A BANNER DAY FOR BALLYDOYLE?

The 19th edition of the World Thoroughbred Championships at Arlington Park could mean a bonanza for Ballydoyle, with trainer Aidan O'Brien saddling seven starters in four Breeders' Cup races. O'Brien is just 31, but he has already accomplished more than most trainers do in a lifetime. Last year, he won a world-record 23 Group 1 races, including seven Classics, and became the first horseman in more than two decades to take the training titles in both England and Ireland. He also saddled his first Breeders' Cup winner, Juvenile hero Johannesburg. While he has a "mere" four Classic wins and 16 Group 1 and Grade I victories this year, the Irish-bred horseman is well on his way to consecutive dual champion-

ships in the British Isles. His Breeders' Cup septet is headed by double Derby winner **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the 8-5 favorite in the Turf; and **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danahill), the even-money favorite in the Mile. "Our horses have hit form at the right time," Ballydoyle stable jockey Michael Kinane said. "This little bit of rain has taken a bit of the sting out of the turf and I don't think we'd be complaining too much about that." High Chaparral, a Classic winner in England and Ireland, was sidelined by the virus that swept Ballydoyle this summer, returning to be third in the Oct. 6 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. "My fellow was a little bit lethargic in the Arc--we'll have to hope he'll bounce forward out of it," Kinane said. Rock of Gibraltar is unbeaten in five starts this year, taking both the English and Irish 2000 Guineas. He picked up an unprecedented seventh straight Group 1 win last time in the Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. "Rock of Gibraltar is very straightforward," O'Brien said. "Just jump him out [of the gate], keep him relaxed and...then just hope he gets his run."

SKY MESA OUT OF JUVENILE

John Oxley's **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), the 3-1 morning-line favorite in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, was declared out of the race yesterday morning after injuring his right front ankle. "It looks like it could be a strain or a wrench," trainer John Ward Jr. said. "The best part of it is that there is no evidence of a condylar fracture and initial pictures show no crack. It's going to take Dr. [Larry] Bramlage a couple of days to sort it out. It's unfortunate timing, but the future might still look good." The injury was discovered this morning. "I looked at the horse this morning," Bramlage said. "There was some swelling just above the ankle joint and he was sore. The X-rays came back negative. We'll get him back to the clinic in Lexington early next week and do a digital bone scan." Undefeated in three starts, Sky Mesa captured the Oct. 5 GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity by four lengths.

BUSY ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ATLANTIC

Aidan O'Brien will be busy in America this afternoon, but his able assistants will send out three in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. O'Brien bids to collect a fourth Racing Post Trophy since 1997. The Ballydoyle trio is headed by **Brian Boru (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who comes off a narrow loss in the Oct. 13 G3 Beresford S. The colt will have the assistance of Kevin Darley, who partnered High Chaparral (Ire) to success in this last year. O'Brien will also be represented by **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who was sixth in the Beresford; and **Powerscourt (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who finished a fine second behind Lateen Sails (GB) in a competitive Newmarket maiden Oct. 2 before getting off the mark at Punchestown 15 days later. Like last year's hero and Aristotle (Ire), who scored in 1999, all three are by Sadler's Wells and all three will relish this mile. Their main rival appears to be **Bahamian Dancer (Ire)** (Bering {GB}), who was beaten a head by Al Jadeed when runner-up in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot Sept. 28. (*Racing Post Trophy field, p2*)

BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

CLASSIC, \$4,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

Jockey Mick Kinane finally got his first Breeders' Cup victory last year when Johannesburg successfully raided the Juvenile. He is hopeful that **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) can give him another win in the Classic. "He's had a tough year and has been a bit unlucky," Kinane acknowledged. "He's probably had the hardest races of all of them [Ballydoyle runners], but if he turns up with his best game I can see him running a big race." The colt has been the runner-up in four of his five races this year, all Group 1 events. "It's a big ask for my colt, but we're here to give it a crack and see what we can get out of it," Kinane continued. "He's bred to handle it [dirt], so it's just a question of how much fight he has left in him this year." Kinane has four mounts for Aidan O'Brien today, including Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the Mile, Tomahawk in the Juvenile and High Chaparral (Ire) in the Turf. "There isn't so much pressure this year because of Johannesburg winning last year," he said. "This is such a big meeting that if you can come here and get a result [one win], then anything above is a bonus. I've got two exceptional rides on High Chaparral and the Rock and either of them winning would be great, but I'll take anything."

BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE, \$1,000,000, 2yo, c/g, 1 1/8m

Trainer Aidan O'Brien will have his hands full in the Juvenile. The 31-year-old Irishman, hoping to add to his win with Johannesburg in last year's edition of the race, saddles the three-horse entry of **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat), **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) and **Van Nistelrooy** (Storm Cat). Mick Kinane has chosen to pilot Tomahawk in his bid for back-to-back Juvenile tallies. "I think the pace of the race will suit him," Kinane said. "[Hold That Tiger] is going to have to sit back a little bit, so I think my horse is just a little bit less complicated." The rider added, "I think all of our horses have the stamina that's required and whether or not they're good enough, we'll see."

Turtle Bow (Fr) (Turtle Island {Ire}) will appreciate the easier ground, according to trainer Francois Rohaut. "I'm happy to see the rain," he said. "The softer the going, the better for her. Her best races have come on soft tracks, at Deauville [a win in the G2 Prix d'Astarte] and at Belmont [a close second to Kazzia in the GI Flower Bowl]." He added, "I thought she should have won the race at Belmont. The rider lost his whip in the stretch, but the worst part was she couldn't get to the rail. She was only beaten a neck...I thought she should have won if she had gotten through on the inside."

Makhlab beat the smart Fiddlers Reach in a Pontefract maiden Aug. 7 before easily accounting for his rivals in a Chester nursery Aug. 30. Upped in class to contest the Listed Stardom S. over a mile at Goodwood Sept. 13, he proved no match for Rimrod and Rainwashed Gold (GB), fading out of contention to finish 7 3/4 lengths back in third. Here he was settled in last place early by Richard Hills as Jay Gee's Choice (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) enjoyed a narrow advantage over the tightly packed field. Pointed to a gap on the inside rail, he quickened through to lead with 300 yards remaining before surging clear under a hand ride for a comfortable score. "At Goodwood he wasn't right, as the ground was very firm, and he wasn't happy with himself," Hills said. "We always knew he had enough speed for seven [furlongs] and the cut in the ground has helped him. He was relaxed in behind and when I asked him to quicken he did it immediately. He's beautifully bred and a really good-looking horse, and with a turn of foot like that, he's definitely got a future." Makhlab may bid for Classic glory at The Curragh in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, according to connections. [Click here](#) for the racingpost.co.uk chart.

### A WING AND PRAYER

Arcangues caused the biggest upset in Breeders' Cup history when he took the 1993 Classic at 133-1. Nine years later, he is still the only foreign invader to take the showpiece of the World Thoroughbred Championships. But the Europeans have been getting closer, with Giant's Causeway missing by a neck in 2000 and Sakhee losing by the bob of a head last year--and their conqueror, Tiznow, won't be in the starting gate this time. Can **Hawk Wing** finally win another one for Team Europe? The three-year-old has been a model of consistency with four wins and five seconds from his nine career starts. Second in both the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas and the G1 Epsom Derby, the bay posted his biggest win to date at the Classic distance, taking the July 5 G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown. He was a nose runner-up in the Sept. 7 G1 Irish Champion S. and most recently second in the Sept. 28 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. His jockey, Michael Kinane, lost out on Giant's Causeway, but proved he could win on the dirt when guiding Johannesburg to victory in the 2001 Juvenile. Hawk Wing's strongest opposition will come from the quintet of American three-year-olds, headed by **Came Home**. The dark bay has been beaten just two times in his 11-race career, running seventh in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile and sixth behind **War Emblem** in this year's G1 Kentucky Derby. Sent off at 10-1 in the Aug. 25 G1 Pacific Classic last time out, he proved he could get the mile and a quarter and beat older horses, driving to a game 3/4-length score, with War Emblem fading to sixth. **Medaglia d'Oro** handled 10 furlongs in his latest test, taking the Aug. 24 G1 Travers S. by a half length; he takes on his elders for the first time. The best of the older generation appears to be **Evening Attire**. The gray gelding makes his first start outside New York after winning the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. and the G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup.

**TURF**...European-based runners have registered three consecutive victories in the Turf and that trend looks set to continue, with dual Derby hero **High Chaparral (Ire)** and **Golan (Ire)** heading the overseas invasion. Following a pair of victories in Ireland this spring, High Chaparral successfully stepped up to 12 furlongs and journeyed overseas to defeat stablemate Hawk

Wing by a convincing two lengths in the G1 Epsom Derby. An easy three-length winner of the G1 Irish Derby, the Aidan O'Brien trainee fell victim to the sickness that sidelined nearly every Ballydoyle horse and was forced to miss the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 15, which was to serve as a prep for the Oct. 6 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Sent to the Arc without a prep, the Magnier and Tabor colorbearer was handed his first defeat of the year, finishing third to Marienbard (Ire) and Sulamani (Ire), a result for which his trainer takes full responsibility. "I probably hadn't gotten him sharp enough mentally," O'Brien said. "[Jockey] Mick [Kinane] just thought he was very relaxed--too relaxed. When the first two just ran by him and got away from him, his mind wasn't in gear." Golan returned from an eight-month absence to defeat Nayef in a stirring renewal of the G1 King George VII & Queen Elizabeth II Diamond S. at Ascot July 27. The bay has made just one other start this season, falling a neck short to Nayef in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 20. He is sent out by the same connections as Pilsudski (Ire), who won the 1996 Turf. The home defense is headed by **Denon** and **With Anticipation**. The latter bested his younger rival by a neck in the GI United Nations H. and by a head in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational before adding a third consecutive Grade I with a narrow win in the Man o' War S., but Denon, who passed that event, rebounded with a 1/2-length victory in the GI Turf Classic Sept. 29, with With Anticipation sixth.

**Turf Notes...**

Eleven of the 18 winners of the Turf have gone on to divisional championships. In addition to her Eclipse as the 1985 champion turf female, Pebbles (GB) was a dual champion in England that season. One winner of the Turf was named U.S. Horse of the Year--Kotashaan (Fr), who won at Santa Anita in 1993.

Trainer Bill Mott was the only repeat winner of the Turf in its first 15 runnings, scoring with Theatrical (Ire) in 1987 and with Fraise in 1992. Since then, trainer Saeed bin Suroor (Daylami {Ire}, 1999 & Fantastic Light, 2001) and Sir Michael Stoute (Pilsudski {Ire}, 1996 & Kalanisi {Ire}, 2000) have become two-time winners. Stoute tries to become the first three-time winner with Golan this year.

Three-year-olds took two of the first three editions of the Turf (Lashkari {GB}, '84; and Manila, '86), but have only won it twice since. Prized succeeded in '89 and Tikannen (Ire) took the race in 1994.

This year marks the smallest field in Turf history. Nine contested the race in 1986, with Manila posting a neck win over Theatrical (Ire). The 1-2 choice Dancing Brave was fourth.

**JUVENILE**....An added wrinkle to the 2002 Juvenile is the 1 1/8-mile distance instituted to accommodate the Arlington oval. It's only an extra sixteenth, but the toll it takes on these young runners could make for some surprises. The toughest of the speed candidates look to be **Bull Market**, a game second to **Kafwain** in the GII Norfolk S. Oct. 5 at Santa Anita; and **Vindication**, the highly impressive winner of the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile Sept. 14 at Turfway.

Flanking the early speed should be **Toccet**, coming of a rail-skimming score in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 5 at Belmont and winner of three straight by a combined 20+ lengths. The talented pair of **Whywhywhy**, first to the line

in the GI Futurity Sept. 15 at Belmont; and Norfolk hero Kafwain may be moving together on the turn to present a challenge to the leaders. But, benefitting from the pace on the front end should be **Listen Indy**, an overlooked 30-1 on the morning line. The bay sports only a maiden win to his credit, but he came back to be third in the Norfolk. He appears to be a late bloomer and should appreciate the added distance. Other late threats include longshot **Most Feared**, a Ronny Werner-trained colt by the Texas-based freshman sire Commanchero (Unbridled); and **Hold That Tiger**, one of a trio of runners sent out by trainer Aidan O'Brien. Most Feared took the GIII Arlington Washington Futurity on Sept. 28, has won his last three starts and is one of only two runners (along with GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity runner-up **Lone Star Sky** {Conquistador Cielo}) with a race over the local strip. Hold That Tiger came flying home to score a rousing victory in the G1 Grand Criterium Barriere at Longchamp Oct. 6; his connections look to make it back-to-back Juvenile wins off their victory with the brilliant Johannesburg in 2001.

**Juvenile Notes**...Three of the stallions represented in this year's Juvenile have already sired Juvenile winners--Seattle Slew (Capote, '86), Phone Trick (Favorite Trick, '97) and Holy Bull (Macho Uno, '00). Unbridled holds the record for most Juvenile winners at two (Unbridled's Song, '95; and Anees, '99).

Jerry Bailey (Bull Market) and Laffit Pincay Jr. have each won the Juvenile three times--Bailey in '96, '98 and '00; and Pincay Jr. in '85, '86 and '88. Pat Day (WhyWhyWhy) won it in '94 and '97.

**F/M TURF**...The great Sadler's Wells has already sired three Breeders' Cup winners in Baratheia (Ire) ('94 Mile), In the Wings (GB) ('90 Turf) and Northern Spur (Ire) ('95 Turf). He has a chance to pick up a fourth with

**Gossamer (GB)** or **Islington (Ire)**. Islington is a perfect two-for-two at the F/M Turf distance of a mile and a quarter, winning a maiden race at Newbury in April and the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood in August. The bay also took the 1 1/2-mile G1 Yorkshire Oaks and acquitted herself admirably in her most recent outing, finishing a close-up fifth in the Oct. 6 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Her trainer, Sir Michael Stoute, saddled Ballymacoll-bred Pilsudski (Ire) to win the 1996 Turf and Kalanisi (Ire) to take that race in

2000. The bay leads the five-horse European squad in this race. **Turtle Bow** is another who could make her presence felt. The three-year-old filly beat subsequent G1 Prix de la Foret winner Dedication (Fr) in the G2 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville in August, then faded to fourth behind 2001 F/M Turf heroine **Banks Hill (GB)** in the one-mile G1 Prix Jacques le Marois 15 days later. She stretched out to a mile and a quarter for her U.S. debut, the G1 Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Park Sept. 28, and missed by a neck behind **Kazzia (Ger)** after jockey Christophe Soumillon lost his whip in the stretch. Kazzia captured the G1

Sagitta 1000 Guineas and the G1 Espom Oaks before suffering her first defeat when fourth in the Yorkshire Oaks. **Zenda (GB)**, winner of the G1 French 1000 Guineas, comes off narrow losses in the June 21 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot and Oct. 12 G1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. The home team is topped by **Golden Apples (Ire)**. The four-year-old filly, who started her career in Europe, looks for her third straight after taking the G1 Beverly D. S. over this course Aug. 17 and the G1 Yellow Ribbon Invitational H. at Santa Anita Oct. 5. **Owsley** is a perfect three-for-three at 10 furlongs.

**SPRINT**...Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who won the 1988 Sprint with Gulch, unleashes a two-pronged attack with GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint winner **Day Trader** and morning-line favorite **Orientate**. The latter is four-for-four at the distance, has won over four different race tracks this term and comes into this event off a four-race winning streak, including the Sept. 1 GI Forego H. last time out. Three-year-old Day Trader followed his Kentucky Cup score with a second in the Oct. 5 GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland. Returning 2000 Sprint champion **Kona Gold** won his 2002 debut handily, the six-furlong GIII Los Angeles H. at Hollywood June 2, but came home a tired sixth in his most recent start when trying seven furlongs in the GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. July 6. The eight-year-old will become the first horse in history to make five Breeders' Cup appearances. Trainer Bruce Headley rounds out his entry with GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. winner **Kalookan Queen**. The six-year-old mare, who has won both starts against the boys this term, has finished in the money in all seven starts in 2002 and has never been worse than second at six furlongs.

**Bonapaw** has earned plenty of frequent flyer miles in 2002, starting at five different tracks in two countries. A lackluster sixth in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in March, the gelding was given a break, returning to take the one-mile GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington in his second start off the layoff July 20. **MILE**...Per usual, the Mile breaks down largely as a showdown between two continents, with Europe crossing the Rubicon earlier this week with a phalanx of battle-tested warriors that are sure to give the North Americans all they can handle. Leading the charge is **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)**, the all-universe Aidan O'Brien trainee that comes into this contest with a record-setting string of seven Group 1 victories in Europe. The bay doesn't necessarily overwhelm the opposition--his largest margin of victory this year is two lengths--but his immense talent and intelligence allow him to expend only the amount of energy needed to cross the line first, the stated goal of most races. Still, the Mile starts right on the turn and "The Rock" drew an undesirable post 10, leaving him vulnerable to a wide trip. Should he fail to break the top three, the tote board may resemble a minor fireworks display. A poor draw may also affect his stablemate **Landseer**. That one has already managed to make a splash stateside, necking out a win in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile in his American debut Oct. 6, and will try to give owners Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier a second Breeders' Cup victory. Tabor and Masgnier broke an 0-for-13 streak with Johannesburg in the Juvenile last year. As for the North American contingent, the effectiveness of **Del Mar Show** and **Beat Hollow (GB)** at a mile remains unproven. Both have won just once at the distance, but another Frankel runner, **Aldebaran**, might just relish eight furlongs. The four-year-old has spent most of '02 finishing second in sprint races on dirt (5-1-4-0 this year in sprints), but his one try at a mile in the GI Met Mile yielded a monster Beyer figure (113) and saw him run second to Swept Overboard, who put forth, arguably, the best performance of his career in that test. Aldebaran has never finished off the board, has shown an affinity for the grass and should offer a nice price. His half-brother **Good Journey**, who capped off a four-race winning skein when taking the GI Atto Mile Sept. 8, also plans to figure into the equation. And for those looking to make their exotics a bit more exotic, take a hard look at **Boston Common**. His sire is hitting at a 23 percent clip with first-time turfers, Arlington whiz Rene Douglas is up, and the three-year-old's low, shuffling stride might translate into boxcar trifectas.

"Of course I've got a little bit of a concern," acknowledged trainer Shug McGaughey, "but I think we'll be fine." One filly who has already successfully negotiated

two turns is **Composure**, whose upturn in form most recently resulted in a sharp three-length victory in the GI Oak Leaf S. Oct. 6. Composure and Santa Catarina, along with **Atlantic Ocean**, are part of a three-horse entry from conditioner Bob Baffert. Baffert has high hopes for Santa Catarina, who prior to her Frizette second was a neck runner-up in the GI Del Mar Debutante. "She reminded us of Silverbulletday from the start," he said. "I think she is eligible to improve off her last start." Trainer Mel Stute sent out Brave Raj to victory in this race in 1986 and hopes that **Buffythecenterfold** can do the same. The stretch-running **Ruby's Reception** could get a solid pace to run at today and could be a live longshot in the exotics. She captured the Ellis Park Debutante by 7 3/4 lengths Aug. 17 before running second in the Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies Sept. 14 and the GI Walmac Alcibiades Oct. 4. A \$12,000 KEESEP yearling, she has brought her connections to the big time. "This is where you want to be--the Breeders' Cup," said part owner Randy Sellers. "She's been a dream for all of us."

She began the onslaught with a three-length victory in the GI Santa Margarita H. and, most recently, captured the Oct. 2 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. Since her win in the La Canada, Summer Colony has won the Pimlico Breeders' Cup Distaff H. and the GI Personal Ensign H., but the four-year-old filly is coming off a third-place effort in the Oct. 5 GI Beldame. The strong sophomore contingent is headed by Godolphin's Beldame winner **Imperial Gesture**. The filly, second behind stablemate **Tempera** in last year's Juvenile Fillies, could earn Godolphin its fourth Breeders' Cup victory. She is unbeaten in three starts since finishing eighth in the GI Kentucky Oaks, including a 2 1/2-length victory in the GI Gazelle H.,

and assistant trainer Tom Albertrani warns that the filly is, "on top of her game," adding, "She's better going into this race than the Beldame." Kentucky Oaks winner **Farda Amiga** is a superstar in Brazil, the home of owners Old Friends Inc., Winner Silk Inc. and Jose DeCamargo and the native land of her trainer Paulo Lobo. "She is very famous in Brazil," Lobo said of Farda Amiga, who has not raced since winning the GI Alabama in August. "ESPN broadcast the Kentucky Oaks to Brazil. All the press in Brazil is aware of her." Lobo, a leading trainer in Brazil before coming to the U.S. nearly two years ago, added, "Running in this race is very important to me, the horse and the owners. It is the most important race for fillies and mares. Every trainer wants to win a Breeders' Cup race. If I win, it would be a dream come true." Rounding out the talented trio of sophomores is **Take Charge Lady**. The filly, second behind Imperial Gesture in the Gazelle, won the Oct. 5 GI Overbrook Spinster at Keeneland last time out and has been first or second in 11 of 12 appearances.

Two fillies graduate from last year's Juvenile Fillies to this year's Distaff: Imperial Gesture (2nd) and Take Charge Lady (6th).

Only three horses have not won Eclipse Awards after winning the Distaff: One Dreamer ('94), Spain ('00) and Unbridled Elaine ('01).
