### TATTS BREEDING STOCK SALE BEGINS

The final leg of Tattersalls' 2002 December Sales, the four-day breeding stock section, begins today at 9:30 a.m. in Newmarket. The 1,315 lots catalogued include broodmares, fillies in and out of training, stallions and stallion prospects. Although seven-figure transactions look unlikely, there should be strong interest in the breeding stock dispersal from the late Prince Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud.

The dispersal, which was

begun at Keeneland in November, will be sold Wednesday through Voute Sales and includes lot 2059, G2 Challenge S. winner **Last Resort (GB)** (Lahib), in foal to Mozart (Ire); lot 2062, G2 Lowther S. winner **Velvet Moon (Ire)** (Shaadi), the dam of Group 2 winner Moon Ballad (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}); and lot 2063, 19-year-old **Victoria Cross** (Spectacular Bid), who is carrying a full sibling to Mozart (Danehill). Many top breeders are present this year, including the Wildenstein family, who will offer lot 1504, the recent French Listed winner **Place Rouge (Ire)** (Desert King {Ire}), from the family of Peintre Celebre. Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard is represented by **Acceleration (Fr)** (Acatenango {Ger}), lot 1477, a Group 3 winner in foal to Galileo (Ire). Only two mares are offered with a Sadler's Wells covering, including lot 1475, the Listed-placed **Fantasy Royale** (Pleasant Colony), consigned by Glenvale Stud. Among the top racing prospects is **Jessica's Dream (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}), lot 1557, a Group 3 winner for trainer James Given this year. "Last year's December Breeding Stock Sale was exceptionally strong, but the foal trade last week has suggested we can expect a good solid trade this week," said Jimmy George, marketing director at Tattersalls. "It's a good catalogue with enormous strength in depth and plenty to appeal to the usual global audience." The sale runs through Thursday, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day.

### THRILLING FINISH IN THE MATRIARCH

The only three-year-old in the field, **Dress To Thrill (Ire)** (Danehill) fought her way past **Golden Apples (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) in the final strides to take the GI Matriarch S. by a head at Hollywood Park yesterday afternoon. Stretching out past a mile for the first time, the Moyglare Stud Farm homebred was on the bit while sitting fourth behind the dueling pair of **Affluent** (Affirmed) and an unusually eager **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill). Golden Apples, just off the top two early, forged to the outside as they raced down the stretch, but Dress To Thrill closed with stout determination to take the photo. "We've always thought a lot of this filly," jockey Patrick Smullen said. "She's a high-class filly and she proved that today." **Magic Mission (GB)** (Machiavellian), the rank outsider at 31-1, came on to be third.

**DRESS REHEARSAL Dress To Thrill** had shown promise at two, breaking her maiden with a neck victory over \$4.4 million KEESEP yearling Shah Jehan in the Listed Tyro S. and running second by 3/4 of a length behind Quarter Moon (Ire) in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. The bay filly was a perfect four-for-four in Europe this season, winning four straight stakes including the Oct. 5 G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket, before making her U.S. bow in the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile. She failed to fire in that event and finished eighth, but rebounded nicely from that effort, handling the added furlong and her elders with aplomb. "The Breeders' Cup did not reflect her true ability," trainer Dermot Weld said. "It was a very soft turf and this filly wants what she got [Sunday]...she wants a firm turf." Trainer Ben Cecil is hoping that **Golden Apples** will still get the Eclipse despite her runner-up finish. "She has been there in every big race this year," he said. "It's tough to see who else you could give it to...I certainly think she deserves it." **Banks Hill**, the crowd's 13-10 choice after a second-place finish in the G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, tired to be fourth. Trainer Bobby Frankel blamed "bad instructions" for the performance. "I thought there'd be no pace," he said. Added jockey Jerry Bailey, "I don't think she wants to run like that. On the board in four straight stakes, Johar finally broke through with a win in the Oct. 13 GII Oak Tree Derby and he came back to make it two in a row. A winner in his first two turf tries, the bay took a break after running fourth in the Apr. 14 La Puente S. at Santa Anita. He returned to run second by a neck in the June 1 GIII Will Rogers S., then finished third, a nose and a half-length behind Inesperado (Zayyani {Ire}), in the June 30 GIII Cinema Breeders' Cup H. Second to Rock Opera (Royal Academy) in a division of the July 24 Oceanside S. and to Inesperado in the Sept. 7 GII Del Mar Derby, The Thoroughbred Corporation's homebred colorbearer was pinched back at the break, but turned the tables with a nose win over Rock Opera last time as Inesperado could do no better than fourth. Johar was squeezed at the start again this time and trailed the field for six furlongs, but launched a five-wide rally in the stretch that carried him to victory. "A lot of horses might have been upset by what happened at the start, but he didn't care," jockey Alex Solis, celebrating his third Hollywood Derby win, said. "As soon as I got him clear, he came on strong." Added Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella, "I'm excited to think toward next year at a mile and a quarter, a mile and a half--some of the better races and what he might be." Along Came Mary went missing after finishing third in this race last year, returning nine months later to destroy statebred competition by 13 lengths in the Jack Betta Be Rite S. at Finger Lakes Aug. 24. Trainer H. James Bond tried the filly on the turf in the Maryland Millions Ladies S. at Pimlico Sept. 21, where she ran a disappointing 11th. She suffered a similar fate in the Gill Turn Back The Alarm H. at the Big A Nov. 3, finishing a well-beaten fifth in her return to the dirt, but sparkled here as she once again took on New York-breds. The chestnut saved ground along the inside up the backstretch, challenged for the lead along the rail and sprinted clear of running-on Princess Dixie despite drifting out in the final panel. A stewards inquiry revealed no foul. "We had a great trip behind the speed," said jockey Noberto Arroyo Jr. "We were able to find some room along the rail and she just exploded."

Promising filly Lacie Girl has yet to find a peer who can beat her to the finish line, and the Jerry Hollendorfer trainee showed plenty of heart here to keep her record spotless. The chestnut came off a wire-to-wire debut victory going six furlongs at Bay Meadows in mid-September to beat \$40,000 optional claimers Sept. 26, then schooled that level again with a sharp 5 1/2-length victory in 1:08 4/5 on Halloween. Off as the tepid bettor's pick in her route, stakes and Golden Gate debut, the late-blooming three-year-old was well-placed off the leaders in third up the backstretch. She seemed to flatten out after making a move with two furlongs to run, but showed gritty determination to get the head bob over Lindsay Jean at the wire.

## WRITERS UP

### REVIEW OF THE 2002 IRISH SEASON by Tom Frary

**Johannesburg (USA)** (Hennessy {USA}), the previous year's champion juvenile, provided an early focus of attention when he stepped forward for his Kentucky Derby prep in the G3 Gladness S. at The Curragh in early April. Few expected to witness his first defeat there, but they had reckoned without **Rebelline (Ire)** (Robellino {USA}), whose late flourish ensured the first major upset of the 2002 season. Kevin Prendergast made hay in the wet spring, when ground conditions favoured the tough and talented filly. She swiftly collected the Listed Mooresbridge S., in which the injury-stricken **Milan (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) sadly limped off the scene before beating **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) and **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}) in the Tattersalls Gold Cup. Her exploits as giant-killer were all the more meritorious as she was troubled by arthritis throughout her four-year-old campaign.

Johannesburg's defeat was a rare setback for trainer Aidan O'Brien, whose sixth straight Irish trainers' title was founded upon the Classic successes of **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) and **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). Although uncompetitive on the face of it, the Irish 2000 Guineas provided the most vivid display of the "Rock's" dominance over his peers in 2002. He was never off the bit to compliment his Newmarket victory and although High Chaparral needed more encouragement to become the 15th colt to complete the English-Irish Derby double in June, he made light work of his task when getting serious. O'Brien's domestic achievements are sometimes overshadowed by his international forays which is no surprise considering that he collected 19 Group 1 successes this year, just four short of his record-breaking 2001 tally, despite a virus affecting the majority of his string in mid-summer. However, it is long odds that anybody will ever match his feat of saddling a one-two-three in both the Irish Guineas and Derby in the same year. That coughing bout set back the two-year-olds, but **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) got going when the going got tough for his ill stable companion **Hold That Tiger (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) in the Phoenix S. back at The Curragh in August.

Jim Bolger added variety to the domestic scene when 33-1 shot **Margarula (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}) poached the Irish Oaks from **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). That family affair--the winner was owned and bred by Bolger and his wife Jackie and ridden by son-in-law Kevin Manning--gave Bolger the belated Irish Classic success he had sought since St Jovite (USA) took the Irish Derby in 1992.

**Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) may in time prove aptly-named and there was much to like about the way he outbattled G2 Futurity S. winner **Van Nistelrooy (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) in the National S. He formed the final leg of a weekend Group 1 double for Melbourne Cup hero Dermot Weld initiated by the remarkable **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}) in the Irish St Leger. That colt, who has an endearing habit of delivering every time, has the material to reach the legendary status afforded to only a few past and present compatriots.

The Irish did not have things all their own way, with the Irish 1000 Guineas falling to the impressive **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) and **Mail The Desert (Ire)** (Desert Prince {Ire}) taking the Moyglare Stud S. Jockeys Michael Kinane and Johnny Murtagh's title battle, which went right to the wire, with Kinane prevailing for his 12th championship, provided a rattling good climax to a great year. A year in which Irish racing continued to raise the bar.
