

### ARLINGTON AFTERMATH

**Azeri** (Jade Hunter)'s impressive victory in the GI Distaff Saturday placed her squarely in the Horse of the Year picture and trainer Laura de Seroux was eager to extol her charge's virtues yesterday. "Who else is there?" asked the California-based conditioner. "Who else is there to give it to? She's simply the fastest filly in the world right now. You can't catch her early and you can't catch her late." After three-year-olds **Came Home** (Gone West) and **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) faltered in the Classic, de Seroux said, "I don't like for anyone to lose, but there were ones I hoped would win. Certainly, Volponi was one of them." It appears that Azeri will be kept in training as a five-year-old and could face the boys next year. "I guess at some point we'll probably have to try it," de Seroux added. "[She] is a model of consistency and everything a racehorse should be...She's what the whole industry is breeding for. She's got speed, stamina and class."

### JOHN DEERE TURF

**Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), who disappointed when sixth as the 7-2 second choice in the Turf Saturday afternoon, may have run his last race. The four-year-old was scheduled to conclude his career in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 24 before entering stud at Coolmore Stud in Ireland next year.

### NETJETS MILE

Winner **Domedriver (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) is expected to remain in training in 2003, but the four-year-old could make one more start this year. Trainer Pascal Bary is considering the G1 Hong Kong Mile as a possibility for Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)'s conqueror. Domedriver is scheduled to fly back to Chantilly Tuesday. Meanwhile, **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) has been retired following his sixth-place finish as the 6-1 third choice. "[He] left [Sunday] morning for Kentucky," said Ruben Loza, assistant to trainer Bobby Frankel. "He's been retired to Juddmonte Farms." The blaze-faced bay has a record of 11-7-2-2 and a bankroll of over \$1.8 million.

### CLASSIC

A day after his upset victory in the Classic, **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) headed back to New York for a vacation. "He came out clean, no trouble," said Heriberto Cedano, assistant to trainer P. G. Johnson. Johnson said that the bay would be back in action next year in late April or early May. The ultra-consistent **Came Home** injured his left knee while finishing 10th in his final career start. "He hurt himself [Saturday] in his left front knee," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "Mike [jockey Smith] said he felt something going into the first turn and then going down the backside, he felt his stride getting shorter and shorter." The dark bay will head today to Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky to prepare for his stud career. **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) came out of his 12th-place finish missing his left hind shoe. "He's fine [Sunday] morning," said trainer Murray Johnson. "He was stripped behind, so we're anxious to watch the race to see when it happened. I can't say if that had an effect because he was just too eager early. We'll look forward to next year." Johnson indicated that he would consider the Nov. 29 GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs as Perfect Drift's next start.

### F/M TURF

French classic heroine **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) will head to the breeding shed after her eighth-place effort behind **Starine (Fr)** (Mendocino). Fellow Juddmonte colorbearer **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill), second in her title defense, will join trainer Bobby Frankel's string on a plane back to Southern California to determine her future. "Plans for what's next will probably be made in the next couple of days," said Frankel's assistant Ruben Loza. "With the exception of Beat Hollow, they're all booked on a flight Tuesday morning to head back to California." Starine made Frankel the first owner/trainer to win a Breeders' Cup race.

Mr Dinos was sent to the head of affairs and the strong-galloping three-year-old never looked back as he ran away with this stayer's event. In doing so, he made amends for his disappointing fifth place behind Bollin Eric (GB) in the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 14. "In the St Leger, he went too fast early on the lead," a delighted trainer Paul Cole said afterwards, "and against good horses, it is difficult to do that and see out the trip. He also needs soft ground to be at his best and that's exactly what he got today." Allowed an uncontested lead, Mr Dinos sauntered through the early stages before opening up at the top of the straight, turning down the challenge of a revitalised Sulk on the drive to the line. He showed his remorseless galloping style to great effect when powering away with the G3 Prix Berteux at Vichy July 27, having finished a half-length runner-up to Mamool (Ire) in the two-mile G3 Queen's Vase on fast turf at Royal Ascot June 21. The Irish-bred exhibited the same courage to deal with those unsuitable conditions in the competitive Northumberland Plate H. at Newcastle June 29, when he went under by a head. Cole has the major Cup races in mind for Mr Dinos next term. "He is through for the season, but he's definitely staying in training as he will strengthen up as he did between two and three," he continued. "He should be better next year when he will be aimed at all the top distance races."

Marotta paid a compliment to her Longchamp conqueror Bright Sky (Ire) with an authoritative display in this contest. Last time, she was put firmly in her place when 4 3/4 lengths back in third behind that filly in the G1 Prix de l'Opera on Arc day Oct. 6, having filled the same spot behind Pearly Shells (GB) in the G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville Aug. 25. She suffered an interrupted preparation for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 9, in which she was fifth, appearing to run below the level of form she showed when taking the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 19. Marotta was held up in mid-division by jockey Thierry Jarnet early as Divisa (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) cut out the running before making her move in the straight. When she quickened inside the final quarter-mile, Choc Ice was the only rival that could initially match her acceleration, but she soon had her measure, passing the game Tomori before powering away for an emphatic score.

The 2 1/2-length winner of the GII Dixie S. at Pimlico on Preakness Day, Strut the Stage was a solid third to Beat Hollow (GB) in the GI Manhattan H. on the Belmont S. undercard June 8. A disappointing sixth to Good Journey in the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill July 4, the chestnut filled the same spot in the July 27 GIII Arlington H., was seventh in the GI Atto Mile Sept. 8 and was coming into this off a fourth-place effort in the GI Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile Oct. 6. Getting an additional three furlongs for this, the Sam Son homebred was eased back off the easy pace set by Stage Classic (Sky Classic), drew even with that rival while three wide on the far turn, assumed a short lead in upper stretch and held off Cetewayo for the victory.

Special Matter had not finished worse than third in his last six starts, but just two of those efforts came against non-claiming company. Haltered by his current connections for just \$12,500 out of a runner-up finish over the Hollywood main track May 31, the bay was third two starts later versus \$50,000 optional claimers going 1 3/8 miles over the Del Mar turf Aug. 3. Returned on six days' rest, the gelding defeated \$16,000 starter allowance types by a head, came back to be a half-length second against \$40,000 optional claimers at the seaside Sept. 2 and was most recently a neck winner of a \$25,000 starter allowance test over course and distance Oct. 14. The second longest shot in this compact field, Special Matter stalked the tepid pace of Alyzig from second, turned up the heat outside that foe at the quarter pole and edged clear to the win. "I got him to relax after we got off the hill and when I asked him, he kicked it in so hard," said winning rider Tyler Baze. "I knew we had a good chance coming in here. We finally found his distance," added the jockey, who has been aboard for each of his mount's six starts since the claim.

Both victories came over the minimum trip on good ground or faster, and it remains to be seen how the speedy colt adapts to this extra furlong in testing conditions. Those factors are bound to suit **Bella Tusa**, a winner over good-to-soft ground in the Listed Dragon S. at Sandown July 6 and Listed Harry Rosebery S. at Ayr Sept. 19. She was all at sea over the firmer conditions prevalent at Newmarket when she had to settle for last of six behind Airwave (GB) in the G1 Cheveley Park S. Oct. 4, but is worthy of respect with everything in her favour here. Following a third placing in the G3 Prix de Cabourg at Deauville Aug. 3, **Pleasure Place** beat Zinziberine by a nose in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at this track Sept. 11. She laid claim to being the best Italian-trained juvenile when the five-length winner of the Listed Premio Divino Amore at Rome Oct. 6, but needs to prove she can handle this give underfoot. Zinziberine beat Acago by 3/4-of a length in the G3 Prix Eclipse over this course Oct. 2 and is sure to give her usual honest running.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has dominated this contest in recent years, winning it five times since 1996, and he saddles Limerick maiden winner **France** and **Great Pyramid**. John Oxx and Johnny Murtagh teamed up to take this in 1995 with Aylesbury (Ire) and they combine again with **New South Wales**, who beat the smart subsequent winner Chevalier (Ire) on his debut in a Curragh maiden Oct. 5. **Walayef** impressed when maintaining her unbeaten record in the Listed Round Tower S. at The Curragh Sept. 1, but has to prove her stamina in this testing ground.

**DISTAFF**

Ready to run off a lengthy layoff, **Farda Amiga** (Broad Brush) may have earned an Eclipse Award as champion three-year-old filly with her hard-charging second to Azeri Saturday afternoon. "It was a tough race," trainer Paulo Lobo said of the Kentucky Oaks/Alabama heroine's effort. "I think she gave 200 percent of herself. No other horse during the day came from behind like her, maybe only Volponi. Azeri is a monster. I think she [Farda Amiga] lost to a Horse of the Year. I think she proved that she deserves the three-year-old filly championship." Fifth-place finisher **Mandy's Gold** (Gilded Time) may make one more start this year in Aqueduct's GII Top Flight H. Nov. 29. "She's fine, no problems," commented trainer Michael Gorham. "I wish we had been closer to the pace, but Azeri proved to be the real deal. We'll take a look at the Top Flight the day after Thanksgiving and then she'll get a vacation. You'll see her again next year." Following her sixth-place finish, **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) was discovered to have a guttural pouch infection. "She's fine," said Ken McPeck. "It should take about 10 days for the infection to clear up. We'll take a look at either the Falls City H. [GII, Nov. 28, Churchill] or the Great State Challenge [at Sam Houston Dec. 7]." Seventh-place finisher **Two Item Limit** (Twining) also came out of the race needing medication. "She got hit in the right eye with a dirt clod and it's a bit ulcerous," explained trainer Stephen DiMauro. "She got hit with a lot of dirt, which is probably why she was so far back. We'll give her about five days here and the vet will evaluate her."

**LONG JOHN SILVER'S JUVENILE FILLIES**

**Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat), who cemented her reputation as the nation's top two-year-old filly with Saturday's determined victory, could try colts next spring if her progression continues, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. "If she were a colt, people would already be talking about the Kentucky Derby," he said. "She's now won at a mile and an eighth and around two turns and beat the best of her division. And she was starting to draw off a little at the end, which would make you think that distance won't be a problem for her. She'll be nominated to the Triple Crown, but it is all going to depend on what kind of winter she has. She is going to get a good break here and then we'll see where she's at." **Ruby's Reception** (Rubiano) will get the rest of the year off after 11th-place finish. "She has a little filling in her right front ankle, but it doesn't look too serious," said trainer Larry Jones. "She didn't look comfortable getting over the track and she probably just wrenched it trying so hard. It shouldn't be something that a little TLC won't cure."

**BESSEMER TRUST JUVENILE**

Trainer Bob Baffert is pretty confident that the Juvenile winner, unbeaten **Vindication** (Seattle Slew), has a bright future. "First of all, I want to thank my assistant, Jim Barnes, because he does all the work and I get all the credit," he remarked. "Second, what's wrong with Vindication for Horse of the Year? Vindication wowed us with his race at Turfway [Sept. 14, GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile]," he said. He made that Arazi move on the turn, the kind of move that Point Given made. We knew he was something special then." The dark colt was sharp on the front end Saturday, but perhaps the most impressive effort in the race came from **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat), who spotted the field several lengths after a disastrous start, then came running late for third. The chestnut colt flew back early Sunday morning to his Ballydoyle base in Ireland, but he could be back next spring for a crack at the GI Kentucky Derby. Favored **Whywhywhy** (Mr. Greeley) finished 10th with a cut leg. "Whywhywhy got a nasty looking cut on a back leg, but it's not bad," said assistant trainer Yan Durespainre. As for **Zavata** (Phone Trick), who was pulled up on the far turn, Durespainre said, "It was too long, too early, too fast. He's a pure sprinter, and he didn't like the dirt in his face."

**NAPA SPRINT**

Sprint champ **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore) could be on his way to New York for his next start. "We've made no decision yet as to their races," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas about **Orientate** and **Day Trader** (Phone Trick), who ran 11th. "But we are looking at the Cigar Mile [Nov. 30 at Aqueduct] for **Orientate**. **Day Trader** will run in a Churchill Downs stakes this fall." Runner-up at 48-1, **Thunderello** (Montbrook) could be back fairly soon. "It could be the DeFrancis Dash [GI, Nov. 16, Laurel], but that is pretty quick," said trainer Scott Lake. "I am not ruling it out, but we have to see how he comes back after this race. He ran awesome. If he had not had the one hole, I think he would have been the winner." Sprint third **Crafty C. T.** (Crafty Prospector) could also make the journey to the Big Apple. "This was going to be his final start of the year, but like I've said, he's at his peak right now and he'll be pretty hickory," said trainer Howard Zucker. "And we're still looking for his first Grade I win. We're thinking of the Cigar Mile." **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) finished off the board for the first time in a sprint, checking in sixth. "She's fine, but cut up and bruised a little bit, and a little body sore, but she's OK," said trainer John Salzman. "We have the sale to go to and we'll see what happens." The diminutive bay is scheduled to go through the ring next Sunday at Fasig-Tipton. **Touch Tone** (Pick Up the Phone), ninth, could be retired. It was the four-year-old's second start off an 11-month layoff; the first was a third to **Xtra Heat** in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup H.

**RECORD HANDLE AT BREEDERS' CUP**

A new event record was established Saturday as preliminary all-source wagering totaled \$115,523,156, ahead of the mark established in 2000 at Churchill Downs. The Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick 6 had a pool of \$4,646,289. Six winning tickets, all purchased at Catskill OTB in upstate New York, had a payout of \$428,392; the consolation for five correct was \$4,606.20. Total handle for the new Head2Head wager was \$768,894.
