THREE ARRESTED IN PICK SIX SCHEME

The three men at the center of an investigation into the Breeders' Cup Pick Six turned themselves into federal authorities yesterday in New York, according to *Associated Press*. The three, Derrick Davis, Glen DaSilva and Chris Harn, were accused of conspiring to violate wire-fraud laws in a complaint filed in White Plains, NY. Davis and Harn did not enter pleas when they appeared before Magistrate Judge Mark Fox yesterday and they were released on \$200,000 personal recognizance. DaSilva's case was put off. According to the complaint, Davis placed wagers on the Pick Six through his New York OTB phone account, while Harn, a senior programmer with Autotote, manipulated the bets after the races had already been run. The complaint alleges that DaSilva was involved in similar schemes in early October. Lawyers for Harn and Davis say their clients maintain their innocence. In a statement in response to the arrests, National Thoroughbred Racing Association Commissioner Tim Smith said, "We commend the authorities on the arrests today in the Pick Six case and support prosecution to the fullest extent under the law. We have said from the beginning, our focus is not only on last month's Breeders' Cup Pick Six but also on protecting the long-term integrity of the entire pari-mutuel system." Smith added, "New security measures being put in place will guard against attempts to abuse the pari-mutuel system. We will do everything necessary to protect the interests of our fans and customers and to earn their confidence."

When fillies start to progress in late summer and fall, they can make great progress in a very short time, and this is what appears to have happened to Softly.

Unraced at two and unplaced in two starts as a three-year-old, Softly won four consecutive races early this year, but in her initial forays into stakes company, she found the waters a little hot. In her first three black-

type outings, Softly's best effort was a third in the GIII Gardenia H. On Oct. 14, however, she garnered her first stakes triumph with a win in the Sweetest Chant S. at Arlington Park. Returning to action nearly four weeks later, Softly captured her first graded victory this weekend, her late charge

carrying her to the wire just in time to take the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. by a neck from Bare Necessities. Softly is a daughter of Binalong, a stallion who began his career at Mill Ridge Farm in Lexington, Kentucky, but who now stands at the Randy Russell Racing Stable in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan. Binalong was one of the best North American-sired sons of Known Fact, an In Reality son who raced with considerable distinction in England, where his victories included the G1 Middle Park S., G1 2000 Guineas (on the disqualification of Nureyev) and G2 Queen Elizabeth II S. Binalong didn't quite attain that standard of performance, but he did win the Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship at four.

DOMEDRIVER TO HONG KONG Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Domedriver (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) is expected to start next in the Dec. 15 G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin. "Domedriver has come back well from his trip to Arlington and he is in fine form at the moment," said trainer Pascal Bary. By the time he goes postward in Hong Kong, the four-year-old will have had two months off since his Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup victory. "He needs time to recover between his races, but the race at Sha Tin will suit him," Bary added. "He has a good turn of foot and the only ground he is unsuited by is very soft ground." In other Hong Kong news, Godolphin's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) arrived in the territory yesterday from Australia. The four-year-old, coming off a third-place effort in the G1 Cox Plate Oct. 26, is expected to start next in the Dec. 15 G1 Hong Kong Cup.

CRYSTAL HOUSE HEADS DAY NINE AT KEENELAND Chilean Horse of the Year **Crystal House (Chi)**, by Golden Voyager out of multiple Chilean champion Christalline (Chi) (Northair), led Tuesday's ninth session at Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. The six-year-old full sister to Crystal Clear, a group winner in Chile, was secured by Santa Escolastica for \$210,000 from Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud. Hip 2934, a dark bay colt by Yankee Victor out of Lahaina (Affirmed) surpassed all other weanling purchases Tuesday with a \$100,000 final bid from Dromoland/Hartwell. The February foal was consigned by Fred Seitz's Brookdale Farm. **Innes**, a four-year-old daughter of A.P. Indy out of Irish champion older mare Kostroma (Ire) (Caerleon), was the second highest broodmare of the day when the hammer fell at \$87,000. Purchased by agent Pope McLean, the filly, who is believed to be in foal to Silic (Fr), was consigned by Calumet Farm. Bidding for today's final session commences at 10:00 a.m.

Binalong also won the Hallandale H. and Olympic H. at five, and he established a track record at Keeneland, scorching through seven furlongs in 1:20.1. Softly is a member of Binalong's third crop, and he is also sire of the graded-stakes winning fillies Binalegend and Binelong Rose from his first crop.

Softly is the first foal of her dam Coragil, a daughter of the Seattle Slew horse Metfield. A solid runner, Coragil won three of 22 starts over three seasons, earning \$120,514 and gaining black type with a third in the Double Delta S. at Arlington Park. Coragil is half sister to the GIII Omaha Gold Cup victor Hold Old Blue (by Seattle Song). She's also half sister to four other stakes winners, including Til Forbid, a Temperence Hill filly who took the GIII Arlington Oaks, and who also placed in the G1 Alabama S., G1 Spinster S., G1 Kentucky Oaks and G1 Ashland S.

White Jasmine, the granddam of Softly, is a minor stakes-placed daughter of Whitesburg. Whitesburg was by juvenile champion Crimson Satan and that fact takes on added significance here as White Jasmine's granddam Sister Satan is a half sister to Crimson Satan. White Jasmine's dam Red Jasmine produced four named foals by Crimson Satan and four by Whitesburg. None of the Crimson Satan matings (which gave Crimson Satan's dam, Papila 2x3) resulted in a stakes winner, but they did yield the unraced Red Jam, subsequently dam of the Grey S. winner Tampa Bay Buck. The Whitesburg matings were more successful, resulting in not only White Jasmine, but also her stakes-winning sister Miss Tarpon Woods. Oddly enough, Sister Satan's only stakes winner, Fancy Crimson, was by Crimson Satan's son, Crimson Falcon, and so had Papila 3x2.

Considering that she was foaled in Argentina during World War II, Papila has had a very significant impact on North American racing. Her son Crimson Satan was voted the best two-year-old of 1961 on some year-end polls and was also a major stakes winner at three and four. An outstanding broodmare sire, he has left an indelible mark on the breed through his daughter, Crimson Saint, the granddam of Storm Cat.

Other well-known descendents of Papila include English champion two-year-old Digression, G1 Swaps S. victor Lively One, the G1 Charles H. Strub S. hero Swing Till Dawn, Horse of the Year Tiznow and his brother Budroyale. Tiznow and Budroyale are particularly interesting in the context of Softly's pedigree, since they are not only descendents of Papila, but are also, like Softly, bred on the very successful In Reality/Seattle Slew cross.

PHARLY DEAD Pharly (Fr) (Lyphard {USA}--Comely {Fr}, by Boran {GB}), one of Europe's oldest active stallions at the age of 28, was euthanized at his Woodland Stud base in Newmarket last Saturday. "We let him out in the morning and found him in some distress soon afterwards," stud groom Pat Cronin explained. "The decision was taken to have him humanely destroyed and he will be sadly missed. He was a wonderful horse to handle, he had a lovely character and was exceptionally fertile." The Classic-placed and multiple G1 winner was responsible for 41 Group/Stakes performers, including G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Nicole Pharly (GB), leading National Hunt sire Phardante (Fr) and five-time G3 Jockey Club Cup winner Further Flight (GB).
