### V IS FOR...VOLPONI?

He was sent off the longest shot in the race at 43-1, but **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) obviously didn't believe the board. The four-year-old powered up the inside to take the lead at the top of the stretch and left 5-2 favorite **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) in his dust, drawing off to win yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic by 6 1/2 lengths. Jose Santos was not shocked by the result. "I'm not surprised at all," said the jockey, scoring his seventh Breeders' Cup victory and his first since taking the 1997 Turf with Chief Bearheart. "I told my wife three days ago that he would win. He has been doing wonderful." With blinkers added for this start, the bay saved ground while racing in fifth as **E Dubai** (Mr. Prospector) and **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) led the pack. He edged closer on the far turn, battled between horses at the top of the lane and drove clear.

### V Is for Versatile...

**Volponi** broke his maiden at two, taking the GIII Pilgrim S. going nine furlongs on the grass. At three, he added a win in the GII Pegasus H. at a mile and an eighth on the dirt. The colt started his 2002 campaign with a victory in a seven-furlong allowance on the Belmont main track and, with blinkers off, came back two starts later to take the GIII Poker H. at a mile on the Belmont lawn July 5. He had hit the board in every start since, running third in the Aug. 10 GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. and second in July 26 GII Bernard Baruch H. and Sept. 14 GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. on the grass and the Oct. 4 GII Meadowlands Cup on the main track. There was no doubt he could handle the distance and surface in the Classic, and Volponi proved he could handle the competition as well. "This horse has always shown promise and the blinkers made him concentrate a little bit better," said trainer P.G. Johnson, who had been off the board in two previous Breeders' Cup tries. Medaglia d'Oro, never far from the front, held off 24-1 **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) for the place. **War Emblem** tired badly to be eighth. "On the first turn, I had to tap on his shoulder a little bit," jockey Victor Espinoza said. "He never got into the race the way he used to." **Came Home** (Gone West) was never really in the hunt and faded early, finishing 10th. "He didn't handle the track at all and he pulled up a little funny," jockey Mike Smith said. "He just wasn't himself." "I think she has more than a legitimate chance for Horse of the Year if she wins the Distaff," De Seroux said. "Horse of the Year implies who performed the best. ## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

**A TOUGH DAY FOR BALLYDOYLE** They started out with high hopes, but Team Ballydoyle suffered through a series of lows before they were able to celebrate the victory of **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The day got off to a very

bad start when Classic winner **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) broke down while making his bid at the top of the stretch in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. "My horse was making a nice move [when he broke down]," jockey Edgar Prado said.

"It happened so quickly. I heard a crack. I don't know if he stepped in a hole or what. I tried to pull him up, but he was full of run. I feel terrible for the horse." The injury proved fatal. "He broke his cannon bone, right below the knee," explained attending veterinarian Dr. Larry Bramlage. The horse was later euthanized. Stablemate **Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill), the odds-on favorite in the Mile, was rallying inside Landseer when the incident occurred and had to steady. He couldn't overcome the lost momentum, finishing second. Trainer Aidan O'Brien saddled three for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but bad luck struck again when both **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) and **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) broke in the air. While Tomahawk never recovered, the gallant Hold That Tiger, who spotted the field at least five lengths, never gave up, grinding out a gutsy third-place finish. "Hold That Tiger was watching the stall handler at the break, but he came home really well," O'Brien said. "I would love to think he could be a Kentucky Derby horse next year." Ballydoyle's **Van Nistelrooy** (Storm Cat) closed for fifth, while Tomahawk came home ninth. High Chaparral saved the day for the stable in the Turf, but **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) proved disappointing in the Classic. Never in the hunt, he finished seventh. "He found it all a bit strange and he panicked a little bit," jockey Michael Kinane said, adding, "He gave me a little bit of a run trying to keep up." O'Brien commented, "When he made his move, he just tired out. It's been a long hard season for him, but we'll look forward to him next year."

High Chaparral established his star credentials with a Derby double earlier in the year, taking the June 8 G1 Epsom Derby and the June 30 G1 Irish Derby. Sidelined by illness, the three-year-old bay returned to finish third as the favorite in the Oct. 6 Arc de Triomphe last time out. High Chaparral settled in mid-pack behind the slow fractions set by The Tin Man (Affirmed). He waited for racing room on the final bend, split foes to gain the lead at midstretch and inched clear late. "I figured I'd just stay in the pack because you really have to work to keep his attention," explained winning rider Mick Kinane. "I thought we'd be going quicker. I expected Ballingarry (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) to be setting a faster pace, but that didn't happen, so I saw that gray horse [With Anticipation] come up the outside and I knew it was really time to go to work on him. Then he really let it go. He's the kind of horse that has loads saved. He's so, so, all class." Winning trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "I was a little concerned early in the race when he got a little bit shuffled back, but he got out at the right time and picked it up really late. He has been doing this all year." GI Man o' War S. winner With Anticipation took the lead briefly in the stretch, but couldn't hold off the winner. "I'm very proud of him," trainer Jonathan Sheppard said of the seven-year-old gray gelding. "He ran a tremendously courageous race. He ran the best race he possibly could. Much of the talk surrounding this race concentrated on the added distance, but it wasn't a problem for Vindication; the handsome son of Seattle Slew broke alertly from the gate and never looked back, shrugging off the early challenge of stablemate Bull Market (Holy Bull) en route to an impressive score. Like his father, the undefeated two-year-old is sure to go on to championship honors. Vindication broke onto the scene with an eye-catching maiden win July 27 at Del Mar, then beat allowance company Aug. 22 over the same strip. Climbing the ranks for his next start, he drew off handily after a rough start in the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile Sept. 14 at Turfway, a win that stamped the colt as a clear Juvenile contender and he did not disappoint, showing a dazzling display of speed and stamina to finish well clear of Kafwain, who completed the Bob Baffert-trained exacta and giving jockey Mike Smith his second Breeders' Cup win of the day. "He's a paparazzi horse right now," Baffert said. "He's going to get all flash and stuff. That was pretty impressive." Whywhywhy (Mr. Greeley), winner of the GI Futurity at Belmont Sept. 15 and the 5-2 crowd choice, never fired, finishing a distant tenth. Jockey Pat Day offered no excuses. "He broke good and clean," he said. "He felt strong on the backside in between the two Baffert horses. He had no response turning for home. He was going nowhere in the stretch." Banks Hill was bidding to become the fifth horse to win back-to-back Breeders' Cup races, but she was stymied by stablemate Starine. The gray mare was sent off at an unconsidered 13-1, but closed from fourth to take command in the stretch and had enough left to keep Banks Hill at Bay to the finish. "I couldn't have asked for a more perfect trip," jockey John Velazquez said. "I was able to sit on her until we turned for home and she just did her own thing when I let her go. I can't believe how well it went for her." Added trainer Bobby Frankel, who also owns the winner, "She loves the soft--that's the main thing. She killed Golden Apples in the Matriarch last year on the soft ground." Starine ended her 2001 campaign with a 2 1/2-length score in the Matriarch, with Golden Apples (Pivotal {GB}) third, then came back four months later to be second to that mare in the Mar. 23 GII Santa Ana H. Beaten a head in the May 27 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H., the French-bred was off another four months before returning for a fourth-place finish in the Sept. 28 GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. She improved off that effort to give her jockey his second Breeders' Cup win of the afternoon. As for the runner-up, Frankel said, "She'll be a champion next year if she stays in training. Nothing is going to beat her on firm turf." Islington, bothered at the break, closed strongly to just miss the place. The 5-2 favorite, Golden Apples was far back after being checked sharply early and finished well, but too late, to be fourth. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who won the 1988 Sprint with Gulch, added a second with the crowd's slight choice Orientate, but the winner had to battle past the second-longest shot on the board to get the job done. The lightly raced Thunderello, off at 48-1, had never been worse than second in six prior starts, but prepped for the Breeders' Cup with a win in the Gallant Bob H. at Philly Park. The three-year-old went right to the front, dashed off fractions of :21.53 and :43.91 and, instead of wilting, dug in gamely, but just couldn't hold off the late charge of Orientate. "I'm amazed that Thunderello took the heat like that and punched down the lane the way he did," jockey Jerry Bailey said, but added, "I had a lot of confidence in this horse. This colt could run down anything." The four-year-old is a shoo-in for an Eclipse, adding this to his consecutive wins in the GIII Aristides H., Smile Sprint H., GII Alfred G. Vanderbilet H. and GI Forego H. But last year's champion three-year-old filly Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat) did not fare as well, sitting just off the pace before fading to sixth. "We decided we would try to take her back today and we got beat," trainer John Salzman, Sr. said.

He wasn't the longest-priced winner in Mile history--that honor still belongs to 35-1 shot Last Tycoon (Ire)--but Domedriver still shocked the crowd, holding off the final charge of odds-on Rock Of Gibraltar to light up the tote board at 26-1. "I think he loves this kind of ground," trainer Pascal Barry said. "The course today was much like it is in France." Domedriver has done all of his running in France this year, winning the G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer Nord at Chantilly in June, then running second by a neck in the G3 Prix Messidor in July. The bay was a length and a half behind Banks Hill (GB) when second in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August, then took a short break before prepping for the Breeders' Cup with a win in the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein at Longchamp Oct. 5. Caught in tight quarters on the first turn, the four-year-old settled off the pace for five furlongs, but launched his bid along the rail as they headed around the far turn. He fought his way between horses at the top of the stretch to grab the lead at the eighth pole and held on to beat the "Rock" at the wire. The runner-up, off slowly and last early, was rallying inside Landseer (Danehill) when his stablemate broke down. He came flying once clear, but ran out of real estate and had to settle for second. Carrying on the family tradition, Storm Flag Flying outfinished Composure to become a third-generation Breeders' Cup winner. Coming off a 12 3/4-length score in the Sept. 15 GI Matron S. and a two-length tally in the Oct. 5 GI Frizette S., the undefeated filly was looking to become the sixth of the seven odds-on favorites in this race to get the victory. The dark bay was tucked in between horses as 33-1 Humorous Lady (Distorted Humor) cut out a quick pace, then drove to the front at the top of the lane. But I hit her left-handed and she responded." Trainer Bob Baffert, who saddled three in the race, including the runner-up, said, "We thought we had won the race, but the other filly saved something for us. She's a great filly." 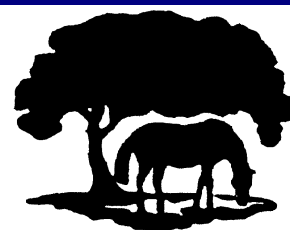
