### THE EAGLE HAS LANDED

**Eagle Café** (Gulch) was sent off at 19-1, but shot through a gap at the top of the stretch and held off 123-1 outsider **Regent Bluff (Jpn)** (Park Regent) to win the G1 Japan Cup Dirt by a length at Nakayama yesterday afternoon. "He was in great form," winning jockey Frankie Dettori said. "I just put the horse in the right position and he did everything." The five-year-old ended a 26-month drought with a win in the

July 7 G3-JRA Tanabata Sho and had started twice since, disappointing when eighth in the G2-JRA Sapporo Kinen Aug. 18, but showing marked improvement with a solid third-place finish in the G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp Oct. 5. Overlooked by the bettors this time, the bay tracked 8-5 second choice **Gold Allure (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence) to the stretch, then rallied past the Japan Dirt Derby winner, grabbing the lead 100 meters from the line. "I had seen Eagle Café run in France and I liked his strong finish," Dettori said. "I didn't expect to be so close to the front this time, but I know Nakayama has sharp turns and it is hard to make up ground on a 200-meter straight, so I wanted to be as close as I could. When I found the gap, I asked him to go and, when he got his head out in front, he went willingly." As for the future, winning owner Kiyoshi Nishikawa said, "He is not young and normally I would think of retiring him at the end of the season. However, having won the Japan Cup Dirt, I'll have to discuss this carefully with my connections and the trainer. The Dubai World Cup--if we get invited--may also be a consideration, although up to now I honestly didn't think that this horse would be so well suited to dirt races." American hopeful **Reba's Gold** (Slew o'Gold) made an outside bid on the final bend, but faded to finish ninth, while countrymate **Abreeze** (Danzig) battled for the early lead, but tired late to be 12th. Attendance for the third running of the Japan Cup Dirt was 55,163.

### SLIGO DRINKS FROM THE CUP

**Sligo Bay (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was caught nearing the wire by Denon in last year's GI Hollywood Derby, but there was a happier ending yesterday, as the blaze-faced bay overtook a game **Grammarians** (Definite Article {GB}) inside the final sixteenth to win the GI Hollywood Turf Cup in Inglewood. Eighth in the GII Arcadia H. in April and 10th in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic the following month, he was sidelined off a fifth in local allowance company June 9, but returned to register a visually impressive two-length score going 10 furlongs at Santa Anita Oct. 18. Sent off at 9-1 stretching out to a mile and a half for the first time, Sligo Bay was a ground-saving fourth passing the stands on the first circuit, was asked to take closer order approaching the far turn, took aim on Grammarians in upper stretch and edged clear late. "Coming down the stretch, I thought I was going to blow by the leader," said winning rider Laffit Pincay Jr. "Then all of a sudden, the other one took off. I was able to get him, but I had to work hard." Sligo Bay is the 10th individual Group/Grade I winner for his sire in 2002. An allowance winner over this turf course during the spring meet, Quick Tip ran fifth in the GIII Early Times Mint Julep May 18 and in local allowance company July 7 before finishing second to England's Legend (Fr) in the GIII Modesty H. at Arlington 20 days later. Fifth over an unsuitable 11 furlongs in the GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga Aug. 26, the Farish homebred returned to the Blue Grass for a confidence-buliding 3 1/4-length allowance score at Keeneland Oct. 17. The second choice in her return to stakes competition, the dark bay filly settled outside the early leaders while racing five wide, launched her bid approaching the stretch, hit the front with better than a furlong to run and held off a determined San Dare for the victory. "I thought I could move a little earlier than normal because it's a mile and an eighth instead of a mile and a quarter or a mile and three-eighths," commented winning jockey Robby Albarado. "She likes to go around horses and when she made the lead turning for home she messed around a bit, but came through and she prevailed as the best one." Trainer Neil Howard indicated that he would consult with his owner, but that the filly would likely be pointed towards races over the winter at the Fair Grounds. One of the three "main track only" entrants in what was supposed to be the final grass stakes of the year in New York, Evening Attire easily disposed of his five other rivals to record his fifth stakes of the year in this off-the-turf affair. Second in the June 1 GII Massachusetts H., the gray was fourth in a paceless renewal of the GII Suburban H. at Belmont July 6, but got back on the beam with a rallying 1 1/2-length score in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 17. The gelding registered his most important and valuable victory to date in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Sept. 28 and was looking to atone for his fourth-place effort in the Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 26. Originally aimed for the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs this coming Friday, trainer Pat Kelly was pleased with a midweek work and entered in this spot as a safety valve. Content to linger at the back of the pack through the opening furlongs, Evening Attire made steady progress up the backstretch, cruised effortlessly to the lead approaching the quarter pole and motored clear. "He's a home town boy and he loves it here," Kelly explained of the decision to remain in New York. "We were looking at a big field down there [in the Clark] and it was only a mile and an eighth."

Roll Hennessy Roll survived a protracted speed duel and kicked clear late to run his career mark to four wins from five starts. Owned by Sunland Park founder Stanley Fulton, the chestnut broke his maiden by 8 1/2 lengths at Albuquerque May 20 before returning to win the Los Ninos S. at Ruidoso Downs July 28. A 6 1/2-length winner of the Ruidoso Thoroughbred Futurity with first-time Lasix Sept. 2, he made a favorable impression in his Southern California bow, closing well to be third in the Oct. 19 Sunny Slope S. at Santa Anita. Adding blinkers for the first time and favored in his graded-stakes debut, Roll Hennessy Roll locked horns early with longshot Jimmy O (Stormy Atlantic) through fast fractions, disposed of that rival at the head of the lane and shook clear to an impressive victory. Red Apache closed well late to be second. "The blinkers really made a difference," commented winning rider Alex Solis. **What A Bad Day** (Dehere), a troubled third in the GIII Iroquois S. beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 3, has suffered a knee injury and will be forced to miss Saturday's race. The gray likely sustained the injury during a five-furlong work Wednesday which went in 1:01 3/5. "He worked great--he couldn't have worked any better," commented Ian Wilkes, assistant to trainer Carl Nafzger. "But he did not come out of the race good." Wilkes indicated that surgery could be indicated.

**Champali** (Glitterman), the 1 1/4-length winner of the Iroquois, breezed five-eighths of a mile yesterday in 1:00 4/5 and remains on track for the race. Trainer Greg Foley is looking for a rider for the colt. Pat Day, who rode Champali in the Iroquois, will be at Hollywood Park to pilot Good Journey in the GII Citation H.

**THUNDERELLO RETIRED** Thunderello (Montbrook--On the Square, by In Reality), who fractured a splint bone and chipped the sesamoid bone during the GI De Francis Dash Nov. 16, has been officially retired from racing and will enter stud at Buck Pond Farm in Versailles, Kentucky, for \$5,000. *Daily Racing Form* reports. A \$47,000 OBSAUG yearling and \$175,000 OBSMAR two-year-old in training purchase, the Florida-bred was second to Mayakovsky in that rival's track-record setting performance at Saratoga last July, but went to the shelf following a 14 1/4-length maiden score last Sept. 1. Second in his return to action a year and a day later, the chestnut won back-to-back races, including the Gallant Bob H. at Philadelphia Park Oct. 5, before his pacesetting second-place finish to Orientate in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 26. Owned by Charles Mady and trained by Scott Lake, Thunderello retires with a career record of 7-3-3-0 and earnings of \$388,400.

**EBARAYA TOPS GOFFS SATURDAY** The three-year-old **Ebaraya (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells--Ebaziya {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}) was initially led out unsold at €800,000, but returned to the ring later in the session and attracted a final bid of €925,000 to top the opening day of the Goffs November Sale of Broodmares and Fillies in Co. Kildare, Ireland, yesterday. Consigned by Gilltown Stud as the property of Aga Khan Studs SC, the bay was purchased by Ardenode Stud. Ebaraya is a full sister to Ebadiyla (Ire), the champion three-year-old filly in 1997 and winner of the G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks and G1 Prix Royal Oak; and a half-sister to Group 1 winners Enzeli (Ire) and Edabiya (Ire). The session topper broke her maiden in a handicap at Roscommon Sept. 3 and was most recently third in a Leopardstown handicap Oct. 28. The second and final session of the sale will be held today.



**AVENTURA (IRE)** (c, 2, **Sri Pekan {USA}**--**La Belle Katherine {USA}**, by **Lyphard {USA}**) raced in a prominent third as 11-4 joint favourite Calbrae (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) set a good pace, but was pushed along to challenge at the top of the short stretch. The 3-1 chance was ridden vigorously from the eight pole and finished strongly in the latter stages to assert a neck superiority over the tenacious Calbrae. **WRITERS UP**

**TWO-YEAR-OLD REVIEW**

At the end of 2001, it was not Johannesburg (USA), Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) or Queen's Logic (Ire) that were giving the juvenile handicappers the biggest headache. This bone of contention was stabled not at Ballydoyle, Lambourn or Newmarket, but in Yorkshire.

For those who framed the international classifications it was **Captain Rio (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), trained by Richard Whitaker, who had forced his way into the reckoning. His eight-length romp through the mud in the strongly contested G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte at the end of October was, after much deliberation, considered a one-off triumph for the small man against the odds.

Twelve months later, the Captain Rio legacy has returned to haunt those who measure the merit of the season's juveniles. Like Whitaker's star, this year's pretenders to the crown of champion two-year-old colt and filly, **Tout Seul (Ire)** (Ali-Royal {Ire}) and **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}), hail from humble backdrops.

Fulke Johnson Houghton, who conditioned Ribofilio to win the Dewhurst in 1968, repeated the feat with Tout Seul, who had followed the route of sales races and valuable conditions races. Another esteemed veteran of the turf, Henry Candy, created a Cheveley Park heroine out of Airwave, who had failed to win Europe's richest two-year-old race, the DBS St Leger Yearling S.

Prior to dismissing supposed better-class rivals across the channel, Captain Rio had finished third in the St Leger Yearling S. and won the Redcar Two-Year-Old Trophy, which despite its huge purse mystifyingly still lacks stakes status. This term, Airwave finished a luckless fourth in the Doncaster jamboree before trouncing **Russian Rhythm (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}) at Newmarket, while Tout Seul was runner-up in the Redcar race, having won the Tattersalls Breeders S. at The Curragh in August.

What these immensely valuable conditions contests offer is a rich source of experience for the juveniles forward enough to take part. They offer the precocious the chance to become battle-hardened by the time they meet their rather more backward, lighter-campaigned rivals in the Group One tests of the fall.

This may explain how Tout Seul managed to sweep aside **Tomahawk (USA)** (Seattle Slew {USA}), who had missed most of the season through illness, in the Dewhurst. Or it may just be that he is the better horse. What is clear is that Captain Rio was no aberration. His record, and that of Tout Seul, Airwave and the gelding **Somnus (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who took the St Leger Yearling S. before inflicting defeat on Tout Seul at Redcar, marks a new era of the sales race, for it is in these ultra-competitive heats that early talent is honed.

Whether any of these juveniles can win Classics remains to be seen, but the general consensus is that they will not. The derisory 25-1 quote for the 2000 Guineas handed to Tout Seul after his greatest victory was bordering on insulting, considering that most winners of that seven-furlong contest are skinned into single figures for the Classics to come.

Heading the betting currently is the Houdini-like **Hold That Tiger (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}), whose run into third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile is likely to see him in the line-up for the Kentucky Derby on Guineas afternoon. He had previously extricated victory from the jaws of defeat with his startling late rattle in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp and he is sure to be judged as the best of O'Brien's team in the classifications. However, stable companions **Brian Boru (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), **Chevalier (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) and **Alberto Giacometti (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), who also made their mark at Group 1 level in the fall, offered promise of another Ballydoyle bonanza in 2003.

Chevalier took part in one of the finest two-year-old spectacles of the season when outpointed by a neck by **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) in the Criterium International at a rainwashed Saint-Cloud in early November. The way the pair pulled away from **Governor Brown (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}) will linger over the winter months and both colts look nailed-on to emerge as major Classic contenders. While Chevalier may stick to a mile, His Highness the Aga Khan's unbeaten half-brother to Daylami (Ire) looks assured to follow the route of Act One (GB) in 2001, with the aim of bettering that colt's runner-up placing in the Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby). His facile success in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp previously had stamped the grey as a serious prospect and he sets the standard among the French two-year-old colts, who generally failed to create any fireworks this year.

It was left to the fillies to steal the show in France and they took up the baton with enthusiasm.

On the same afternoon that **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}) sealed the title of champion juvenile filly with a stirring display in the Prix Marcel Boussac, **Intercontinental (GB)** (Danehill {USA}) was the first home of the domestic team when third behind Hold That Tiger in the Grand Criterium. While the Niarchos family may be tempted to send Six Perfections over to Newmarket in May to take on Russian Rhythm and the Fillies' Mile winner **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), Andre Fabre is likely to prime Intercontinental to win the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, the race in which her sister Banks Hill (GB) was a head runner-up in 2001.

Italy provided some quality in the shape of **Le Vie dei Colori (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), who split Hold That Tiger and Intercontinental on Arc day; and **Pleasure Place (Ire)** (Compton Place {GB}). Slap Shot (Ire), denied by the shortest of head verdicts in this year's Prix de l'Abbaye, has provided proof that Italy can produce top-class sprinters, and Pleasure Place's natural speed may prompt connections to be bold at three.

Germany's traditional two-year-old feature, the G3 Preis der Winterfavoriten, was won in style by **Eagle Rise (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}), who holds pole-position as he bids to emulate his sire's past domestic Classic winners Tiger Hill (Ire) and Royal Dragon (USA).

Others colts with scope to reach the top are **Oasis Dream (GB)** (Green Desert {USA}), who set a new race-record time in the Middle Park on lightning-fast ground; and **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), who outbattled **Van Nistelrooy (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) in the G1 National S. Injury denied G2 Champagne S. winner **Almushahar (USA)** (Silver Hawk {USA}) the opportunity to live up to his connections' comparisons with the great Dubai Millennium (GB) in the Dewhurst, where the huge **Trade Fair (GB)** (Zafonic {USA}), who had trailed Godolphin's colt in his Newmarket maiden, filled third spot. **Statue of Liberty (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}), unsighted since winning the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot in June, remains an enigma, while G1 Prix Morny hero **Elusive City (USA)** (Elusive Quality {USA}) will be a force to be reckoned with in the major sprints of 2003 if connections can channel his nervous energy.

With the 2002 international classifications seemingly wide-open, it remains to be seen whether they will reflect the shifting patterns among the juveniles when they are set out in January. Just how far adrift of the regally bred Hold That Tiger, Dalakhani and Six Perfections will Tout Seul, Airwave and Somnus, who cost no more than 35,000 guineas between them, be in the charts?
