BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup hero **Evening Attire** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) wrapped up his preparations for this Saturday's Classic with a five-furlong breeze in 1:02 at

Arlington yesterday. After the work, trainer Pat Kelly related his admiration of the competition. "I'm scared to death of the Europeans," he admitted. "They've been firing bullets the last few years. They are good horse-

men and they are training good horses. I have a lot of respect for them. I also have a lot of respect for the three-year-olds [competing in the Classic]. Some of them have a lot of speed. But you can only do what you can with your horse."

In other Classic news...

Winner of the 2000 edition of the Juvenile, four-year-old **Macho Uno** worked three furlongs in :40.20 in company at Arlington yesterday morning. Trainer Joe Orseno indicated he was satisfied with the move, adding, "He's happy and he's got a good bottom under him right now." Orseno plans on taking the Stronach Stable-owned colt to the paddock this morning.

F/M TURF, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/4mT

Irresistible Jewel (Ire) (Danehill) will not contest Saturday's Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Arlington Park, but will head to Nakayama Racecourse instead for the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 24, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. The three-year-old filly, whose stablemate **Dress To Thrill** (Ire) (Danehill) is still online for the Mile, won the G2 Ribblesdale at Royal Ascot earlier this summer and placed last time in the G1 Prix l'Opera Oct. 6 at Longchamp.

NAPA SPRINT, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 6f

Top sprint candidate **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore) cruised through four panels yesterday at Churchill Downs in :48.20, his final serious prep before Saturday. The work by Bob and Beverly Lewis' four-year-old tied with two others as the fastest of 57 moves at a half-mile. "We're pleased," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I thought that was just about right today. We didn't want to do a lot with him so close to the race. At this point, all we're trying to do is fine-tune him and keep him happy...We really feel comfortable that we've got him where we want him." **Orientate** has blossomed this year with four graded stakes victories, including his first grade I score in his latest, the Forego S. at Saratoga Sept. 1. Although confident about his colt's chances, Lukas, who is looking to add another Sprint win to Gulch's 1988 score, concedes, "These are the most difficult races in the world to win because there are so many top horses. There are so many variables...We are going in with guarded optimism." Overbrook Farm's **Daytrader** (Phone Trick), Lukas' other entry in the Sprint, is scheduled to work today.

Another Sprint Setback...

D'Wildcat (Forest Wildcat), winner of the GIII Swale S. last year, appears unlikely to compete Saturday at Arlington Park. Cross-entered in the Sprint and the Mile, the winner of the Live The Dream H. at Del Mar Sept. 11 missed his original flight out of California because of a fever and has developed a cough since. Trainer Robert Hess will make a final decision today.

LONG JOHN SILVER'S JUVENILE FILLIES, \$1,000,000, 2yo, f, 1 1/8m

Steven Miles' **Westerly Breeze** (Gone West) tightened the screws in preparation for Saturday's Juvenile Fillies, breezing five furlongs in 1:00.80. Ian Wilkes, assistant to trainer Carl Nafzger, was pleased with the move, which was the fastest of 46 at the distance. "It was a good, solid work," said Wilkes. "We got her in :23 4/5 down the lane and she galloped out strong." **Westerly Breeze**, who broke her maiden at Arlington in mid-August, is coming off a win in the GII Walmac International Alcibiades at Keeneland Oct. 4.

The undefeated **Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat) worked five furlongs in a solid 1:01.80 yesterday at Belmont Park under the watchful eye of trainer Shug McGaughey. The move was her last serious work before flying to Chicago Thursday morning. The impressive daughter of My Flag romped by 12 3/4 lengths in the GI Matron S. Sept. 15 and easily defeated Bob Baffert's Santa Catarina by two lengths in the GI Frizette S. Oct. 5, the latter at 1 1/16 miles. On the 1 1/8 miles Juvenile Fillies, McGaughey commented, "She is bred to go longer, and I think the added distance in the Juvenile Fillies will help her relax more."

BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m

Undefeated **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) turned in what assistant trainer Donna Ward called a "pedestrian" five-furlong work in 1:05 at Arlington Park yesterday. "Perhaps I cautioned Danny [exercise rider Danny Ramsey] too much. I didn't want the colt to go too fast this time," said Ward. "He went 59 [seconds for 5 furlongs] last week. I would have liked him to go a little faster, but I'd rather have it a little too slow than too fast." Sky Mesa, who won the GI Hopeful S. Aug. 31 and the GII Lanes End Futurity Oct. 5, has been on the grounds since last week and appears to have acclimated well to the weather, according to Ward. Also on the work tab, trainer Richard Mandella's improving colt **Listen Indy** (A.P. Indy) worked "a nice little five-eighths," in 1:00 1/5 at Santa Anita yesterday, according to Mandella. The colt will ship to Arlington Tuesday.

PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Veteran trainer Fulke Johnson Houghton turned back the clock last Saturday when he won the Dewhurst S. for the second time, 34 years after his first victory in this Group 1 contest which often decides the year's two-year-old championship. However, their trainer is just about the only thing that Johnson Houghton's two Dewhurst winners have in common.

The first, Ribofilio, was a blue-blooded individual who had ranked among the 10 highest-priced American yearlings of 1967. This colt followed Ribocco and Ribero as the third highly successful Ribot colt that the English handler had trained for the tremendously wealthy Charles W. Engelhart. The colt started odds on for the Dewhurst on the strength of impressive wins in the Chesham S. and Champagne S.

The second, Tout Seul, was a 25-1 outsider making his Group race debut in the Dewhurst. This son of Ali-Royal had been bought by his trainer for the equivalent of 9,600 English guineas (Ir£12,500) at the Tattersalls (Ireland Ltd) September Yearling Sale at Fairyhouse, where the average price was Ir£7,778. The colt became the property of a syndicate of 10 enthusiasts, who have since had a wonderful time. Tout Seul was entitled to contest the Tattersalls Breeders S., a valuable race confined to graduates of the Fairyhouse sale. As a winner of three of his four races, Tout Seul started favorite and won comfortably.

Tout Seul's last appearance before the Dewhurst came in the betabet Two-Year-Old Trophy, a valuable race confined to horses whose sires had had at least one yearling sold at public auction in 2001. The weights carried are determined by the average price achieved by the stallion. As Ali-Royal's average was a mere 6,394gns, Tout Seul was set to carry only 118 lbs, but he failed by a head to catch Somnus, a Pivotal gelding carrying 6lbs more.

One advantage that Tout Seul had over most of his highly-regarded opponents in the Dewhurst was that, as a veteran of six races, he was better equipped to cope with the pressures of a 17-runner Group 1 race contested over a course with a tricky run down into the Dip a furlong from home. He also had the advantage of being able to race against the rail, while his main opponents were wandering off a true line. It is going to be interesting to see whether Tout Seul can maintain his superiority over the likes of Tomahawk and Trade Fair.

Tout Seul was entered as Lot 799 at Tattersalls' Autumn Sales later this month, which suggests that his owners will consider selling him if the price is high enough. What are the chances that he will become the latest recruit to the free-spending Godolphin team?

The Dewhurst S. has been dominated by the Northern Dancer male line virtually from the time that Charles Engelhard's Nijinsky II won the race back in 1969. Appropriately, Tout Seul is by a grandson of Nijinsky II and he is inbred 4x5x4 to Northern Dancer, with the other lines coming through Lyphard and Danzig.

Ali-Royal died in January 2001, after developing severe laminitis during the Southern Hemisphere season in Australia. The son of Royal Academy had been a very good miler in 1997, when he took the G1 Sussex S. on the last of his 16 career starts. He also had the attraction of being a brother to the classic-winning filly Sleepytime, as well as being a half brother to a third Group 1 winner, Taipan. *(Pedigree Insights cont. p5)*

Longshot Hishi Miracle, a late supplement to the race, settled in mid-pack of the 17-horse field. He angled to the outside for the drive and gained the lead in the shadow of the wire. "I knew he would do well over 3000 meters, so I rode with a lot of confidence," said winning rider Koichi Tsunoda. In his last trip to the post, Hishi Miracle finished sixth in the Sept. 22 G2 Kobe Shimbun Hai.

Of the 10 colts gathered for this contest, two were unbeaten: Peasant, winner of the G1 Polla de Potrillos in his latest, and Memorion, winner of the G2 Ensayo S. Peasant was sent to post as the crowd's choice and proceeded to prove he deserved every penny. Well placed in fifth through the early stages, the colt reeled in the pacesetters with a strong move, was on even terms as they entered the stretch and was all out in the final stages to hold off the game challenge of Pellegrino.

"He was sandwiched in the closing stages of the race, but he never gave up," said winning jockey Hatsuhiko Kowata.

Ali-Royal's court...

This attractive blend of pedigree and performance ensured that Ali-Royal received plenty of mares in his first season as a member of the Coolmore team. However, his popularity quickly declined, with his number of mares falling from 122 to 96 and then to 68 in his third and final season in Ireland. That sizeable drop between his second and third seasons can be attributed partly to the fact that his first-crop weanlings, sired at a fee of Ir6,000gns, achieved a median price of only 7,150 gns.

Ali-Royal's first Irish crop has so far produced only one stakes winner, the Italian filly Royal Rhapsody, and Tout Seul is only the second stakes winner from his second, following the good French juvenile Castor Troy.

Although Tout Seul was bought cheaply, his pedigree is by no means bargain-basement material. His third dam, Condessa, was a very tough Irish filly who scored notable victories in the G3 Musidora S. and G1 Yorkshire Oaks, as well as finishing second in the G1 Irish Oaks. She was reportedly sold to Craig B. Singer for more than half a million dollars after her Musidora win and Singer retired her to stud in the U.S., where her mates included Spectacular Bid, Mr. Prospector, Nijinsky II, Lyphard and Danzig.

Condessa's first visit to Danzig resulted in Bashoosh, a \$700,000 yearling who now ranks as Tout Seul's second dam. Condessa had already paid another visit to Danzig by the time that Bashoosh began what proved to be a very disappointing racing career, and the mare fared much better the second time. Her Danzig colt, Biko Pegasus, developed into a leading sprinter-miler in Japan, where he won two G3 races and was second in the G1 Sprinters S. Biko Pegasus' success led to Bashoosh being bought for Japan in 1994, after she had produced two foals for Gainsborough Stud. The first, a filly by Groom Dancer named Total Aloof, won twice over 5 furlongs before being culled for only 6,400gns. Now, as the dam of Tout Seul, she must be worth considerably more than that.

KRIS S. FILLY TOPS FASIG TIPTON DAY 1

Dinwiddie Farm had to go up to \$300,000 to secure a Kris S. filly at yesterday's opening session of the Kentucky Fall Yearling Sale held at Fasig Tipton's Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. Consigned by Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud, the chestnut filly is out of the unraced seven-year-old mare Dance Swiftly (by Danzig), a full sister to Canadian Horse of the Year and Champion three-year-old in the U.S. Dance Smartly. "She was a nice Kris S. with a nice pedigree and good conformation," said Bandoroff. "I thought she was worth the price she brought." Commenting on the overall health of the market, Bandoroff added, "If you are careful with your reserves, you can get them sold. We are twelve for twelve today." Second highest price of the sale honors went to hip 341, a dark bay colt by freshman sire Acceptable out of the stakes-producing mare Midnight Polka (by Danzig). Purchased for \$280,000 by Tom Conway from the consignment Valkyre Stud, agent for Robert Spiegel and Catherine Parke, the colt is from the family of multiple Grade 1 winner Tank's Prospect.
