WALK ON GOLD TOPS KEENELAND SUNDAY

Walk on Gold (Seeking the Gold) attracted a final bid of \$290,000 to top yesterday's seventh session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. In foal to freshman sire Joyeux Danseur, the three-year-old filly was consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent, and John J Greely, IV made the session-topping final bid. Walk on Gold, who raced only once, is a half sister to multiple Grade I winner Marquetry (Conquistador Cielo) and a full sister to French group winner Spain Lane. The broodmare prospect **Ever Hopeful** (With Approval) was the second-highest priced lot of the session at \$260,000. Consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent, the three-year-old was purchased by Brookdale Farm. Ever Hopeful's dam Private Colors (Private Account) is a full sister to Personal Ensign and Personal Flag. Two youngsters shared the top weanling price of \$90,000. Hip 2135, a son of freshman sire Distorted Humor out of It's Personal (Personal Flag), was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency and was purchased for \$90,000 by Bloodstock Services. Bloodstock Services also paid \$90,000 for hip 2201, a daughter of Forest Wildcat--Our Seattle Star (Seattle Song). The bay filly was consigned by Fred Seitz/Brookdale Farm, as agent for Montesacro Farm.

Life is good for José de Camargo.

The affable Brazilian has had an outstanding year at the races as the part owner of Farda Amiga, winner of the GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Alabama S. prior to her runner-up finish to Azeri in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. Despite the lack of a stakes victory against older females this season, de Camargo thinks his filly is worthy of an Eclipse Award as champion three-year-old filly.

"That would be great, wouldn't it," de Camargo said Thursday from Keeneland, where he was attending the November Sale. "I think she has a chance. We won the Oaks and the Alabama and those are two pretty important races. You won four Grade I's and she may be overlooked, but I like our chances."

But he has goals loftier than that. De Camargo, who purchases horses under the banner of Santa Escolástica, was very active during the first week of the November Sales, acquiring five horses (two weanlings and three broodmares) for gross receipts of \$260,000. The most expensive of those purchases was hip 1067, the eight-year-old mare Prime Affair (Deputy Minister), who he bought for \$110,000. There is a method to the madness.

"We are trying to buy nice broodmares that will produce future generations of horses in South America," de Camargo explains. "We want to try to increase the South American genetic pool."

"We were lucky to be able to buy a few horses [earlier in the week]. The market was strong and the prices were high. It got a little more favorable as the week went on. Our goal is to buy weanlings and mares to export to South America."

De Camargo has also been instrumental in bringing Northern Hemisphere stallions to service South American mares. He pioneered the age of shuttling stallions to South American with the leasing of the Mr. Prospector stallion Fast Gold in 1991. Currently in the southern hemisphere are the Storm Cat sire Bernstein, Walmac International's Romanov and Jade Hunter, the last of whom is leased by de Camargo's Haras La Providencia, for which he purchases horses at the sales.

De Camargo established that farm in 1988. He is particularly excited about the coming year.

"We brought Salt Lake to South America a few years ago from Walmac and his first crop races this year," de Camargo explains. "We think he is a tremendous young sire and are very excited to see his horses race."

De Camargo, who has also raced Bangles and Beads S. winner Posadas, GSW Pavilion (Brz) and Fly Borboleta, indicated that the star of his stable could make one more start as a three-year-old.

"For Farda Amiga, we are considering running in the [GI] Matriarch [nine furlongs, turf, Dec. 1] or we could wait for the La Cañada series at Santa Anita," he said.

So when you see the guy with the bushy black mustache celebrating his next victory, give him a pat on the back. He deserves it.

GARLAND OF ROSES NEXT FOR XTRA HEAT

Champion **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat), coming off a sixth-place effort in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, could make her first start for new owners ClassicStar in the Dec. 14 Garland of Roses H. at Aqueduct, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The four-year-old filly failed to sell with a final bid of \$1.7 million at last week's Fasig-Tipton November Mixed Sale, but was sold privately the next day for \$1.5 million. "I think it's a wonderful thing because they are going to treat her right and they seem like good people," the filly's trainer and former co-owner John Salzman, Sr., told *Thoroughbred Times*. "They bought her as a broodmare prospect, so any races she wins will just be added pleasure to them. They told me that the first bad step she takes to let them know and she'll go right into breeding." Xtra Heat's tentative goal is the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad al Sheba, a race in which she ran third last year.

VICTORY RIDE RETIRED **Victory Ride** (Seeking the Gold--Young Flyer, by Flying Paster) has been retired from racing after a third-place finish in Saturday's GII Churchill Downs Distaff. The four-year-old filly defeated champion Xtra Heat to take the GI Test S. last year at Saratoga. Her career was interrupted by a condylar fracture to her right front cannon bone, but Victory Ride returned to win the Madison S. at Keeneland and the Omnibus S. at Monmouth Park and was third in the GII Shuvee H. "She came out of the race super," Jack Bohannon, assistant to trainer Rusty Arnold, said of the filly's third-place effort Saturday. "It was a good run. I think she just probably lost a step after that surgery [to repair her cannon bone fracture]. "She ran hard. We're disappointed a bit, but we are really blessed that we were around a filly like her." Bohannon added, "She was very nice and we thought she was one of the better fillies in the country before she was hurt. To get the opportunity to train a horse like that and be around good horses like that is just a pleasure. You hate to see it end, but you've got to do what's best." On the board in all but one of her nine starts, Victory Ride retires with five victories and earnings of \$380,391.

The runner-up behind Escania in the G1 Tanteo de Potrancas, she easily turned the tables on that rival here, with 1000 Guineas second La Tour just missing the place this time.

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

November 10, 1984...The inaugural **Breeders' Cup Championship** was held at Hollywood Park, with Wild Again taking the first Classic in a wild finish which saw Gate Dancer disqualified from second and placed third. Favored Slew o'Gold was moved up to second.

November 11, 1978...At age four, Triple Crown winner **Seattle Slew** won his last race, the Stuyvesant H. at Aqueduct Racetrack, by 3 1/4 lengths.

November 12, 1904...New Zealand...Four-year-old **Machine Gun** carried 159 pounds, believed to be the highest impost in a winning effort on the flat, to victory at Riccarton in New Zealand. Time for the five-furlong race was :58 flat.

November 15, 1990...**Alydar**, runner-up to Affirmed in all three 1978 Triple Crown races, died at Calumet Farm in Kentucky.

Beautiful America, a winner of three of four starts, won by 2 1/2 lengths in the seven-furlong Joe A. Gimma S. against New York bred Sept. 29 before eking out a narrow half-length victory last time in the state-bred Maid O' the Mist S. over a mile at Belmont Oct. 19. Quick off the mark this time, the dark bay held a modest advantage through four furlongs, increased her lead to 5 1/2 lengths at the top of the stretch and maintained her dominance late to score by daylight. "Good horses can win at any distance, especially when they have more quality than the rest of the field," said trainer Mike Hernandez. "I think she can go any distance. We have to discuss whether to stop or keep going for the year. We might go to Houston [Great Challenge Juvenile Fillies Dec. 17]."

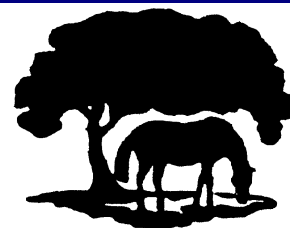

FALLON TO STAY CLOSER TO HOME Kieren

Fallon has pledged to spend more time riding in Britain next season in his bid to defend the championship title he secured for the fifth time at Doncaster Saturday. Despite high-profile international successes on **Elusive City (USA)** (Elusive Quality {USA}) in the G1 Prix Morny and **Hold That Tiger (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) in the G1 Grand Criterium this term, Fallon sees his primary duty as riding more domestic winners next year. "I am going to concentrate a lot more next year and not ride abroad as often," Fallon, who is quoted as the 4-6 favourite by Paddy Power to retain the title in 2003, told *PA Sport*. "I will be trying to get 200 winners again as I used to do in previous years, so we will see, but for now it is good to be champion again." Fallon ended the 2002 campaign with 144 winners, 18 clear of Richard Hughes. Paul Hanagan was crowned champion apprentice Saturday with 81 winners.

KINANE IS KING Michael Kinane clinched his 12th Irish jockeys' championship with a treble yesterday at Leopardstown. Level with Johnny Murtagh at the beginning of the eight-race card, he seized the early initiative by taking the opening Bracken EBF Maiden on the Aidan O'Brien-trained **Salt Lake City (USA)** (Danzig {USA}), who scored a comfortable success as the 4-6 favourite. After he had steered the late-closer **Bermaho (Ire)** (Desert Story {Ire}) to success for Ger Lyons 30 minutes later in the Blackthorn EBF Premier Nursery, the outcome was regarded as academic by bookmakers Paddy Power, who quoted Kinane at odds of 1-100, with Murtagh on 25-1. Kinane settled the debate in the sixth race, taking the Listed Eyrefield S. on the impressive winner **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). "Myself and Johnny have had a fantastic tussle and it's nice to do it in style," Kinane said. "I had a strong book of rides today and I have an outstanding job. If I stay injury-free there should be more to come." Reflecting on a memorable year, Kinane singled out the achievements of record-setting miler **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}). While the jockey came in for criticism for his ride in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, he said, "He was outstanding and a pleasure to be associated with," adding, "luck didn't go our way in America." Champion apprentice Tadhg O'Shea sealed a memorable year by partnering **Golden Cross (Ire)** (Goldmark {USA}) to success in the final race, the Ravens Rock H.

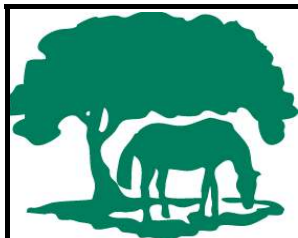
