FASIG-TIPTON A TASTY APPETIZER

While the bulk of Kentucky's Fall Mixed sales dates takes place across town at Keeneland beginning tomorrow, Fasig-Tipton warms the plate with a particularly strong renewal of its November Selected Sale at the Newtown Paddocks tonight beginning at 7 p.m. A total of 97 lots has been cataloged for the single-session sale, including mares in foal to such sires as A.P. Indy, leading freshman sire Distorted Humor, Exploit, Grand Slam and Kentucky Derby winners Monarchos and Thunder Gulch. Over half the catalog is devoted to weanlings by stallions such as Deputy Minister, Forestry and Mt. Livermore as well as by young sires such as Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Artax (Marquetry), 1999 Kentucky Derby hero Charismatic (Summer Squall), Elusive Quality (Gone West) and Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat).

The Heat Is On

This year's catalog features a phenomenal collection of horses in and out of training, headlined by hip number 69, the irrepressible **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat). The winner of 24 of her 32 career starts and over \$2.2 million, the four-year-old filly is consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency for an ownership group headed up by trainer John Salzman Jr. A respectable sixth in last weekend's Breeders' Cup Sprint, last

year's champion three-year-old filly is offered as a broodmare/racing prospect. The sale also includes the dispersal of the racing stock of West Coast owner and television producer David Milch. Heading up the seven-lot draft is MGSW **Disturbingthepeace** (Bold Badgett), who won six consecutive races, including a trio of graded stakes, prior to his seventh-place finish in the BC Sprint; **Echo Eddie** (Restless Con), second beaten a head in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen; and **Above Perfection** (In Excess {Ire}), second to Xtra Heat in the 2001 GI Prioress S. at Belmont Park. DALAKHANI REMAINS UNBEATEN

His Highness The Aga Khan's homebred **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) justified odds-on favoritism to retain his unbeaten record when accounting for Irish raider **Chevalier (Ire)** (Danehill) in the second renewal of the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud yesterday. The half-brother to the esteemed Daylami (Ire) had previously confirmed the good impression given on his debut at Deauville Aug. 29 by taking the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp Sept. 22 and offered connections a winter of content with this performance. "This is a serious colt who is rather cold and needs some time to find his best stride and balance in a race," said winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "He is definitely a staying type and next year we will bring him back in the Derby trials rather than the Guineas trials." A stalking third as Chevalier set even fractions, Dalakhani went up to challenge the front-runner at the quarter-pole and outbattled his game rival to the wire.

Helenus continued his meteoric rise from maiden to spring carnival star in just four weeks and revealed himself to have a remarkably similar finishing flair to his Arc-winning sire Helissio in the process, flattening low to the ground and snaking his neck forward to snatch the Victoria Derby by a narrow margin. Sent out the favorite, Helenus settled near the rear of the 11-horse field while Hydrometer took up the lead until Davidoff (Pentire {GB}) challenged in the straight. Helenus had already launched himself rounding the home corner and came down the outside to capture the race in a photo-finish over a game Hydrometer. "He got to the front and he waited," said jockey Steven King. "He was going to win by three or four lengths, but he got there and got a bit lost. He's going to be a superhorse."

Lonhro, sixth in the Cox Plate last Saturday after missing the start, reclaimed some of his luster collecting a third Group 1 win here, but trainer John Hawkes could not pretend the victory made up for his tattered Cox Plate ambitions. Hawkes went away from Moonee Valley last week saying "I just train them" and later said the colt had been leaning against the barrier when the field jumped for the Cox Plate. "You can't give them a start like that and win the Cox Plate," he said. Hawkes was relieved Lonhro had won this time, fearing his heartbreaking effort in the Cox Plate may have dented the horse's confidence, but labeled the win 'a consolation.' He added, "It was a great win, but these are not the elite horses." Lonhro had to work hard to overcome Royal Code by a neck after moving from his spot in sixth position to charge forward at the 400 meters. He goes to the paddock with A\$2,238,450 and 13 wins from 19 starts, with Hawkes predicting better things to come for the horse who won't actually turn four until December 10. Melbourne Cup hopeful Distinctly Secret rounded off a perfect preparation for his main assignment finishing a half-length away in third.

Canadian invader Added Edge has been invincible at Woodbine, rolling through daylight victories in a maiden test Aug. 8, the Silver Deputy S. Sept. 1 and the Swynford S. Sept. 22. Shipping away from his home base and trying a mile for the first time, the chestnut was sent off the second choice. He raced with the leaders from the outset, drove to the front in the stretch and drew clear. "He's a nice horse," winning jockey Patrick Husbands said. "From Day 1, he has been very professional and has done everything right. He a classy little horse. I think he's got a good future." The colt's immediate future includes a vacation. "He's going to the farm in Ocala and he'll spend 30 days there before going to Gulfstream," trainer Mark Casse said. "We'll try to get him ready for the Kentucky Derby, I hope." Boston Bull, the 4-5 favorite off his win in the Oct. 13 GIII Cowdin S., set the pace and faded late to be third. "Watching the races the last couple of days, speed really hasn't done any good and that was our biggest concern coming in," said his trainer, Todd Pletcher. "I thought he ran a credible race." The runner-up may go next in the GII Remsen S. Nov. 30.

Kimberlite Pipe picked a good time to register his first victory in over a year. An allowance winner over the Woodbine main track last Oct. 20, the bay had not finished better than fourth in any of his five starts this season, filling that spot most recently in the Sept. 29 Chief Bearhart S. after setting the early pace going 10 furlongs. Cutting back to a more suitable distance for this effort, the 1999 GII Louisiana Derby victor was conceded the early advantage here and set easy fractions of :23 4/5 and :47 1/5. A two-length leader turning for home, the six-year-old dug in gamely and withstood a late bid from Aslaaf for the win. Winning jockey Chris Emigh felt good from the break. "I broke well and got going early, but I had expected others with me," he commented. "If another horse was going to fire for the lead, I had planned on dropping back, but when nobody came with me, I just kept going." Damien Oliver will partner Media Puzzle wearing jodhpurs emblazoned with his brother Jason's initials and another Cup win for Oliver, grief-stricken after Jason Oliver died on Tuesday as a result of injuries sustained in a fall, would be dedicated to his brother. **Beekeeper (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), Pugin and **Hatha Anna (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) are out to go one better than Central Park and Give the Slip, second in recent years. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor believes Beekeeper may have an edge over his stablemates following his eye-catching Caulfield Cup effort for sixth. "He gives me a good feeling. He will stay and he has the class to be among the best horses," bin Suroor asserted. "He settles well, he is tough. I like this horse a lot."

TRACK ORGANIZATIONS TO IMPROVE TOTE SECURITY In light of the ongoing scandal involving the Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six, three of the country's leading horseracing organizations, Magna Entertainment Corporation, Churchill Downs Incorporated and the New York Racing Association have announced that effective immediately, new measures are being undertaken to improve security at on-site totalisator facilities. MEC, CDI and NYRA are working with the country's three major tote system providers--Autotote Corp., United Tote Co., and AmTote International to (a) ensure that internal controls, including personnel, protections and access to logs, are being maintained; (b) ensure the physical security of all on-site tote facilities and; (c) perform background checks on all on-site tote and racetrack employees with access to tote facilities. Executives from all three organizations have announced their full support for the NTRA Wagering Technology Working Group, which will work with the tote system providers to review the current computerized wagering systems and make recommendations on ways to improve the existing security measures.

PRETTY WILD SCRATCHED FROM NASHUA Einar Paul Robsham's **Pretty Wild** (Wild Again) was declared from yesterday's GIII Nashua S. due to a bone chip in his right knee which will require surgery. "He had a little filling in his knee yesterday and X-rays showed a piece that broke off," trainer Stan Hough commented. "He worked four days ago and came back fine. It seems like something that's been in there and finally broke off." A maiden winner in six starts, the son of GI Alabama S. winner Pretty Discreet was runner-up in both the GI Hopeful S. and GI Futurity, but was most recently fourth in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 5. Following the surgery, Pretty Wild is expected to be out of action for 90 days.

CORRECTION: In last Wednesday's *TDN*, Alan Porter indicated that Indian Ridge (Ire), sire of Breeders' Cup Mile winner Domedriver (Ire), was transferred to the Irish National Stud following Ridgewood Pearl's Breeders' Cup victory in 1995. In fact, the sire was moved to the stud in August 1993, the first year he had runners.

CARSON HOLLOW GETS A BREAK Carson Hollow (Carson City), last in the Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 26, has been sent to owner Frank Stronach's Adena Springs Farm near Lexington for some rest and relaxation. "She came out of the race with a bad lung infection and she bled some," trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. explained. "She might have picked something up on the way out there." The winner of the GI Prioress S. earlier this summer, the sophomore filly is expected to rejoin her trainer's string at Palm Meadows in Florida in about 30 days.
