### RECORD HANDLE AT BREEDERS' CUP 19

Total betting on last Saturday's 11-race Breeders' Cup program at Arlington Park was an all-time record of \$116,367,198. The handle easily eclipsed the old mark of \$108,603,040, set in 2000 when the event was held at Churchill Downs, and there is still approximately \$400,000 in wagers yet to be tabulated from several foreign countries. This year's handle showed an 11.7 percent increase from 2001. Total handle on the eight Breeders' Cup races was \$108,885,673. "Our fans responded positively to this year's Breeders' Cup, as evidenced by the resumption of growth in our off-track handle and an 18-percent increase in our television ratings," said Breeders' Cup President and National Thoroughbred Racing Association Vice Chairman D.G. Van Clief, Jr. New York topped the U.S. simulcasting jurisdictions, with \$13,447,398 wagered on the program. France led the overseas outlets with a handle of \$2,574,656, an increase of 18 percent from 2001.

### QUIET RESOLVE RETIRED

**Quiet Resolve** (Affirmed), Canada's Horse of the Year and Champion Turf Horse in 2000 after running second in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, was retired after fracturing his left hind leg Thursday, *The Blood-Horse* reports. The seven-year-old gelding was getting ready for tomorrow's Labeeb S. at Woodbine when he was injured. He was sent to the University of Guelph Equine Hospital for surgery. "He took a funny step after a routine gallop," Hugh Chatman, assistant to trainer Mark Frostad, told *The Blood-Horse*. "The surgery went well." The Sam-Son Farm colorbearer will be retired to his owner's farm. The winner of the GI Atto Mile in 1999, the GII Hong Kong Jockey Club Trophy S. and GII Dixie S. in 2000, the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. in 2001 and the GIII Connaught Cup this season, Quiet Resolve retires with 10 wins, six seconds and four thirds from 31 starts for earnings of \$2,346,768.

### A CHANGE IN CAME HOME'S STUD FEE

The stud fee of **MGISW Came Home** (Gone West--Nice Assay, by Clever Trick), originally announced at \$50,000, has been amended. The three-year-old, who heads to stud at Lane's End in Versailles, Kentucky in 2003, will be \$40,000, live foal.

### "YOURS" TRULY AT THE BIG A

A winner in three of his four previous tries at Aqueduct, **I'm All Yours** (Belong to Me) will try to take his batting average at the Big A to .800 in today's GII Knickerbocker H. The late-running New York-bred has won two of his six starts this season, capturing an open allowance test at Saratoga in July and the Ashley T. Cole H. against fellow state-breds at Belmont Sept. 21. The five-year-old gelding's biggest concern will be the condition of the turf. Last time out, on

a Belmont course labelled soft, he could do no better than seventh in the Oct. 19 Mohawk H. If the Aqueduct lawn does not dry out by this afternoon, the one to beat will be **North East Bound** (D'Accord). The six-year-old gelding showed an affinity for a slow course when second by a head in the GII Appleton H. at Gulfstream Park back in January and cruised to a front-running 4 1/2-length score in the GIII Canadian Turf H. over a "good" turf at Gulfstream in February. He faces a much softer field than in his latest, when he faded to sixth after pressing the pace in the Oct. 6 GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland.

**GRANDERA TO HONG KONG** **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) will ship from Australia to Hong Kong next Monday to begin preparations for the 10-furlong G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 15. An excellent third in the G1 Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Oct. 26, the four-year-old leads stablemate and recently retired Marienbard (Ire) in the 2002 World Series Racing Championship with 32 points. He would win the series even if he sat out Hong Kong's race, which is the final leg. A three-time Group 1 winner in 2002, Grandera was fifth behind Eishin Preston in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 21.

**NTRA GROUP TO REVIEW PARI-MUTUEL**

**INTEGRITY** In the wake of the scandal surrounding the Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six, the National Thoroughbred Racing Association has formed the Wagering Technology Group, which will review computer security and other issues of consumer confidence concerning the integrity of the wagering process. "We will be assembling the best talent inside and outside the industry, all with the purpose of ensuring our fans and customers that the technology in connection with wagering on horse racing is absolutely as reliable and secure as possible," NTRA Commissioner Tim Smith said. "As an industry, we need to stay focused on the priority of keeping faith with the fans, those who support the game through legal wagering. That's the purpose of the Wagering Technology Working Group." Smith added that several individual racetracks were already working internally on security issues, and the New York State Racing and Wagering Board is looking at other multiple-race wagers that may have been hit by illegal means, but Smith said he knew of no other winning bets that had so far been revealed as suspicious. The formation of the task force was clearly an act of damage control in light of a Pick Six scandal, which is likely to erode consumer confidence in the sport. When asked how much damage has already been done, Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief Jr. replied, "I have no idea what the level of concern is among the betting public, but we are treating that issue with the upmost concern." The *New York Times* has identified the ex-Autotote employee who was fired after apparently altering the winning Pick Six tickets after the first four races had been run as 29-year Chris Harn. According to some media reports, Harn was a college classmate at Drexel University of Derrick Davis, the Baltimore resident who purchased the tickets in question.

**A KNIGHT'S TALE** Inaugurated just last year, the Criterium International was the lone Group 1 race for juvenile colts in 2001 that eluded trainer Aidan O'Brien. The Ballydoyle conditioner goes after the second edition of the race with **Chevalier (Ire)** (Danehill) this afternoon at Saint-Cloud. A fast-finishing runner-up on his debut in a Curragh maiden Oct. 5, the Ballydoyle homebred came back six days later to post an impressive six-length maiden win at Gowran Park. But he faces a stiff task in overturning the unbeaten **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}). That colt, a half-brother to Daylami (Ire), debuted with an impressive score at Deauville Aug. 29, then swept aside Mister Charm (Fr) and Graikos (GB) in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp Sept. 22. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre is confident that, like his sire, Dalakhani will stay well and appreciate the expected soft ground. Connections will be hoping that he goes one better than his esteemed sibling, who surrendered his unbeaten record when runner-up over this course in the 1996 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. **Napper Tandy (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), a head behind Chevalier at The Curragh, upheld that form by finishing third in the G3 Killavullan S. Andre Fabre's **Songlark (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) maintained his undefeated record at the expense of **Sylvestre (Fr)** (Anabaa) in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon Oct. 14 and warrants maximum respect. Paul Cole, third in this last year with Guys and Dolls (GB), puts forward a similar type this time in **Governor Brown** (Kingmambo). He may find the conditions unsuitable, however, having shown his best form when winning on a fast surface in the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at Newmarket Oct. 2.

The Godolphin filly will head to the sidelines for a vacation after compiling a record of five wins from her seven starts this year, but will be back for a four-year-old campaign. The runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and winner of the GI Gazelle H. and GI Beldame S. this season, she currently boasts a record of six wins, two seconds and a third with earnings of \$1,331,816.

**Krone Fourth In Return:**

Hall of Fame jockey Julie Krone made a successful, if not winning, return to the saddle yesterday at Santa Anita, guiding TNT Stud's **Justly Royal** (Royal Academy) to a troubled fourth-place finish in the fifth race. "Like the horse, maybe I needed a race today," Krone said in a post-race interview with TVG. "My filly was right there at the eighth pole, but Mike Smith's horse kept coming over on me and crowded her. I wanted to win so bad, but I'll have to take that up tomorrow. It felt great to be back. I definitely have the drive and the ambition." The leading female jockey of all time, Krone is named on four mounts on today's Cal Cup program.

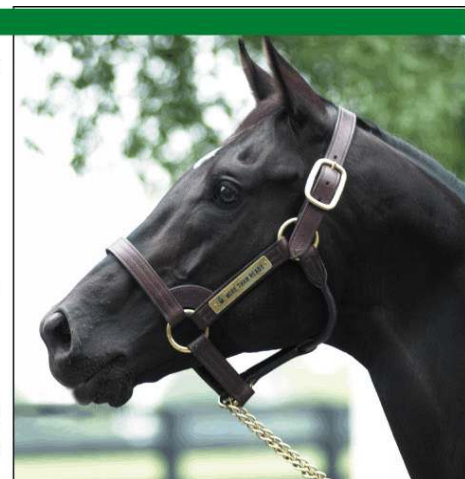

Tom Goff of Blandford Bloodstock made the winning bid with trainer Philip Mitchell the direct underbidder. "He's an athletic good-topped colt from a very decent family and I think he stood out this morning," said Goff, who was acting for an undisclosed domestic client. Officials at Tattersalls were overwhelmed by the results of both the Yearling Sale and the preceding Autumn Horses In Training Sale. "The record-breaking Tattersalls October Yearling Sale two weeks ago introduced a real feeling of optimism throughout the industry and it has very definitely continued this week," Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony said. "The Autumn Yearling Sale has been little short of a revelation with two yearlings eclipsing the previous top price for the sale and sustained international demand from the outset. The diversity of the buyers at the Autumn Horses in Training Sale never ceases to amaze, and we were delighted to see the turnover break 12,000,000 guineas for the first time as well as significant rises in both average and median." Mahony admitted that the unusually large number of high-class withdrawals from the sale remains a concern, but was pleased with the worldwide representation at the sale. "The number of North American buyers, in particular from California, has never been greater and they dominated the top of the market, but equally crucial to the success of the sale was the demand at all levels from the Middle East," Mahony commented. "Three of the top ten lots are heading to the region, and at the middle to lower end of the market we sold a phenomenal 103 horses to Kuwait." (*Final stats, p4*)
