### UP TO THE CHALLENGE

Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland yesterday. The Fox Ridge filly caught Zenda in the final jump to earn her first Grade I by a neck. "At the sixteenth pole, I knew I had her, but after a few more jumps, I didn't know," jockey Mark Guidry said. "[Zenda] didn't want to

give up. She ran a very game race, but [Riskaverse] showed a lot of heart." The winner of the GIII Sands Point S. in June, Riskaverse was eighth in the July 6 American Oaks, then ran second to **Wonder Again** (Silver Hawk) in the Aug. 18 GII Lake Placid H. and the Sept. 8 GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. Off at 7-1 yesterday, the dark bay was next to last for six furlongs, with Zenda just in front of her, but closed stoutly to get the nod. Favored Wonder Again lacked a late kick and finished fifth. ### FORET FOR THE TREES

The G1 Prix de la Foret--Europe's only Group 1 contest for older horses over seven furlongs--will be run this afternoon at Longchamp. While no horse has won consecutive renewals of this event since **Moorestyle (GB)** in 1980 and 1981, **Mount Abu (Ire)** (Foxhound) will bid to match that achievement today. The bay, who registered a two-length upset over **China Visit** in this a year ago, has been pointed for a title defense and prepped with promise on ground faster than he would like when ninth in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 7. Stable companion **May Ball (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) fared better in that sprint, running fifth, then finished 11th in last Sunday's five-furlong G1 Prix de l'Abbaye. She will be better over this longer trip, having won the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over 1300 meters at Deauville Aug. 11. This race has favoured the older generation recently, with only **Poplar Bluff (Ire)** scoring for the sophomore division since 1984, but there are several three-year-olds in this field who could pose a threat. **Godolphin's Meshaheer (Nureyev)** bounced back to form when winning the Listed Dubai Duty Free Cup over this trip at Newbury Sept. 20, while **Medecis (GB)** (Machiavellian), runner-up in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains over this course May 12 and winner of the G3 Prix de la Jonchere at Chantilly June 17, was not disgraced when fifth behind **Banks Hill (GB)** in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 18.

Bringing back memories of his sire Octagonal, Lonhro dug in deep to deny Sunline a 14th Group 1 win in Australia's second major spring weight-for-age contest at Caulfield. The seven-year-old mare, who endured a particularly biting New Zealand winter and arrived here with a thick coat, appeared more forward than when she was third to Defier (Aus) in the WFA George Main at Randwick Sept. 3. The imposing mare immediately assumed her customary lead in the Yalumba, quickened the tempo at the 1000 meters and had a four-length advantage from Ustinov and Lonhro at the 800 meters. But Lonhro reeled her in, getting on top in the shadow of the wire. "When [Sunline's] got that big a start, most horses can't pick her up," said winning trainer John Hawkes. "[Lonhro] showed his true qualities. In their own way, they both did exactly what they could, and I was lucky enough to come out the victor. He's got a way to go to catch up to Octagonal." Highly regarded commentator Richard Freedman summed up prevailing sentiment, saying, "I didn't think Sunline could win the Cox Plate before today, but I do now. She goes beautifully at Moonee Valley. Lonhro's only ever won two Group 1s and they have both been at Caulfield. Can he go to Moonee Valley and turn the tables on her there? That's her course. That is her house of pain, Moonee Valley. When she puts the pressure on them at the 1000 meters out, they'll know it."

Helenus made the leap from maiden galloper to Group 1 winner in just eight days with a Guineas win that earned him favoritism for the Victoria Derby in three weeks time. With Choisir setting a fierce pace up front, Helenus settled ninth of 16 while favorite Bel Esprit settled two from the rear. Jockey Steven King angled Helenus out entering the straight and the colt rapidly gathered in Choisir to win by 1 1/2 lengths before tossing King off his back upon returning to the enclosure. "I had to have a stiff drink to settle my nerves a bit, but this is great," said winning trainer Leon Corstens. "I've never been this nervous since Let's Elope won the Caulfield Cup [1991], but I thought he had a good chance going in to the race and everything worked out great." Helenus emerged on the spring horizon with an eye-catching long neck third in the Guineas prelude Sept. 3, then notched his first win in five appearances in last Friday night's G2 Bill Stutt S. on a rain-affected track. While Helenus silenced doubters who believed his win last Friday was aided by a soft track, G1 Blue Diamond S. winner Bel Esprit silenced a legion of critics with his sensational sprint from last to take second for his third straight Group 1-placing this campaign, and his connections are considering pressing ahead toward the G1 Cox Plate Oct. 26.

Bold young Randwick conditioner John O'Shea took on Shot of Thunder and turned the compact runner from a noted backmarker into a horse capable of racing right on the pace. O'Shea's ebullient confidence in the five-year-old was rewarded when his charge dived for the line to earn his first Group 1 success by a nose in a blanket finish here. He settled fifth and wide with dual Toorak winner Umrum leading by a length from Scenic Peak. Scenic Peak took over at the 200 meters, but Shot of Thunder, with his distinctive white bandages and black and yellow colors featuring a lightning bolt, emerged from the pack in a powerful burst of speed. Grand campaigner Umrum rallied and Scenic Peak matched strides with Shot of Thunder, but winning jockey Glen Boss flattened along his mount's neck to push him over the line in front. Purchased by Perth trainer Dave Edwards from the first crop of Thunder Gulch for A\$255,000 at Inglis Easter 1999, Shot of Thunder was later acquired by O'Shea, who syndicated him. His new owners include Jon Haseler's Glenlogan Park Stud, where Shot of Thunder will eventually stand stud. Umrum, winner of the race in 1999 and 2000, was elevated from third to second when stewards ruled that Pernod had lugged in close to the finish.

After three straight second-place finishes, Union Place broke the streak with a game victory here. The bay started the season with a Gulfstream Park allowance score Jan. 27, but had been winless since, playing the role of runner-up in four of his next six starts including the Aug.5 GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga. In his latest, he came home second, a length behind Finality in the GII Jamaica H. at Belmont Park Sept. 22. Getting Eibar Coa in the saddle this time, the Florida-bred was never far from the lead and went up inside favored Miesque's Approval on the far turn. Those two fought it out to the wire, with Union Place outfinishing the crowd's choice for a narrow score. "I really wanted to wait a little longer, but [jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard Miesque's Approval] made kind of an early move," Coa said. "I decided just to go with him. I was inside and had room to go through. My horse really resounded well, the way I was expecting. He fought all the way to the end." Added Bailey, "Someone ran up behind us and clipped heels with my horse. That made him want to run and get into the race too early. This horse does not like to run that way and it kept him from running his own race." **Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.**

Love Everlasting had to work to justify odds-on favouritism, but responded to grind out her first Group success, providing Kevin Darley with an afternoon stakes double in the process. An authoritative winner of the Listed Harvest S. over this course Sept. 27, she had previously disappointed when last of nine in the G3 Park Hill S. at Doncaster Sept. 11. She had to be niggled along in last place by Darley in the early stages as Frankie Dettori took Bright and Clear to the front. That rival looked to have poached a healthy advantage off the final turn, but Darley was driving Love Everlasting to close and she gradually wore down the pacesetter with 150 yards remaining before asserting herself for the score. "It got messy early on and she was having to race with the horse on her inner to get a position," said winning trainer Mark Johnston. Jockey John Velazquez lost his whip at the head of the lane, but used a different bit of equipment to urge favored Fisher Pond to victory. "When I called on him, he responded," Velazquez said. Added trainer Todd Pletcher, "Fisher Pond likes a wet track. He's an A.P. Indy and it looks like he's getting better with age. He likes these longer distances." As for his future, Pletcher said, "He's lightly raced and we are both optimistic and realistic."
