### SOPHOMORE FILLIES CLASH IN FALLS CITY

Each the winner of important races within the sophomore filly division this season, **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) and **Allamerican Bertie** (Quiet American) should start the two favorites in this afternoon's GII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs. Trained by Ken McPeek, the former towered over her peers this past spring, capping

a three-race winning streak with a blowout victory in Keeneland's GI Ashland S., but has been somewhat less consistent this fall. The attractive dark bay, who returned from a 3 1/2-month absence to be a solid second to Imperial Gesture in the GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Sept. 7, romped to a 2 1/2-length score in

the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 5, but is coming into this off a disappointing sixth in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. "I'm excited about it," McPeek commented. "I think she deserves to get a little redemption after what happened to her in the Breeders' Cup. She didn't run well." Take Charge Lady was found to have had a guttural pouch infection following the race. The GIII Delaware Oaks winner, Allamerican Bertie nearly wired the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 17, just getting caught by Farda Amiga. A distant fifth in the GI Beldame S. in her first try versus older Oct. 5, the bay registered an impressive eight-length allowance victory over the Churchill turf course Nov. 7 and is in receipt of five pounds from the likely favorite.

### A PIVOTAL OPENER AT TATTS

Day one of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale was topped yesterday when a colt by locally-based sire Pivotal (GB) out of the Persian Bold mare Persian Air returned 60,000gns when sold by 93-year-old breeder Evelyn Charlton from Trickle-down Stud. Irish pinhooker Eddie O'Leary, acting through agent Margaret O'Toole, is the recipient of the colt, for whom Japanese trainer Masamaichi Wada was underbidder. "I saw him a couple of days ago and thought he was the standout lot today," said O'Toole. "The sire has had a fantastic year and I would imagine Eddie will resell this colt next year." Pivotal, who stood the 2001 season at Cheveley Park Stud for £5,000, but has a £25,000 fee for the coming year, is responsible for the smart fillies Golden Apples (Ire) and Megahertz (GB) in the U.S. and Group 1-winning British sprinter Kyllachy (GB) this season. Yesterday is traditionally the weakest of the four weanling days at this sales and the second best price of 34,000gns came for a Mark Of Esteem (Ire) colt offered from Helshaw Grange Stud as agent. Joss Collins of Blandford Bloodstock, buying for James Egan's Corduff Stud, bought the chestnut, who is another likely to be resold next year. Although yesterday had only a 57 percent clearance rate, the turnover, average and median all showed big advances on a disappointing corresponding day a year ago. The sale continues today, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

**Hero's Tribute** (10-1) gets a generous seven-pound pull from top weighted **Lido Palace (Chi)** (9-5) and could pull the upset at a nice price. A 3/4-length winner of a seven-furlong allowance test beneath the Twin Spires during the spring meeting, the John Oxley colorbearer finished a solid third in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic two back, but turned in a sharp performance when accounting for Balto Star in the Black Tie Affair H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard at Arlington. Jockey Edgar Prado flies in for the mount. Lido Palace successfully defended his championship in the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Sept. 7, besting **Gander** (8-1) by three parts of a length before finishing runner-up in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Sept. 28. The five-year-old, whose connections passed on the Breeders' Cup Classic, prepped for the Clark with a 1/2-length allowance score at Belmont Oct. 20. **Tenpins** (7-2), winner in his most recent start of the GIII Fayette S. at Keeneland Oct. 26, looks to make it six wins from seven starts this season.

**Mandy's Gold** returns to one turn off her fifth-place finish behind Azeri in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, her only off-the-board finish in 12 starts this term. The Virginia-bred has tallied three graded stakes among her five wins this year, including her first Grade I success in the 8 1/2-furlong Ruffian H. at Belmont Sept. 14. Three-year-old **Sightseek**, a half sister to turf star **Tates Creek**, is three-for-four in her young career, capped by a visually impressive 3 1/4-length score in the GIII Raven Run S. at Keeneland Oct. 9. Purchased for \$1.075 million at the Keeneland November Sale, **Nasty Storm** makes her first start for Stronach Stables on Friday. The chestnut most recently registered a 14-1 upset in the GII Gallant Bloom H. at Belmont Oct. 6.

**COMMITTEE NAMES THREE NEW GRADE I RACES** After reviewing 741 unrestricted U.S. stakes with purses of at least \$75,000, the American Graded Stakes Committee has assigned graded status to 487 of them for 2003. The list includes 16 races upgraded and 15 downgraded from 2002. Three races were upgraded to Grade I status: the Suburban H. at Belmont Park, the Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park and the Diana H. at Saratoga. Three races run as Grade I events this year, will be run next year as Grade II races: the Gulfstream Park H. at Gulfstream Park, the Oaklawn H. at Oaklawn Park and the Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood Park. The Illinois Derby, originally scheduled to be downgraded to a Grade III race in 2003, will retain its Grade II status. There are 101 scheduled Grade I events for 2003 and 155 Grade IIs. Both figures remain constant with 2002. There are 231 Grade III races, one more than this year.

**NOTE:** The American Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has decided not to reinstate the Grade II status of last weekend's Red Smith H. at Aqueduct. Taken off the turf, it should be recorded as a Grade III for this running only.

**VERNE WINCHELL DIES** Verne Winchell, who founded a donut company which bore his name in 1948, died from a heart attack Tuesday at his home in Las Vegas. He was 87 years old. Often referred to as "The Donut King," Winchell bought his first horse at auction in the early 1960s and named him Donut King, who went on to win the Champagne S. in 1961 and was one of the favorites for the Kentucky Derby the following season, only to suffer an injury in his final pre-race workout. "That was our first good horse," recalled trainer Ron McAnally. "That was the best chance I had of winning the Derby." Winchell campaigned two champions in his life, Mira Femme, the co-champion two-year-old filly of 1966, and her descendant Tight Spot, who took down honors as champion turf horse in 1991. The latter's full brother, Valiant Nature, won the GI Hollywood Futurity two years later and also took Winchell to Louisville, where he finished a troubled 13th behind Go for Gin. Other horses owned by Winchell include Fleet Renee, Olympio, Amerique, On Target, Call Now, Sea Cadet and Future Quest. He is survived by his wife and a son. The family intends on retaining the farm and horses.

Vespers captured her career debut on the dirt at Saratoga, but all of her subsequent starts had come on the turf. She had finished third in her two most recent outings, including a dead-heat for the show Sept. 19 at Belmont. The second choice in this off-the-turf contest, the dark bay kept Shooting Party in her sights down the backstretch, took charge turning for home and skipped over the off going under a hand ride.
