SAINT BALLADO DEAD

Saint Ballado (Halo), who underwent spinal surgery at Rood and Riddle equine hospital last Tuesday, was euthanized yesterday morning. The 13-year-old stallion seemed to be recovering from the operation and was returned to Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky, but his condition deteriorated. "When it became obvious that Saint Ballado's condition was critical, in consultation with

the owners and our team of veterinarians, the difficult decision was made to euthanize the horse," said Dr. Phil McCarthy. Saint Ballado, out of Canadian Broodmare of the Year Ballade (Herbager), was a full brother to champions Glorious Song and Devil's Bag. He won four of his nine career starts, including the GII Arlington Classic and GIII Sheridan S., before starting his stud career in Florida in 1993. His first crop included GISW Captain Bodgit, the runner-up in the 1997 Kentucky Derby. He has also sired Grade I winners Yankee Victor, who took the 2000 Met Mile; and Sister Act; and was represented this season by the ill-fated Freedom's Daughter, who died after winning the GII Schuylerville S. His son Warhol topped the 2001 Keeneland July Sale at \$4 million. The stallion stood for a fee of \$125,000 at Taylor Made this year. "Saint Ballado was a great horse and no one wanted to see him suffer needlessly," Ben Taylor, head of Taylor Made Stallions, Inc., said. "We are grateful for the meticulous care afforded the horse by our dedicated staff of team members and the veterinarians involved. Saint Ballado represented a lot to Taylor Made. He will be greatly missed." Saint Ballado will be buried at Taylor Made.

SPARTACUS ESCAPES SPILL

Spartacus (Ire) (Danehill) escaped a frightening spill to post a dramatic victory in the G1 Gran Criterium in Milan yesterday. After breaking well, the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt settled in third behind **Excelsius (Ire)** (Dr Devious), and he managed to stay out of trouble when **Chippolino (Fr)** (Perugino) fell on the final turn, causing **Silverboat (Ire)** (Silver Wizard) and **Winning Dash (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) to lose their riders. While the horses appeared unharmed, jockey Lennart Hammer-Hansen suffered a broken chin and neck injuries and jockey Andrasch Starke complained of stomach pains; they were taken to San Carlo Hospital. Avoiding the melee, Spartacus drove to the front with a quarter of a mile remaining and went on to a comfortable three-length tally over **Checkit (Ire)** (Mukaddamah). Spartacus adds the win to his upset in the Aug. 11 G1 Phoenix S. Excelsius held for third, but jockey Frankie Dettori was suspended for his ride. While not held totally to blame for the spill, Dettori was found to have put Silverboat in tight quarters on the turn and received a three-day ban, to be served Oct. 29-31. Under a strong ride by Michael Kinane, Black Sam Bellamy won the hard way to provide trainer Aidan O'Brien with a Group 1 double at San Siro. In succeeding at the highest level, the full brother to Galileo (Ire) finally stepped out from the shadow of his sibling. The colt was winless during his juvenile campaign, but managed a third behind stable companion Ballingarry (Ire) in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November. Returning to take a Curragh maiden Apr. 7, he was promoted from third to second behind Khalkevi (Ire) in the G2 Prix Hocquart May 8, then fared best of his trainer's representatives when fifth in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club June 9. Black Sam Bellamy was fifth again in the two-mile G3 Queen's Vase at Royal Ascot before getting a break. Last time out, he led until the final quarter of a mile in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 6, but weakened late to finish 10th. Taken to the front early again yesterday, he was harrassed by Guadalupe inside the final quarter of a mile and looked booked for the runner-up spot when that rival passed him and built a clear advantage at the furlong marker. Ange Gabriel defied his Group 1 penalty in game fashion and booked his place in the line-up for the G1 Japan Cup at Nakayama Nov. 24 with this win. After defeating Califet (Fr) in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour at this track Mar. 31, he was twice beaten by that rival when runner-up in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville at this venue Apr. 18 and third in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay at Saint-Cloud May 20. Despite dead-heat-ing for second behind Anabaa Blue (GB) in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 9, he was overlooked as he took on Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 30, but he proved strongest in that event under an enterprising ride from the front by jockey Thierry Jarnet. Jarnet executed the same tactics this time, cutting out moderate early fractions before quickening to hold off the late challenge of Thompson Rouge. "That was a real nice performance from the horse, to return after a few months off and win the race by making all and giving weight all round," said Henri Devin, husband of the winning owner. "Obviously, he was a little rusty and should improve a lot for that effort. French Riviera started her career at Lone Star Park, breaking her maiden June 6 of last year, but was sidelined after running 10th as the favorite in a restricted stakes at the Texas track 24 days later. The chestnut filly returned after a 13 1/2-month layoff to take a Louisiana Downs allowance by 10 lengths Aug. 13 and made it two straight at that track with a neck tally Sept. 12. Given little chance with this step up into the major leagues, the three-year-old dashed right to the front over the muddy Keeneland strip and never looked back, cruising home an easy winner. "That's what I came here for," trainer Larry Robideaux, Jr. said. "The only time she got beat was when she fractured her knee. This filly is an extraordinary filly. She's got natural talent. She doesn't require much training--I just have to hold it together." Added winning jockey Donnie Meche, "[Robideaux] told me she was a free-running horse, so there was no use choking her down and taking her air away. He said by the second jump out of the gate, she would really leave out of there. I'm glad he tightened the saddle. She was moving right along down the backside and I didn't want to interfere. At the head of the lane I smooched to her and she dropped even lower. She's a nice little filly." [Click here](#) for the [brisnet.com](#) chart.

Stepped back up to a mile, she beat Sonorous (Ire) by 1 1/2 lengths in the Listed Rosemary S. at Ascot Sept. 28. Sent right to the front this time by jockey Richard Quinn, she was shadowed by Kootenay to the top of the straight, but shrugged off her foe's challenge before starting to hang left approaching the final furlong. That handed the initiative to Fallen Star, who looked to have the contest won until Welsh Diva found extra to regain the lead, asserting in the final 50 yards for the victory. BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

Dollar Bill (Peaks and Valleys), runner-up in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic last time out, worked a half mile in :50.20 over a sloppy surface at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. "It was a very good work," trainer Dallas Stewart said. "It was a little bit muddy, but it was very safe and firm down on the rail from the half-mile pole on down to the wire. It was just what I thought we needed--an easy half." The four-year-old has only managed one win this year, taking a Fair Grounds allowance in March, but Stewart is optimistic about his Classic chances. "I think he's got a shot," he said. "There's going to be a lot of speed in there and he's going to come running. He's got a great jockey in Pat Day and we feel like he's doing better than ever."

BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m

Unbeaten **Vindication** (Seattle Slew) prepped for the Juvenile before the first race at Santa Anita yesterday, going six furlongs, in company, in 1:11. Since 1998, the gross has risen by 88 percent, while the average price has increased by 40 percent. Recent high-profile graduates include Maille Pistol (Fr) (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}), winner of last year's G2 Prix Hocquart and G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp; this year's GII Del Mar Derby winner Inesperado (Fr) (Zayyani {Fr}); and the top-priced yearling of the 2000 auction, Without Connexion (Ire) (Rainbow Quest {USA}), the Listed scorer who was third in this year's G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp. More than 130 sires are represented in the sale with Septieme Ciel (Fr) accounting for 18 yearlings, the largest in the sale. Top sires include Alhaarth (Ire), Alzao (USA), Grand Lodge (USA), Highest Honor (Fr), Indian Ridge (Ire), In The Wings (GB), Linamix (Fr), Machiavellian (USA) and Selkirk (USA). Among the new sires featured at this year's sale; Croco Rouge (Ire), Dagers Drawn (USA), Gold Away (USA), Lord Of Men (GB), Medaaly (GB), Starborough (GB) and Tiger Hill (Ire).

Hips to Look Out For...

Lots to note include hip 53, an Indian Ridge (Ire) filly out of a sister to Tenby (GB) and half sister to Bristol Channel (GB) and Bright and Clear (GB). The yearling is from the draft of Haras de Thenney. That operation also features hip 190, a colt by Grand Lodge from the family of Shergar (GB).
