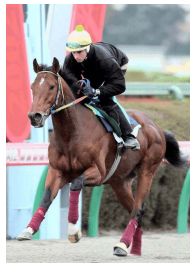

SIXTEEN SET FOR SUNDAY CUP

Last year's Japanese Horse of the Year **Jungle Pocket (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}) is back to defend his title in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup at Nakayama, but the four-year-old will have to top a host of foreign challengers as well as some of the top Japanese performers in 2002. Headlining the home team is **Symboli Kris S.**

(Kris S.), who defeated older horses in the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) over this course Oct. 27. British raider **Storming Home (GB)** (Machiavellian) has shown improvement since the addition of sheepskin cheekpieces, most recently battling his way home in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19. Flying in from France is **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound), the G1 Prix de Diane heroine who dominated her rivals in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp Oct. 6. "She's a light, agile filly," trainer Elie Lellouche told *Paris-Turf*, "and the long trip didn't bother her at all. I think she'll adapt well to this track. She's a handy filly and the 2,200 meters is a perfect distance for her." Making his final career

start is **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), who has only run three times since finishing sixth in last year's renewal. After winning the King George to start the year, he was a close second in the G1 Juddmonte International and most recently ran sixth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 26. "He likes an uphill finish and will act on this track--it's

pretty similar to Ascot," jockey Kieren Fallon told *Racing Post*. Italian invader **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) was beaten just a length in the G2 Prix Foy before finishing ninth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Jungle Pocket rallied to win last year's Japan Cup, held at Tokyo, but has only started twice this year. Second in the Apr. 28 G1 Tenno Sho (Spring) in his second outing of the season, the bay was scheduled for a European campaign, but an injury to his right hind curtailed those plans. *Japan Cup Field, p3*

DELTA FORM GETS TOP BILLING

The peripatetic **Delta Form (Aus)** (Marscay {Aus}) has been tabbed as the morning-line favorite for the G1 Hollywood Turf Cup this afternoon at the Inglewood, California oval. Bred in Australia, he was a solid campaigner in South Africa before being purchased by Team Valor. It's taken him a while to get going in the U.S., but Delta Form is finally in top form. He captured the GII Del Mar H. Sept. 1 before heading to New York for the G1 Turf Classic, where he was beaten a half-length by Denon Sept. 29. **Grammarians** (Definite Article {GB}) won the GII Sunset H. over course and distance in just his fourth career start July 21. He lost his next three, but rebounded with a wire-to-wire effort in an allowance at Churchill Nov. 3 and will be one to watch from post 10. Trainer Jonathan Sheppard is shipping in **Rochester** (Green Dancer), who followed up his GIII Kentucky Cup Turf tally with a victory in the Sycamore Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 6 at Keeneland. The six-year-old is 5-4-1-0 at 1 1/2 miles. The lone Grade I winner in the Turf Cup field is **Cetewayo** (His Majesty). Now eight, he kicked off 2002 with a victory in the G1 Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. and comes to California on the strength of a close second in the GII Sky Classic H. at Woodbine Oct. 27.

Beaten just 1 1/2 lengths in the G1 Japanese Derby on the turf May 26, **Gold Allure** has been unstoppable in his last two efforts on the dirt, taking the G1-NAR Japan Dirt Derby by seven lengths July 4 and most recently the G1-NAR Derby Grand Prix by 10 lengths Sept. 23. Fifth to Japanese star Kurofune in this event a year ago, **Preeminence** comes in off a nine-length success in the Sept. 17 Mercury Cup in the mud and a 2 1/2-length score in the G3 Elm S. over the Sapporo turf Aug. 31. American invader **Reba's Gold**, drawn just inside the favorite, will try to take this field wire-to-wire. Third in the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Oct. 6, the bay registered a head victory in the off-the-turf Steinlen H. at Hollywood Nov. 10.

If the rains which have been falling in metro New York force this event onto the main track, GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner **Evening Attire** rates a standout choice. Trainer Pat Kelly indicated that if the grey doesn't run in this spot, he'll head to Churchill for the GII Clark H. next Friday. Should it remain on the turf, **Man From Wicklow** could record his first victory of the season. Despite his winless mark, the five-year-old was a close fourth to Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up With Anticipation in the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga in August and third to that rival in the GI Man o' War S. at Belmont the following month. The gelding was most recently third in the GII Sky Classic H. over a soft Woodbine turf course Oct. 27. **Dawn of the Condor** displayed affinity for an "off" turf course when charging home a two-length winner of the nine-furlong GII Knickerbocker H. Nov. 2 and should appreciate the added distance of this test.

CALLOUS JOCKEY FINED, SUSPENDED The Aqueduct stewards slapped jockey Victor Carrero with a 15-day suspension and fined him \$2,000 yesterday for what they termed a "gross display of temper." The ban and fine were the result of Carrero's actions after a horse he rode, Saltaat, broke down in Thursday's second race at Aqueduct. After Carrero was thrown from the stricken horse, he threw his whip and dirt at the horse before walking off in disgust. Saltaat, who was trained by Debbie Bodner, had to be humanely destroyed. Yesterday, Carrero, who speaks limited English, issued a statement in which he apologized for his actions. In part, it read: "I conducted myself in an unprofessional manner and I deeply regret what I did. After meeting with the stewards, I was given a suspension and a fine, which I will not appeal. I apologize to Deborah Bodner, the owner and trainer of Saltaat. I apologize to my fellow jockeys, the owners and trainers." Bodner had little to say about the incident. "I'm too depressed to comment about it," she said.

FORMER CHAMPION JOCKEY TAKES NZ TOPPER

Former Australian champion jockey Mick Dittman went to NZ\$240,000 to get the top seller at the New Zealand Bloodstock Ready to Run Sale, held Tuesday and Wednesday in Auckland. The sales topper, a gelding by Golden Brose (NZ) out of Shepherd's Delight (NZ) (Famous Star {GB}), was consigned by Parkvale Farm. He is a half-brother to New Zealand Group 1 winner Vinaka (NZ). "He's an impressive sort with a lot to like about him--plenty of size, good walking and he looked the part in his breeze-up," said Dittman, who won 3,000 races (including 90 Group 1 races) during his riding career. There were 13 two-year-olds offered by **Tale of the Cat** (Storm Cat) at the auction, with 11 selling for an average of NZ\$65,410. The stallion accounted for the sale's second-highest seller, a gelding from the Sally's Stables consignment bought by Joe Barnes for NZ\$160,000. Freshman sire **Desert Prince (Ire)** (Green Desert {USA}) also had a successful sale, with his two offered taking the third and fourth spots on the top sellers' list. A Desert Prince gelding consigned by Ebony Lodge was purchased for NZ\$150,000 by New Zealand Bloodstock Ltd., while a colt by the young stallion from the Anzac Lodge consignment brought NZ\$145,000 from Barnes. The two-day sale achieved a clearance rate of 64 percent during its Select Session and 70 percent during its General Session, with buyers from Australia, Macau, Hong Kong and New Zealand contributing to the results. The Select Session realized an aggregate of NZ\$5,738,500 for 114 lots sold. The average of NZ\$50,338 was down 11 percent from last year, while the median remained steady at NZ\$45,000. The General Session aggregate was NZ\$1,063,500 for 64 lots sold, with the average of NZ\$16,617 showing a 4 percent drop from 2001.
