SINGSPIEL COLT TOPS TATTERSALLS DAY 2

A 280,000gns Singspiel (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}) colt sold just six lots into yesterday's second session of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and remained the top lot throughout another day of solid trade. Hamdan Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estates purchased the Lavington Stud offering, a half brother to the useful juvenile filly Luvah Girl (GB) (Alzao). Racing manager Angus Gold, who saw off Cheveley Park Stud manager Chris Richardson, reported: "He was very athletic and by a sire who has not had many runners, but the ones that he has had have shown a bit of class. Sheikh Hamdan will allocate yearlings to trainers within the next three weeks."

Coolmore agent Demi O'Byrne, who failed to make the buyer's sheet on Tuesday, was busier yesterday, when his haul included a pair of Danehill colts--a grandson

of Irish St Leger winner Eurobird (Ire) (Ela Mana-Mou {Ire}) offered by Gerry Jennings's Carrowdore Castle Stud, made 220,000gns and the second was a 250,000gns colt out of an unraced half sister to the G1 Italian Oaks winner Valley Of Gold (Fr) (Shirley Heights {GB}) and to this year's G3 Vintage S. winner Dublin (Ire). There have been 63 six-figure lots over the first two days at this sale compared with 56 at last year's entire fixture.

LOTS TO NOTE...

Lot 340 (f, Danehill--Meritxell {Ire}, by Thatching {Ire})

Danehill was a sire in demand and his filly out of Almushtarak's half sister Meritxell (Ire) yielded a good return for her breeder Maire Costelloe when offered through John Kilpatrick's Co Kildare-based operation J K Thoroughbreds. Joss Collins of Blandford Bloodstock signed for her at 250,000gns with Johnny McKeever the underbidder. Collins said: "She is for an American owner who is in the air at the moment so I don't know where she will be heading. She was a great mover and just a lovely filly, as she would need to be for me to give that money for her."

Lot 436 (c, Grand Lodge--Top of the Form {Ire}, by Masterclass)

Johnny McKeever signed at 225,000gns for a Grand Lodge colt that had cost 75,000gns as a weanling consigned by Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud. "He's for an existing client with Jeremy Nosedo," said McKeever. "We've been bidding like fury and underbidder a couple of times, but we kept on trying."

Lot 290 (Unfuwain--Haboobti, by Habitat)

Irish trainer Charles O'Brien, son of legendary handler Vincent and brother-in-law of John Magnier, will train an Unfuwain filly bred by former jockey Willie Carson and bought for 200,000gns by Charlie Gordon-Watson. The yearling is a half sister to stakes winner Boojum (GB) (Mujtahid).

Lot 525 (Imperial Ballet {Ire}--Fantastic Flame {Ire}, by Generous {Ire})

Flaming Eyes (Ger) sold for in utero for 55,000gns at the Tattersalls December Sale. Yesterday, the bay filly fetched 155,000gns from bloodstock agent Brian Grassick. Her dam is a full sister to group stakes winner Germano (GB) and a half sister to graded stakes winner Moon Solitaire (Ire).

BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

Trainer Paco Gonzalez sent out **Came Home** (Gone West) for an easy five-furlong work yesterday morning at Santa Anita. The sophomore colt, winner in his most recent start of the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 25, got interior fractions of :12 2/5 for the opening furlong, :37 1/5 for three-eighths and a half in :49 2/5 before completing the work in 1:02. "I didn't want him to work fast today," Gonzalez explained. "I just want to keep him happy. And he is happy; that's the main thing."

Evening Attire (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) arrived at Arlington Park by van yesterday morning at 4:30 and is comfortably bedded down in barn 16 on the backstretch. The consistent four-year-old registered the most important victory of his career in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park Sept. 29 and is likely to take to the autumnal weather in the Midwest. "[Evening Attire] is a good cold weather horse," trainer Pat Kelly commented on a windswept and cool morning. "He once won a race in the snow," he added, referring to his victory in the GIII Aqueduct H. last January.

JOHN DEERE TURF, \$2,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/2mT

Seven-year-old **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) worked five furlongs over the Oklahoma turf course at Saratoga yesterday morning. With the dogs placed in the middle of the track, the gray galloped an easy three-eighths of a mile before breaking off, getting the distance in 1:04 3/5. "I was very happy with the way he went," commented Hall of Fame trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "It was a long, useful steady sort of maintenance breeze. We were well satisfied with the work." The gelding, seventh in last year's Turf, strung together three straight Grade I victories this summer, capped by his one-length score in the GI Man o' War S. at Belmont Sept. 7, but comes into this year's event off a sixth-place finish in the GI Turf Classic Sept. 29. Although Sheppard believes that With Anticipation prefers some give in the ground, it is unlikely that the Augustin homebred will run if the Arlington turf is "very soft," according to Sheppard. Weather permitting, the Pennsylvania-bred will work again next Wednesday at Saratoga before vanning to Chicago later that evening.

DISTAFF, \$2,000,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/8m

Azeri (Jade Hunter), who rates the strongest favorite in any of the Championship races, turned in a sharp three-furlong drill Tuesday morning at San Luis Rey Downs, covering the distance in :35 3/5. "I'm starting to get nervous," trainer Laura de Seroux told *Daily Racing Form*. "I just want to give her a couple of three-furlong works, have her gallop out five furlongs. I'm just trying to keep her from getting too fresh." De Seroux will also saddle three-year-olds **Dublino** (Lear Fan) in the Filly and Mare Turf and recent import **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the Turf.

NETJETS MILE, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 1mT

Touch of the Blues (Fr) (Cadeaux Geneux {GB}), runner-up to **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) in the GI Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile Oct. 6, worked a half mile in :49 2/5 over the Keeneland turf course Tuesday morning and is reported to be on course for the Mile. "He just cruised around there," trainer Neil Drysdale commented. "At the present time we are planning to send him to the Breeders' Cup."

NAPA SPRINT, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 6f

Disturbingthepeace (Bold Badgett), who will be supplemented to the Sprint for \$90,000 by owner David Milch, breezed five panels at Santa Anita yesterday morning in 1:01. Regular rider Victor Espinoza was aboard for the move. "He was supposed to go in around a minute," trainer Darrell Vienna explained. "I told Victor not to go too fast with him because he's been working a little faster than we want. I'm really happy. Victor did a great job with him this morning." The California-bred carries a six-race winning streak into the Sprint, including a head success in the GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar Aug. 18.

LONG JOHN SILVER'S JUVENILE FILLIES, \$1,000,000, 2yo, f, 1 1/8m

Ivanavinalot (West Acre), an impressive 13 3/4-length winner of last Saturday's My Dear Girl S. at Calder, has been pre-entered for the Breeders' Cup by owner and breeder Gil Campbell. "She came out of the race great and I had to send her back to the track...because she's been suicidal around the barn and she feeling so good," trainer Kathleen O'Connell told *Daily Racing Form*. A decision to enter the Florida-bred into the race could come as late as next Wednesday, when post positions will be drawn. "Unfortunately, the Stallion Series finale fell only two weeks before the Breeders' Cup," the conditioner continued. "If we had another week, it would be a no brainer." Once beaten in her six-race career, Ivanavinalot's five wins have come by a combined 41 1/4 lengths.

GII Walmac International Alcibiades S. heroine **Westerly Breeze** (Gone West) breezed five furlongs yesterday morning in 1:02 4/5 at Churchill Downs beneath jockey Robby Albarado, who has the call on race day. "She finished up good," trainer Carl Nafzger commented. "We just wanted to let her stretch her legs. We wanted to see where we're at with her. She's had a race and she's fit. She ran hard in her last race. But I just want her finishing." Westerly Breeze, who broke her maiden at Arlington Aug. 16, will van to Chicago Oct. 24.

BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m

Dogwood Stable announced yesterday that **Boston Bull** (Boston Harbor), four-length winner of the Oct. 13 GII Cowdin S. at Belmont Park, will pass the Juvenile in favor of the GIII Nashua S. Nov. 2 and the Nov. 30 GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct. "We were slightly tempted by the Breeders' Cup, but the fact that it was a mile and an eighth and involved a ship to Chicago two weeks after the Cowdin dampened our enthusiasm," commented Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "This colt has the pedigree and looks to be anything and his race in the Cowdin was most impressive. We hope he can be a serious racehorse for us."

CHARISMATIC SOLD TO JAPAN Charismatic (Summer Squall--Bali Babe, by Drone), winner of the 1999 Kentucky Derby and Preakness S., has been sold to the Japan Racing Association in a deal brokered by bloodstock agent Rollin Baugh. The chestnut, an unknown commodity when winning a \$62,500 claiming race by disqualification early during his three-year-old season, was well beaten in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but returned on just 15 days' rest to win the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland, punching his ticket for Louisville. Bred by Parrish Hill Farm, Charismatic took the Run for the Roses by a neck and followed up with a 1 1/2-length success in the Preakness. The 8-5 favorite to become racing's 12th Triple Crown winner, Charismatic was injured in deep stretch of the Belmont, but managed to cross the line in third before being quickly pulled up by jockey Chris Antley. He entered stud at Lane's End Farm in Kentucky where he stood his first three years at stud for a fee of \$35,000. A half brother to the recently retired Grade I winner Millennium Wind, GSW Tossofthecoin and MSP Bahatur, the six-year-old joins War Emblem, Squirtle Squirt and Swept Overboard as recent purchases by the Japanese.

BEST OF THE BESTS TO DALHAM HALL Godolphin yesterday announced that **Best of the Bests (Ire)** (Machiavellian--Sueboog {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}) will retire to Dalham Hall Stud in 2003. Purchased by the Dubai-based operation at the end of his two-year-old campaign, he achieved Group 1 success at the age of five, when beating Poussin (Ire) and Banks Hill (GB) in the Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 19. Best of the Bests was also the winner of the G3 Solario S. as a juvenile, G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville at three and twice successful in the Maktoum Challenge on the dirt at Nad al Sheba. He was also third behind Giant's Causeway in the 2000 G1 Irish Champion S. and in this year's renewal behind stable companion Grandera (Ire) and Hawk Wing. "He's been a super-consistent and brave campaigner for Godolphin," the stable's Simon Crisford said yesterday. "His run against Grandera and Hawk Wing was sensational, typified his spirit and showed just what a good horse he is." Sam Bullard, head of nominations at Darley, added, "Best of the Bests was a super racehorse--precocious, brave and very talented, and he held his form over four years on the track. He is a handsome horse, out of a fast, group-winning Darshaan mare and we're delighted to be standing him next to his sire." On the board in 12 of 19 starts, the Irish-bred chestnut won five times and earned \$684,728. Best of the Bests will stand at a fee of £5,000 Oct. 1st, special live foal.

Epsom H. winner Filante, raced by Geoff and Beryl White whose best known sire was the Widden-based Marscay, stands at Widden. Macedon Lady was a A\$22,000 Inglis Classic purchase for trainer John Symons, who also purchased Bel Esprit for just A\$9,000 from the same sale. She will target the G1 VRC Oaks (2500 meters) after making up a dozen lengths today from the home turn to record her fourth win in seven appearances. "I think she has a lot of staying potential and I didn't know if this race would be a bit short for her," said jockey Steven King.

GORGEOUS DIES Gorgeous (Slew O' Gold--Kamar, by Key to the Mint), one of the leading three-year-old fillies of 1989, died Oct. 4 after suffering internal hemorrhaging at owner Robert Clay's Three Chimneys Farm near Midway, Kentucky. She was 16 years old. A maiden winner in two starts as a juvenile, the dark bay mare won the GI Ashland S. and GI Hollywood Oaks before finishing second to Bayakoa (Arg) in that year's Breeders' Cup Distaff at Gulfstream Park. She returned the following season to defeat her rival in the GII Apple Blossom H. and took the GI Vanity Invitational before being injured when runner-up to Bayakoa in the GI Spinster S. A half sister to GI Kentucky Oaks winner and outstanding producer Seaside Attraction, Gorgeous has had seven foals to race, the best of which is Stunning (Nureyev), a stakes winner and multiple graded-stakes placed performer in France. She has a two-year-old of 2002 by Broad Brush. Gorgeous was buried in the stallion cemetery at Three Chimneys alongside *Gallant Man and Chief's Crown. "She was given the distinction of being in the same cemetery as the stallions," Three Chimneys President Dan Rosenberg told *Thoroughbred Times*. "We do have one for the broodmares, but given her meaning to the farm, it was appropriate that she was buried near the stallion division."

KERRI CASNER AMONG BALI MISSING Kerri Casner, the 23-year-old daughter of WinStar Farm co-owner Bill Casner and his wife Susan, is among those reported as missing following the bomb explosion in Bali, Indonesia, last Saturday. Kerri Casner was vacationing in Bali and has not been seen since the bombing. She has not been reported as dead or wounded, but her whereabouts remain undetermined. Mr. and Mrs. Casner have flown to Bali to monitor the situation.

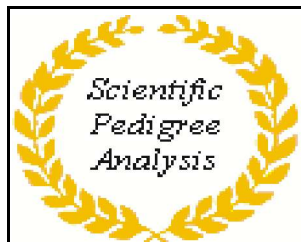
