### FREDDY FOILS PEASANT'S TRIPLE CROWN BID

This year's renewal of the Argentine Derby featured the unbeaten **Peasant II (Arg)** (Equalize), but it was **Freddy (Arg)** (Roy) who walked away with the victory in the Gran Premio Nacional, the last leg of the country's Triple Crown. After sweeping the first two legs of the series, Peasant II appeared poised to become Argentina's 21st Triple Crown winner, but this wasn't his lucky day, as he stumbled soon after the start and never showed the strength of his previous races. **Semblanza (Arg)** (Roy), the only filly in the field, led early and was followed closely by Peasant II and **Memorion (Arg)** (Roy), while Freddy lingered at the back of the pack. Turning for home, Peasant II took the lead briefly and was soon passed by **Pellegrino (Brz)** (Nugget Point {Ire}), but Freddy was closing quickly. Mowing down the leaders 300 meters from the wire, the winner of the Oct. 26 G2 Casey and the June 29 G1 Estrellas Juvenile passed stablemate Pellegrino in deep stretch for the win.

### WOLF POWER DIES AT 24

Gainesway announced that South African Champion and Horse of the Year **Wolf Power (SAf)** (Flirting Around) died from a ruptured aorta while in his stall at the Lexington-area farm last Friday afternoon. "Wolf Power was a true professional on the race course and at stud," said Gainesway Director of Sales Michael Heron. "He was a very kind stallion and was looked upon as a member of the family here at Gainesway. We will all remember him well." The South African all-time leading money earner covered 34 mares in 2002 and 30 are reported in foal to the six-time Group 1 winner. The roan is represented by 38 stakes winners, including Grade I victress Freedom Cry and 2002 stakes winners Warrens Whistle and Get Down Wolfie, while his progeny earnings have surpassed the \$23-million mark with 16 crops to date. Wolf Power is buried at Gainesway.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

### THE LEGACY OF DEPUTY MINISTER

*(Vice Regent--Mint Copy, by Bunty's Flight)*

When Robert Brennan paid \$6,000,000 for a half-share in the champion two-year-old colt Deputy Minister early in 1982, he no doubt hoped that he was buying into the main contender for the Triple Crown races. Unfortunately, Deputy Minister injured himself in the Bahamas S. and came out of his next race with a severely wrenched ankle. So, instead of running in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, Deputy Minister spent the month of May recuperating at Kinghaven Farms in Canada, where he was blistered twice.

We can only guess how he would have fared against the likes of Gato del Sol, Aloma's Ruler and Conquistador Cielo, but his subsequent record raised the question of whether he would have had the necessary stamina for the Derby and the Belmont S. When Deputy Minister returned to action for two more races at three, it was over six furlongs. Then, in a very welcome return to form in his first three races at four, he won the seven-furlong Gulfstream Sprint Championship H., the GII Donn H. over nine furlongs and the seven-furlong GII Tom Fool S. This last win was all the more meritorious because it came after a five-month absence caused by a badly infected foot.

The ambitious itinerary planned for him after these wins reportedly included the Jockey Club Gold Cup over 1 1/2 miles, but a sequence of defeats led to his running instead in the seven-furlong Vosburgh S. Then, just as we had him categorized primarily as a speed horse, Deputy Minister tackled 1 1/4 miles in the GI Meadowlands Cup on his final appearance. He appeared to have the race won until Slewpny nipped through on the inside to snatch victory by a neck.

### *The versatility of 'Deputy'...*

As Deputy Minister clearly possessed a degree of stamina, there was every chance that he would sire everything from sprinters to stayers, depending on the type of mare he was mated to. This he has done, with quite a few of his best progeny winning graded stakes over 1 1/4 miles or more. Among them are Open Mind (Alabama S., CCA Oaks), Go For Wand (Alabama S.), Touch Gold (Belmont S.), Awesome Again (Queen's Plate, Breeders' Cup Classic), Deputy Commander (Travers S., Super Derby), Mr Purple (Santa Anita H.), Flag Down, Victory Speech and Da Dean.

It has been suggested that, if Deputy Minister was going to make his name as a sire of sires, it would be through his faster sons. This theory gained credence over the last few years through the successes of French Deputy, Silver Deputy, Dehere, Salt Lake, Open Forum and Service Stripe, but it ignored one relevant fact--that the best of the staying sons had hardly had a chance to prove themselves.

Fertility problems effectively ruined Mr Purple's stallion career, and Victory Speech was by no means a sure-fire bet to make the grade, judging by his International Classification ratings which placed him 14 pounds behind Skip Away as a three-year-old and 21 pounds below Gentlemen at four, when he gained his Grade I win.

There was reason to hope that it would be a different story with the three Grade I-winning Deputy Minister horses which are currently being represented by their first runners. Touch Gold, with a Classification rating of 126, was rated the best American three-year-old of 1997, one pound above Silver Charm; Deputy Commander was rated 122 as a three-year-old; and Awesome Again was rated 130 as a four-year-old in 1998.

None of these three stallions was ever likely to sire a lot of early two-year-old winners, but they have all been making their mark in recent weeks, especially the Adena Springs pair of Awesome Again and Touch Gold.

Awesome Again has added six races to his tally since the start of October, thanks to Awesome Action, Symmetron, Clays Awesome, Ghostzapper and the very talented Toccet, while Touch Gold has been ably represented during the same period by the winners Composure, Buzzy's Gold, Seek Gold, Powerful Touch and Region of Merit.

It is interesting that Awesome Again's progeny have already won six races at around 8 1/2 furlongs, which suggests he is going to build on these successes as the distances lengthen. Remember, he rounded off his career with three straight Graded wins over 1 1/4 miles.

Touch Gold's progeny are also going to appreciate longer routes (as his excellent daughter Composure demonstrated over 1 1/8 miles in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies), but the fact that their last two wins came over seven furlongs is a reminder that he wasn't a stayer pure and simple. He won over six furlongs on his debut at two and his Belmont S. victory was sandwiched between an easy defeat of Smoke Glacken in the Gil Lexington S. over 8 1/2 furlongs and a win in the GI Haskell Invitational H. over 1 1/8 miles.
