VELVETY SMOOTH AT TATTS

The major breeding stock reduction of the late Prince Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud brought 4,213,000gns for 16 head sold at yesterday's penultimate session of the Tattersalls December Sales yesterday. Leading the way was the 11-year-old **Velvet Moon (Ire)** (Shaadi), covered by Daylami (Ire), who had twin boasts as winner of the G2 Lowther S. and dam of this season's G2 Dante S. winner Moon Ballad (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}). Her fanciers included Charlie Gordon-Watson, underbidder

John Ferguson and finally Anthony Penfold, Salman's former racing manager, who clinched the deal at 875,000gns. "I'm afraid I can't say anything about where she is going," said Penfold. "I'm very pleased to renew my association with her. The last time I bought her was for 30,000gns here as a yearling. She was a top racemare and has become a top broodmare." Ferguson had prevailed shortly

before when getting the G2 Challenge S. winner **Last Resort (GB)** (Lahib), in foal to Mozart (Ire), for 825,000gns. Charlie Gordon-Watson, acting for Watership Down Stud, was underbidder. "She is for Darley and is a beautiful mare," said Ferguson. "She was very good on the racecourse and is a young mare in foal to an exciting horse who sadly died this year. It's a great family and we're very excited to have her. The family has worked really well with the Sharpen Up-line so Halling could be a possibility next year." Mozart (Ire)'s dam **Victoria Cross** (Spectacular Bid) will join the Coolmore broodmare ranks after selling for 600,000gns in foal to Mozart's sire Danehill. Earlier Anthony Penfold's Bugley Stud had success as a vendor when selling the Listed winning **Pink Cristal (GB)** (Dilum) for 720,000gns to Hugo Lascelles Bloodstock with Charlie Gordon-Watson again the underbidder. "She was bought to go to America but she will foal here first and be bred - I don't know to who," said Lascelles. "It's a great family, you have lots of daughters working for you and there is no Northern Dancer."

SPEND A BUCK DIES IN BRAZIL Spend a Buck (Buckaroo--Belle de Jour, by Speak John), the 1985 Kentucky Derby winner and that season's horse of the year, died last month from anaphylactic shock while at stud in Brazil. He was 20 years old. Third to Chief's Crown in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the bay became eligible for a \$2 million bonus put up by Garden State Park's Robert Brennan for any horse which won the Cherry Hill Mile, the Kentucky Derby and Jersey Derby. A 5 1/4-length winner beneath the Twin Spires, he defeated Creme Fraiche by a neck in the Jersey Derby to secure the bonus. He made only two additional starts, finishing second to Skip Trial in the GI Haskell H. and winning the GI Monmouth H. by a nose en route to year-end honors as top three-year-old. Spend a Buck stood the 2001 breeding season at Red River Farms in Louisiana and was relocated to Haras Bage do Sul in Brazil later that year. He was the sire of 30 stakes winners and two champions, both in South America. His best North American runner was Antepend, a Grade I winner on turf and dirt.


CONGAREE TO REMAIN IN TRAINING Stonerside Stables' Congaree (Arazi), impressive winner of Saturday's GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct, will remain in training as a five-year-old, trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's just getting his act together," the gray-haired conditioner said. "I've finally got him to where he was as a three-year-old." That sophomore campaign included wins in the GII Wood Memorial in New York and the GI Swaps S. out west as well as third-place finishes in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness. Congaree has seven career victories from 14 trips to the post and earnings in excess of \$1.6 million.

Trainer Rice Injured By Kick:

New York based trainer Linda Rice was injured when she was kicked by a horse in her barn at Belmont Park Tuesday. The 38-year-old suffered a cracked rib and a puncture wound to her left arm in the incident. "I've got a puncture wound in my arm and they want to make sure that it doesn't bleed [and get infected]," the conditioner told *Daily Racing Form* Tuesday from North Shore Hospital, where she remained overnight for observation. "If I had gotten kicked in my spine, it could have been a lot worse."

"Working in company was a big help," Ward admitted. "He broke off about 10 lengths behind another horse and just blew by in the stretch. The boy had his chin to his chest and he just pulled him up." The California-bred gelding looks to join Native Desert and John Henry to win a Hollywood stakes event at age nine.
