KAZZIA RETIRED

Dual Classic winner **Kazzia (Ger)** (Zinaad {GB}--Khoruna {Ger}, by Lagunas {GB}) has been retired, Godolphin announced yesterday. A perfect two-for-two

as a juvenile, including a win in Milan's G3 Premio Dormello, the three-year-old filly opened her 2002 season with a neck win in the May 5 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket and came back to score a half-length victory over Quarter Moon (Ire) in the June 7 G1 Epsom Oaks. The dark bay surrendered her unbeaten record when

fourth behind Islington (Ire) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 21, then was taken to the States for her final two starts, bouncing back to win the G1 Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Park Sept. 28 before finishing sixth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Arlington Oct. 26. John Ferguson, who represented Godolphin at Wednesday night's Cartier awards, where Kazzia topped the three-year-old filly category, said, "To win the 1000 Guineas and the Oaks was really special and, after a bit of a hiccup in the Yorkshire Oaks, to come back and win the Flower Bowl in America was a great tribute to Saeed bin Suroor and his wonderful team." Kazzia retires with five wins from her seven career starts for earnings of \$1,090,330.

HARLAN'S HOLIDAY TO CIGAR MILE

MGISW **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), ninth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic last time out, is being pointed for the G1 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 30. "If all goes well, I'm planning on running him in the Cigar Mile," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "After that, I'll bring him south and his main objective this winter will be the Donn H. [G1, Feb. 22, Gulfstream Park]." Explaining the three-year-old's lackluster performance in the Breeders' Cup, Pletcher said, "He didn't like the track at Arlington and he didn't run any step of the way." Pletcher added that GIII Cowdin S. winner **Boston Bull** (Boston Harbor) will go next in the GII Remsen S. at the Big A Nov. 30.

THUNDERELLO TOPS DEFRANCIS DASH

Thunderello (Montbrook), who was beaten just a half length by Orientate as a 48-1 shot in the Oct. 26 G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint, has been installed as the 9-5 morning-line favorite in the G1 Frank J. Francis Memorial Dash S. at Laurel Park tomorrow. The three-year-old has been first or second in all six career starts. Looking back at his near-miss in the Breeders' Cup, trainer Scott Lake said, "It was bittersweet. You feel so good that the horse ran well, but you're sick to your stomach at the same time to get beat in the last two jumps." He added, "We knew all along what type of animal he was." Lake, a finalist for the Eclipse Award as top trainer the last two years, has led the country in number of winners for the last two seasons as well and is once again in front in the standings with 345 wins (through Nov. 12). He goes for his first Grade I victory in the DeFrancis Dash. The second choice in the race at 5-2 is South American import **Avanzado (Arg)** (Luhuk), who ran his U.S. record to a perfect three-for-three with a 3/4-length win in the Oct. 6 GII Forest Hills H. at Belmont Park. This is the 13th running of the DeFrancis Dash. The inaugural edition, won by Northern Wolf, was held at Pimlico in 1990. The race was moved to Laurel in 1991. Richter Scale holds the stakes and track record, winning the six-furlong event in the time of 1:07 4/5 in 2000.

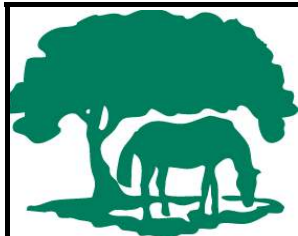

ROBBIE FRADD CLEARED IN HONG KONG

After a five-day trial, South African jockey Robbie Fradd was acquitted of cheating at gambling in Hong Kong Thursday. Fradd was one of 19 arrested in February, but was the only one charged in the case, which involved a race at Happy Valley last January in which Fradd finished third as the even-money favourite. The 37-year-old rider was accused of winning money by placing bets on the race. He has been suspended since his arrest, and is to meet with Hong Kong Jockey Club officials today to see if he can get his license reinstated. The HKJC welcomed the decision. "There was no evidence of a conspiracy; there were no incriminating conversations produced; there were no physical surveillance logs or observations of suspect parties presented; there were no telephone logs implicating suspect relationships; [there were] no receipts or financial records produced," said Timothy McNally, the HKJC's executive director of security and corporate legal services. Deputy Judge Colin Mackintosh said Fradd was found 'not guilty' because the prosecution failed to prove that he had won money on the race in question, but added that the rider had restrained his mount and denied him legal costs. "By his own evidence, Mr. Fradd acknowledged that it was a deliberate decision to give away his position behind the leader," Mackintosh told *Racing Post*. "I reject Mr. Fradd's assertion that it was a tactical move." Fradd was quoted as saying, "I'm glad the whole thing's over. It should never have gone this far."

Trainer Gai Waterhouse was fined A\$3,000 yesterday after being found guilty of giving false evidence to the Racing Victoria stewards at an inquiry involving the questionable scratch of one of her horses. In their decision, the stewards made special note that the investigation found no impropriety in terms of betting activity.
