**THE SUN OR THE MOON?**

In the absence of Sakhee and Nayef, **Burning Sun** (Danzig) has been elevated to pole position in this afternoon's G1 Emirates Airlines Champion S. at Newmarket. Still a maiden when taken to Royal Ascot for the Listed Hampton Court S. June 20, he duly lost that tag with a fluent success on good to firm ground. He encountered softer conditions next time when beating subsequent G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis winner **Kaieteur** (Marlin) by 3/4-lengths in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 14. He paid for that success when shouldering a four-pound penalty in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville Aug. 15, but was only beaten a head when third behind Highdown (Ire). **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), bidding to provide Godolphin with its first success in this race, followed a win in the G2 Dante S. at York May 15 with a game third in the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. Given time to recover from that arduous slog, he returned with a facile score in the G3 Select S. at Goodwood Sept. 14. Godolphin supply the chief prospect among the older generation in **Noverre** (Rahy). He was 1 1/2 lengths in front of **Indian Creek (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who was third in this race last year, when that pair finished third and fourth, respectively, behind Nayef in the G1 International S. at York Aug. 20.

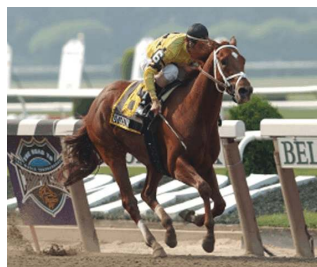

**GYGISTAR CONFIRMED OUT OF SPRINT**

**Gygistar** (Prospector's Music), slated to run in the G1 Breeders Cup Sprint at Arlington Park, will not contest the six-furlong event. The three-year-old has been on the sidelines since Oct. 11 when he sustained a cut on his left front hoof in a stall mishap. "We decided there was no way we could adequately protect the hoof so he could get back on the track and be ready for the race," trainer Mark Hennig told the *Thoroughbred Times*. "It was never a question of whether it would heal in time for the race, because there is no way it could. It was a pretty deep gash." A pair of Scott Lake pupils, Thunderello (Montbrook) and My Cousin Matt (Matty G), stand to benefit from the defection as they are on the also-eligible list.

**CHURCHILL BC DELAYED UNTIL 2006**

The 2005 Breeders' Cup, originally slated for Churchill Downs in Louisville, appears likely to return to Belmont Park for the 22nd running of the World Thoroughbred Championships. Churchill Downs will be reunited with the championship event in 2006. Scheduled for Oct. 29 in 2005, the Breeders' Cup would face major scheduling conflicts with the Future Farmers of America Convention, which is expected to draw approximately 50,000 people to the city during the same period. Although disappointed, John R. Long, interim president of Churchill Downs, remained upbeat, "We look forward to 2006, when our construction will be complete and the Breeders' Cup will be held for the first time in a sparkling and renovated Churchill Downs, and to our track's return to the regular rotation of Breeders' Cup host sites." Breeders' Cup Ltd. officials have shown interest in Belmont Park for the 2005 series. "We're honored to be considered as the first preference to host the 2005 Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships on the 100th anniversary season of Belmont Park," said Terry Meyocks, President and COO of the New York Racing Association.

## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

### CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

A minor foot ailment has prompted trainer Murray Johnson to postpone the final pre-race workout for Breeders' Cup Classic contender **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer). The winner of the Gill Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park last time out Oct. 5, the gelding was scheduled to work this morning at Churchill Downs' Trakside Louisville training center, but the move is now likely to take place Monday or Tuesday. "He was uncomfortable and we took a look at the foot right away," said Johnson. "There was no bruise or anything, but there was some heat in there. We took off the shoe and found a little pocket of infection, so we drained it and it looks very good today [Friday]." The trainer does not expect the problem to keep the sophomore out of the Oct. 26 Classic field. "He's doing very well," he added. "He's sound and he's very happy. He's bouncing around his stall."

### JOHN DEERE TURF, \$2,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/2mT

G1 Canadian International hero **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) continues to train forwardly over the gallops in France and is expected to arrive at Arlington on Monday to begin his local preparations for the Turf. "He's fresh and well and feeling very good," said trainer Laura de Seroux, who trains the colt for Sid Port, Marsha Naify and her husband Emmanuel. "Despite all his racing and traveling, it has not knocked him out." The bay, who returned from a 10-week absence to win the G1 Irish St Leger Sept. 14, was purchased privately following his Woodbine success, but was forced to return to Europe following his win. He remains at the yard of trainer John Hammond and under the care of de Seroux's assistant Jeff Ford. Third, beaten five lengths by **High Chapparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Irish Derby June 30, the trainer knows that her charge has his work cut out for him. "It looks like [High Chapparral] and **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) are standouts and I'm not going to tell you that we can bridge the gap," de Seroux admitted. "But [Ballingarry] is an improving son of Sadler's Wells. He's maturing physically, he likes it soft and maybe that can move him up a bit." Kent Desormeaux will ride Ballingarry for the first time in the Turf.

### BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m

**Toccet** (Awesome Again), who earned his way into the Breeders' Cup with a 1 1/2-length victory in the G1 Champagne S. at Belmont Park Oct. 5, worked seven furlongs yesterday in 1:27 at Laurel Park for trainer John Scanlan. "He worked very well this morning," the conditioner said. "He was very strong. I had him work six furlongs, but he galloped out a strong seven-eighths." The 53-year-old Scanlan, who has been training horses since 1973, likes his chances in his Breeders' Cup debut. "I've trained some good horses, but this one is the best I've ever had. The distance is no concern for him, it's right up his alley. He has shown promise right from the start and is getting better and better every day." The bay carries a three-race winning streak into the Cup, including a Sept. 8 allowance score going two turns. Owned and bred by Daniel Borislow, Toccet is scheduled to fly out on Sunday. "We'll probably do a little something with him on Thursday, three-eighths in about 40 seconds," said Scanlan. Jorge Chavez, who was aboard for the Champagne, has the call in the Juvenile.

Surrounded by hyperbole, **Trade Fair (GB)** (Zafonic) steps out to prove he is worthy of the fuss in this afternoon's G1 Darley Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. He took part in one of the strongest maidens run in Europe this year when third on his debut behind Almushahar and Maghanim (GB) at the July Course Aug. 23. His impressive performance when subsequently winning a Newbury maiden Sept. 21 suggested he can live at this level. Aidan O'Brien filled the first three places in last year's renewal and saddles four in an attempt to repeat the dose. **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) won a Curragh maiden over five furlongs Mar. 24 and was upped in trip to seven furlongs in the Listed Chesham S. at Royal Ascot June 19, where he was beaten a short head. Like the majority of his stablemates, he was ill with a cough in mid-summer and faced a stern test when returning in the G1 Middle Park S. back over six furlongs at this track Oct. 3. In that event, he ran with great credit, finding only Oasis Dream (GB) 1 1/2 lengths too strong. It appears as if this extra furlong will suit. **Rimrod** (Danzig), a half brother to Ian Balding's star miler Selkirk, would provide a fitting curtain call for that conditioner's career with success in this event. He beat Oasis Dream in a Sandown maiden Aug. 30 before holding off Rainwashed Gold (GB) in the Listed Stardom S. at Goodwood Sept. 13.

Connections of **Mount Abu** sidestepped the chance to win back-to-back renewals of last Sunday's G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp and the colt has ground conditions to suit in this contest. He shaped with promise when ninth in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 7, where he had **Nayyir** and **Frenchman's Bay** behind, and returns to his favoured specialist trip as he bids to provide John Gosden with his fourth renewal of this contest. Godolphin have won this twice with Charnwood Forest (Ire) and Kahal (GB) and put forward **Firebreak**, who followed a fine fourth in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood Aug. 24 with a convincing score back at that track in the G3 Supreme S. Sept. 26. He is held by the Richard Hannon-trained duo **Redback** and **Reel Buddy** on the Celebration Mile form and the former may hold sway back at the track that saw him finish third behind Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 2000 Guineas S. May 4. **Warningford** is best fresh and showed he retained his ability when winning the Listed John of Gaunt S. at Haydock June 8.

**Casual Look**, who was beaten 1 ½ lengths by Soviet Song (Ire) when runner-up in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot Sept. 28, sets the standard in this contest. She faces a host of unexposed types headed by **Camlet**, a half sister to the stable's flagbearer Gossamer (GB). She was impressive in winning on her debut in a Yarmouth maiden Sept. 18 and bids to provide Luca Cumani with his third renewal of this contest. Roger Charlton holds a strong hand with **Luvah Girl** and **L'Ancrese**. While the former was beaten a head by **Duty Paid** in the Listed Henry Carnarvon S. at Royal Ascot June 22, she went on to finish a 1 1/4-length runner-up to Russian Rhythm in the G3 Princess Margaret S. back at that track July 27. That day, **Nasij** was back in third. **L'Ancrese** was impressive in winning on her debut in a conditions event at Newbury Sept. 20 and looks sure to have improved for the experience. **Irresistible** has claims on her 1 1/4 length-defeat by subsequent G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Airwave (GB) when runner-up in the Listed Firth of Clyde S. at Ayr Sept. 21.

**PAIR OF TOPPERS ON PENULTIMATE DAY** With just this morning's session to go, the 2002 Tattersalls October Sale was on course for a record average by the time business closed last night. After four days the average was running at 44,498gns--compared to the 41,567gns previous best in 2000. Friday saw 134 lots sold for 3,034,000gns, averaging 22,641gns with a median of 20,000gns. The morning session was topped by a racy Hernando colt out Oops Pettie (GB) (Machiavellian), offered from locally based Gay Slater's Stradishall Manor Stud, for whom Irish agent Brian Grassick had to go to 120,000gns to shake off interested parties including Anthony Bromley. "He was the pick of the last two days--I would be home now if it wasn't for him," said Grassick. "He is going to Dermot Weld to race for the same partnership I bought a 325,000gns Grand Lodge colt for earlier in the week." The very last lot into the ring also brought 120,000gns. She is a Night Shift half sister to this year's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. winner Where or When (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and it was no surprise that it was that colt's trainer Terry Mills who saw off Mark Johnston for the filly, offered by Ann Egan from Joe Hernon's Castletown Stud. "She walks like Where or When and has a lot of his attitude," said Mills. "She's a natural and I'll probably keep her for my wife Beryl." A Halling half brother to three winners consigned by Owdeswell Manor Stud started the morning with a bang when selling for 72,000gns. Agent Amanda Skiffington signed the buyer's ticket after seeing off trainer Terry Mills. "He's going to Alec Stewart and stood out a bit today," said Skiffington. "He's a very athletic horse by a good sire." Krone's book will be handled by Brian Beach, who is also Mike Smith's agent.

The Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation is contributing \$50,000 to a study which aims to explore means of exterminating Eastern Tent Caterpillars on Kentucky horse farms. The caterpillars have been singled out as a possible cause for the Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome which resulted in the loss of several hundred fetuses in 2001. The study will be undertaken by Professor Daniel Potter, an entomologist at the University of Kentucky. "This study comes outside our normal grant cycle," said Edward L. Bowen, president of the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation, "but in this cause we felt it is extremely important to do something to anticipate the return of the problem."

**TIGER REP HITS THE CENTURY MARK**

With no fanfare, no heady announcements over the P.A, no elaborate presentations in the winner's circle from esteemed former heads-of-state, a two-year-old first-timer at Philly Park this past Wednesday hit the finish line first in a special weight contest and, at the same time, marked an impressive achievement for his 24-year-old mom. When Little Mack Truck, a bay colt by the sophomore sire Tamayaz, won the sixth race for his owners and breeders Patricia and Richard Izdebski, he represented the 100th win from 13 starters for his dam, Tiger Rep (The Reprobate). Through nearly two decades, Tiger Rep has churned out what has become an increasingly rare sight in racing these days: blue-collar, workman-like horses who earn paychecks on a regular basis by simply running as best they can, every time they run. "All of her foals are the same," explained Richard. "They all try hard, and hit the board probably 50 to 60 percent of the time."

Tiger Rep herself was an honest, if unspectacular, racehorse, winning nine of 31 races while earning \$59,166 in her three years at the track. Her career as a broodmare got off to an inauspicious start when her first two foals won five races combined, but then she began to show signs as a producer of useful runners. Her third foal, Laura Who (Deputed Testimony), notched 20 wins in 88 starts and hit the board in four minor stakes events while earning \$248,406, and a year later Tiger Rep had Micheal's Rep (Parfaitement), who had two stakes wins in 24 starts and made \$101,861. Her next four failed to earn black type, but between them averaged 77 starts and purse money of \$124,732. As of yesterday, Tiger Rep's foals have started a whopping 538 races, with combined lifetime earnings of \$1,278,974. Rest assured, if Cher were a Thoroughbred, she'd be out of Tiger Rep.

The Izdebski's got into the picture when they purchased the then 14-year-old in 1992 and began raising her offspring at their Kensington Farm in Ocala, Florida. The congenial mare has proved a big hit at the home-stead. "She's great with the foals," said Richard. "We put her in with the youngsters, and she'll school and teach them. And as for her age, she looks like she's still ready to go to the track. She looks like a five-year-old."

To date, the best horse Tiger Rep has produced for the Izdebski's is Michael's Pride, a five-year-old Not For Love colt that was claimed from them recently for \$50,000. A familiar face at Philly Park and in New Jersey, the chestnut has banked \$222,515 in 31 starts and, if he's anything like his brethern, has about 50 or 60 starts left in him. But with him out of their racing operation, the Izdebski's are focused on the George Cross-trained Little Mack Truck. "The Mr. Prospector line has really worked for us," said an optimistic Richard. "And who knows? This could be the best one yet."

**THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...**

**October 20, 1923...Zev**, winner of the 1923 Kentucky Derby, defeated English hero **Papyrus**, winner of the 1923 Epsom Derby, in a \$100,000 match race at Belmont Park. The race, called the International Special, marked the first time an English champion was sent to the U.S. to race. Public interest was so great the race was broadcast on the radio--a first.

**October 21, 1961...Jockey Eddie Arcaro** won the Jockey Club Gold Cup for a record 10th time, riding the great Kelso to victory at Belmont Park. Winner of the race in 1960 as well, Kelso went on to take the race in '62, '63 and '64, setting the mark for most consecutive victories in a stakes race.

**October 22, 1945...El Lobo and Featherfoot** became the first Thoroughbreds to be transported by airplane. The two were flown from Los Angeles to San Mateo, California, in the Flying Tiger Line's twin-engine Budd transport plane, landing in the parking area at Bay Meadows. El Lobo went on to take the Burlingame H. at that track October 27.

**October 22, 1955...Stormsorno, Chance Speed and Beaufair** finished in a triple dead-heat for the win in the eighth race at Mexico's Caliente racetrack.

**October 22, 1964...Jockey Bill Shoemaker** won his 5,000th career race aboard Slapstick at Aqueduct Race-track.

**October 24, 1877...**The United States Congress adjourned so its members could go to Pimlico to watch a race between **Parole, Ten Broeck and Tom Ochiltree**.

**October 24, 1953...Tom Fool** won the Pimlico Special by eight lengths to cap off a perfect 10-for-10 four-year-old campaign. The Special was his fourth consecutive race run as a non-betting exhibition. He was voted the 1953 Horse of the Year over Native Dancer, whose lone loss that year came when he finished second in the Kentucky Derby.
