SPEED TO SPARE IN DEFRANCIS DASH

There will be a battle on the front end in the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash at Laurel Park this afternoon, but trainer Scott Lake is hoping that his

Thunderello (Montbrook) is not mixing it up early. The three-year-old colt flew through fractions of :21 2/5, :43 4/5 and :56 en route to his second-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but Lake and his crew have been working to harness that speed. "We've been trying

to get him to relax and come from off the pace and he's been handling it well," the conditioner said. "Being on the outside gives us an advantage in that we can sit and breathe on them instead of them breathing on us."

Boston Common (Boston Harbor), who dueled through the opening quarter in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile before tiring to finish 13th, will not have the luxury of taking back from post 2. Front-running winner of the July 4 GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. and the Sept. 14 GII Jerome H., he was second behind Thunderello in his Breeders' Cup prep, the Oct. 5 Gallant Bob H. at Philly Park. **Avanzado (Arg)** (Luhuk) will also be vying for the early lead. A Group 3 winner in his native country, he is undefeated in the U.S., taking an optional claimer at Del Mar Aug. 18, the restricted Pirate's Bounty H. at that track Sept. 7 and the GII Forest Hills H. at Belmont Park Oct. 6. He picks up six pounds off that score.

FARDA AMIGA RETIRED

Kentucky Oaks winner **Farda Amiga** (Broad Brush--Fly North, by Pleasant Colony) has been retired from racing. "Her owners made the decision," said trainer Paulo Lobo. "She has one physical problem and they do not want to put a horse that is only 90 percent on the track." A leading candidate for champion three-year-old filly honors, Farda Amiga won the GI Alabama S. at

Saratoga and was a late-closing second behind Azeri in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. On the board in five of eight starts, the filly won four races and earned \$1,282,302. "She's an amazing filly and I think she deserves the [championship] title," Lobo commented. "She gave me a lot of thrills.

She has such a big heart and made me well known. We will miss her a lot." Lobo added Farda Amiga will retire to Kentucky, but no breeding decision has been made.

QUEEN HOPES TO REIGN IN LONG ISLAND

Moon Queen (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) makes her first start since a 6 1/2-length romp in the Feb. 17 GIII The Very One H. in today's GII Long Island H. at Aqueduct. A Group 2 winner at Longchamp last October, the four-year-old made her U.S. bow in this event last year and tired late to be fifth. The Very One was her second U.S. outing. Trainer Christophe Clement, who also saddles **Mot Juste (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}), just hopes his entry gets the chance to run--the forecast for New York is calling for rain. "Both horses run well on off turf," Clement said, but added, "If the race comes off the turf, I will not run either." Mot Juste comes off a third-place finish in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Sept. 28; Clement takes over the four-year-old's training from Sheikh Mohammed's trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. If the race does get switched to the main track, **Critical Eye** (Dynaformer) will be one to watch. The New York-bred, two-for-three on wet tracks, captured a Belmont allowance test Oct. 18 and was third in the GIII Turnback The Alarm H. over this track Nov. 3.

Trainer Bill Mott sends out the three-horse entry of **Showlady**, **Stylelistick** and **High Maintenance**. "It's the end of the year and the last opportunity the majority of them will have to run against straight three-year-olds," said Mott's assistant, Ralph Nicks. "We'll try to take our best shot." Showlady, a \$4-million KEESEP yearling, has been transferred to Mott from trainer Kiaran McLaughlin's barn for the winter. Winner of the GIII Boiling Springs H. at the Meadowlands Sept. 6, the bay was most recently eighth in the Oct. 12 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. Stylelistick comes off a fourth-place finish behind **Bedanken**, **Mariensky** and High Maintenance in the Oct. 19 GIII Valley View S. at Keeneland. Bedanken is now a perfect two-for-two on the turf, while **First Quarter** is three-for-four after taking her third straight in the Oct. 14 Carotene S. at Woodbine last time out. **Glia**, a Listed winner in France this spring, made her U.S. and dirt debut in the Oct. 14 Pebbles H. and showed a serious turn of foot in a 3 1/4-length victory.

CASTLE GANDOLFO SOLD Castle Gandolfo (Gone West) has been sold and transferred to trainer Craig Dollase's barn, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The three-year-old, formerly trained in Ireland by Aidan O'Brien and owned by Susan Magnier, has been purchased for an undisclosed sum by J. Paul Reddam. Castle Gandolfo, who journeyed to Louisville with stablemate Johannesburg this past spring, finished 12th in the Kentucky Derby and has since run sixth in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club and third in a listed event at The Curragh Sept. 15. As a two-year-old, he captured the G3 Beresford S. and was second in the G1 Racing Post Trophy and in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. In his first breeze for Dollase, Castle Gandolfo worked three furlongs at Hollywood Park Tuesday in :38.80. "We're pointing him toward the [Dec. 1 GI] Hollywood Derby and then for the Strub series at Santa Anita," Dollase told the *Times*. "He won in Europe on the dirt and he's bred for dirt, so after the Hollywood Derby, that's where we're going to try him."

SUNDAY BREAK BOUND FOR MALIBU Sunday Break (Jpn) (Forty Niner), off since a third-place effort in the Belmont S., could make his return to the races in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Of the long layoff, trainer Neil Drysdale commented, "He hurt a stifle behind in the Belmont. The first time we breezed him after the Belmont, he wasn't himself." The bay colt has won four of eight starts, including a one-length victory in the GI Peter Pan S.

Saarland, winner of last year's GII Remsen, was making his first start since a disappointing 10th-place effort in the Kentucky Derby. The well-bred colt, wearing blinkers for the first time, was heavily favored in the field of seven. After bobbling at the start, Saarland tracked the early leaders, moved to the front approaching the stretch and forged clear down the lane. "I didn't know that he had a mile in 1:34 in him," commented winning trainer Shug McGaughey. "I think the blinkers have helped. I think he's grown up some and filled out. He stumbled a couple of jumps out of the gate and grabbed a quarter. It looked like he grabbed that quarter pretty good and it might take a while to get that thing put back together." Of Saarland's next start, McGaughey said, "If everything goes right, I'd like to use the [Feb. 22] GI Donn H. and maybe the [Feb. 16] GI Gulfstream Park H. and be ready for the races here [in New York] in the summer."

First Winner for Ho:

Hong Kong jockey Sunny Ho won the first North American race of his career aboard 59-1 longshot Peters Punkin in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields Thursday. It was the 40-year-old's second career victory. Peters Punkin is trained by James Li and owned by Ho's brother Sung Kit Ho, who claimed the three-year-old filly for \$8,000 at Bay Meadows Oct. 31. "I'm very happy for Sunny," Li said. "He wanted to win bad. Hopefully other people will start to give him a chance." Li added that Ho won a race in Hong Kong in 1983, but couldn't become a licensed rider in the territory because the jockey club requires a person to win 10 races by the time he turns 23. Ho has been working horses for 20 years and has been in the U.S. since last December.

RACING INJURIES EXAMINED Dr. Peter Webbon, the Jockey Club's director of veterinary science, proclaimed the findings of Thursday's second veterinary conference an example of the "solid foundation of cooperation" in the racing industry. After a series of talks uncovering the results of extensive research into racehorse injury, Webbon praised the level of support given by trainers to the teams that have investigated the causes of fracture and respiratory disease. Among the findings was that of Tim Parkin from the University of Liverpool, which focused on the instance of fractures on an all-weather track compared to turf. Parkin and his team discovered that risk of fracture was almost twice as great on an all-weather track as on a traditional turf track, citing that the risk of fatal fracture on the former surface was 0.72 per 1000 starts, while on the latter was only 0.38. Parkin pointed to the fact that the slipping forward of the foot on impact on all-weather was greater than on turf, resulting in greater extension at the fetlock and subsequent strain on the suspensory apparatus. The Animal Health Trust's Dr. Kristien Verheyen's study into racehorse fractures concluded that nearly 80 percent of those occurred in training, while that organisation's Dr. James Wood found that risk of respiratory disease was greater in young horses in the autumn, with risk greatly diminishing with age. Recommendations included the Royal Veterinary College's Dr Roger Smith's exercise regimes to minimise degeneration of the tendon in young and immature horses. Webbon concluded of the studies, funded by the Levy Board, "Here we have everybody with a single thought in mind: to promote the safety, welfare and health of the horse."

ITALY WELCOMES NEW STALLIONS

Mutamam (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) and Single Empire (Ire) (Kris {GB}) are to stand at stud in Italy in 2003. Mutamam, winner of the GI Canadian International, has left the National Stud in Newmarket to take up duties at Allevamento di Besnate near Varese, the main stallion centre in north of Italy. He will replace the 15-year-old stallion **Elmaamul (USA) (Diesis {GB})**, who has been relocated at Beechwood Grange Stud in Yorkshire by owners Shadwell Estate Company Limited. Single Empire, winner of the G1 Derby Italiano and GI San Juan Capistrano Invitational H., is due to arrive in Tuscany at Siena.

UNIRE TO RESHAPE RULES

In an unprecedented ruling, UNIRE appear to have changed the domestic rules regarding imported horses. The case involved the Naples handicap success of the ex-Richard Hannon-trained Bram Stoker (Ire), who, it was argued by some Italian trainers, did not qualify under the current conditions of racing. These dictate that an imported horse must have made his debut in the country or been placed at least once in group class, or in a listed race. They also state that to be eligible for listed races, the horse must have won or been placed in races worth a minimum of the winner's prizemoney. In the case of Bram Stoker, who had finished unplaced in group company three times, the disciplinary committee rejected the claims that he did not fulfill the conditions. They ruled that Bram Stoker was a European Community horse and was therefore allowed to run anywhere.

GOLAN TOUCHES DOWN

Meanwhile, Geoffrey Snook, groom of the Barry Hills-trained **Storming Home (GB) (Machiavellian {USA})**, took the four-year-old for a walk, jog and canter yesterday, before putting him through the stalls. "He's eating so well we had to add some more hay," Snook commented. "I think he's fully recovered from the his trip now. He'll probably do a strong canter after we move to Nakayama, but I'll have to discuss the details with the trainer when he comes."
