

ALL EYES ON ARLINGTON

The eight star-studded races of the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships were drawn yesterday at Arlington Park. Just two of the races--the NetJets Mile and the Bessemer Trust Juvenile--have attracted full fields of 14 intended runners, but each of the events will be ultra-competitive. Tiznow made history by repelling a European raider in each of the past two Classics; this year's lone overseas challenger in the \$4-million race is **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) from Ireland. His stablemate, superstar miler **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill), had been pre-entered in both the Mile and the Classic, but his connections ultimately opted for the former's known quantity. "[The Mile] was the sensible choice; he's got a European grass pedigree and has had a lot of success this year at a mile, so we decided to stay with what's worked," said Mike Dillon, racing manager to owner Sir Alex Ferguson. "Hawk Wing was [Coolmore's] entry for the Classic and Rock of Gibraltar had never been further than a mile; we considered the Classic to the extent that we held an entry, but John Magnier and Aidan [trainer O'Brien] decided to stay with the Mile."

Playing Favorites

Rock of Gibraltar is one of two morning-line favorites at even-money, the other being the unbeaten **Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat), the headliner in the Long John Silver's Juvenile Fillies. Storm Flag Flying could be the first third-generation Breeders' Cup winner, but will have to overcome her temperment issues. "She has so much talent, but she can go ahead and do something dumb at any moment," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "She has acted as good as a horse can over the last week or so...[but] there is going to be a lot of attention on her [at Arlington] and she is liable to do just about anything."

A Classic Dilemma

With many of the year's top handicap horses missing in action, three-year-olds occupy the first four spots on the Classic morning line. Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) has the call at 3-1, followed closely by Travers victor **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) at 7-2 and the underappreciated **Came Home** (Gone West) at 4-1. "I could have made any of three or four horses favorite," admitted Arlington Park oddsmaker Mike Battaglia. "When the top three are 3-1, 7-2 and 4-1, anything can happen. War Emblem has been favored in his last four races and I'm not talking a slight favorite. He's beaten Medaglia d'Oro two of the three times they have raced and the public just loves him." Battaglia continued, "Came Home...on paper, he should be the favorite. He's defeated older horses, his numbers are great, but he never seems to get bet, so I didn't want to make him the favorite."

A sick **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo) was withdrawn from consideration just before the draw. Trainer Christophe Clement told Breeders' Cup officials that the four-year-old filly had a cough and a runny nose and "didn't scope clean." **Gossamer**, who also held an entry in the Mile, opted for this 10-furlong test. "We thought the filly race would be the better spot for several reasons," said her trainer, Luca Cumani. "One, I'd just as soon avoid running against Rock of Gibraltar. Also, with the full field [in the Mile], there was more risk of her drawing an unfavorable post. This is her first time racing beyond a mile, but if she's ever going to get a mile and a quarter, she'll get it here, where the going is on the quick side of good."

The last two winners of the Discovery H.--Evening Attire in 2001 and the ill-fated Left Bank in 2000--went on to be among the best in their division. That means that Saint Marden has some big shoes to fill, but the chestnut colt has done things the right way thus far and put up a determined effort to earn his first stakes victory. After a pair of solid performances in his first two starts, he graduated with a 7 3/4-length win June 9 at Delaware and returned July 28 to score by 7 1/2 lengths at Saratoga. Rushed into the GI Travers S., he caught a sloppy track and never fired, running a distant eighth Aug. 24. Any doubts about his talent were quashed when he romped by 8 1/2 lengths Sept. 19 in a Belmont allowance, earning a 112 Beyer. Never far from the front while three wide, the odds-on choice moved to challenge at the top of the stretch, put away the pacesetter and then held off Regency Park's late run. "We're going to wait for Florida and give him a little break right now," said winning trainer Michael Matz. "I think this can be a real good horse as a four-year-old."

Shane Sellers Fourth in Return:

Jockey Shane Sellers, who retired in 2000 because of knee problems, returned to racing yesterday afternoon. Sellers rode first-time starter Global Attraction to a fourth-place finish in the second race at Keeneland for trainer Nick Zito. "I felt great out there," Sellers, who has won 3,720 races in his career, said. "I'm sure people will be watching me for a while. It's great coming back with Nick. The horse ran really well--that should give other [trainers] confidence."

Unshaded, winner of the 2000 GI Travers, had been winless in six starts this year with his best finish a runner-up effort in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. in July. The gelding was fifth in both the GI Whitney and the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. before being eased at the wire in an eighth-place finish in a Sept. 29 Arlington allowance.
