**I WANT OUT**

The Florida-based two-year-old **Ivanavalot** (West Acre) was declared from Saturday's GI Long John Silver's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with a poor blood count. "She did not eat up [Wednesday] and she never misses an oat," said trainer Kathleen O'Connell. "That's not like her, so we took some blood just to be sure. Two labs confirmed that she has a high white blood cell count. We just can't send her to this race if she isn't 110 percent. It's disappointing to get this close and not be able to make it. She will be OK, though."

**STOUTE PAIR READY**

Sir Michael Stoute sent out his highly regarded duo of **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) and **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to stretch their legs over the Arlington turf Thursday morning. With jockey Kieren Fallon aboard, Golan was timed in :38 for a three-eighths breeze with dogs up. "He's trained very well," Fallon said of the morning-line second choice for the Turf. "He's had an easy year [two starts] coming up to this, and he's got a nice draw in the middle of the field [post four]." Golan captured the G1 2000 Guineas last year and returned from a long layoff to take the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 27, defeating Nayef. His only other start this season was a half-length second to Nayef in the G1 Juddmonte International Aug. 20. "I think he's got it together better now than in the Juddmonte," Fallon added. "There wasn't much pace in that race and that didn't suit him at all. I think he's in good form now." Like Golan a Weinstock homebred, F/M Turf hopeful Islington matched her stablemate's effort with a three-furlong breeze in :38, dogs up. Fallon has been aboard the sophomore filly in each of her starts, piloting her to wins in the G1 Nassau S. and the G1 Yorkshire Oaks. Most recently, the pair was fifth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 6. "She's had a very hard season," Fallon cautioned, "and she had a hard race in the Arc. It will be interesting to see how she comes out of the Arc. She's a very good filly."

**AROUND THE ARLINGTON OVAL**

**Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) prepared for her initial try beyond a mile in Saturday's GI F/M Turf with an easy exercise over the Arlington turf course. Trainer Luca Cumani sent the bay filly, a full sister to 1994 Breeders' Cup Mile hero Barathea (Ire), out for a five-furlong canter and the clockers credited her with a three-furlong work in :39 4/5, dogs up. "It was just a light canter, not even a breeze," said the conditioner. "I just wanted her to stretch her legs. She's already done all her work at home [Newmarket]. She worked around the bend at Newmarket last week to get ready for Arlington." Cumani sought to avoid a clash with Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the Mile, but thinks his charge can handle the additional quarter-mile. "If she's ever going

to get a mile and a quarter, it will be over this course," he said. "It's on the firm side of good, and that should be to her liking." One of the rivals that she will have to face is **Starine (Fr)** (Mendocino), who returned from an extended layoff to run a solid fourth, beaten 1 3/4 lengths in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational Sept. 28 at Belmont. Owner/trainer Bobby Frankel warned onlookers not to forget about the grey mare. "People keep overlooking Starine," he said. "Just look at her form. She had a break and people forgot about her. She ran the best [Ragozin sheet] number in her last race and that was the first time I ran her in four or five months." The Weather Channel reports that there is a 90-percent chance of rain Friday, conditions which would suit Starine, but may preclude Frankel's other runner, defending champion Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill). "It's not my decision," Frankel said when asked if Banks Hill would scratch. "But as of now, it looks like we're going to run." Mile hopeful **Medecis (GB)** (Machiavellian) took to the main track for his last major piece of work, blowing out three furlongs in :34 1/5 Thursday morning. Alex Solis has been booked to ride the chestnut, who was second by a length to Landseer (GB) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains earlier in the year.

Crown Lodge trainer John Hawkes, who sent Octagonal (NZ) out to win the 1995 Cox Plate and is chasing a second Cox Plate triumph with **Lonhro** at Moonee Valley Saturday, has thrown the race into controversy saying that the Gai Waterhouse-trained **Assertive Lad** and Bart Cummings' underachiever **Ustinov** are not entitled to be among the nine-horse field. Hawkes maintained the race should be invitation only. The owners of **Bel Esprit** have also fought a public battle over whether the three-year-old would start in the Cox Plate, but part-owner Lee Fleming of Eliza Park Stud maintained that Bel Esprit was up to the task. Octagonal was the last three-year-old to win the weight-for-age championship, although the Crown Lodge colt Viscount placed in **Northerly's** 2001 Cox Plate. Guy Walter, trainer of **Defier**, said it was "incomprehensible" that a night meeting was held at Moonee Valley Thursday, saying any subsequent track bias would ensure a third Cox Plate victory for Sunline. Hawkes is thrilled with Lonhro, who galloped on Tuesday, finishing with 400m in :22.5, the final 200m in :10.6. Three time Group 1-winner Assertive Lad bounced back to form winning the Melbourne Racing Club S. last Saturday after an 18-month winning drought. He spent a year in the paddock with a tendon injury after capturing the 2001 G1 Doncaster H. "He's back to his best now, and when he's right, he's up there with the best horses around," Waterhouse maintained. Northerly's trainer Fred Kersley has shrugged off suggestions his charge cannot back up after winning Caulfield Cup on Saturday, although only three horses in history have captured the Caulfield Cup/Cox Plate double in the same year. "Physically and mentally, the horse is at his peak now," he said. "It is not going to be easy, but I'm looking forward to it." Frankie Dettori has a point to prove aboard **Grandera**--he has had 25 rides in Australia for just one win, but the ebullient jockey declared his mount the best 2000-meter horse in the world.

### MANDY HOPING FOR DISTAFF GOLD

When **Mandy's Gold** (Gilded Time) shipped to Arlington this past June, trainer Mike Gorham had no idea that he and the chestnut filly would be making a return trip to the Midwest. But here they are. The Virginia-bred looked the picture of health Wednesday morning as she took two laps around the main track. Her trainer is looking forward to Saturday's race. "She's been excellent since she arrived here on Monday," the 38-year-old Gorham said. "She shipped good and there have been no problems. She likes it here." A game winner of the GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. over seven furlongs this past June 8, Mandy's Gold had a four-race winning streak snapped when third in the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga Aug. 25, but she bounced right back to register an 8-1 upset in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park Sept. 14, her first attempt past a mile. "We wanted to see if she would stretch out for us and if she belonged," Gorham explained. "She did and she does. Since then, the Distaff has been our goal." The conditioner, who is making his Breeders' Cup debut, feels that his charge can improve off her last effort, a rallying runner-up finish to Imperial Gesture in the GI Beldame S. at Belmont Oct. 14. "She was running fastest of all at the finish on a track she really didn't care for," Gorham, who is based at Delaware Park, explained. "The track was cuppy and dry that day, but she ran well." Mandy's Gold, who will be trying two turns for the first time in the Distaff, breaks from post position six under jockey Jose Santos.

### MEMORIES OF A BLACK TIE AFFAIR

There have been 129 races contested in the 18-year history of the Breeders' Cup, but just three winners used Arlington Park as their base. One of those was Black Tie Affair, who put in a front-running tour-de-force to win the 1991 Classic on a 43-degree afternoon at Churchill Downs. The memories of that event are very special and fresh in the mind of Dee Poulos.

"We felt very good going into the race," said Mrs. Poulos, the wife of the late Ernie Poulos, who trained the grey for local car dealer Jeffrey Sullivan. "We planned his races very carefully that year. The horse had been prepared as good as he could have been. Ernie was confident, although I wasn't nearly as confident."

Black Tie Affair was actually making his third Breeders' Cup appearance in as many years in 1991. A well beaten ninth in the 1989 Sprint at Gulfstream Park after being knocked sideways at the start and losing all chance, he returned to finish third, beaten just over four lengths by Safely Kept in the 1990 renewal at Belmont Park. His next start would forever alter the course of his career.

"We decided to see if he would stretch out, so we tried him in the [10-furlong] Hawthorne Gold Cup," Poulos explained. "Before that, we knew we had a special horse, but we didn't know how great he would become."

In a 1991 campaign which focused mostly on two-turn races, the five-year-old won the GI Iselin H., the GII Michigan Mile-and-One-Eighth H., the GIII Cornhusker H. at Ak-Sar-Ben and the GIII Stephen Foster at Churchill. For good measure, he also scored the seven-furlong GIII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup at Keeneland and was runner-up in the GI Carter H. Named champion older horse and Horse of the Year in 1991, Black Tie Affair entered stud at Vinery, where he stood five seasons before being sold to Japanese interests shortly after Ernie Poulos' death in 1997. His best runners include Formal Gold, License Fee and Evening Attire, who figures to take his fair share of action in the Classic.

"He reminds me a lot of Black Tie," Mrs. Poulos says of the Pat Kelly trainee. "They have a similar way of going and big strides, although they have different running styles. It's very special to have one of [Black Tie Affair's] sons running in the Classic, especially here at Arlington."

Poulos feels that her late husband will be looking down on Saturday with a broad smile.

**EATING OUT AT THE 2003 Cup:  
A Locals' Guide to Chicago Dining**

Most of you who read the *TDN* have been around racing long enough to know that when you're in Saratoga, you eat at *Ciro's*; at the Keeneland race meeting or sales, it's *Dudley's*. Gulfstream Park? *Joe's Stone Crabs*.

But with the first-ever Breeders' Cup being held at Arlington Park tomorrow, we thought our *TDN* subscribers might like a couple of dining-out tips from some of our local Chicago sharpies, as well as some, well...professional advice.

**The Locals Say...**

We pored through our database (and our office...) and asked the following local subscribers where they would eat if they only had one or two nights in town.

**Top Pick:** [MAGNUMS PRIME STEAKHOUSE](#), 225 West Ontario, Chicago. 312-337-8080; and 1701 West Golf Road, Rolling Meadows. 847-952-8555.

"They have wonderful steak and seafood as well as fantastic salads. Before you order, the waiter brings a platter to your table with the various cuts of meat and fish, and you make your choice from a tray of fresh selections. My top main-dish picks are the filet (10 oz for \$24.95 or 14 oz. for \$29.95), the prime rib (12 oz. for \$23.95 and 24 oz. for \$31.95) and a giant broiled lobster tail (10 oz. for \$44.95). The portions are overly generous, so I skip the appetizers, but go for the roasted garlic mashed potatoes as your side dish; they're delicious. A Breeders' Cup Day angle: I'm told that one of the remote parking areas for Breeders' Cup Day is at Continental Towers; the Rolling Meadows Magnum's is located on the lower level." "Everyone who is staying downtown would want to go to **Gibsons**. It is the place where most of the power brokers in the city go. First of all, it's good food--a steak joint, and the food is excellent. Any of their steaks are a good choice--big pieces of meat, done correctly. It's got an active see-and-be-seen bar, and it's in the physical location where the famous Mr. Kelly's used to be. The politicians and CEOs tend to get the first booths. It puts you in the locale of about five restaurants, so you can hop from one to another. That area is the restaurant hub. That's my top personal choice. Then, if people like Greek food, Greek Town is on the west side of the Loop, and there are five Greek restaurants on Halsted. If you want very family, home-style Greek, go to **Rodity's**. For upscale Greek, with really nice fish and more atmosphere, I'd choose **Santorini**. Finally, for Italian, **Rosebud on Rush**. They started on Taylor Street in the Old Italian neighborhood, and still have Rosebud on Taylor Street, but Rush is now the in, fancy place." But if there was one name in our database which stuck out as that of a guy who knew his way around a restaurant, it was Bobby Flay's. The celebrity chef, who has two shows on the Food Network and makes regular appearances on *CBS This Morning*, owns and operates two restaurants in New York City, the Mesa Grill and Bolo. The Thoroughbred owner will be heading to Chicago for the Breeders' Cup and gave the *TDN* his insider's scoop.

#### Bobby Flay, Chef and Restaurant Owner

"Chicago is a steak town, and *Gibsons* is the best steakhouse by far in Chicago. *Gibsons* is to me the quintessential Chicago steakhouse, with big prime aged steaks, big lobsters, and, of course all the side dishes you'd expect, done in high-quality, with a great steak list. I'm going to eat at *Gibsons* this week while I'm at the Breeders' Cup. For high-end contemporary cuisine, I'd go to *Tru*. It's a four-star restaurant with a young American chef (Rick Tramonto) who is doing contemporary American cuisine with influences from different parts of the world. So there's some French, some Asian, and it's really top-notch. Finally, there's a really hot new restaurant that everyone seems to like called *Spring*, so I'll try that while I'm there. My inside sources tell me that's the place to go."

### Chicago is....Pizza and Hot Dogs

Looking for slightly less fancy fare? Hot dogs and deep dish pizza are to Chicago and environs what cheese steak is to Philadelphia and are within easy reach of the racetrack. First, a hot dog primer. Chicago hot dogs are always boiled, never grilled, and are properly served on a steamed (poppy-seed) bun. Some doggie do's n' don'ts...DO ask for your hot dog to be "run through the garden." This will get you mustard, relish, tomato, pickle, chopped onions, sometimes cucumber slices and a sprinkle of celery salt (most underrated). DON'T spoil the experience with a squirt of ketchup. It has no place on a Chicago dog. Look for Vienna Beef products. [Pizzeria Uno](#) (locations in nearby Schaumburg as well as three locations in downtown Chicago) is the original creator of the Chicago deep dish in 1943. The pie, served at your table from the pan, is overloaded with fresh veggies and cheese and is complemented by a buttery crust. [Lou Malnatis](#) (several area locations) has been around only since 1971, but is a worthy competitor for Unos. Sliced mozzarella cheese is layered generously over a delicious crust and can be topped by a variety of ingredients, best of which is its mild sausage (correctly pronounced saah-sudge in Chi-town). The entire pizza is then crowned by a thick and chunky tomato sauce. Among Chicago pizzerias, these two easily complete the exacta.

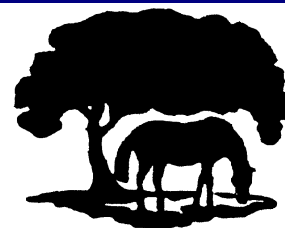
