JAPAN WELCOMES THE WORLD

With Tokyo Racecourse undergoing repairs this year, the 21st running of the G1 Japan Cup is set for this Sunday at Nakayama Racecourse and has drawn an internationally flavored field of 16 for the 1 3/8-mile event. Japanese-based horses have been successful in each of the last four runnings of the \$4 million test and the home defense is headed this time around by **Symboli Kris S.** (Kris S.). Unraced as a juvenile, the Kentucky-bred colt has been outstanding this season, with four victories in five tries, including a 3/4-length success in the G1 Tenno Sho at Nakayama Oct. 27.

Seven overseas invaders will try to upset the apple cart, including GI Eddie Read H. hero **Sarafan** (Lear Fan), from the barn of Neil Drysdale for co-owners Gary Tanaka and Fusao Sekiguchi of Fusaichi Pegasus fame. European hopes rest on the heads of **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), sixth in this event a year ago, G1 Prix de l'Opera winner **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound) and **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King), a dual Group 1 winner this year in Italy who would appreciate fast ground.

FOR SHEILA, IT WAS WORTH THE WAIT

Sheila's Prospect (Not for Love) had a three-race winning streak snapped when she ran fourth to **El Prado Essence** (El Prado {Ire}) in the Seaway S. Sept. 1, but the Woodbine-based filly improved to run second by a half-length to **Feathers** (Cherokee Run) in the Ontario Fashion H. Oct. 26. Dismissed at 7-1 in this rescheduled event, the Maryland-bred dark bay settled into stride on the outside, rallied four wide at the top of the stretch and outfinished **Miss Sweep** (End Sweep) to earn her first stakes victory. "It was pretty exciting," said winning trainer Lorne Richards. "It looked like she might get caught, but she held on. I'm very pleased. She's had a great campaign," he said. "I think she's very deserving of a stakes win. She ran her eyeballs out [Wednesday]. This filly had to give everything she had today just to hang on, and she did."

Gigawatt never got involved when sixth to Wando in his career opener July 7, but he put it all together next out, crushing Woodbine maidens by 17 lengths Sept. 1. He followed that up with a solid runner-up finish to Wando Oct. 6 in the GII Grey Breeders' Cup S. and was heavily favored to go one better this time. Never far from the front, the dark bay tracked the early leader, took charge as they straightened into the stretch and pulled away from his rivals. "I let him run free and he relaxed very good behind horses," said winning rider Patrick Husbands. "When I called on him, he responded." Gigawatt will head south for the winter. "All being well, Mark [trainer Casse] will confer with [the owners], and we'll proceed to Gulfstream and see what happens with his three-year-old year," said assistant trainer Greg DeGannes.

Darby Dan Introduces "Profit Protection":

Darby Dan Farm has developed a stud fee protection program entitled 'Profit Protection,' designed to minimize risk for the commercial breeder. The program allows for stud fees to be paid from the proceeds of weanling and yearling sales while providing the breeder a buffer on a financially unsuccessful sale. If, for example, a horse by a Darby Dan stallion who stood for \$5,000 brings just \$7,000 that at auction, the breeder retains 50 percent of the net income regardless of what is due on the stud fee. In the case of a profitable sale, the breeder retains the lion's share of the income while paying the farm a 25-percent premium on the stud fee in addition to the fee itself. "We put our thoughts together to find a way to lessen the risk for the commercial breeder without compromising our stallions' aggregate earnings and underlying value," explained Darby Dan owner John Phillips. "We believe this elastic stud fee structure will minimize risk for the breeder on any commercial mating. The plan protects profit." The plan is limited for 2003 to stallions standing for less than \$10,000. Darby Dan will also maintain a traditional stud fee format.

CRACKDOWN CONTINUES

Jockey Dermot Browne, who confessed to TV expose *Panorama* to doping racehorses in 1990, was yesterday handed a 20-year ban by the Jockey Club. Having been warned off in 1992, the former jockey and trainer learned that his suspension was extended at a hearing of the Jockey Club's disciplinary committee at Portman Square. In a week when trainer Ferdy Murphy was fined £4,000 for comments on another TV program, *Kenyon Confronts*, the British racing authorities are stepping up the crackdown on threats to racing's integrity. Ben Gunn, former Chief Constable of Cambridgeshire, was yesterday named as the chairman of racing's new Security Review Group, a joint operation set up by the Jockey Club and the British Horseracing Board. Among the tasks of the group is to investigate the need for links between racing and the police, and to examine the current framework of disciplinary and licensing functions.

BHB DEFEND DATA CHARGES

Nigel Smith, managing director (commercial) of the British Horseracing Board (BHB), yesterday defended the increased charges for racecard data used by newspapers. The proposed increase from the current rate of £3,400 per year to around 100 times that figure has led to a wave of criticism from Britain's major newspapers, whose measures include dropping sponsors and certain meetings from print. "We have met newspapers and we have noted the very strong response that they have made to almost any increase, almost no matter what the commercial justification would be," Smith said yesterday. "We get the benefit from many ways for distributing our product, but that's not saying the same as a fair price shouldn't be paid for it. We get value out of it [and] so do they. We are prepared to sit down and have a sensible discussion about it. We don't want racecards out of newspapers."

We're very pleased with her. She has travelled well and she has eaten well." The Wildenstein family have finished runner-up in the Japan Cup with **All Along (Fr)** in 1983 and **Ode (USA)** in 1990. "We have raced here three times before and twice had very close seconds," Wildenstein continued. "It has always been our dream to win this race, and we thought the right-handed track this year would suit this filly. Whoever finishes in front of us will win." Trainer Elie Lellouche added that the three-year-old would have one more canter today. In related news, **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) had his first work on the turf at Nakayama yesterday under Roy Carter, who declared himself pleased with the G1 King George winner's progress. Kieren Fallon, who partnered the four-year-old to the Ascot success July 27, described Golan as a "very intelligent, very laid-back horse," adding, "Other than Kazuo Fujisawa's horse [Symboli Kris S], I'd be pretty confident. I think Symboli Kris S will be very hard to beat." **Storming Home (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}) also undertook an easy canter on the turf under exercise rider Geoffrey Snook alongside the Dermot Weld-trained filly **Irresistible Jewel (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}). "I don't think he needs a lot of fast work," said Snook of Storming Home, "Michael Hills arrives tomorrow, and maybe he'll give him a good blow out."
