### SAKHEE RETIRED

Godolphin yesterday announced that **Sakhee** (Bahri--Thawakib {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells) will not make Saturday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. and will instead be retired immediately. The five-year-old will stand the 2003 breeding season at owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Nunnery Stud in Thetford, England. Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "Sakhee's campaign has been held up this year, owing to the fact that his knee problem meant that we couldn't possibly risk him on the firm ground that has prevailed for so long both at home and on the racecourse." He added, "Sakhee has been a great champion for Godolphin. His stunning victory in the Arc last year and brilliant run in the Breeders' Cup Classic were the highlights for us."

### A Champion at Four...

Plagued by knee problems after finishing runner-up to Sinndar (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby of 2000, he was still able to come back at four to post imperious victories in the G1 Juddmonte International S. and the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. The bay was beaten a nose by Tiznow in a memorable battle in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont and ended the season as the 133-pound heavyweight in the 2001 International Classifications. He was taken to Dubai to be prepared for a tilt at the 2002 G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba, but, although he impressed with a smooth trial on dirt, he disappointed when third behind Street Cry (Ire) in the main event. He made only one more start, finishing a game second in the Aug. 10 G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville. Sakhee retired with eight wins, three seconds and a third from his 14 starts for earnings of \$3,253,253. He will stand for a fee of £20,000. "He was always very straightforward--a gentleman of a horse--and when he was on his song he was unbeatable," jockey Frankie Dettori said.



## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

### CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

GII Washington Park H. winner **Tenpins** (Smart Strike) worked five furlongs in 1:03 1/5 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning, but after the move, trainer Don Winfree said the four-year-old would not be running in the Classic. The colt will instead point for the Oct. 26 GII Fayette S. at Keeneland and the Nov. 29 GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs. "This horse has made a believer out of me--he's for real," Winfree said. "But he'll be for real next year. That was the original plan--to let him mature and prep him this fall in these other races. It would be a better year than I could have hoped for if he got a piece of the Fayette and a piece of the Clark--and maybe a big piece of one or the other. It would be an unbelievable year for him."

**Macho Uno** (Holy Bull), fifth in the Washington Park last time out, worked a mile in 1:40 at Arlington Park yesterday. The four-year-old cruised through fractions of :25 2/5, :38, :49 4/5, 1:01 2/5, 1:14 4/5 and 1:28 2/5. "I was really happy with the work," trainer Joe Orseno said. "He broke off with a horse in front of him just the way I wanted, so he would have something to run at. Then he caught the other horse and came home fast the last part of it. He got everything out of it I was looking for."

### NETJETS MILE, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 1mT

GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Night Patrol** (Storm Boot) will skip the Mile and instead head for the GII Citation H. at Hollywood Park Nov. 30. "He loves Hollywood," trainer Nick Canani said, adding, "He's been the type of horse that really doesn't like to ship. He loves it here and he likes time between his races. If I ran in the Breeders' Cup, it would cut my time of running at Hollywood and he loves that course." **Breeders' Cup Bulletin cont. p2**

**BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m**

**Lone Star Sky** (Conquistador Cielo), sporting blinkers for the first time, worked a half in :50 over the Churchill main track yesterday morning. "We tried that today with the idea of putting him into the race a little earlier than he has been the last couple of times and we think it could make a big difference at Arlington Park," trainer Tom Amoss said. "He's always been kind of a lazy horse in the mornings--or a horse that took care of himself on the track. That's beginning to happen early on in his races and he's becoming a horse that only does what he is made to do. We want to put him closer to the pace in the Breeders' Cup so that he doesn't have a lot to do at the end of the race. We think that might be the way that we might turn the tables on some of the competition we face." Lone Star Sky came from far back to be second in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity last time out. The colt will have one more work at Churchill before heading to Chicago toward the middle of next week.

**LONG JOHN SILVER'S JUVENILE FILLIES, \$1,000,000, 2yo, f, 1 1/8m**

**Buffythecenterfold's** (Capote) chances of going to the Breeders' Cup have improved, from "70-30" on Sunday to "85-15" yesterday. "I'm pretty sure we're going to go," trainer Mel Stute said.

**DISTAFF, \$2,000,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/8m**

**Two Item Limit** (Twining), third at 32-1 in the 2001 Distaff, worked six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 4/5 and galloped out seven furlongs in 1:27 2/5 at Arlington yesterday. Rene Douglas, who partnered the four-year-old to a win in an Arlington handicap Sept. 14, was in the irons for the move. "Even Rene was happy [with the work], and he's a hard man to please," said Mike O'Neill, assistant to trainer Steve DiMauro. "She was full of herself today. Everything is falling into place."

**NAPA SPRINT, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 6f**

**Bonapaw** (Sabona), a perfect two-for-two at Arlington, worked over the Chicago oval's main track yesterday, going five furlongs in a rapid :57 4/5 and galloping out three-quarters in 1:11 2/5. The six-year-old gelding is coming off a victory in the GI Vosburgh at Belmont Park. "I thought it was an excellent breeze," trainer Norman Miller III said, but added, "We just followed the same routine that we follow month after month. We don't get too excited about it and Bonapaw doesn't get too excited about it, either." As for the bay's training schedule going forward, Miller said, "We'll just gallop him up to the race now and hope we have enough gas in the tank to beat these other champions."

**Kona Gold** (Java Gold), the 2000 Sprint champion and Eclipse Award winner, zipped five furlongs in :58 2/5 with jockey Alex Solis in the saddle at Santa Anita Monday. "He's never worked this good," Solis said. "He's working out of this world. It's amazing how fast he is working and how easily he's doing it. He's coming into this race so good." Kona Gold, who makes his fifth Sprint appearance this year, has not been out since running sixth in the July 6 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H.

**Explicit** (Distant View) has been taken out of Sprint consideration after working five furlongs in :58.80 at Hollywood Park yesterday. "He ran down again, just like he did in the Ancient Title and at Saratoga," trainer Ian Jory said. "It's the same leg, his left fore. We'll give him a breather and get him right again and look to run in Hong Kong." The five-year-old will be pointed for the Dec. 15 Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin.

Glia hadn't been expected to try the dirt for the first time in her U.S. bow, but she was kept in the race when it was switched off the turf and proved the decision a wise one with a decisive score. The bay had beaten subsequent G1 Prix de la Foret winner Dedication (Fr) by a neck in a Listed event at Maisons-Laffitte in April, then tired to be eighth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches in May. In her lone start since, she had finished fifth in the Aug. 4 G2 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville. The second choice trying the main track for the first time, the Flaxman homebred was rated at the back of the small field of five for a half and followed the leaders around the far turn, but drove between horses at the top of the lane and quickly opened daylight on her rivals, winning handily. "I saw the hole and went for it," said jockey Javier Castellano, who picked up the mount from Jerry Bailey, who is currently sidelined by a kidney stone. "When I asked her, she really exploded." **PEDIGREE INSIGHTS**

**DYNA-MITE**

When Dynaformer moved to Three Chimneys Farm for the 1995 breeding season, his fee of \$15,000 placed him well down the farm's pecking order, with only one of the nine stallions standing for less. This son of Roberto has now earned much more respect and next year will see him standing his second successive season at a fee of \$50,000--a figure which places him \$30,000 below Rahy, \$25,000 below Point Given and \$10,000 below War Chant.

It could be argued that Dynaformer currently represents better value than either Point Given or War Chant, simply because he has already proven himself capable of getting high-class performers crop after crop. Even when he commanded a fee of only \$5,000 in the five years he spent at Wafare Farm at the start of his career, he sired winners of the calibre of Vergennes (GI Holywood Derby), Blumin Affair (second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile) and their fellow graded-stakes winners Formal Tango, Old Chapel, Dynamic Trick, Rabiadella, Dixie Dynasty and Voyagers Quest.

It is well worth remembering that much of the success he has enjoyed over the last two years has been with offspring sired at fees of \$20,000 or less, including GISW Critical Eye. His 1998 and 1999 crops, each of which contained around 60 named foals, have produced Baptize, a dual Grade II winner on turf; Starrer, a dual Grade II winner on the dirt; Grade III winner Blazing Fury, who was recently a close second in the GI Turf Classic; the Grade II winner Perfect Drift, who became the second son of Dynaformer to finish third in the Kentucky Derby; and Riskaverse, who followed Collect The Cash as Dynaformer's second winner of the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup in the last three years.

There is also an extensive and talented supporting cast from Dynaformer's 1998 and 1999 crops, featuring the turf stakes winners Bold Answer, Dynamous, Maliziosa, Minimalist, Mystery Giver, Spanish John and Transition Time.

While the number of turf performers on this list suggests that this is the best surface for the majority of Dynaformer's progeny, the likes of Perfect Drift, Blumin Affair, Starrer and Critical Eye provide a strong reminder that he can sire top performers on both surfaces. Dynaformer was also versatile in his racing days, gaining his Grade II wins in the Jersey Derby and the Discovery H. on dirt and later setting a track record over 1 1/2 miles on turf at Keeneland.

Because Dynaformer stands 17 hands, I am always surprised by his ability to get juvenile winners. He had sired 77 of them to the end of last year, with as many as 11 coming in a single crop, and he already has his first stakes winner from his 2000 crop (sired at a fee of \$30,000). This is Fortuitous, who collected the second division of the GIII Natalma S. at Woodbine, not long after another daughter, Sand Springs, had finished third in the first division.

Riskaverse's dam, The Bink, is a perfect example of the better class of mare that Dynaformer has been attracting in recent years. The Bink is a very well-bred individual, a member of the first crop by Seeking The Gold. Her second dam, Toll Booth, earned the title of Broodmare Of The Year at the age of 20 in 1991, when her daughter Christecat was in the midst of a very successful career which, coincidentally, included a neck second in the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup.

Christecat was no less than the seventh stakes winner out of Toll Booth, following a sextet led by the top-class Plugged Nickle and his Grade III-winning sister Key To The Bridge. Toll Booth's dam, the celebrated Missy Baba, would also have been a worthy winner of the Broodmare Of The Year title, as her six stakes winners included GISW Sauce Boat, the champion sire Raja Baba and the highly influential Gay Missile, ancestress of A.P. Indy, Summer Squall and Lemon Drop Kid.

The Bink is inbred 3x3 to Buckpasser, a distinction she shares with the very good broodmare Whakilyric, who has the French Derby winner Hernando and the Group 1 winner Johann Quatz among her five stakes winners. The Bink could prove similarly effective judging by her first two living foals, which are the Grade III turf winner Cozy Corner and Riskaverse.
