**ROCK OF GIBRALTAR RETIRED**

**Rock of Gibraltar** (Danehill--Offshore Boom {Ire}, by Be My Guest), who won a record-setting seven consecutive Group 1 races, has been retired from racing and will stand the 2003 season alongside his sire Danehill at Coolmore's Irish base in Co. Tipperary. The three-year-old bettered the win streak of Mill Reef with a string of victories that started with last year's G1 Grand Criterium and included winner's circle stops in the G1 Dewhurst S., G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas, G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, G1 St James's Palace S., G1 Sussex S. and G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. In the final start of his career, the colt was a valiant runner-up after a troubled trip in the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile. Rock of Gibraltar, trained by Aidan O'Brien, raced in the colors of Sir Alex Ferguson and Susan Magnier. He retires with 10 wins in 13 starts and earnings of \$1,884,167. In a statement, Ferguson said, "As a relative newcomer into ownership, I cannot adequately express the pleasure I have derived from the association with such a great horse. Whilst I will be saddened not to see Rock of Gibraltar in action on the racecourse, I look forward to the future with keen anticipation and I have every confidence that he will transmit his amazing talent and courage to his offspring." No stud fee has been announced.

**LA FILLE QUI DANSE**

Lightly raced **Dance Dress** (Nureyev) maintained her perfect provincial record at Toulouse with an authoritative display for a first group race win at rewarding odds in Monday's G3 Prix Fille de L'Air. Unraced as a juvenile, she made a successful racecourse debut in a seven-furlong conditions event at Longchamp May 2 before finishing sixth in the G2 Prix Sandringham at Chantilly one month later. The filly collected her first stakes win in the Listed Prix Madame Jean Couturie at Vichy July 23 and returned to group company for her only other starts, a fifth-place effort in the G3 Prix Minerve at Deauville Aug. 23 and an eighth-place finish in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp Oct. 6. This time, the eventual winner settled in second early as Whim (Fr) (Poliglote {GB}) made the running, but challenged for the lead at the top of the stretch. Jockey Christophe Soumillon sent his mount to the front approaching the final furlong and Dance Dress ran on well late repel the bid of Almond Mousse. "I had a perfect trip behind the leader," said Soumillon. "I took off quickly because she is a filly who likes to dominate and she stayed on really well to the line." "It's déjà vu all over again" read *TDN's* headline after the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud--and you can say that again. When Alberto Giacometti edged past Summerland in the last strides of this mile-and-a-quarter stamina test, he provided his sire Sadler's Wells with no less than his 14th Group 1 victory of the year, and his sixth in the space of 56 days.

To increase this feeling of having seen it all before, Alberto Giacometti's win in one of France's Group 1 juvenile events followed those of Refuse To Bend in the National S., one of two Group 1 races open to juvenile colts in Ireland, and of Brian Boru in the Racing Post Trophy, one of Britain's three Group 1 two-year-old races for colts.

The déjà vu effect was made all the stronger by the fact that Alberto Giacometti is Sadler's Wells' sixth stakes winner this year out of mares by Shirley Heights, winner of the 1978 English and Irish Derbies. Five of the six--Alberto Giacometti, Dance Routine, Moon Queen, Morozov and Starbourne--have scored at Group or Graded level, increasing the champion sire's total of Group winners out of Shirley Heights mares to 10, from a total of 62 foals of racing age (which includes 13 largely unexposed two-year-olds).

### Sire Power...

Altogether 14 of the 62 have become stakes winners and among them are In The Wings (himself sire of a highly impressive total of eight Group winners this year), the Grade I winner Subtle Power and the G3-winning filly Legend Maker. Interestingly, Legend Maker made an impact on another of this year's Group 1 juvenile events, when her second foal, the Danehill colt Chevalier, recently failed by only a neck to land the Criterium International after making much of the running.

Chevalier, like Alberto Giacometti, is trained by Aidan O'Brien, who therefore has two live classic contenders for next year with Sadler's Wells and Shirley Heights in their pedigrees. Of course O'Brien has already reaped rich rewards from the even more successful nick involving Sadler's Wells and mares by Shirley Heights' son Darshaan. O'Brien's three Group 1 winners from this cross include this year's dual Derby winner High Chaparral, who showed tremendous determination in landing the Breeders' Cup Turf; and Quarter Moon, who had the misfortune to finish second in three classics this year. O'Brien also has classic ambitions for Yesterday, a sister to Quarter Moon, who recorded her first stakes win in Sunday's Eyrefield S.

Alberto Giacometti's dam, Sweeten Up, was bred by Cliveden Stud from a family which has served Cliveden very well over the years. As a comparatively small but high quality operation, Cliveden is obliged to cull regularly and four mares were consigned to Tattersalls' December Sales in 1998.

The draft enjoyed some good luck and some bad luck, but things weren't as they seemed at the time. The first Cliveden mare into the ring was Francfurter, carrying a foal by the top German stallion Acatenango. Her owners must have been disappointed when she was led out unsold at only 13,500 guineas, but the situation looks very different now that Francfurter's Acatenango foal, Fraulein, has collected over \$500,000 for her recent win in the E.P. Taylor S.

**TURTLE BOW JOINS DE SEROUX STABLE**

French group winner **Turtle Bow** (Fr) (Turtle Island {Ire}) has been sent to the California barn of trainer Laura de Seroux, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The three-year-old filly, winner of the G2 Prix d'Astarte, finished second behind Kazzia in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont Sept. 28 and was ninth in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. "She's had a hard campaign," de Seroux told the *Form*. "I'll freshen her up." The conditioner of Horse-of-the-Year contender Azeri, will also now train **A Ma Guise** (Silver Hawk). The two-year-old filly began her career in France, where she scored a seven-furlong maiden win in August. She is being pointed for the Nov. 29 Gill Miesque S.

**DUO TOPS DAY EIGHT OF BREEDING STOCK SALE**

**Dynamous**, a bay filly by Dynaformer out of the unraced mare Nateja (Diesis {GB}) tied for top honors at Monday's eighth installment of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. The four-year-old, who was consigned by Mill Ridge Sales, agent, was purchased by Gainesway for \$80,000 as a racing or broodmare prospect. The other leading lady was **Gold Bracelet**, a three-year-old filly by Dixieland Band out of unraced Easy 'n Gold (Slew o' Gold). The chestnut, in foal to Open Forum, was secured by John J. Greely IV from the Lane's End consignment. A pair of weanlings realized the top prices among the babies when hip 2684 and hip 2824 each reeled in a \$60,000 final bid. The former, a chesnut filly by Two Punch out of the unraced Dixieland Band mare Skat Girl, was purchased by New Partners from the Lane's End consignment. Also from Lane's End, hip 2824, a bay filly out of Color of Gold (Seeking the Gold) by champion Pleasant Tap, went to Edward P. Evans with Steve Jackson acting as agent. The April foal hails from the family of Sulemeif, who is the dam of multiple graded-stakes winner Withallprobability and a half sister to Grade I winner One of a Klein. The sale continues today at 10:00 a.m.

**How Sweet it is....**

The twice-raced Sweeten Up, carrying her first foal, followed two lots later and she sold successfully, for 56,000 guineas. Sweeten Up's vendor could have been forgiven had he suffered a sinking feeling on hearing that the mare had been bought by a member of the Magnier family. With the vast Coolmore resources at their disposal, the Magniers are often able to provide their mares with better opportunities than other breeders are able to afford.

For example, Cliveden would have struggled to justify spending 150,000 Irish guineas on a 1999 Sadler's Wells nomination for Sweeten Up, even though she was bred to a similar pattern to Reference Point, the Cliveden-bred winner of the Derby and St Leger in 1987. Whereas Reference Point was by Mill Reef out of a stoutly-bred daughter of Habitat, Sweeten Up was by Mill Reef's son Shirley Heights out of another stoutly-bred daughter of Habitat. The problem was that Sweeten Up's form was a long way below classic standard: she had finished third at Warwick and then second at Lingfield in maiden company at two and hadn't raced subsequently.

Sweeten Up's new owners, on the other hand, were bound to consider her a potential mate for Sadler's Wells, if only because her sire Shirley Heights and broodmare sire Habitat already had impressive records with Sadler's Wells. The classic winners Baratheia, Dance Design and King of Kings all figured among the impressive number of stakes winners that Habitat mares had produced to Sadler's Wells.

Alberto Giacometti can certainly be expected to stay well next year. His second dam, the Group-placed Honeybeta, won three times at up to 1 1/2 miles and his next dam, the champion three-year-old filly Attica Meli, gained the last of her five Group wins in the Doncaster Cup over 2 1/4 miles. Attica Meli also won the G2 Park Hill S. over 1 3/4 miles and so did her half sister Royal Hive, who went on to finish second in the Ascot Gold Cup over 2 1/2 miles.

The colt is Sadler's Wells' third winner of the Criterium de Saint-Cloud, following Poliglote (a successful young stallion) and Ballingarry. This pair, respectively, went on to finish second in the French and Italian Derbies. Can Alberto Giacometti go one better in whichever Derby he is aimed at, or will it be déjà vu all over again?

Capturing his first graded-stakes success, Blue Concorde showed a maturation over his earlier form this season and figures to be a major player in 2003. Last out, the bay was fifth in the G2 Dally Hai Nisai S. in October. Away in good order here after breaking from post one, the colt patiently tracked the leaders from a stalking position, then slipped through on the rail to register a driving victory. "Compared to his last race, his attitude has improved a lot," said winning jockey Shinichiro Akiyama. "He wasn't afraid to go through the narrow opening in the closing stages of this race." Next up for the two-year-old will most likely be the G1 Asahi Hai Futurity S. Dec. 8.

**MC CARTHY TO RETIRE** Jockey Mike McCarthy will retire from riding on Sunday, the final day of the Delaware Park meeting. McCarthy has been the leading jockey at Delaware five times and will likely add his sixth riding title Sunday. The 39-year-old began riding at Belmont Park in 1982 and he was the leading rider at Philadelphia Park in 1994 and 1995. "I am not as excited about [riding] as I used to be," McCarthy admitted. "I know there are a lot of people who would kill to be in my position, but I have lost my desire to do it." The New York native plans to open a public stable in Florida this winter and expects to return to Delaware Park next season as a trainer. "Being a trainer is going to give me the excitement, I think I need to continue in the horse racing business," McCarthy said of his new career. "It is going to give me the excitement to keep going, something new to strive for and hopefully reach some attainable goals. It will be a serious challenge."

**PROUD CITIZEN CONTINUES TO MEND** Proud Citizen (Gone West), winner of the GII Coolmore Lexington S. Apr. 20, appears likely to return to training in two to three months after the remaining two screws were removed from his left cannon bone Friday. Currently at Belmont Park, the D. Wayne Lukas trainee could begin walking the shedrow in about two weeks. "He won't go back to training until the screw holes fill in," Dr. Stephen Selway told the *Daily Racing Form*. Second in the GI Kentucky Derby May 4, the colt was injured while running fifth in the GI Belmont S. June 8.

### HAPPY BIRTHDAY POLYTRACK

In the year since legendary racecaller Sir Peter O'Sullivan opened Lingfield Park's revolutionary Polytrack circuit Nov. 13, the course's profile has been transformed. The reason for the altered attitude to Lingfield Park is simple: at last, trainers had use of an all-weather surface on which horses could run a true race. Jockeys could ride a turf-style race and come from off the pace to win, while the safety element for jockeys and horses was greatly improved. The old issue of exaggerated "kick-back", as on the previous Equitrack surface, became almost non-existent, while the new track rode with bounce and had no "jar". The evident confidence of trainers and jockeys in the surface has directly resulted in a markedly higher standard of racing. The biggest seal of approval came in March when Aidan O'Brien flew over a team of six horses from Ballydoyle to work on the course. They were truly six of the very best: Rock of Gibraltar, Hawk Wing, Sholokhov, Castle Gandolfo, Shoal Creek and the top 2001 juvenile, Johannesburg. Other leading conditioners followed suit, and now the Polytrack is in constant use by trainers preparing their horses at all times of the year. The forthcoming winter season, which again carries the generous support of Littlewoods Bet Direct, began at Wolverhampton yesterday. There are 35 meetings scheduled at Lingfield, 25 at Southwell and 39 at Wolverhampton. The climax is on March 15 at the end of the winter season, when the well-established Littlewoods Bet Direct Winter Derby (£60,000) will share the spotlight with the first running of the Spring Cup, a £75,000 race for three-year-olds over seven furlongs. The winter highlight at Lingfield Park is the Listed Churchill S. Nov. 23. As before, the leading trainers, jockeys and owners will compete for the Littlewoods Bet Direct all-weather Championship. The awards will be presented at a gala dinner in the evening of Winter Derby day at Lingfield Park racecourse.
