journey** (Nureyev). "I knew she would do well in the Atto Mile," Fehr continued. "She certainly ran a big race and I was so proud of her, as was [jockey] Emile [Ramsammy]. I think she proved she can run with the best." The grey filly worked a solid six furlongs over the Woodbine main track Oct. 8 and will be cross-entered in the Mile and the F/M Turf. The winner of a pair of optional claiming events north of the border prior to the Atto, Chopinina's efforts have not gone unnoticed. "We've had some calls from New York and elsewhere in the States, people who saw the race," the trainer said. "They're aware of what she did."

**QUARTER MOON RETIRED** Quarter Moon (Ire)

(Sadler's Wells--Jude {GB}, by Darshaan {GB}), a Group 1 winner at two and three-times Classic runner-up at three, has been retired to stud and will be bred to Danehill. Last year's winner of the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh, she returned to finish fifth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5 before finishing runner-up in the Irish version at The Curragh May 26. The bay was beaten a half-length by Kazzia (Ger) in a memorable battle in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7 with the pair pulling 14 lengths clear of the remainder before being beaten two lengths by Margarula (Ire) in the Irish Oaks back at The Curragh July 14. Susequently third in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 3, she was sixth in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York 18 days later while the majority of her stable were afflicted with bouts of coughing. In her final start, she faded into ninth behind Bright Sky (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Sunday. "She is some credit to the team at Ballydoyle," part-owner Richard Henry said yesterday. "She was never sick and it was a real thrill to see her in all the Group 1 races. Mick [Kinane] got off her on Sunday and said she was gone. She will visit Danehill--it's the same cross as [GSW] Irresistible Jewel."

Nick Zito's Najran began 2002 under the care of trainer Kathleen O'Connell, breaking his maiden at Calder on New Year's Day and finishing second in a Gulfstream allowance test Jan. 25, then was off for eight months before making his first start for Nick Zito at Saratoga. That one saw the colt leading the way through sharp fractions and prevailing by two lengths going seven furlongs Aug. 3. He returned a month later to show he could carry his speed as he trounced non-winners of two at 1 1/8 miles Sept. 1. Making his stakes debut as the crowd's pick, the gray battled on the front end with Soaring Free (Smart Strike) through fractions in :22 and :44 2/5. Najran edged clear of that rival turning for home and turned on the jets to roar home an open-lengths winner. "All along we've been thinking what a special horse he is," said Zito. "He's been just perfect since we've got him. Some really good three-year-olds showed up for this race. We're very proud [and] very pleased with this effort."

The classy Quiet Resolve, champion turf horse in Canada two years back, notched his first win of the year when taking the GIII Connaught Cup S. at Woodbine May 25 and had varying success at that track over the summer. After finishing second in consecutive starts, the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. June 16 and the GII Chinese Cultural Center S. July 21, he failed to fire in a disappointing 11th-place effort in the GI Atto Mile Sept. 8. Dipping into allowance company for the first time since April of 2000, he broke alertly and soon settled just off Get Down Wolfie (Wolf Power {SAf}) through six furlongs. When that foe began to fade on the turn, Quiet Resolve took advantage by opening up two lengths on the field and gamely held off the late charge of Cheshire in the final sixteenth.

**SAVILL OUTLINES NEW STRUCTURE** Peter Savill, chairman of the British Horseracing Board, yesterday gave the assurance that a review of the current regulation and security framework would be underway immediately. That could lead to a new structure to police the sport within a period of 18 months, as part of a joint venture between the Jockey Club and the BHB. Savill, who described Sunday's Panorama expose as "a huge embarrassment for racing", said, "The review will be looking--amongst many other things--at the relationship between the governance, regulation and commercial responsibilities for racing and how they should interface. I suspect that the recommendations that emerge will be the same as would have emerged if Panorama had not taken place. We currently have, effectively, two Governing bodies--the BHB and the Jockey Club--whereas all other sports and racing jurisdictions have just one. In order to modernise our structure, I believe that we need to merge the governance and regulatory responsibilities of the two governing bodies into one. We would hope to produce a report by early next year."

**BOYS IN BLUE IN ACTION DOWN UNDER** Godolphin yesterday reported that their contenders for the G1 Tooheys New Melbourne Cup worked well as they begin their build-up to the main event at Flemington Nov. 5. **Beekeeper (GB)** (Rainbow Quest {USA}), **Hatha Anna (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) and **Pugin (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) had their first serious workout yesterday morning since arriving in Australia at the beginning of the month.
