D'WILDCAT IN THE DEFRANCIS

Although his two previous wins this year had come via disqualification, **D'wildcat** (Forest Wildcat) got to the winner's circle under his own steam yesterday at Laurel when he closed strongly on the inside to take the GI DeFrancis Memorial Dash. A \$600,000 OBSMAR purchase, the chestnut colt was sidelined following a splashy 10 1/2-length victory in the GIII Swale S. last March at Gulfstream. In his third start off a year's lay-



off, D'wildcat was struck by a rival's whip when missing by a neck in the GII Churchill Downs H. May 4 and was placed first. He lost his next three starts and then tried the turf, where he benefited from the stewards' decision in the Live the Dream H. at Del Mar

D'wildcat Dashes to Victory

Sept. 11. Following an eighth in the GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile, D'wildcat was forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint when he spiked a fever. He caboosed the DeFrancis field through an opening quarter of :22.12, but advanced steadily on the inside turning for home, collared **Sassy Hound** (Deerhound) in midstretch and edged clear in the final strides. "When he broke he didn't show me speed, so I just waited, waited, waited and on the turn I started moving," said winning rider Jorge Chavez. "My horse did a really good job." Locally based **Deer Run** (Deerhound), the second longest shot on the board 16-1, came flying on the far outside to take second. The race was marred when even-money **Thunderello** (Montbrook), the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint runner-up, was pulled up on the turn before being vanned off the track. "It appears he reinjured his lower suspensory," said trainer Scott Lake. The chestnut had been out of action for a year with a suspensory problem after breaking his maiden by 14 1/4 lengths at Saratoga in 2001. *Chart, p2*

URIAH REIGNS ON LONG ISLAND

Making her first start outside of Germany, **Uriah (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) came up the rail and found the wire just a nose in front of **Sunstone (GB)** (Caerleon) to take the GII Long Island H. over a soft Aqueduct turf course yesterday. The bay filly had taken her first three career starts before running third twice against colts, including the G2 Deutsches St. Leger Sept. 29. She bounced back to take the Listed Frankfurter Stutenpreis Nov. 3 over heavy ground and was the fourth choice in her U.S. bow. After breaking a step slowly, Uriah saved ground and gradually reached contention approaching the stretch, where she came flying up the inside to earn her fifth victory in seven career outings. "She was a little shy at first coming through that hole, but I chirped at her a few times and she got through," said winning rider Norberto Arroyo Jr. "I didn't know if I got there." Favored **Moon Queen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), off since February, tired after a mile and finished last.

A maiden winner in three starts over the winter at Philadelphia Park, Caught in the Rain returned from a seven-month hiatus to be sixth in state-bred allowance company at Philly Sept. 14. Switched to the infield for her next start, the dark bay filly came from just off the pace to register a 32-1 upset in the Mrs. Penny S. for Pennsylvania-breds Oct. 5 and was coming into this off a half-length score over the Aqueduct turf course Oct. 23, but was given little chance to maintain her unblemished record over the grass in her graded-stakes debut. Caught in the Rain came out at the start and bumped with favored Glia, who was forced to steady a bit. The former recovered to force the pace down the backstretch while wide, took a short lead in upper stretch and was collared for a few strides by Bedanken, but dug in gamely for a narrow success. "She's never had a chance before, but she's showing us what she can do," said Ray Preciado, brother of and assistant to trainer Guadalupe Preciado. "She's improving with every race."

This race lost some of its luster when likely second choice and undefeated Soto (Dehere) was scratched from the event, but favored Toccet made up for that loss with a convincing performance. Third in his July 7 debut at Colonial Downs, the bay broke his maiden by 10 lengths at this track Aug. 16 and followed up with an 8 1/2-length score in his two-turn bow at Pimlico Sept. 6. The waters got deeper for Toccet in the GI Champagne S. in New York Oct. 5, but he handled the class hike with aplomb, scooting through along the rail to register a 9-1 upset. He came into this race off an eventful ninth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26. The recipient of an aggressive ride by jockey Jorge Chavez, Toccet was bumped at the start before taking up a stalking position from the rail and close to the early pace of Ironton. He advanced between rivals on the final turn and responded when asked, pulling clear to the daylight score. "I was waiting for my time," explained the winning rider. "At the top of the stretch, I let him go a little bit and he galloped away by himself. It was a nice easy win. This will definitely be a Derby type horse."

The champion Japanese juvenile of 1998, **Admire Cozzene** was held winless through the next three seasons, but finally broke that streak with a victory in the G3 Tokyo Shimbun Hai in his 2002 debut back in January. He made it two in a row with a Group 3 triumph in February, finished second in the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen in March, then captured the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June. He took a summer vacation, returning to be second in his latest, the G1 Sprinters S. in September. "He looks good and I'm hoping for another championship," trainer Mitsuru Hashida said.

Shibuni's Falcon provided a rare Italian success in the G1 Premio Roma last year, but the home team may have to take a back seat this year in the face of a strong foreign threat headed by **Carnival Dancer**. Sir Michael Stoute's four-year-old showed a liking for soft ground last July when beating the smart Albarahin by three lengths in the G3 Scottish Classic at Ayr, where **Island House** was a further 3/4-length back in third. He returned this season to finish a disappointing fourth behind Asian Heights (GB) in the slowly run Listed Berkshire S. at Windsor May 26 before performing below par on unsuitably fast ground when last of five behind Naheef (Ire) in the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor Aug. 24. Although he was held by the fourth-placed **Imperial Dancer** there, he readily reversed that form when an unlucky fourth behind Storming Home (GB) in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19.

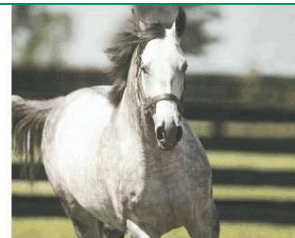

INDIGENOUS OUT OF JAPAN CUP

Indigenous (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) will be withdrawn from the Nov. 24 G1 Japan Cup after having his feed confiscated by Japan's Department of Agriculture, *Racing Post* reports. The eight-year-old gelding, the runner-up in the 1999 Japan Cup, arrived in Tokyo Tuesday, along with a supply of feed. In accordance with the country's requirements, samples of the feed had been sent ahead for testing, but the Department of Agriculture seized the shipment without warning. "It is disgraceful that the Japanese authorities did not alert us of their intention to disallow the feed prior to the shipment of the horse," trainer Ivan Allan told *Racing Post*. "If they had done, I would have withdrawn Indigenous from his invitation to compete. He has always been selective about his feed and this disruption of his diet will seriously affect his chances."

GRANDERA UNFAZED BY NEW TRIP

Grandera (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA}) and **Atlantis Prince (GB)** (Tagula {Ire}) were yesterday reported to have settled in since arriving for the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 15. Third in the G1 Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Oct. 26, Grandera traveled straight to Hong Kong for his bid to wrap up the Emirates World Series title.
