STORMING HOME STORMS HOME

Yesterday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. was advertised as being one of the most open in recent memory and so it proved as **Storming Home (GB)** (Machiavellian) produced a battling display to deny Godolphin pair **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and **Noverre** (Rahy) in an exciting finish to Newmarket's autumn showpiece. Ironically, Storming Home only ran after owner Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum suggested supplementing him to the race at a cost of £24,000,

and the owner's enterprise was handsomely rewarded with a first Group 1 win for the four-year-old, who sported Australian blinkers, commonly known in Britain as sheepskin cheekpieces.

The race was delayed as **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) proved reluctant to enter stalls, and it was without

TOUT SEUL IN SPLENDID ISOLATION

Bargain buy **Tout Seul (Ire)** (Ali-Royal {Ire}) created a huge shock yesterday when streaking to a 25-1 one-and-a-quarter length success in the Darley-sponsored G1 Dewhurst S.. The colt accounted for market leaders **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) and **Trade Fair (GB)** (Zafonic) in his first attempt at stakes level that was also a first ride at Group 1 level for apprentice jockey Steve Carson. Owned by the 10-strong Eden Racing syndicate, Tout Seul provided trainer Fulke Johnson Houghton with his second win in the race, 34 years after Ribofilio did the trainer proud in 1968. "It's been a long wait," enthused Johnson Houghton, who added, "He's got a lovely turn of foot and there would be few horses that would quicken as well as him. He's engaged in Tattersalls Horses-In-Training Sale, but I think we might give that a miss now." Tout Seul had been campaigned with a relatively low profile, but has come to the fore in his last two outings when landing the valuable Tattersalls Breeders S. at The Curragh Aug. 24 and when an unlucky second in Redcar's valuable Two-Year-Old Trophy Oct. 5. Carson belied his lack of big-race experience and reserved the outsider in the rear as Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)'s brother **Great Pyramid (Ire)** (Danehill) set a solid tempo from the outset, but the eventual winner proved as good as his name when sent toward the rail to plough a lone furrow at the quarter-mile marker. Tomahawk and Trade Fair dueled for the lead from that point, but Tout Seul quickened to the front at the distance and, within a matter of strides, it became apparent that the shock tree was about to bear a bumper harvest. Young Carson ensured his mount was not to falter late on for a famous victory. Favored Trade Fair ran greenly, but connections are still optimistic for next season and expect he will improve for the effort. "[Jockey] Richard [Hughes] said that from his outside draw, he still felt a bit babyish and though he came to win his race, he just did not have the experience of the first two in the closing stages," said his trainer Roger Charlton. "He is a big colt and I am sure he has a future." Runner-up Tomahawk may still keep his engagement in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but connections will wait to see how much of a toll yesterday's race has taken out of him. **Click for the racingpost.com chart or the brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree.**

EQUIPMENT CHANGE DOES THE TRICK

Godolphin third-string **Equerry** (St. Jovite) assumed the role of pacesetter in advance of stablemate Moon Ballad with Storming Home positioned in a tracking fourth at Newmarket yesterday. Jockey Michael Hills asked his mount to take issue with the front rank with three furlongs remaining and the partnership, moving strongly, took the lead approaching the final furlong. At that point it was just a formality for Storming Home, who responded gallantly to his rider's urgings to fend off the ominous challenges of the rallying Moon Ballad and the determined Noverre. Winning trainer Barry Hills, on the equipment change, said. "It is not that he is unguine, but [the cheekpieces] have helped him to concentrate and made him an easier horse to ride." The victorious jockey, Hills' son Michael, echoed his father's sentiments. "They have made a big difference to him and he just travels so much better. It's much easier to ride a race on him now." Never-say-die gelding Northerly doggedly fought off Fields of Omagh to collect his seventh Group 1 win, becoming the fourth-highest Australasian money earner. Settled in third early, Northerly took command at the home turn. At that point, it looked as though he didn't have much left to give, but when Fields Of Omagh powered through the middle of the field to challenge, Northerly rallied himself to click up a gear and prevail by a head, clocking 11.97 for his final 200 meters. Childs is a perfect six-for-six aboard the West Australian galloper, who won the 2001 G1 Cox Plate, but immediately reaffirmed his commitment to Sunline (NZ) in next Saturday's Cox Plate; that race will be her last before retiring. (see story p9). "I have had a great association with Sunline and that isn't changing," he said. "Northerly is such a good horse to ride, you can ride up on the pace and he has a real dogged finish, he just hates horses getting past him." Winning trainer Fred Kersley said he was not tempted to contest the Melbourne Cup Nov. 5, where the horse would have to carry top weight of 60 kilograms in the wake of his win.

Having belatedly started his career with a victory on Lingfield's artificial surface in March this year, Nayyir has made up for lost time since with a busy campaign that has yielded two Group 3 wins. He was successful in the G3 Diomed S. at Epsom June 8 and in the G3 Lennox S. at Goodwood Aug. 2 before a fine third-place effort in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 11. He recorded a lifetime best performance here for a first Group 2 win. With jockey Eddie Ahern exhibiting patience throughout as Firebreak and Red Carpet (Pivotal {GB}) disputed the running, Nayyir made smooth headway through the field from the three-furlong mark. He quickened to the front at the eighth pole and put the race to sleep in an instant by striding clear for a deserved victory. Winning trainer Gerard Butler said, "He didn't work at all well last Saturday and we didn't know what to do, but he came back a bit on Wednesday. "That was great," said winning jockey Martin Dwyer, who added, "What can I say that hasn't been said already? He's a great horse, a wonder horse." Dwyer sent the the eventual winner to the lead from the outset and the partnership held sway over the field until coming under pressure with a half mile remaining. The field closed slightly on the pacesetter as he came under strong driving at the quarter-mile marker, most notably market choice Boreas who had been ridden with patience throughout, but all threats proved unfounded as the Punch kept on in determined fashion to record victory.

Momentum (Nureyev) is out of the race due to a soft tissue injury in his right foreleg, according to trainer Craig Dollase. "We noticed it [Friday] and he was supposed to work today," the conditioner explained. "It looks like he'll be out for a few months, then we'll rescan in and see where we're at." Despite being winless in seven starts this season, the four-year-old finished a tough-luck second in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup and GI Pacific Classic and was most recently runner-up to Pleasantly Perfect in the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita Oct. 5.

Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) worked seven furlongs yesterday in 1:24 2/5 just after 12 noon at Santa Anita. The near black colt broke off and got his first two furlongs under stout restraint from exercise rider Dana Barnes in :25 1/5. Given his head, he covered a half mile in :49 4/5 and six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 before galloping out the mile in 1:37 1/5. "He wanted to do a lot today," commented trainer Bob Baffert. "He always wants to get it all in the second eighth, but [Barnes] kept him under a good hold. He's doing well."

GI Spinster S. winner **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) worked at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. The clockers caught the three-year-old going a half in :48.40 and galloping out five furlongs in 1:02.80 over a fast main track; trainer Ken McPeck had her going five-eighths in 1:01.80. "It was a good solid breeze," McPeck said. "She doesn't need much at this stage. We just wanted to let her stretch her legs a little bit and do her thing--but not too fast. That was our biggest concern. You can ask her to work in :58 and she'll go, but she doesn't need that at this stage." Jockey Patricia Cooksey was aboard for the move. As for her Distaff prospects, the trainer said, "I think she's going to be very difficult to beat. I know Azeri is getting a lot of hype out of California, but I don't think that the West Coast horses have been nearly as stellar as the East Coast. I think you could make a case that whoever wins this race could be possibly 'Horse of the Year' as well. I like the hand I'm holding."

Victorian Premier Steve Bracks today announced that the Melbourne Cup meeting at Flemington Nov. 5 would be subject to increased security as a result of the terrorist attack in Bali that is believed to have killed up to 137 Australians. About 40,000 attended the Caulfield Cup and double that number are expected to attend the Melbourne Cup. However, Bracks urged Victorians to "go about their business" as normal and encouraged them not to change their plans. "Of course there will be some extra security in place, but we don't want to, at all, cower or change our way of life because of these incidents overseas," Bracks told the Australian Associated Press. "We will ensure that the best possible security arrangements are in place and people can be assured that every step is being taken to make sure it's a safe Melbourne Cup."
