104 PRE-ENTRIES FOR BREEDERS' CUP XIX

A class of 104, including European standout **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill) and Kentucky Derby winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), was yesterday pre-entered for the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup at Arlington Park. The 14 pre-entries for this year's Breeders' Cup Classic are dominated by talented sophomores, with the Derby winner followed by GI Pacific Classic winner **Came Home** (Gone West), GI Travers winner **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) and GI Blue Grass S. winner **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan).

The Europeans will try to steal the Classic, likely with the Irish-trained three-year-old **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), but the \$4-million purse could persuade connections to try stellar miler **Rock of Gibraltar** at 1 1/4 miles on the dirt. Both horses are trained by Aidan O'Brien and both were entered in the Classic and Mile. Rock of Gibraltar has first preference in the Mile and Hawk Wing has first preference in the Classic. Of the decision to run in the Classic or in the Mile, O'Brien explained, "The [Mile] is worth \$1 million and the other is \$4 million. That's a big pot. We'll have to see whether we should take a chance in it with Rock of Gibraltar, going a different distance on a different surface. We'll have to see about that and we'll have to see how Hawk Wing and [Mile entrant] **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) are doing."

Rock, Route, Paper, Dirt?

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) (Danehill) is unbeaten in five starts this year, all in Group 1 company, but all at one mile on the turf. His resumé includes wins in the English and Irish 2000 Guineas and in the G1 St. James's Palace S., so the Breeders' Cup Mile would seem an obvious choice. But trainer Aidan O'Brien feels his star can handle the new distance and surface of the Classic. "People say he's not dirt bred, but people over here say for a horse to handle dirt they have to handle firm ground," he explained. "He's a horse we ran over soft, firm and heavy ground and he likes them all. His form has held very level and he's very solid no matter what surface we run him over. The surface doesn't seem to matter to him and we've always thought he'd handle a mile and a quarter."

O'Brien's Invasion

Whatever the decision on Rock of Gibraltar and Hawk Wing, O'Brien will be busy on Breeders' Cup day. The Irish trainer entered 10 horses in five of the eight races, with his strongest hand a five-horse entry in the Juvenile. O'Brien's two-year-old contingent, a strength last year when Johannesburg took the Juvenile, has been less successful so far this season. "They were all very sick," O'Brien said of his two-year-olds. "I thought our year was over. They were so sick I couldn't train them and when I did I had to bring them back gently so there were no relapses. The problem was when we brought them back there were only big races for them and that's where we had to start. It was difficult putting them into those races knowing they're going to improve. But if I didn't do that they wouldn't be ready at this stage to come to America." O'Brien feels his team is ready for a top Breeders' Cup effort. "[This is] probably the strongest team of three-year-olds we've ever had," he said. "We've got mile, 1 1/4-mile and 1 1/2-mile horses and the two-year-olds are really starting to pick up now. We have good chances in the races we have the runners in."

Few Full Fields

Only three of the eight races were oversubscribed, with the Mile attracting the most attention with 24 pre-entries. Also overfilled is the Sprint and the Juvenile, both with 16 entries. In races that are oversubscribed (more than 14 horses), the top seven Breeders' Cup point earners gain automatic berths. The remaining seven horses are selected by the Breeders' Cup Racing Directors/Secretaries panel. Post positions will be drawn Oct. 23.

Trainer Patrick Biancone sent out his two juveniles for five-furlong works yesterday at Arlington. GI Futurity winner **Whywhywhy**, working in company, went the distance in 1:03 4/5. Stablemate **Zavata** went the same distance in 1:02 4/5. "Whywhywhy worked good," said Biancone. "I didn't want him to go too fast today. He came out of it good and scoped clean afterward. Everything went perfect for him." Of Zavata, Biancone added, "Zavata worked a little faster. He needed to have a more serious work. He's on his way. We'll probably do something else with him in another three or four days. He'll be right by the time the race comes up. We'll just have to wait. Zavata also came out of his work good and also scoped clean." Zavata has been off since finishing third in the Aug. 31 GI Hopeful S. He was scratched from the GI Champagne S. with a bruised foot.

Sky Mesa (Pulpit), winner of the GII Lane's End Futurity, arrived at Arlington on Wednesday and had his first gallop over the track yesterday. "One good thing," commented Donna Ward, assistant to her husband trainer John Ward, "is that he handled this racetrack very well."

MARIENBARD TO EAST STUD **Marienbard (Ire)** (Caerleon--Marienbad {Fr}, by Darshaan {GB}), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, yesterday became the latest Godolphin horse to be retired when it was announced that he will stand at East Stud in Japan. His 3/4-length defeat of Sulamani (Ire) at Longchamp Oct. 6 proved the highlight of his career, having earlier won the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf July 28 and the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden Baden Sept. 1. "Marienbard was a great racehorse," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented yesterday. "He improved a lot this year and has been very brave in his races. He was the impressive winner of four races this year and we are going to miss him. He beat the best horses in the Arc and he is the best of the best now. Marienbard has a very good temperament and was easy to train, always relaxed. This year he was a real professional horse, trying to give his best all the time." Marienbard, who also took the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3, follows stable companions **Noverre (Rahy)**, **Sakhee (Bahri)** and **Best of the Bests (Ire)** (Machiavellian) to stud in 2003.

SLICKLY TO HARAS DU LOGIS **Slickly (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}--Slipstream Queen, by Conquistador Cielo) yesterday joined the list of recently retired Godolphin stalwarts when it was announced that he will stand at Haras du Logis for the 2003 season. Four days after the six-year-old took his second consecutive renewal of the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in Milan, Godolphin decided to retire him to the Normandy stud. Having been purchased out of the Andre Fabre stable, for which he recorded successes in the G3 Prix la Rochette, G2 Prix Noailles and G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp, he added success in the G1 Prix du Moulin at that track last September. "Slickly was a very tough horse who was always very honest in his work and his races," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said yesterday. "He has been one of our stars and we will miss him." Racing Manager Simon Crisford added: "Slickly was an admirably consistent and talented performer, winning 10 of his 16 races, including four Group 1s. He was a great international campaigner for Godolphin and he did particularly well in France, winning the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in good style from a strong field last year. We have been delighted with the way he performed for us." Slickly will stand for €8,000 October 1st, Special Live Foal.

GRAND LODGE COLT TOPS TATTS DAY 3 Late-comers to Tattersalls yesterday would have missed the day's top offering at the October Yearling Sale, a 150,000gns Grand Lodge colt consigned by Jamie Railton for his breeder, Tim Rootes' Shutford Stud in Oxfordshire. Anthony Stroud signed for the colt out of Newmarket maiden winner Hakkaniyah (GB) (Machiavellian) with disappointed parties including Dwayne Woods, Amanda Skiffington and Johnny McKeever. An undisclosed American owner will race the March-born colt, who will be trained by Englishman Richard Gibson at Chantilly in France. Yesterday's 3,799,000gns turnover helped this year's October Sale pass the entire 2001 handle of 26,055,700gns, although the 2000 record aggregate of 32,256,200gns looks a tough target. The auction continues today, with a session beginning at 10 a.m. and a second at 5:15 p.m. The final session begins Saturday at 10 a.m.



Aidan O'Brien yesterday left four juveniles in tomorrow's seven-furlong contest headed by **Tomahawk**, who is expected to be the mount of Michael Kinane. Having finished runner-up in the Listed Chesham S. at Royal Ascot June 19, he was hit with the virus that afflicted Ballydoyle before returning to finish runner-up to Oasis Dream (GB) in the G1 Middle Park S. at the track Oct. 3. O'Brien told *PA Sport* yesterday, "He won his maiden very well, then we took him to Ascot and we thought he was a banker, but he was very green and he got caught on the line on the fast ground. He was very sick after that, but we were delighted with him in the Middle Park and we've always thought he was a very good horse."

Hip 684 (c, Ali-Royal {Ire}--Elfin Queen {Ire}, by Fairy King)

The second six-figure lot at yesterday's session of the Tattersalls October Yearlings Sales, and the 65th in total at the auction, came close to the end of the evening when Hugo Lascelles went to 120,000gns for an Ali-Royal (Ire) colt out of Elfin Queen (Ire). The colt was offered by Ciaran Conroy's Glenvale Stud, who got the youngster for Ir£24,000 as a foal. Mare Statistics for 2002 Released by Jockey Club:

The Jockey Club reports that 3,364 stallions covered 59,090 mares in North America in 2002, according to the Reports of Mares Bred received by the JC as of Oct. 10, 2002. The report includes the number of mares bred to each stallion, representing approximately 90 percent of the mares bred this year. The number of stallions declined 2.7 percent from 3,457 reported last year at this time while the number of mares rose 1.3 percent from 53,318 one year ago. According to Matt Iuliano, vice president of registration services at the Jockey Club, "This trend tends to be accompanied by an increase in live foal percentage which supports our earlier projection of 37,000 registered foals of 2003." The number of stallions bred to 100 mares or more increased from 77 last year to 93 this term. Grand Slam led all stallions with 215 mares bred, two more than Giant's Causeway, the only other stallion to cover at least 200 mares this year. States in which a stallion covered at least 100 mares were Kentucky (72); Florida (11); California (3); New York (3); Maryland (2); Pennsylvania (1); and Texas (1).

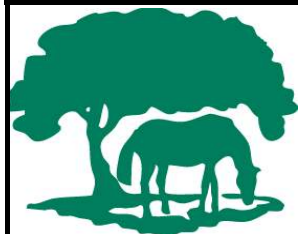
