HARMONIOUS TIDINGS FROM KEENELAND

Glen Sikura searched land and sea and came up with a pair of classy mares with Canadian ties at yesterday's fourth session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Consigned by Anderson Farms, agent for Sam-Son Farm, Water Music brought Thursday's top bid when Sikura, who operates Hill n' Dale Farm in Canada, gave \$420,000 for the daughter of Danzig out of the Seattle Slew mare Classic Slew. According to Sikura, "She was the one in the catalog that I wanted more than any other. I wanted to get as close in to that family as I can and that was the best available." The four-year-old's second dam, 1985 Canadian Broodmare of the Year No Class, has produced numerous champions, including Sky Classic, Regal Classic and Classy 'n Smart, also the dam of Canadian Horse of the Year and blue hen mare Dance Smartly. "There are so many wonderful fillies in the family," added Sikura. "There were a couple of things that might have put some people off of her--the late cover date [June 12] and the fact that she wasn't a stakes horse. But that didn't matter to me." Sikura, whose brother John pilots Hill n' Dale in Kentucky, also bought hip 1167, Terra Nova, for \$245,000 from the Anderson Farms consignment. Leading the babies was hip 1071, a bay colt out of the Copelan mare Profit System by the five-year-old stallion High Yield, whose first foals are weanlings of 2002. The Apr. 1st foal was consigned by Lakland LLC and Gerry Dilger signed the ticket on behalf of Belvedere Inv. Keeneland kicks off today's fifth session at 10:00 a.m.

ENGLAND'S LEGEND RETIRES

England's Legend (Fr) (Lure--Mystery Tune {Ire}, by Commanche Run {GB}), winner of the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington last year, has been retired from racing and will be bred to Kingmambo in 2003. "She's sound, but we didn't think she trained as well as she could have," trainer Christophe Clement told the *Daily Racing Form*. The five-year-old, who amassed \$948,136 through three seasons, won six of 13 starts, including the July 27 GIII Modesty H. and last year's GII New York H. Sixth in her most recent start in the GI Flower Bowl at Belmont Sept. 28, the French-bred appeared on course for the GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Dec. 1 before her retirement was announced.

BC PICK SIX CIRCLE WIDENS

The investigation into a suspicious Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six wager has widened to include a third former member of the Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity at Drexel University and other possible rigged wagers, reports the *New York Times*. Attributing their story to a state investigator and racing officials, the *Times* reported that suspicious bets were made on an Oct. 3 Pick Four wager at Balmoral Park and the Oct. 5 Pick Six at Belmont. It is believed that the same individuals who may have conspired to alter a Breeders' Cup Pick Six ticket, may have made the Balmoral and Belmont bets as a dry run prior to the championship. The BC Pick Six bet was placed by Derrick Davis, who was a TKE fraternity member along with Chris Harn, a one-time Autotote employee who was fired by the company for his alleged involvement in the Pick Six scandal. The name of a third fraternity member, Glen Da Silva, has now surfaced. Da Silva allegedly placed the suspicious wagers on the Balmoral and Belmont races. The bets were similar in nature to the Breeders' Cup Pick Six bet in that they singled horses in the first legs and used the entire field in the last two legs of the wager. Da Silva held eight of the 70 winning tickets on the Belmont Pick Six, which paid \$13,070. All the wagers in question were placed with Catskill OTB.

Forbush Hits A Home Run...

While yesterday's session failed to produce the big numbers of the first two days of the sale, or even Wednesday's third session, there was still plenty of money to be made. Just ask Forbush Farm, which consigned a pair of horses yesterday, including hip number 1052, a weanling colt by Meadowlake, which sold yesterday for a modest \$95,000. But that's only part of the story. Richard Forbush, owner of the farm, purchased the colt's dam at the 2000 Fasig-Tipton December Mixed Sale for just \$7,000 carrying a foal by Binalong. "I have no idea why she brought such a low number," said Richard Lueck, who is the co-breeder of the in partnership with Richard Forbush. "She was a mare with nice size and substance, which is exactly what we look for." The seven-year-old mare was booked back to Meadowlake, making the resulting foal a very close relative to Bonita Meadow (Meadowlake), winner of 14 of her 23 career starts, including five stakes, with earnings in excess of \$335,000. "He was always a very nice colt and we thought he would do well," Lueck added. "Anytime you see the same nick on the page that has worked, that's always a plus." The mare was bred back to Honor Grades shortly before his death earlier this year.

Silic Off To Flying Start at Sales...

Breeders' Cup Mile winner Silic (Fr) (Sillery), who stands for a fee of \$3,500 at Pope McLean's Crestwood Farm, got off to a flying start as a sire when his very first weanling to go through a sales ring brought nearly 15 times his stud fee yesterday afternoon at Keeneland. Hip 1134, a bay colt from the family of G1 Cigar Mile hero El Corredor, was consigned by Crestwood and was purchased by J. Terrence Lanni for \$45,000. "He was a very nice individual," said Pope McLean Jr. about Silic's sole Keeneland offering. "This is the only one by Silic that we consigned, but we like the other Silics that we have and breeders seem to like them as well. We are pleased that [Silic] was so well represented." McLean also explained the reason for the withdrawal of Xtra Heat's full brother from Tuesday's session. "He's a May foal and a little on the small side," McLean explained. "We just decided to give him a little more time. We'll try to bring him back here next September. If he sells the way we think he will, then great, and if not, then we'll race him."

The bay is a half brother to *Timely Action* (Gilded Time), a two-time winner who has never finished out of the top three in seven career starts in California for *Richard Mandella*. He was purchased by *Canadian Club Partners*. *Donato Lanni* of *Hill 'n' Dale Farm*, who signed the ticket for the partnership, said, "He looks very racy and athletic with natural muscle tone. He's a nice colt, very mature. We paid a little more than we wanted to, but when they're that nice you have to be willing to stretch a little. We don't know if we'll sell him back. We'll put him into our program and see how he develops." *Langara*, carrying this foal, was purchased for \$82,000 at this sale a year ago. The mare is a half sister to *She's Tops*, the dam of *Dixie Union*.

Salty Perfume, Hip 1096 (m, 7, *Salt Lake--Pretty Is, by Doonsbury*)

The seven-year-old mare, who was the second highest price of the fourth session, won the *GII Adirondack* and placed in the *GII Astarita S.* as a juvenile. She is a half sister to German two-year-old champion *Green Perfume*, who placed in a pair of *British Group 1* events. According to *Denali Stud's Craig Bendoroff*, who consigned the bay mare, "She is just a beautiful mare. She had a lot of ability and is just gorgeous. The physical is a big part of her appeal. She looked like the kind of mare who could have a big-time horse."

SHIBBOLETH SUCCUMBS TO LAMINITIS
 International winner **Shibboleth** (*Danzig--Razyana, by His Majesty*) recently died in England after contracting laminitis. The five-year-old, who was slated to stand his initial breeding season at *Banstead Manor Stud* near *Newmarket*, is a full brother to top sire *Danehill* and to *Grade II* winner *Eagle Eyed*, who currently stands in *Turkey*. "We have lost a very kind and brave horse who we envisioned having a great future at stud," *Banstead Manor General Manager Philp Mitchell* told the *Racing Post*. "His death is a huge blow and everyone is very saddened." Last year, *Shibboleth* won the *G3 Criterion S.* at *Newmarket* and managed to carry that form state-side when he landed this term's *GIII Jaipur H.* *May 27*.

Bulla Borghese, an unlucky fourth in the G2 Wakeful S. Nov. 2, made her fifth start of the season here as she settled in fourth just off the fence as Wakeful winner Hierogram (Aus) set a solid tempo early. At the 1200-meters pole, the A\$45,000 Magic Millions yearling faced a stiff challenge from race favorite Macedon Lady (Aus) (Filante {NZ}), but took command with 200 meters to run and held on to win by a half length from the fast-finishing Lashed, with Antique a further three quarters of a length away third. "We brought a fresh horse on the scene, and she has pulled it out today," said trainer Ron Quinton. "I thought Lashed was going to get there for a couple of strides, but [jockey] Chris Munce is a great distance rider, he gets them to stay, and she had a perfect run." Munce said he was surprised when Hierogram led, but the tactic worked in his favor providing a genuine pace. "I had a lovely run," Munce commented. "She hit the line better than anything else in the race the other day [the Wakeful], so we were very confident today. I thought she could win. They might have got to her, but I don't think they would have gotten past her."

With the same ease that she won her earlier contests, Miss Terrible bagged her seventh Group 1 race in a row, becoming the first thoroughbred to do so in Argentina. Her detractors wondered if she would last her initial attempt at 2000 meters, but she quickly dispelled all such doubts. She took the lead right from the start, as usual, and refused to be headed as she went on to score comfortably. The only mar on the classy sophomores resume was a 1/2-length defeat, second time out, behind Beau Fete (Arg) in the G1 Gran Premio Santurino J. Unze Mar. 3. Her next start will probably be the G1 Copa de Plata next month, where she will have face older mares in this same track and distance.
