**A FUNNY THING HAPPENED IN THE ASTARITA**

**Humorous Lady** (Distorted Humor), making her first start in open company, went wire-to-wire and just held on to win yesterday's GII Astarita S. at Belmont Park. Since finishing third in her debut at Hollywood in June, the dark bay filly graduated for \$40,000 at Hollywood June 19 before besting fellow Cal-breds in the July 26 CTBA S. at Del Mar and again in the Aug. 11 Mid-Peninsula S. at the Bay Meadows Fair for trainer James Chapman. After her dominant performance at Bay Meadows, where she clocked the 5 1/2 furlongs in 1:02.72, Humorous Lady was purchased by S. David Plummer and sent to trainer Michael Smith, a former assistant to Gary Jones. Making her first start for the new connections, Humorous Lady splashed to an early lead, setting fractions of :21.91 and :45.23, she opened up a three-length advantage in the stretch and had just enough left to hold off the late-charging **Fast Cookie** (Deputy Minister) to win by a nose. The final time for the 6 1/2-furlong race over a sloppy track was 1:17.76. "She's one of the fastest horses I've ever been on," jockey Jerry Bailey said after riding Humorous Lady for the first time. "When the gate opened, I lit her out of there and she took off. I wish I hadn't asked her to run so hard early on. She got tired, but she ran awfully hard early." Smith added, "She's something special. She's very aggressive. I talked to [jockey] Russell Baze before we bought her and he told me he wished he hadn't sent her so hard in her races in California because she's so fast. She's very quick from the gate. **DEDICATION CEREMONY AT LONGCHAMP**

**Dedication** (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) swooped wide in the straight, then held the late thrust of **Medecis** (GB) (Machiavellian) to collect yesterday's G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in stakes-record time. "After all these years riding for [trainer] Mrs. [Criquette] Head, I had never won a Group 1 race in her mother's colors," said jockey Olivier Doleuze, who left to begin his career in Hong Kong after the race. "To do so now is a great moment for me and I could not be more proud." Sixth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 12, Dedication captured the Listed Prix Amandine going seven furlongs July 12 before finishing a half-length runner-up in the G2 Prix d'Astarte Aug. 4 and G3 Prix Quincey Aug. 31, both at Deauville's mile. She was a troubled sixth last time in the Listed Prix du Pin Sept. 22, but reversed that form in style, accelerating from mid-division to take the lead with 150 yards remaining before leaving favoured Medecis with a fruitless pursuit. Co-owner/breeder Alec Head revealed that Dedication is States-bound now. "It was my intention before the race to send her to New York to be trained by Christophe Clement, as the European program does not favour fillies and mares," he said, but ruled out a crack at the Breeders' Cup. Frankie Dettori made no mistake on the 3-5 favourite Slickly as he took the steel grey to the head of affairs and led all the way to the wire in a dominating performance. In doing so, Slickly was winning back-to-back renewals, having registered a facile score in this race on his last racecourse appearance 12 months ago. Since he joined Godolphin from Andre Fabre's stable in 2000, Slickly has been campaigned lightly, and that patience is paying dividends as he has developed into a consistent performer at the highest level. The winner of the G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp in September 2000, he was off the board in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket the following month, finding the 10 furlongs of that test a trip too far. Returned to a mile in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp last September, he was imperious in defeating Banks Hill (GB) by three lengths before following up with a six-length score in last year's running of this race. Winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor said: "He won very well and he continued his Group 1-winning run from last year. He is a tough horse and he ran a big race, leading all the way under Frankie who gave him a good ride." As for what's next, bin Suroor added, "There are no plans at present--everything is up in the air--but we may consider the G1 Hong Kong Mile [at Sha Tin, Dec. 15]." Johar had been knocking on the door of graded stakes success all summer with a runner-up finish in the June 1 Gill Will Rogers and a third-place effort in the June 30 Gill Cinema Breeders' Cup H. Most recently, the bay colt was second behind Inesperado (Fr) (Zayyani {Ire}) in the Sept. 7 GII Del Mar Derby. After getting squeezed at the start, Johar moved to a stalking position early. He angled to the outside for the stretch and closed determinedly to just nip Rock Opera at the wire. "I was worried because the seconds were starting to pile up a little bit for him," admitted winning rider Alex Solis. "But really, he's a very nice horse and the longer distance is what he needed. He's bred to go 1 1/2 miles and that's what his best game is going to be." Of the trip, Solis added, "He got squeezed really hard at the start, but after that I was in a good position the whole way. I was very glad to see the favorite [Inesperado] in front of me. I just followed him and when I asked my horse, everything came out good for us. Laffit [Pincay]'s horse [Rock Opera] was very tough to catch, though. He really dug in hard and we got him right at the wire." Winning trainer Richard Mandella commented, "He's a good horse. I think he'll really prosper when they go 1 1/4 miles. And I think he'll be a good, old horse."

**COWDIN S.-GIII results cont.**

Boston Bull raced greenly while coming up just a neck short in his 5 1/2-furlong debut at Saratoga Aug. 31, but returned to graduate over seven furlongs at Belmont Sept. 21. Heavily favored in the short field of four, the bay colt pressed the pace through fractions of :22.47 and :45.27 before charging clear down the lane. "We planned to stalk the speed, but he broke so sharp that [jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] just let him run," explained winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "He was impressive today and I think he'll go longer. He galloped out well and has been getting better with each race. He made a few mistakes in his debut, but he's learned from them." As for what is next for Boston Bull, Pletcher added, "We weren't planning on using this as a prep for the [Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup] Juvenile, but I don't want to rule anything out until I talk to [owner] Mr. [Cot] Campbell." West Point paid Dhs425,000 for **Alocadito (Arg)** (Mutakddim--Alsaciana {Arg}, by Merce Cunningham), a three-year-old colt who was twice second in his two starts in Argentina. The chestnut is from the family of Argentine champion La Galerie (Arg), MG1SW Gouache (Arg) and G1SW Apeles (Arg). "Dubai is a new frontier for us," West Point President Terry Finley said. "We enjoyed our time and were impressed with what we saw. We hope to be back." Also bringing Dhs500,000 was **Dreadlock (Arg)** (Candy Stripes--Brushing, by Equalize), a three-year-old colt who was purchased by Sheikh Khalid Saqr Al Qasimi. The dark bay was a winner at two in his native country. The sale featured 30 North American-bred two-year-olds and 20 Argentine-bred three-year-olds. The top-selling North American-bred was Hip 38, an unnamed Canadian-bred colt by freshman stallion Grand Slam out of SW Social Director (Deputy Minister) who was purchased for Dhs475,000 by Rashid Bouresly. The third annual Pearls of Dubai International Sales realized an aggregate of Dhs9,010,000 for the 50 lots sold. The gross was down 42 percent from 2001, when 53 lots brought a total of Dhs15,530,000. The average of Dhs180,200 was down 38.5 percent from last year.
