IT'S DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN...IN FRANCE.....

In a thrilling finale to the European juvenile Group 1 program, **Alberto Giacometti (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) got the better of **Summerland (Ire)** (Danahill) to provide trainer Aidan O'Brien with back-to-back renewals of the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. Like last year's conqueror Balingarry (Ire), Alberto Giacometti arrived here off a recent maiden score and ground out the victory to suggest he can be a major player in next year's top middle-distance contests. He had previously shown impressive speed to beat stable companion Mingun and 22 other rivals by a neck over seven furlongs at The Curragh Oct. 31. Held up in last place by Michael Kinane in the early stages as Nelson Creek (Ire) (Briar Creek) cut out the running, he made his move wide in the straight and joined the battle with Summerland in the final furlong. Edging ahead in the closing stages, he battled gamely when that rival rallied to prevail. "It was a big step up for my colt, and asking him to go into a Group 1 on his next start from a maiden was a tall order," Kinane explained. "They had gone a nice pace, and he quickened really well to get there and showed just a little bit of inexperience in the last furlong. He's a colt with a bit of potential and pace, and it was a good performance." Kinane sees a bright future for the winner. "I rate him quite highly--he's a horse that can travel nicely and can quicken. He can only improve, and I think you will see him as a Classic contender next year." **Graikos (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), sent off the favourite, disappointed by not picking up when asked for his effort in the straight and was eased. JOI'S FLAME LIGHTS UP AT KEENELAND

Sold as just the seventh horse through the ring yesterday, **Joi's Flame** (Strawberry Road {Aus}--Joi'ski Too, by Bold Bidder) was hammered down for a final bid of \$200,000 to top yesterday's sixth session of the Keeneland November Sale in Lexington. Consigned to the sale by Henry D. White, agent for the complete dispersal for Disler Farm, the six-year-old sold in foal to first-year weanling sire Behrens, who stood his first year at stud in 2001 at Darby Dan Farm for \$20,000. ....AND ACROSS THE POND IN NEW YORK

The margin of victory was a bit smaller, but the name was the same as **Babae (Chi)** (Barkerville) successfully defended her title in the GIII Athenia H. at Aqueduct. A 2 1/2-length winner a year ago, the bay defeated **Tates Creek** in the GIII Just A Game Breeders' Cup at Belmont June 8 before falling a length short of that rival when fourth in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga July 27 two starts later, but was coming into this off a convincing win in the GIII Violet H. at the Meadowlands Sept. 28. Settled in second within easy striking distance early on, Babae assumed command at will approaching the stretch and held on late for the win. The winner, who was withdrawn from the Keeneland sale earlier this week, could make her next start in the GIII My Charmer H. at Calder Dec. 7.

Churchill Downs Distaff cont.

Softly capped a four-race winning streak with a victory vs. optional claiming foes over this track in May. She made her stakes debut in her next start, running fifth in the July 6 Iowa Distaff at Prairie Meadows, then improved to be third in the Aug. 10 GIII Gardenia H. at Ellis Park. A distant fourth behind Trip (Lord At War {Arg}) in the Sept. 14 GIII Turfway Park Breeders' Cup H., the dark bay had rebounded with a win in the Oct. 14 Sweetest Chant S. at Arlington Park, but was let go at long odds with a return to graded company. Biding her time at the back of the pack through rapid early fractions, the James Tafel homebred was tucked between horses on the far turn. She was caught in traffic until the eighth pole, but found running room in the final furlong and closed well to catch Bare Necessities at the wire. On the board in all seven previous starts this season, Parose captured the Izvestia S. over this track July 20, then took a two-month break. The veteran returned to be second behind Dream Launcher in the Oct. 5 GIII Durham Cup H. and found himself playing the role of favorite when that rival was scratched from this event. The chestnut gelding had one horse beat after a quarter and two horses behind him after a half, then swept past the rest of his rivals and held off Attest in the final drive. "He was on the bridle with me the whole way and he dug in gamely," winning jockey Todd Kabel said. "I was a little concerned when I saw [Attest] get through on the rail at the last minute, but he hung on and fought back. He ran a great race." Added trainer Alex McPherson, "Parose always shows up and runs his best race. All in all it was a tremendous performance by both the horse and the rider. The brilliant filly **Fine Motion**, a leading candidate for champion three-year-old filly honors, is looking for her sixth straight victory. She is coming off an impressive victory in the G1 Shuka Sho in October. "She has a very big stride and has powerful speed, so I am looking forward to watching her run on Sunday," said assistant trainer Sasada. **Diamond Biko** won the G3 Nakayama Himba S. in March, but was winless for seven months before taking the G3 Fuchu Himba S. in October. "She is in great condition right now and very relaxed," commented assistant trainer Matsuda. "This is her first race over 2200 meters, but she won the 2000-meter Rose S. last year and she has improved a lot mentally, so I don't think the distance will be a problem." Japanese Oaks winner **Smile Tomorrow** has not started in six months. "She was supposed to come back in the Rose S., however the weather was too bad in the summer," explained trainer Kazuhiro Seishi. "So, she came back to my barn in late August. I skipped the Shuka Sho because she was not ready, so we've had plenty of time to get ready for this race. I think she has improved a lot mentally and it was good for her to have a vacation. It will be a hard race with the older horses and the very powerful filly **Fine Motion**, but she is the Oaks winner and they'll have to beat her."

SEEKING THE GOLD SEASONS TOP STALLION ACCESS SALE

Two 2003 "No Guarantee" seasons to supersire **Seeking the Gold** (Mr. Prospector) topped the Stallion Access November Sale of Selected Seasons and Shares, held Friday night at Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. The first season brought \$195,000 and the second sold for \$192,000. A season to **Kingmambo** (Mr. Prospector) sold for \$185,000, as did the first nomination to **Danzig** (Northern Dancer). The second Danzig season attracted a final bid of \$145,000. A total of 37 "No Guarantee" nominations sold for an aggregate of \$1,271,200 and an average of \$34,357. There were six stallion shares sold for a gross of \$45,100 and an average of \$7,517; the shares were topped by one in **Rubiano** (Fappiano), which brought \$21,000.

CHURCHILL TO CLOSE POOLS EARLY

Responding to wagering security concerns in the wake of the investigation of the Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six, Churchill Downs Inc. announced Friday that, effective Wednesday, Nov. 13, all mutuel pools accepting wagers on CDI racing will close at zero minutes to post--approximately one minute before the horses are loaded into the starting gate. Also beginning Nov. 13, Churchill will only do business with account wagering services that make recordings of bets placed using the key pad of a touch-tone telephone, a measure mandated by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association Friday. The NTRA has given account wagering services until Nov. 29 to comply with this demand. Churchill also will implement the NTRA's directive that makes any winning simulcast wager involving multiple races subject to review and, if suspicious, further investigation.

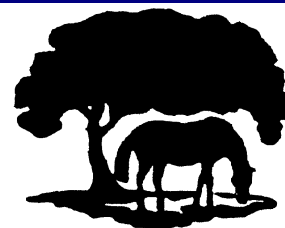
